## LEADING OFF

- The Cavaliers come into the ACC Tournament with wins in 10 of their last 14 games. Two of its four losses in that span were by one run.
- Virginia has been part of every ACC Tournament since its inception in 1973 and will make its 46th overall appearance.
- The Cavaliers own a 52-75 overall record in the ACC postseason and have captured tournament crowns in 1996, 2009 and 2011.
- Under head coach Brian O'Connor, the Cavaliers have a record of 27-21 overall mark in the ACC Tournament.
- Since 2004 Virginia is 4-1 against North Carolina in the ACC Tournament with the last meeting coming in 2014, a 3-2 Cavalier victory. Virginia and Miami have split four total games since 2004 with the Hurricanes coming away with an 9-5 win.
- The No. 9 seed has won the ACC Tournament once. Georgia Tech went 4-1 and defeated Maryland in the 2014 ACC Championship game.
- No. 19 North Carolina and No. 16 Miami will be the seventh and eight Virginia opponents this season ranked in the USA Today Coaches Poll. The Cavaliers are 4-8 in games against ranked foes this season

## THE STARTING PITCHER

- After turning in back-to-back quality starts in his first two starts of the season, senior Chesdin Harrington will get the nod for the Cavaliers against North Carolina on Wednesday.
- He made his first start of the season on Senior Day against then-No. 5 Louisville, his first start in over two years. The right-hander tossed six innings and struck out six batters in a series-clinching, 12-6 win.
- He clinched the series last week against Virginia Tech behind a career-high seven innings pitched. From the fourth to the seventh innings, he sat down, 11-straight Virginia Tech hitters.
- Harrington is one of three pitchers on the staff with 20+ appearances
- Off the field, Harrington served as the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee President and was one of two UVA student-athletes awarded the ACC Postgraduate Scholarship.

## RANKING THE HOOS

- At the conclusion of the regular season, Virginia has the third-highest team batting average (.294) and the second highest team fielding percentage (.979) in the ACC. The Cavaliers have racked up 10 or more hits in six-straight games.
- As a team, Virginia has struck out 351 times, the fewest in the league. The Cavaliers are one of three teams (Louisville, Boston College & North Carolina) that have not struck out more than 400 times
- Catcher Logan Michaels is the toughest player in the ACC to strike out, fanning once every 11.7 at bats. He's only struck out multiple times in a game once.
- Shortstop Tanner Morris is currently ranked fifth in the league in batting (.353) and tied for fifth among his ACC cohorts with 76 hits.

- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- Program has had 75 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 14 years
- UVA has had 26 All-America and 68 all-conference selections in his tenure

### CARDIAC CAVALIERS

- Virginia is 6-7 in one-run games this season and have played in 20 games decided by one or two runs.
- Three times this season Virginia has lost an ACC-series deciding game by one run, including a 5-4 setback at North Carolina.
- Of its 32 wins this season, Virginia has come-from behind to win in 21 of them. The Cavaliers have faced a deficit after the fifth inning and won nine games.

### PLAYER NOTES/TRENDS

- Freshman Nic Kent comes into the tournament riding an 11-game hit streak and has reached base safely in 14-consecutive games. In his last five games, he's 11-for-22 (.500) with four runs and four RBI.
  - Brendan Rivoli surged into a tie for the team lead in RBI (41) thanks to a seven-RBI series against Virginia Tech. Rivoli has hit safely in a team-best and career-high, 12-straight games.
  - Two-way player Devin Ortiz has established himself as one of the key contributors in the Cavalier bullpen. The sophomore has now pitched 19.1 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run, a span of seven appearances.
  - Tanner Morris leads the league in doubles with 21. He is one of eight players in UVA history with 21 or more doubles in a single season. He is two shy of matching the school record of 23 held by Stephen Bruno (2012) and Dan Street (2002).
  - Senior Nate Eikhoff is an RBI shy of 100 for his career. He has started 109 consecutive games, including all 54 at first base this season. He's the team's active leader in hits with 172.
  - As a true freshman, third baseman Zack Gelof has started all 54 games at third base. He served as the team's lead-off man for the first 21 games before moving to the middle of the lineup.
  - Cayman Richardson recorded his 11th career outfield assist in a what turned out to be a run-saving play in game one victory over Virginia Tech. He originally came to Virginia as a middle infielder and served as the team's primary centerfielder last season, filling in for an injured Cameron Simmons.
  - Simmons, a 2017 All-ACC performer, is coming off back-to-back two-hit performances. He is the team's active leader in career home runs with 18 and stolen bases with 23.
  - Cameron Simmons became the third player on the team to enter the double-digit stolen base club this season. He is a perfect 11-for-11 on the year and 23-for-27 in his career.
- Virginia has only had three different players steal 10 or more bases one other time the previous five seasons (2017)

### FIRST YEAR THIEVES

- Freshmen Zack Gelof and Nic Kent each have 10+ stolen bases to their credit
- Only one other time in UVA history has a two or more freshmen stolen 10 bases in a single season. Back in 2008, Jarrett Parker (14), Dan Grovatt (10) and David Coleman (10) swiped 10 or more bags in their first year on grounds.
- As a team, Virginia has compiled 66 stolen bases in 54 games with Gelof (16) and Kent (15) leading the way.

