Meets Leading Up To XC 23

- Virginia Invitational (By invite)
 - Saturday, September 23, 2023
 - Race time approximately 8:00am
 - 24 teams with preference given to the teams who qualified for the 2022 NCAA XC Championships until the field is full
 - Approximately 300 student-athletes per gender for "A" race.
 - Scored race, full teams only (no individuals or unattached)
 - If demand warrants, we will have a second, non-scored race.
- XC 23 (Open to all NCAA Division I teams)
 - Saturday, October 14, 2023
 - Race time approximately 8:45am
 - "A" race will accommodate full teams only (approximately 300 student-athletes per gender)
 - Priority given to those teams ranked on USTFCCCA poll at that time
 - Second, non-scored race if demand warrants

Intent to Compete

- Intent to compete forms for Virginia Invitational and XC 23 will be sent out in February 2023.
 - Must be returned to <u>uvatrackmeets@gmail.com</u> no later than May 1, 2023
- Intent to compete forms will be reviewed and a contract will be generated and returned to institution. Contract must be signed and returned to <u>uvatrackmeets@gmail.com</u> no later than July 1, 2023.
 - Any team that withdraws from competition after August 1, 2023 will be assessed a financial penalty
