Game Notes

- UVA's nine-game home winning streak was snapped. It was tied for the tenth-longest in the nation among active streaks and was tied for the third-longest of the UVA modern era. UVA has only lost two of its last 15 games at Scott Stadium (2018 vs. Pitt; 2020 vs. NC State).
- For the 36th time under Bronco Mendenhall, UVA held an opponent (363) under 400 yards of total offense. UVA is 21-15 in those games, including 16-7 since the start of 2018.
- UVA attempted 64 passes, which ranks No. 2 all-time in program history for a game.
- UVA's 24-0 deficit to start the game was the most it has trailed during the home winning streak.
- UVA allowed a blocked punt for the first time since 2018 (vs. VT).

- Stone finished with career highs in completions (30), attempts (53), yards (240) and touchdowns (3).
- WR Terrell Jana finished with nine receptions, including notching his 100th career pass in the third quarter. Jana is the 23rd Cavalier all-time to record 100+ career receptions and 1000+ career receiving yards.
- Jana extends his streak with at least one catch to 19 games.
- Finishing with 111 receiving yards, Jana surpassed 100 for the first time this season and third time in his career.

- QB Brennan Armstrong connected with RB Shane Simpson for a 71-yard scoring strike, which were career longs for both Cavaliers. The 71-yard receiving touchdown was the longest by a Cavalier since Joe Reed went 75 yards at Virginia Tech in 2018 and it was the longest by a Cavalier running back since Taquan Mizzell scored on an 80-yard reception against William & Mary in 2015.

Game Notes

- UVA held Abilene Christian to 62 yards rushing. It is the 16th time in the Bronco Mendenhall era the Cavaliers have held their opponent under 100 rushing yards. UVA's record is 15-1 in such games, including 3-0 in 2020.
- UVA scored on a one-play, 90-yard touchdown play on the final play of the first quarter. It is the second-longest one-play scoring drive in school history. A 93-yard one-play scoring drive against Wake Forest in 1982 is the longest.
- UVA scored on a 90-yard play to end the first quarter and a one-yard play to end the second quarter. It has had an 84-yard pick-6 to end the game.
- WR Lavel Davis Jr. caught a 90-yard touchdown pass from QB Brennan Armstrong. It was a career long for both players. It is also tied for the fifth-longest pass play in program history. It is the longest by a Cavalier since Emmanuel Byers found Deyon Williams for 90 yards against Miami in 2005. The pass play is tied for the fifth longest in the nation this season and is the longest in the ACC so far this season.
- Davis Jr.'s 90-yard touchdown is the second-longest by a true freshman in program history, second only to Tyrone Davis' 91-yard score in 1991 against NC State.
- QB Brennan Armstrong finished with a career-high 383 passing yards. It is the first career game with 300+ passing yards.
- Armstrong set a career high with four passing touchdowns. Coming into the game he had only one pass of 50 yards or more. Three of his four passing touchdowns came on passes of 90, 56 and 52 yards.
- Armstrong becomes the first Cavalier to throw at least three passes of 50+ yards in a single game.
- Armstrong is the first UVA quarterback since Bryce Perkins in the 2019 Orange Bowl to throw for at least four touchdowns in a game. It marked the 24th time a UVA quarterback threw for 4+ touchdowns in a game.
- OLB D'Sean Perry closed the game on an 84-yard interception return for a touchdown, which is the fifth-longest return in program history. Perry made his collegiate debut in the game.

Game Notes

- The win over Boston College is the first in series history. They were 0-6 prior to the win against the Eagles.
Virginia played its third all-time regular season game at Scott Stadium in the month of December (3-0).
Virginia has scored 30+ points in four-straight games (4-0).
UVA finished with 549 yards of total offense. It is the first time since 2014 (vs. Kent State and vs. BYU) the Cavaliers had 500+ yards in back-to-back games. They had 518 last time out against Abilene Christian.
UVA finished with 262 rushing yards. It marks the third time in 2020 the Cavaliers have surpassed 200 yards rushing.
UVA held Boston College to -7 yards rushing. It is the first time UVA held an opponent to negative yards rushing since 2012 when the Cavaliers held Maryland to -2 yards rushing.
UVA held its fourth opponent of 2020 under 100 yards rushing. UVA is 4-0 in those games. UVA is 16-1 all-time under Bronco Mendenhall when holding an opponent under 100 yards rushing.
UVA's 95-yard scoring drive in the second quarter is the second-longest drive of the season. UVA has five drives this season of 90 yards or more. Five scoring drives of 90+ yards in the same season is a UVA single-season record.
QB Brennan Armstrong finished with 417 yards of total offense. It is the first time a UVA quarterback has 400+ yards of total offense in back-to-back games. He had 435 against Abilene Christian last time out. It is only the seventh time in program history a UVA quarterback has recorded 400+ yards of total offense in a game. Six of the seven quarterbacks that have accomplished this feat have done so since 2016 during the Bronco Mendenhall era.
Armstrong finished with a career-high 130 yards rushing. He is the first Cavalier in 2020 with 100+ yards rushing. He is the first UVA quarterback to rush for 100+ yards since Bryce Perkins in 2019 vs. VT (164).

- UVA played game No. 10 of the season, becoming one of 17 FBS programs in 2020 that has not been the reason for a COVID-19 postponement or cancellation in 2020 and has reached 10 games played. They join: Army (10); Auburn (10); Boston College (11); Clemson (10); Coastal Carolina (11); Duke (11); Georgia Southern (12); Iowa State (10); Kansas State (10); Kentucky (10); Oklahoma State (10); South Carolina (10); Syracuse (11); Texas State (12); West Virginia (10); Western Kentucky (11).
UVA and VT met for the first time in series history in the month of December (102 games).
UVA's 322 yards of total offense was its lowest output of the season.
WR Lavel Davis Jr. had three catch for 75 yards. Fourteen of his 20 receptions this season have gone for 20+ yards. All but one have gone for a first down or a touchdown.
Davis moved into second place on UVA's freshman receiving list, passing Billy McMullen (483, 1999), Herman Moore (466, 1988) and Tyrone Davis (465, 1991). Davis Jr.'s season total after the game is 515 receiving yards.
WR Terrell Jana (24) and TE Tony Poljan (66) each went over 400 receiving yards for the season, joining both WR Billy Kemp IV and WR Lavel Davis Jr. It is just the third time since 2000 UVA has had four different receivers with 400+ receiving yards in the same season. It also happened in 2003 and 2016. The only other time UVA has had at least four players each with 400+ yards receiving was 1991.
With nine receptions, WR Billy Kemp IV became the 26th Cavalier in program history with at least 100 career receptions. Kemp IV currently has 102 career receptions, tying him for No. 24 all-time at UVA with Canaan Severin.
With three receptions, WR Terrell Jana extended his active streak with a reception to 27 games.
With 24 receiving yards, Jana moved passed former teammate Joe Reed (1,465) for No. 17 all-time on the UVA career receiving yards list. Jana finished career with 1,481.
With five receptions, TE Tony Poljan extended his active streak with a reception to 23 games.
Poljan notched his sixth touchdown of the season, pushing him to a four-way tie for No. 2 on UVA's single-season touchdown receptions list by a tight end. He shares the spot with Ed Carrington (1965), Bruce McGonnigal (1989) and Heath Miller (2003). The six career touchdowns at UVA also puts Poljan in a tie for No. 8 in program history for career touchdowns by a tight end.
Coen King notched a career-high 10 tackles.