### BREAKING DOWN THE STREAK(S)

- Freshman Zack Gelof reached base in his first 28 games of his collegiate career, only Joe McCarthy (36 games in 2013) started off on a longer streak in UVA history.
- He used a hit in 24 of the 28 games to reach base.
- In the midst of the reached base streak, Gelof put together a 17-game hit streak, the longest by a UVA freshman since 2000.

### SUCCESS AT THE DISH

· The victory on April 24th against James Madison was the 20th of the season for the Cavaliers. Virginia has won 20 or more games at home in all but one season (2015) since Brian O'Connor took over the program in 2004.

· Virginia is 448-123 (.785) overall and 107-53 (.669) in ACC play at Disharoon Park during O'Connor's tenure.

### SMALL MARGIN FOR ERROR

· Virginia has played in 12, one-run games this season and own a 5-7 mark in those matchups. All but two of those one-run games have come in ACC play.

· The Cavaliers have dropped four, series-deciding victories by one run this season including Sunday finales against then No. 4 NC State and then No. 15 North Carolina.

· Of the 27 ACC games played this season, 13 have been decided by one or two runs with Virginia owning a 4-9 record in those contests.

· Over the past two seasons, Virginia is 9-15 in one-run games against ACC foes.

### MLB4 AT A GLANCE

· Virginia played three ranked foes (No. 2 Vanderbilt, No. 17 TCU & No. 24 Cal State Fullerton) in the inaugural MLB4 Collegiate Baseball Tournament in Scottsdale, Ariz. to open the 2019 season.

· It marked the first time in school history Virginia played three-ranked opponents to start a season and Vanderbilt was the highest ranked team to open the season since 2010 when it started up with a three-game series at No. 11 East Carolina.

· Against Vanderbilt, an eight-run third inning doomed Virginia in a 15-9 loss in a game that aired live on MLB Network. On Saturday against TCU, the Cavaliers fell behind 7-0 after the first inning and could not recover. In the tournament finale, Cal State Fullerton scored three runs in the top of the ninth to wipe away a 5-3 Virginia advantage.

· Virginia is winless through its first four games for the first time since 2003 when it dropped its first three games at Auburn.

### FRESH START

· 2018 marked the first time in Brian O'Connor's tenure that Virginia failed to qualify for the NCAA Tournament. The streak of 14-straight regionals was the fourth-longest in college baseball going into last season. Only two programs, Florida State (41-straight) and Cal State Fullerton (27-straight) hold active streaks more than 14.

· In the history of college baseball only 15 programs have

qualified for the NCAA Tournament 14-straight seasons.

· Head Coach Brian O'Connor is one of five coaches ever to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the first 14 seasons at the helm.

· Counting his time as an assistant at Notre Dame under Paul Mainieri, O'Connor went to 19-straight NCAA Regionals, five with the Irish from 1999-03.

· Virginia is unranked in the preseason for the first time since 2009, the same season the Cavaliers reached the College World Series.

### COMEBACK KIDS

After an injury-riddled 2018 season the Cavaliers return a number of key pieces to the lineup that missed significant action last year:

· OF Cameron Simmons - Missed entire 2018 season with shoulder injury, batted .352 in 2017 and was an 2nd Team All-ACC honoree (only one ACC player batted over .352 in 2018, Joey Bart-GT the 2nd overall pick in the 2018 draft)

· RHP Noah Murdock - Had Tommy John surgery after 2017 season, pitched in five games at end of 2018 season.

· RHP Evan Sperling - Sunday starter in 2018, season cut short due to injury, had a 1.96 ERA over first four starts

· RHP Chesdin Harrington - Missed 2018 season due to injury, figures to big part of UVA bullpen in 2019, one of three pitchers with NCAA Regional experience

### STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

- Virginia reliever Andrew Abbott, a freshman All-American last season was on the initial NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Watch list, annually giving to the country's top relief pitcher.

- Abbott pitched almost exclusively out of the bullpen with 23 relief appearances

- His 74 strikeouts as a reliever were the third most in the ACC and sixth most in the ACC

- SS Tanner Morris, a draft eligible sophomore is the No. 49 overall prospect on Baseball America's Top. 50 College Prospect list.

- Six Cavaliers were selected in the 2018 MLB Draft for the second-straight season.
- Two of this year's picks fell in the Top 40, including Daniel Lynch at No. 34 overall to the Royals.
