## LEADING OFF

- Virginia begins a four-game road trip, its longest stint away from Charlottesville this season.
- The Cavaliers are 2-5 in true road games this season.
- This weekend will only be the second trip for Virginia to South Bend for an ACC series.
- Virginia is 8-4 all-time against Notre Dame and 5-2 against the Irish since they joined the ACC.
- The Cavaliers enter the weekend one game out of first place in the ACC Coastal Division standings.
- Virginia has won all four series-opening games in ACC play and are a combined 2-6 in games two and three.

## FAMILIAR TERRITORY

- Head Coach Brian O'Connor returns to South Bend for the second time as the head coach at Virginia.
- He spent nine years 1994-2003 as an assistant at Notre Dame under Paul Mainieri, the current head coach at LSU.
- The Irish made five-straight NCAA Tournaments (1999-03) and reached the 2002 College World Series for only the second time in program history.
- Since moving on from Notre Dame both Mainieri and O'Connor have won National Championships in 2009 (LSU) and 2015 (Virginia), respectively. The two are part of a crop of eight active head coaches to win a National Championship.
- Counting his five appearances at Notre Dame, O'Connor had been to the NCAA Tournament in 19-consecutive years (1999-2017) until last season.

## SOUTH BEND CONNECTION

- A pair of former Cavaliers, Derek Casey and Andy Weber are on the Opening Day Roster for the South Bend Cubs, single-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs.
- A ninth-round pick in last year's MLB Draft, Casey is scheduled to be the opening day starter on Thursday (April 4) at Four Winds Stadium in South Bend.
- Also expected to start in the opener is infielder Andy Weber, a fifth-round selection in the 2018 draft and the Cavaliers top hitter last season.
- Notre Dame lost 1-0 in a five-inning exhibition game against the South Bend Cubs on Wednesday night.

### ASA TEAM

- Virginia has seven different players with 15 RBI or more, the most in the ACC.
- The Cavaliers did not commit an error in all three games at NC State last weekend and have committed only seven in 12 league games, second fewest to only the Wolfpack (6).
- Virginia's .979 fielding percentage is the second highest in the ACC and ranks 21st in the nation.
- As a team Virginia has struck out a combined 186 times the fewest of any other ACC school. Only UVA and North Carolina have fanned less than 200 times this season.
- Coming into the weekend Virginia ranks third in the ACC in batting average (.294)

### FROM THE BATTER'S BOX

- Cameron Simmons enters the weekend having reached base safely in 15-straight games. His .404 batting average through 12 ACC games is the fifth highest in the league. Simmons has a hit in all but one of 12 ACC games this year and enters the weekend on a nine-game hit streak.
- Tanner Morris collected his 13th double of the season on Wednesday, in a 2-for-4 effort at the plate. The second-year shortstop is tied for second in the league and tied for 13th in the country in doubles. Over the last five games, Morris is 10-for-17 (.588) with two doubles, a home run and five RBI.
- Brendan Rivoli scored twice and went 2-for-3 with an RBI against Old Dominion on Tuesday night. It marked his team-best, 13th multiple hit game.
- Morris (5th - .360) and Rivoli (7th - .355) both rank in the top-7 in the ACC in batting. Only Wake Forest has multiple players in the top seven in batting average this season.
- Nate Eikhoff rounded out the Cavalier two-hit performers on Tuesday with a 2-for-3 effort at the plate. He's made 84-straight starts dating back to last season and started all 29 this season at first base. Over the course of those 84 games, he's played four different positions - first base, second base, third base and left field.

### On the Mound

- Griff McGarry will start on Friday night for the second-straight week. He's faced two top-5 opponents this year in opening games (Vanderbilt-No. 1) and NC State - No. 4). Last week against the Wolfpack, McGarry struck out five of the first six batters he faced in a no-decision.
- Noah Murdock has a team-best four quality starts including his last two. The right-hander matched a career high in innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (7) against NC State last Saturday.
- Reliever Kyle Whitten leads the staff in appearances (15) and saves (4). He's seen action in six of the last eight games where he's allowed two runs in 6.2 innings pitched with a win, two saves and a hold to his credit.

### BREAKING DOWN THE STREAK(S)

- Freshman Zack Gelof reached base in his first 28 games of his collegiate career, only Joe McCarthy (36 games in 2013) started off on a longer streak in UVA history.
- He used a hit in 24 of the 28 games to reach base.
- In the midst of the reached base streak, Gelof put together a 17-game hit streak, the longest by a UVA freshman since 2000.
- He prolonged his reached base streak in his final turn at the plate five times and used his final turn to extend his hit streak, three times.

## COMEBACK KIDS

- Virginia has a total of 10 come-from-behind victories in 2019.
- On Friday (March 15), Virginia erased a two-run deficit in the top of the ninth, scoring three runs and taking the series opener against Georgia Tech, 9-8. The last time Virginia erased a two or more run deficit in the ninth inning or later was almost a year to the day earlier, when Virginia scored three in the 10th to defeat Boston College on March 18, 2018.
- The Cavaliers have scored 30 runs in the eighth inning this season, only the fourth inning (34 runs) has been more productive.

## MLB4 AT A GLANCE

- Virginia played three ranked foes (No. 2 Vanderbilt, No. 17 TCU & No. 24 Cal State Fullerton) in the inaugural MLB4 Collegiate Baseball Tournament in Scottsdale, Ariz. to open the 2019 season.
- It marked the first time in school history Virginia played three-ranked opponents to start a season and Vanderbilt was the highest ranked team to open the season since 2010 when it started up with a three-game series at No. 11 East Carolina.
- Against Vanderbilt, an eight-run third inning doomed Virginia in a 15-9 loss in a game that aired live on MLB Network. On Saturday against TCU, the Cavaliers fell behind 7-0 after the first inning and could not recover. In the tournament finale, Cal State Fullerton scored three runs in the top of the ninth to wipe away a 5-3 Virginia advantage.
- Virginia is winless through its first four games for the first time since 2003 when it dropped its first three games at Auburn.

