LEADING OFF

- Virginia is in the midst of an eight-game stretch in which seven will be played at home. Virginia will not leave the Commonwealth for a game for more than a month (4/16-5/20) until the final series of the year at Boston College.
- Virginia head coach Brian O'Connor is 299-195-1 all-time in ACC play and is looking to become the eighth ACC coach ever to reach the 300-win plateau.
- Duke is the first unranked ACC opponent to come to Disharoon Park this season, the previous four opponents at home have been inside the D1Baseball Top 25.
- Virginia is 10-10 at home this season and 3-9 against ACC foes in its home ballpark.

AGAINST DUKE

- The Blue Devils have taken the last two ACC series against the Cavaliers including their first ever series win in Charlottesville in 2019.
- Duke took both games of a doubleheader in 2019, 2-1 and 6-8 to clinch the series.
- The Cavaliers own a 102-62-1 advantage in the all-time series against Duke that was first played in 1926, an 8-2 Virginia victory.
- Under head coach Brian O'Connor, Virginia owns a 35-16 mark against Duke. The Cavaliers won all but one game in a 16-game stretch from 2009-14.
- The last seven meetings have all been decided by three or less runs including three one-run affairs.

MIDWEEK REVIEW

- In its final non-conference road game of the season Virginia dropped a 5-3 decision against VCU at The Diamond.
- VCU scored three first inning runs and never trailed in its fourth win in 25 tries against Virginia since 2004.
- Reliever Zach Messinger kept the game at bay, tossing a career-high 4.1 innings of scoreless baseball. The righthander fanned 10 batters, the third most in a single game by a UVA pitcher this season.
- The two teams will wrap up their home-and-home series on May 4 in Charlottesville.

ON THE MOUND

- The Virginia pitching staff comes into the weekend with a 4.02 ERA, the third lowest in the ACC and its 362 strikeouts rank 15th in the NCAA.
- Virginia has struck out 10 or more batters in six of the last 10 games. Opponents have struck out 10 or more times on 21 different occasions this season and Virginia is 12-9 when compiling 10 or more strikeouts in a game.
- Friday's starting pitcher, Andrew Abbott, is tied for the ACC lead and ranks fifth in the nation with 77 strikeouts. The lefthander fanned 11 last week against then-No. 7 Louisville, his second 10+ strikeout performance of the season.
- Abbott moved into the top 10 of UVA's career strikeout list and now sits at No. 9 with 242 career strikeouts one behind current Cincinnati Reds reliever Sean Doolittle for 8th. Abbott has averaged 13.44 strikeouts per nine innings over the course of his career, the second highest of any active NCAA pitcher.

- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

· Junior Mike Vasil is scheduled to make his 26th career start in a Cavalier uniform on Saturday, the most starts of anyone on the staff.

· Vasil is tied for the league lead with five wins. His 1.07 walks allowed per nine innings and 8.17 strikeout-to-walk ratio are tops in the Atlantic Coast Conference.

· Abbott and Vasil have each struck out 23 batters looking the season, the second only to Florida State's Parker Messick's 24.

· Closer Stephen Schoch is second in the ACC with six saves and is sitting at 11 saves in two seasons at UVA, one shy of cracking the program's all-time top-10. His 24 career saves are the fourth most of any active NCAA pitcher

NOTES/TRENDS

· The one-run affair in the opener against Louisville was Virginia's seventh in ACC play and the Cavaliers improve to 4-4 in one-run games against league opponents. So far in 2021, 11 of Virginia's 24 conference games have been decided by one or two runs.

· Duke and Miami are the only two teams in the Coastal Division not to play 24 games this season. Only Florida State has reached the 24-game mark in the Atlantic Division.

· Devin Ortiz had his 14-game hit streak come to an end on Tuesday at VCU. It was the longest by a Cavalier since 2018. Over the course of the streak Ortiz is batted .411 (23-for-56) with 15 runs scored, five doubles, three homers and 13 RBI.

· For the third-straight game, Brendan Rivoli put forth a two-hit game with a 2-for-4 effort against VCU on Tuesday. The senior leads the team with 14 multi-hit games this season.

· Nic Kent reached base in all four trips to the plate against VCU and went 2-for-2 with a pair of walks and two runs scored. It was his first multi-hit effort since going 2-for-4 with a grand slam against Georgia Tech on April 2. The Cavalier shortstop also stole his ninth base of the season, tied for the seventh most in the ACC.

· Zack Gelof has enjoyed his time as the team's table setter of lineup. He's batted first in the last 11 games and is 18-for-53 (.340) with three homers and 11 RBI.

RECORD SETTERS

- Since 2000, no Cavalier relief pitcher has ever struck out 10 or more batters in a game until Zach Messinger fanned 10 on Tuesday against VCU.
- Logan Michaels threw out four out of five runners attempting to steal in Saturday's loss against Louisville, the most in a single game by a UVA catcher since 2000.

ONE RUN AFFAIRS

- The Cavaliers were involved in five, one-run decisions in their first seven games of the 2021 season, matching a school record set in 1938 and 1951.
- The North Carolina series marked the first time Virginia played an ACC series with each game decided by a run since 2018 when it played six-straight starting with Louisville on the road and ending with a three-game set against Clemson at Disharoon Park.
- The Cavaliers have played a total of six ACC series in which all three games were decided by a run in the Brian O'Connor era.

CLOSING THE DOOR

- Closer Stephen Schoch is 6-for-7 in save attempts this season. No save was more stressful than the seven-out heart-stopper at Florida State. The righthander escaped two bases loaded jams and left the tying run on second in the ninth inning in an eventual 2-1 victory. The save was Schoch's longest as a Cavalier and fourth save that has required four or more outs.
- Schoch's 24 career saves are the fourth most among active NCAA pitchers. 11 of the 24 have come in a Cavalier uniform.
- One more save and Schoch will enter the top-10 all-time in career saves at UVA.
