OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

Virginia welcomes the North Carolina Tar Heels to Klöckner Stadium on Thursday night. Faceoff is set for 7 p.m. This week Virginia is ranked No. 8 in both the USILA coaches and Inside Lacrosse media polls. UNC is No. 1 in the coaches poll and No. 2 in the media poll.

THE SERIES VS. THE TAR HEELS

 Thursday marks the 85th all-time meeting between the Cavaliers and Tar Heels, a series the Cavaliers own a 53-31 advantage in since 1938. UVA faced the Tar Heels every year from 1964-2019 until the pandemic shutdown the 2020 season.

 After winning 19-of-21 meetings dating back to 1997, UVA dropped four straight against UNC until beating them 13-11 at the ACC Showcase Game in April 2014. UNC's four-game winning streak was the longest in the series for the Tar Heels since winning four straight during the 1990-92 seasons. · After losing seven of eight meetings with the Tar Heels, UVA has won the last three games with UNC.

UVA VS. THE NO. 1 TEAM IN THE NATION

• UVA is 15-25 all-time against teams ranked No. 1 in the USILA coaches poll, however since 1990 the record is even at 12-12. The 2012 ACC title game at No. 1 UNC is the last time UVA has faced the top-ranked team.

· UVA is 7-2 against the USILA coaches No. 1 team when the game is played at Klöckner Stadium.

 The last time UVA hosted the No. 1 team in the nation at Klöckner Stadium was a 12-11 win over then-No. 1 Syracuse in 2011.

COVERING THE CAVALIERS

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos"

was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent vears.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as

the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wahhoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

THE SERIES VS. THE TAR HEELS

Virginia leads the all-time series with North Carolina by a 53-31 margin.

- The Cavaliers' 53 wins place the Tar Heels on UVA's list of most beaten opponents (UVA has defeated Duke 50 times) • Overall Virginia has won 23 of the last 32 games dating back to 1997, but North Carolina has won seven of the pa 11 meetings - including in the semifinal round of the 2012 ACC Championship and the 2013 ACC Finals.

 Three of the Tar Heels' wins in this span were all by two goals (7-5 in 2001, 11-9 in 2004 and again in 2012
 UNC scored back-to-back goals with 2:33 and 2:38 left in the game to escape with an 11-10 win at Fetzer Field in Chap Hill in 2014's regular season meeting.

· UNC won three of the last seven games by three goals, 10-7 in Charlottesville during the 2013 regular season meet ing,16-13 in the 2013 ACC Championship game at UNC's Kenan Stadium and 15-12 in 2017 at Klöckner Stadium. • North Carolina's previous five wins over UVA before the 2013 meetings had been by either one or two goals; until 201

the Tar Heels had not won by more than two goals since a 15-7 win in the 1994 ACC Tournament.

· Virginia owned a 10-game winning streak over the Tar Heels, the longest winning streak in the series since winning s in a row from 1997-2000, but UNC snapped it in the ACC Tournament in 2012.

· UVA's 168 loss to UNC in 2016 at Kenan Stadium was UVA's worst loss in the series since dropping a 14-5 game

the Tar Heels in the 1992 ACC Tournament at Maryland.

· UVA used seven points from Michael Kraus (3 g, 4 a) and four goals from Mike D'Amario to record its first ACC win sin 2014 when the Cavaliers won, 15-12, at Kenan Stadium in 2018. The ACC win snapped an 18 game losing streak league play. Counting the 2018 win over UNC, UVA has won four of its last six games in ACC play.

LAST MEETING: 2019 AT UNC (UVA 14, UNC 13) - ACC SEMIFINALS

 The then-No. 6 Virginia Cavaliers used a 6-1 run in the fourth quarter to outlast the North Carolina Tar Heels, 14-13, at UNC Lacrosse Stadium to advance to the ACC Championship final for the second year in a row. This game serves as the last time a team beat UNC. Since April 27, 2019, UNC has gone 13-0. The Tar Heels went 7-0 in 2020 before the season was shut down and are 6-0 this season.

· Virginia jumped out to a quick 3-0 lead, courtesy of goals from Matt Moore, Ryan Conrad and Petey LaSalla. UNC made the game close, 4-3, after scoring three goals in a 3-1 run. Ian Laviano and Ryan Conrad scored to conclude the first guarter with a 6-3 lead after 15 minutes. Moore tied his career-high with four assists in the first frame.

· After scoring with 14 seconds left in the first quarter, UVA didn't score again for the next 26:17 in which UNC reeled off a 7-0 run to take a commanding 10-6 lead with 8:16 left in the third quarter. Michael Kraus broke through with an unassisted goal at 3:06 to cut UVA's deficit to three goals, 10-7. North Carolina responded with a 2-0 run, taking a 12-8 lead with 14:09 left to play.

• Dox Aitken started the comeback with 7:31 left in the game, scoring backto-back goals to cut the UVA deficit to two goals, 12-10. Aitken's first goal was the 100th of his career and the second goal broke Shamel Bratton's school record for career points by a midfielder.

 After Aitken's goals, Laviano scored on a Moore helper at 6:32 in the fourth, followed by an acrobatic goal on another Moore assist by Mikey Herring with 5:37 left to play to tie the game at 12-12.

· Alex Trippi bounced in a shot at 3:24 to give UNC the lead, 13-12 for the final time. Kraus tied the game, 13-12, with an unassisted goal at 3:05. After a huge save by Patrick Burkinshaw and an ensuing ground ball by Matt Dziama, UVA moved the ball in transition and Cade Saustad recorded his first career assist when he found Laviano for the game-winning goal at 1:30 in the fourth.