## FRESH START

- 2018 marked the first time in Brian O'Connor's tenure that Virginia failed to qualify for the NCAA Tournament. The streak of 14-straight regionals was the fourth-longest in college baseball going into last season. Only two programs, Florida State (41-straight) and Cal State Fullerton (27-straight) hold active streaks more than 14.
- In the history of college baseball only 15 programs have qualified for the NCAA Tournament 14-straight seasons.
- Head Coach Brian O'Connor is one of five coaches ever to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the first 14 seasons at the helm.
  - Mike Martin, Florida State - 1980-present (39 seasons)
  - Jim Morris, Miami - 1994-2016 (23 seasons)
  - Brian O'Connor, Virginia - 2004-17 (14 seasons)**
  - Dave Van Horn, Arkansas - 2002-15 (14 seasons)
  - Jack Leggett, Clemson - 1994-2007 (14 seasons)
- Counting his time as an assistant at Notre Dame under Paul Mainieri, O'Connor went to 19-straight NCAA Regionals, five with the Irish from 1999-03.

- Virginia is unranked in the preseason for the first time since 2009, the same season the Cavaliers reached the College World Series.

## COMEBACK KIDS

- After an injury-riddled 2018 season the Cavaliers return a number of key pieces to the lineup that missed significant action last year:
- OF Cameron Simmons - Missed entire 2018 season with shoulder injury, batted .352 in 2017 and was an All-ACC honoree (only one ACC player batted over .352 in 2018, Joey Bart-GT the 2nd overall pick in the 2018 draft)
  - RHP Noah Murdock - Had Tommy John surgery after 2017 season, pitched in five games at end of 2018 season.
  - RHP Evan Sperling - Sunday starter in 2018, season cut short due to injury, had a 1.96 ERA over first four starts
  - RHP Chesdin Harrington - Missed 2018 season due to injury, figures to big part of UVA bullpen in 2019, one of three pitchers with NCAA Regional experience

## STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

- Virginia reliever Andrew Abbott, a freshman All-American last season was on the initial NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Watch list, annually giving to the country's top relief pitcher.
- Abbott pitched almost exclusively out of the bullpen with 23 relief appearances
- His 74 strikeouts as a reliever were the third most in the ACC and sixth most in the ACC

## PRESEASON RANKINGS

- SS Tanner Morris, a draft eligible sophomore is the No. 49 overall prospect on Baseball America's Top. 50 College Prospect list.
- According to D1Baseball.com Nate Eikhoff ranked No. 49 on its top 100 senior list
- Cam Simmons (#19), Tanner Morris (#24), and Noah Murdock (#27) were included on the D1Baseball's Top ACC prospects for the 2019 Draft.

## THE NEW GUYS

- The Cavaliers added 16 newcomers to its roster for 2019, 13 freshmen and three transfers.
- According to Perfect Game, Virginia's 2019 recruiting class was ranked No. 14 in the country with two top 100 players (Mike Vasil - No. 23 & Brandon Neeck - No. 63)

- O'Connor spent nine seasons working as an assistant on Mainieri's staff at Notre Dame from 1995-2003.
- While working together, the Irish posted an overall record of 399-160-1, won six conference championships and made six trips to the NCAA Tournament.
- O'Connor's college coach at Creighton, Jim Hendry, will also be on staff as the bench coach. Hendry now works for the New York Yankees as a special assignment scout.

· O'Connor will face six former Team USA members this season Will Wilson (NC State), Patrick Bailey (NC State), Mason Feole (UConn), Graeme Stinson (Duke), CJ Van Eyk (Florida St.), and Drew Parrish (Florida St.)

### MLB DRAFT SUCCESS

- Six Cavaliers were selected in the 2018 MLB Draft for the second-straight season.
- Two of this year's picks fell in the Top 40, including Daniel Lynch at No. 34 overall to the Royals.
- Virginia is the only program in country to have first round pick in each of last five seasons.
- Five of the six selections came in first 10 rounds, tied for the second most in the country.
- Virginia is one of four schools (Florida, Oregon, Stanford) with multiple selections in the top-40 in 2018
- 20 Cavaliers have been selected in the top three rounds under in the past 15 years and the only school in the country with multiple selections in the top-40 in back-to-back seasons.
- 81 players have been drafted in the Brian O'Connor era (since 2004) and a total of 136 since the start of the program.
- Including this year's class, Virginia has had 14 First Round draft picks, 12 have played for head coach Brian O'Connor.
- Adam Haseley (7th overall) and Pavin Smith (8th overall) are one of two sets of position players teammates to be selected in the top-10 since 1988 (OSU - Monty Fariss & Robin Ventura)

### HOOS IN THE WORLD SERIES

- Chris Taylor became the first Cavalier to play in back-to-back World Series as a member of the Dodgers in 2017 and 2018. He was named co-MVP of the 2017 NLCS after batting .316 with two home runs, five runs scored and three RBIs. Virginia has been represented in the last three World Series (Brandon Guyer - CLE -2016).
- Derek Fisher became the second Cavalier to win a World Series as a member of the Houston Astros. He scored the game-winning run in game five on a walk-off single by Alex Bregman.
