THE KICKOFF

BATTLE FOR THE DMV

- The two teams faced off in the first-ever collegiate soccer match at Audi Field in 2018 and now return for the fourth edition of the "Battle for the DMV"
- Virginia fell by a score of 1-2 in last season's contest to 11th-ranked Maryland
- The series at Audi Field is dead even with both teams holding records of (1-1-1). The inaugural Battle for the DMV ended in a 0-0 draw in 2018. Virginia took home a 2-0 win over the No.1-Ranked Terps in 2019. Maryland claimed the victory in 2021

THE RIVALRY

- Maryland is Virginia's oldest rival in the sport of men's soccer as the programs will meet for the 84th time in a series that dates back to 1941, Virginia's inaugural season of men's soccer
- The Terps lead the overall series with a record of 43-30-10 and have won five of the last eight matchups
- In his 27th season, head coach George Gelnovatch is 12-16-6 against the Terrapins
- Before exiting the ACC for the Big Ten, Maryland and Virginia faced off three times in 2013 including a matchup in the College Cup Semifinal where Maryland edged the Cavaliers by a score of 2-1
- While both teams competed in the ACC, Virginia was 23-30-9 against Maryland in ACC contests and 4-5-1 when the teams met in the ACC Tournament
- The teams have met in the NCAA tournament four times splitting the results with two wins each

CHANGING OF TIDES

- The early days of Virginia's rivalry with Maryland were heavily one-sided for long periods of time
- Maryland won the first 20 games of the series and went unbeaten in the first 23 contests
- In 1978 Virginia began a streak of 12 straight wins and over Maryland and went unbeaten in 19 out of 20 contests with 17 wins and three ties
- Since 2010, Maryland has won seven out of the 11 meetings between the two teams

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia took down James Madison by a margin of 3-0 to improve to 2-1-0
- The Cavaliers have kept clean sheets in back-to-back games while scoring more 3 or more goals in each for the first time since the 2008 season
- Virginia has outshot its opponents by a margin of 45-14 through three games this season

THE HEAD COACHES

- George Gelnovatch and Sasho Cirovski have combined for 794 wins and five national titles
- Among active head coaches, Sasho Cirovski ranks second in total wins (441) while Gelnovatch clocks in at ninth (353)

AGAINST RANKED FOES

- Maryland enters the match as the No. 9 team in the country according to the most recent United Soccer Coaches Poll
- Virginia went toe-to-toe with four ranked sides in 2021 and struggled in those matches posting a record of 0-3-1
- The lone draw Virginia took from its ranked opponents last season came against the highest ranked team the Cavaliers played. Virginia battled to a 2-2 draw at home against No. 10 Pittsburgh
- George Gelnovatch is 50-52-23 in his career against top-10 opponents

EXCITING TRANSFERS

- Virginia has welcomed a recruiting class of 16 freshmen and transfers that ranks in the nation's top-five.
- Included among Virginia's newcomers is a trio of transfers, **Daniel Mangarov**, **Axel Ahlander** and **Moritz Kappelsberger** who have each found themselves a spot in the Cavaliers' starting XI
- Mangarov scored a goal and assist in his debut and has started in each of UVA's last two games
- Kappelsberger has tallied a goal and an assist in three games at left center back for the Hoos.

A NOSE FOR GOAL

- Leo Afonso is off to another good start for Virginia as he leads the team in goals with two this season
- As Virginia's leading goal scorer from the 2021 season with eight goals, Afonso was outscored by just two players who return to ACC rosters in 2022.