UVA AND UNC OPENED UP METLIFE STADIUM

· The 2010 meeting was a No. 1 (UVA) vs. No. 2 (UNC) matchup that served as the first-ever event at MetLife Stadium, home of the New York Giants and New York Jets. The event was a triple header titled the Big City Classic. UVA won the second game of the day over the Tar Heels, 7-5.

UVA ON THE GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER

 Virginia owns a 154-40 (.7938) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 3-0 mark in 2021 and are winners of 15 of last 17 played in the historic edifice. UVA also is 12-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament

UVA is 27-8 all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.

· Klöckner Stadium first hosted lacrosse in 1993.

KOLOGY HEATING UP

 Preseason All-American D Kyle Kology is starting to heat up. He has 14 ground balls and nine caused turnovers over the past three games.

 Kology had five ground balls and five caused turnovers in the win over High Point while guarding All-American Asher Nolting. While Kology guarded Nolting, the HPU senior did not score a goal. Nolting scored his only goal on an EMO situation while Kology was in the penalty box.

Nolting had 12 turnovers against UVA on March 3.

CORMIER AND SHELLENBERGER MAKING MARKS EARLY

• A/M Payton Cormier shares (Bertrand) the team lead with 14 goals in just six games. He had 12 goals in UVA's six games in 2020. Cormier also has at least a hat-trick in six of his 12 career games.

• A/M Connor Shellenberger is off to a productive start in his career. He leads the team in points with 27. Shellenberger dished out at least two assists in five of UVA's six games, including a career-high four against Air Force the last time out. GAVIN NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK (FEB. 16)

• GK Bobby Gavin (San Diego, Calif.) was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 16.

• Gavin made his first collegiate start against No. 12 Army after he was pressed into action for starter Alex Rode, the 2019 NCAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Player, who was not available.

• In just his second collegiate game, Gavin made 13 saves and helped UVA defeat the Black Knights, 14-9.

 \cdot After allowing four goals on the first four shots he saw on goal, Gavin saved 13 of the Black Knights next 18 shots on goal to aid the Cavalier defense.

• Gavin also saved seven of nine shots on goal by Army's All-American attackman Brendan Nichtern. He also picked up six ground balls and caused two turnovers in the winning cause.

CONNERS AND FOX REPEAT AS TEAM CAPTAINS IN 2021

• Virginia men's lacrosse head coach Lars Tiffany announced that long-stick midfielder Jared Conners and midfielder John Fox have been selected as captains for the 2021 season, as voted on by their peers.

• Conners and Fox repeat as captains. It makes just the fourth time that UVA has had at least two repeat captains. In 1971 and 1972 it was Jay Connor and Bob Proutt, while in 1985 and 1986 it was Roddy Marino and Jeff Nicklas. Most recently, it was Conor Gill and Mark Koontz in 2001 and 2002.

The No. 5 Virginia Cavaliers (1-0) used a sevengoal second quarter to distance themselves from the Towson Tigers (0-1), 20-11, at Klöckner Stadium.

Connor Shellenberger scored seven points on four goals and three assists in his collegiate debut. Payton Cormier added a career-high six goals and one assist, while graduate transfer Charlie Bertrand notched four goals and two assists in his UVA debut.

HOW IT HAPPENED

UVA scored 52 seconds into the game to take an early 1-0 lead on an unassisted Shellenberger score. Towson rebounded with a 4-1 spurt to take a 4-2 lead with 6:26 left in the first frame. Cormier broke through with his first goal at 3:50 in the first quarter to jumpstart a 7-0 Cavalier run, pushing the Cavaliers ahead for good. Cormer scored four times during the run and capped it on a Shellenberger helper with 9:37 left in the second quarter, giving UVA an 9-4 lead.

Leading at the half, 11-5, UVA opened the third quarter scoring on a 7-2 streak to put the game out of reach. A dropdown shot by Peter Garno on another Shellenberger assist closed the third quarter scoring as UVA led 18-7 heading into the fourth quarter.

FROM THE LOCKER ROOM

"Give Towson a ton of credit. The way they came at us in the first quarter - they scored those four goals and hit three pipes. They were all over us. They came to Charlottesville to get a win and they were not intimidated at all. I was really impressed with their team and their coaching staff and how prepared they were. For us, it was getting into a rhythm at the face-off X, and Petey LaSalla started to pick up some tough ground balls and winning the possessions there. I thought we really did a nice job with our shooting. The goalie for Towson, Shane Brennan, was fantastic early and he's a really talented goalie, but we were smart with our shooting and didn't take too many shots from too far out. I know Griff Harris stuck one from deep in that first quarter, but for the most part we made sure we got closer and took good shots and got them off his body. The No. 3 Virginia Cavaliers (2-0) picked up a key non-conference home win over the No. 12 Army West Point Black Knights (0-1), 14-9. The contest was played at the Lower Turf practice field due to field conditions at Klöckner Stadium.

The Cavaliers won 10-of-13 first-half faceoffs to control possession and alleviate a first-time starter in goal, Bobby Gavin, from a strong Army attack. Gavin, starting for Alex Rode who wasn't available, allowed four goals on the first four shots he saw from Army. He settled down and shutout Army in the second quarter as UVA held an 8-4 lead going into the intermission.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Matt Moore scored five goals and Connor Shellenberger notched five points (2-3-5) as the No. 3 Virginia Cavaliers (3-0) overcame a slow start to pick up a key road win against the No. 11 Loyola Greyhounds (1-1), 15-12, at the Ridley Athletic Complex.

Loyola led 4-1 after the first quarter thanks to a 3-0 run by the Greyhounds to close the first period. Kevin Lindley scored twice for Loyola during the streak.
