## LEADING OFF

- Virginia will conclude a four-game road trip on Tuesday, the longest stretch away from Charlottesville this season. Wednesday's game will commence a 10-game home stand with ACC series against Miami and Florida State.
- Tuesday will be the first of a home and home midweek series against James Madison. The Dukes will come to Charlottesville on April 24.
- The Cavaliers will take on Norfolk State for the first time since 2009. Virginia is 4-0 against the Spartans in Brian O'Connor's tenure.
- Virginia owns a 4-2 mark against schools from the Commonwealth in 2019.
- Virginia is 25-6 at home and 43-8 overall against non-conference opponents over the past two seasons.
- When playing two non-conference opponents in the same week, Virginia is 4-0 this season. The Cavaliers have one more two-game midweek remaining, April 23rd and 24th when they host Liberty and James Madison, respectively.

## CAVALIERS TAKE TWO

- Virginia won its second ACC of the series of the season by sweeping a road doubleheader on Saturday (April 6) at Notre Dame. It marked the first road ACC doubleheader sweep since 2016.
- Virginia erased a pair of three-run deficits in the twin bill to record its 11th and 12th come-from-behind wins of the season.
- In the nightcap, the Cavaliers held off the Fighting Irish thanks to a heads up play by Cameron Simmons in centerfield. Instead of throwing home with two outs on a single to centerfield, the senior fired the ball to second base to record the final out of the game, just before the tying run was able to cross the plate
- The Cavaliers dropped the opening game of an ACC series for the first time on Friday night, falling 5-2.

## DOUBLE TIME

- Sophomore Tanner Morris recorded three doubles in the three games at Notre Dame and upped his season total to 16, tied for the third most in the country and second-most in the ACC.
- He has put together seven-straight multi-hit games and is currently riding a career-high, nine-game hit streak.
- Morris has a team-best, 15 multi-hit efforts, including five three-hit games.
- Since moving to the leadoff spot he's 18-for-39 (.426) with six doubles, a home run and eight RBI.

### DOUBLE DUTY

• Reliever Kyle Whitten saved both games of the Saturday doubleheader at Notre Dame, becoming the first UVA pitchers to close down both games of a doubleheader since Branden Kline in 2011 against Maryland. Kline is now in Triple-A with the Baltimore Orioles.

• Whitten leads the team with 17 appearances and is tied for second in the ACC with six saves. His five saves in ACC play are tops in the league and he has a pair of holds to his credit.

### ON THE MOUND

- Evan Spering will make his third start of the season and first since Feb. 26.
- The right-hander is one of two pitchers on the Virginia staff with 100 career strikeouts.
- In four of Spering's five relief appearances since his last start he's produced scoreless outings.

### TEAM SUPERLATIVES

- Virginia has six players with 19 or more RBI, tied NC State for the most in the ACC.
- As a team Virginia has struck out a combined 208 times the fewest of any other ACC school.
- Coming midweek Virginia ranks third in fielding percentage (.977) and fourth in the ACC in batting average (.291)

### BREAKING DOWN THE STREAK(S)

- Freshman Zack Gelof reached base in his first 28 games of his collegiate career, only Joe McCarthy (36 games in 2013) started off on a longer streak in UVA history.
- He used a hit in 24 of the 28 games to reach base.
- In the midst of the reached base streak, Gelof put together a 17-game hit streak, the longest by a UVA freshman since 2000.
- He prolonged his reached base streak in his final turn at the plate five times and used his final turn to extend his hit streak, three times.

## COMEBACK KIDS

· Virginia has a total of 12 come-from-behind victories in 2019.  
 · On Friday (March 15), Virginia erased a two-run deficit in the top of the ninth, scoring three runs and taking the series opener against Georgia Tech, 9-8. The last time Virginia erased a two or more run deficit in the ninth inning or later was almost a year to the day earlier, when Virginia scored three in the 10th to defeat Boston College on March 18, 2018.  
 · The Cavaliers have scored 30 runs in the eighth inning this season, only the fourth inning (34 runs) has been more productive.

## MLB4 AT A GLANCE

· Virginia played three ranked foes (No. 2 Vanderbilt, No. 17 TCU & No. 24 Cal State Fullerton) in the inaugural MLB4 Collegiate Baseball Tournament in Scottsdale, Ariz. to open the 2019 season.  
 · It marked the first time in school history Virginia played three-ranked opponents to start a season and Vanderbilt was the highest ranked team to open the season since 2010 when it started up with a three-game series at No. 11 East Carolina.  
 · Against Vanderbilt, an eight-run third inning doomed Virginia in a 15-9 loss in a game that aired live on MLB Network. On Saturday against TCU, the Cavaliers fell behind 7-0 after the first inning and could not recover. In the tournament finale, Cal State Fullerton scored three runs in the top of the ninth to wipe away a 5-3 Virginia advantage.  
 · Virginia is winless through its first four games for the first time since 2003 when it dropped its first three games at Auburn.

## FRESH START

· 2018 marked the first time in Brian O'Connor's tenure that Virginia failed to qualify for the NCAA Tournament. The streak of 14-straight regionals was the fourth-longest in college baseball going into last season. Only two programs, Florida State (41-straight) and Cal State Fullerton (27-straight) hold active streaks more than 14.

· In the history of college baseball only 15 programs have qualified for the NCAA Tournament 14-straight seasons.  
 · Head Coach Brian O'Connor is one of five coaches ever to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the first 14 seasons at the helm.
