LEADING OFF

- Virginia climbed back to the .500 mark for the first time since March 17 with a 7-6, 12-inning win over William & Mary on Tuesday at Disharoon Park.
- The Cavaliers finish a stretch that includes seven road games in a 13-days this weekend. The Cavaliers return home Wednesday to take on Old Dominion and will play nine of the next 10 at Disharoon Park.
- Clemson is the first team not ranked inside the D1Baseball Top 25 that Virginia will play on the Weekend since ACC play started.
- Virginia is 5-6 on the road in 2021 and has won three of the last four away from Charlottesville.

MIDWEEK NOTES

- Virginia climbed back to the .500 mark for the first time since March 17 with a 7-6, 12-inning win over William & Mary on Tuesday at Disharoon Park.
- The Cavaliers registered their third comeback win of the season, rallying from two runs down in the ninth to stay unblemished at home (5-0) against midweek opponents.
- Devin Ortiz delivered a one-out, two-run double in the bottom of the ninth to tie the game at six and Zack Gelof drove in the game-winning run in the 12th on a bases loaded sacrifice fly. It was the first Cavalier walk-off since 2018.
- William and Mary put the go-ahead run on in the 10th, 11th and 12th innings but the combination of Stephen Shoch, Luck Schauer and Matt Wyatt did not allow a run to score. Wyatt was credited with the win, pitching the final 1.1 innings.

AGAINST CLEMSON

- The Tigers own a 108-56 advantage in the all-time series that was first played in 1955. Under Brian O'Connor, Virginia is 27-12 against Clemson.
- This weekend will be Virginia's first visit to Clemson since 2017. The Cavaliers have won three of the last four series at Clemson.
- The two schools played three, one-run games in their last ACC series against one another in 2018. It marked a stretch of six consecutive one-run contests against ACC opponents for UVA that season.
- Clemson has won five of the last six against Virginia, its only blemish coming in the 2017 ACC Tournament, a 10-2 UVA victory.

ON THE MOUND

- As a staff, Virginia has struck out 296 batters, the 10th most in the NCAA this season. Collectively, its 10.7 strikeouts per nine innings ranks 24th in all of college baseball.
- Two of the lowest six ERAs among qualified ACC pitchers will start on the mound this weekend for Virginia. Andrew Abbott carries a 2.49 ERA and is the fourth-lowest ERA in the league while Mike Vasil's 2.52 ranks sixth.
- Through 28 games this season, Virginia pitchers own a staff ERA of 3.58 the second lowest in the ACC. The Cavaliers and Florida State are the only two teams in the league with three shutouts this season.
- Andrew Abbott comes into Friday with 224 career strikeouts, nine shy of cracking Virginia's top-10 all-time. His 13.29 strikeouts per nine innings are the third highest among active NCAA pitchers. The lefty ranks second in the league in strikeouts (59) and third in innings pitched (43.1).

· Saturday night starter Mike Vasil has produced a quality start in five of seven chances this season. He has not walked a batter in consecutive starts and has the lowest walks per nine innings ratio (0.92) in the ACC.

· Nate Savino will make his first ACC start of the season and second of his career. Virginia is 6-0 in his six career starts, including a 10-3 series clinching win over NC State in 2020.

· Blake Bales pitched three innings of scoreless relief and stranded both inherited runners in the sixth inning by retiring three-straight batters. He has allowed two of his 16 inherited runners to score this season and has yet to allow an earned run in 22.1 innings.

NOTES/TRENDS

- Virginia is 4-1 in its last five games and averaging 7.6 runs per game in that span.
- The Cavaliers sport a .977 fielding percentage, the fourth-highest in the league. Virginia has committed just two errors in the last five games.
- In the last 10 games, Devin Oritz is batting .351 (13-for-37) with three homers, 13 RBI and 10 runs scored. The first baseman has scored a run and hit safely in his last eight games.
- Senior Alex Tappen was 5-for-6 with three doubles, four runs scored and 2 RBI against Georgia Tech. He doubled in each game, two of them came as a pinch-hitter. He is sitting on 99 hits for his career.
- Zack Gelof produced has produced back-to-back three-RBI efforts including the walk-off sacrifice fly to win on Tuesday. He leads the team with six multi-RBI games and has put together multi-hit efforts in three of his last four games.

ONE RUN AFFAIRS

- The Cavaliers were involved in five, one-run decisions in their first seven games of the 2021 season, matching a school record set in 1938 and 1951.
- The North Carolina series marked the first time Virginia played an ACC series with each game decided by a run since 2018 when it played six-straight starting with Louisville on the road and ending with a three-game set against Clemson at Disharoon Park.
- The Cavaliers have played a total of six ACC series in which all three games were decided by a run in the Brian O'Connor era.

CLOSING THE DOOR

- Closer Stephen Schoch is 5-for-6 in save attempts this season. No save was more stressful than the seven-out heart-stopper at Florida State. The righthander escaped two bases loaded jams and left the tying run on second in the ninth inning in an eventual 2-1 victory. The save was Schoch's longest as a Cavalier and fourth save that has required four or more outs.
- Schoch's 23 career saves are the fourth most among active NCAA pitchers. 10 of the 23 have come in a Cavalier uniform.
- Two more saves and Schoch will enter the top-10 all-time in career saves at UVA.