UELAND NAMED TO 2022 ACC PRESEASON WATCH LIST

- On August 16 the ACC released its preseason watch list for the 2022 season and among those on the list is Virginia captain, **Andreas Ueland**.
- Ueland was a mainstay for the Cavaliers in 2021 as he led Virginia field players in total minutes played with 1,638 and started all 17 of the games he participated in.
- Ueland has played all 90+ minutes in all but three games throughout his entire career at Virginia

HOOS BACK FOR VIRGINIA

- The Cavaliers return a strong contingent of last season's impact players including their leading goal scorer from the 2021 campaign, **Leo Afonso**, as well as defensive anchor **Andreas Ueland**.
- The Hoos will also look to sophomore goalkeeper **Holden Brown** following a campaign in which he played every minute in goal for the Cavaliers posting a save percentage of .761.
- Virginia returns all of its top-five scorers from 2021 including Afonso, **Kome Ubogu**, **Michael Tsicoulis**, Ueland, and **Will Citron**.

HORTON'S RETURN

- As an understudy of Daryl Dike's during Virginia's run to the NCAA Final in 2019, **Phil Horton** has long seemed the natural heir to the striker position at Virginia
- Injuries put a halt to Horton's progression over a pair of seasons, but has found his way back into the starting XI in the 2022 season opener.
- Horton scored his first goal NCAA Division I goal in 692 days with a solo effort against James Madison.

NOTING THE TERPS

- Maryland enters the match as the No. 9 ranked team with a record of (1-1-1)
- Maryland won its season opener by a score of 2-1 over then ninth-ranked New Hampshire at home
- The Terps have since stumbled, drawing with Liberty and falling to No. 20 Denver

HEAD COACH GEORGE GELNOVATCH



George Gelnovatch enters his 27th season as the head coach of the Virginia men's soccer program. The longest tenured head coach in program history, Gelnovatch has led the Cavaliers to a pair of national championships in 2009 and 2014 as well as six NCAA College Cup appearances and 24-consecutive berths in the NCAA tournament.

Gelnovatch became the program's all-time leader in wins on August 25, 2017 with a 3-2 double-overtime victory over Villanova, surpassing his UVA mentor Bruce Arena for the program record in wins with 296. He reached the 300-win plateau on Sept. 15, 2017 with a 2-1 triumph at Virginia Tech, becoming just the fourth coach in Atlantic Coast Conference history to win 300 career matches.

A former Cavalier soccer All-American and assistant coach,

Gelnovatch has guided Virginia to five ACC tournament titles, three regular-season ACC championships and a record of 352-148-62 (.681) during his tenure as UVA head coach. Over the course of his tenure as an assistant and head coach at Virginia, he has been a part of all seven of the Cavaliers' national championships.

Gelnovatch is the first coach in NCAA Division I men's soccer history to lead 20-straight teams to the NCAA tournament. He is one of just eight coaches in the Division I men's soccer annals to take 20 teams to the tournament and one of only four active coaches to do so.

Going into 2022, Gelnovatch ranked as the 12th-winningest active head coach in Division I college soccer, with a .681 career winning percentage. He stood 10th in career wins among current head coaches. Among Division I coaches all-time, he ranked 40th in career wins and 43rd in career winning percentage. These figures are even more striking when considering Gelnovatch's teams play one of the nation's toughest schedules on a yearly basis.

Virginia has won at least 15 games in a season 10 times under Gelnovatch, including 2019 when it won 21 games the second most in the history of the program en route to an ACC Coastal Division Championship, an ACC Tournament crown and a Runner-Up finish in the NCAA College Cup.

Gelnovatch has developed a number of Major League Soccer players during his UVA tenure, with 30 players going in MLS drafts and 12 in the MLS Supplemental Draft, while eight signed Project-40/Generation Adidas contracts and Jordan Allen (2014), Derrick Etienne (2015), Scott Thomsen (2015) and Aboubacar Keita (2018) each signed MLS Homegrown contracts. Jason Moore (1999) and Alecko Eskandarian (2003) were selected No. 1 in the MLS Draft, as 13 Cavaliers have been picked in the first round of the various MLS drafts.

Gelnovatch was named the 10th coach of the Virginia program on Jan. 3, 1996, after Bruce Arena announced he would end his 18-year career at the helm of UVA soccer to become head coach and assistant general manager of Major League Soccer's D.C. United.


