## LEADING OFF

- Seton Hall will be Virginia's final non-conference opponent on the weekend before opening up ACC play against Duke on March 8-10.
- Virginia is 18-5 at home and 36-6 overall against non-conference opponents over the past two seasons.
- The Cavaliers have won their last four weekend series against non-conference opponents dating back to 2016.
- Under head coach Brian O'Connor, Virginia is 5-1 against Seton Hall.
- Seton Hall is the second Big East opponent in 2019, after sweeping Villanova last weekend. O'Connor is 11-2 against current members of the Big East (4-1 vs. St. John's; 4-1 vs. Georgetown, 3-0; Villanova 3-0).

## AGAINST THE PIRATES

- In a game originally scheduled to be played in Charlottesville, inclement weather forced the last meeting against Seton Hall in 2015 to be played in Myrtle Beach, S.C., a 4-1 Cavalier victory.
- All but one of the 55 previous meeting against Seton Hall have been played in Charlottesville.
- The last time the Pirates played three games at Disharoon Park was 2004, a three-game sweep by the Cavaliers in O'Connor's first year at the helm. The three wins in 2004 were a part of a 17-2 start by the Cavaliers.

## DOUBLE VISION

- Freshman Zack Gelof collected his fifth double of the year in Tuesday's game against William & Mary, tied for the most in the ACC and tied for the ninth-most in the country. He also leads the team in RBI with 10, driving in a run in each of the last four games.
- Sophomore Brendan Rivoli has put together three-straight multi-hit performances, bumping his season average up to .375, second-highest on the club and 13th highest in the ACC. His four doubles are also tied for the second most in the league.

## SEASON STREAKS

- The left side of the infield, Gelof and Tanner Morris have reached base safely in all eight games. Morris leads the team in hitting (.387), the ninth highest in the league.
- Nate Eikhoff, is in the midst of a six-game hit streak and drove in four runs in the Villanova series.

### LIFTOFF

- Over the weekend, Virginia hit the first three home runs of the season.
- Tanner Morris tied up game two with a solo shot in the eighth inning, igniting a five-run, game-winning rally.
- Cameron Simmons blasted a three-run shot in the fifth inning of game one, capping a five-run frame. An inning later Alex Tappen lined a solo homer off the facing of the bleachers in left field.
- Simmons has 14 career home runs to lead all active Cavaliers while Tappen is tied with Nate Eikhoff with five for second most.

### NEWCOMERS IMPACT

- Junior transfer Logan Michaels has made most of his opportunities, hitting safely in all five games he's appeared in. In the final two games against Villanova he went 5-for-7 with three runs scored.
- Reliever Paul Kosanovich was credited with his first win in a UVA uniform in the series finale. The junior transfer pitched two hitless innings facing only six batters.
- In the midweek win over VMI last Tuesday (2/19), freshman Zach Messinger pitched three shutout innings of relief with five strikeouts in his collegiate debut. He has yet to yield an earned run in 4.0 innings pitched.

### MLB4 AT A GLANCE

- Virginia played three ranked foes (No. 2 Vanderbilt, No. 17 TCU & No. 24 Cal State Fullerton) in the inaugural MLB4 Collegiate Baseball Tournament in Scottsdale, Ariz. to open the 2019 season.
- It marked the first time in school history Virginia played three-ranked opponents to start a season and Vanderbilt was the highest ranked team to open the season since 2010 when it started up with a three-game series at No. 11 East Carolina.
- Against Vanderbilt, an eight-run third inning doomed Virginia in a 15-9 loss in a game that aired live on MLB Network. On Saturday against TCU, the Cavaliers fell behind 7-0 after the first inning and could not recover. In the tournament finale, Cal State Fullerton scored three runs in the top of the ninth to wipe away a 5-3 Virginia advantage.
- Virginia is winless through its first four games for the first time since 2003 when it dropped its first three games at Auburn.

### FRESH START

- 2018 marked the first time in Brian O'Connor's tenure that Virginia failed to qualify for the NCAA Tournament. The streak of 14-straight regionals was the fourth-longest in college baseball going into last season. Only two programs, Florida State (41-straight) and Cal State Fullerton (27-straight) hold active streaks more than 14.
- In the history of college baseball only 15 programs have qualified for the NCAA Tournament 14-straight seasons.
- Head Coach Brian O'Connor is one of five coaches ever to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the first 14 seasons at the helm.
- Mike Martin, Florida State - 1980-present (39 seasons)
- Jim Morris, Miami - 1994-2016 (23 seasons)
