LEADING OFF

- Virginia enters the game winners of nine-straight midweek games and an overall record of 16-6 against non-conference opponents.
- Virginia owns a 9-2 mark against schools from the Commonwealth in 2019.
- Tuesday's game will put the finishing touches on Virginia's third, four-game road trip of the season. The Cavaliers have not played more than four consecutive road games in the regular season since 2016.
- Virginia is 6-8 in true road games this season and 6-11 in games played away from Disharoon Park.
- The Cavaliers own a 43-22 advantage in the all-time series against VCU that was first played in 1979.

AGAINST VCU

- Tuesday's matchup will be the first of two meetings against VCU this season. The home and home season series finishes up in Charlottesville on May 14.
- The two teams split the season series last year with each school winning their respective home game. The Rams scored the first seven runs in a 11-3 win at the Diamond last season. The Cavaliers earned the split with a 2-0 shutout in Charlottesville. Five pitchers combined for the two-hitter and Cameron Comer's two-run home run in the bottom of the seventh inning.
- Virginia head coach Brian O'Connor is 19-3 against VCU in his career. Two of the three losses against the Rams have come at The Diamond.

CLOSE CALLS

- Virginia lost a pair of one-run games this past weekend at North Carolina. Sunday's 5-4 defeat marked the third time this season the Cavaliers have lost a rubber match of an ACC series by one run.
- All but one of Virginia's 11, one-run games this season have occurred in conference play.
- The Cavaliers are 4-7 overall in one-run games and 2-3 in games decided by two runs.
- Against North Carolina this weekend Virginia held the lead three times in the two, one-run losses on the weekend.
- In Saturday's 5-4, walk-off loss, the Cavaliers out-hit the Tar Heels, 11-9. It marked only the third time this season Virginia lost a game despite out-hitting its opponent.

MOVING RUNNERS

- With four sacrifice flies in five games last week, Virginia moved to a tie for sixth in the country with 29 on the season. UC Santa Barbara leads the country with 34 in 39 games.
- The Cavaliers are ranked second in the ACC in sacrifice hits with 28, trailing ACC-leader Notre Dame who as recorded 32 on the season.
- Senior Jack Weiller has five sacrifice flies to his credit, tied for the third most in the ACC.

ON THE DEFENSIVE

- Virginia made an uncharacteristic, four errors in the North Carolina series. Coming into Chapel Hill, the Cavaliers had committed just two in their previous nine games.
- The Cavalier infield combination of Nate Eikhoff (1B), Nic Kent (2B), Tanner Morris (SS) and Zack Gelof (3B) have started each of the last 39 games together. Morris, Gelof and Eikhoff have started every single game at the same position this season.
- Virginia comes into the game with a .979 fielding percentage, the third-best in the ACC.

PLAYER TIDBITS

- Nate Eikhoff started his 101st straight game on Sunday vs. North Carolina, the longest active start streak on the team.
- Catcher Logan Michaels enters the weekend ranked in 49th on the country's toughest to strikeout list (11.3). He carries a 10-game reached base streak into Tuesday's game.
- Zack Gelof swiped his 13th bag of the season on Saturday moving into 10th place in the ACC. One more would tie Jarrett Parker for the third most ever in a single season by a UVA freshman.
- Tanner Morris comes into Tuesday night's game tied for fifth in the country and tops in the ACC with 20 doubles. His .344 batting average leads the team and ranks sixth in the league. His 62 hits through 46 games, tops his freshman year season total of 59.
- In Sunday's series finale at North Carolina Cameron Simmons became third different Cavalier to bat in the lead-off spot. It marked the third time in his career he's led off. Tanner Morris (23 games) and Zack Gelof (21 games) have spent time in the top spot of the lineup. The Cavaliers have used 32 different lineup combinations in 46 games.
- Chesdin Harrington kept the Cavaliers in game two of this past weekend's series with North Carolina. He tossed a career-high five innings of relief, allowed three hits and struck out three batters. Defensively he was responsible seven of the 15 outs he was on the mound for (three strikeouts, four assists and one putout).
- As a first year, Nic Kent leads the Cavaliers with 37 RBI and 10 multi-RBI games. A freshman has not led the Cavaliers in RBI since Jon Benick in 1999.

FIRST YEAR THIEVES

- Freshmen Zack Gelof and Nic Kent each have 10+ stolen bases to their credit
- Only one other time in UVA history has a two or more freshmen stolen 10 bases in a single season. Back in 2008, Jarrett Parker (14), Dan Grovatt (10) and David Coleman (10) swiped 10 or more bags in their first year on grounds.
- As a team, Virginia has compiled 42 stolen bases in 43 games with Gelof (12) and Kent (18) leading the way.

COMEBACK KIDS

· Virginia has a total of 12 come-from-behind victories in 2019.
· On Friday (March 15), Virginia erased a two-run deficit in the top of the ninth, scoring three runs and taking the series opener against Georgia Tech, 9-8. The last time Virginia erased a two or more run deficit in the ninth inning or later was almost a year to the day earlier, when Virginia scored three in the 10th to defeat Boston College on March 18, 2018.
· The Cavaliers have scored 30 runs in the eighth inning this season, only the fourth inning (34 runs) has been more productive.

MLB4 AT A GLANCE

· Virginia played three ranked foes (No. 2 Vanderbilt, No. 17 TCU & No. 24 Cal State Fullerton) in the inaugural MLB4 Collegiate Baseball Tournament in Scottsdale, Ariz. to open the 2019 season.

· It marked the first time in school history Virginia played three-ranked opponents to start a season and Vanderbilt was the highest ranked team to open the season since 2010 when it started up with a three-game series at No. 11 East Carolina.
· Against Vanderbilt, an eight-run third inning doomed Virginia in a 15-9 loss in a game that aired live on MLB Network. On Saturday against TCU, the Cavaliers fell behind 7-0 after the first inning and could not recover. In the tournament finale, Cal State Fullerton scored three runs in the top of the ninth to wipe away a 5-3 Virginia advantage.
· Virginia is winless through its first four games for the first time since 2003 when it dropped its first three games at Auburn.

FRESH START

· 2018 marked the first time in Brian O'Connor's tenure that Virginia failed to qualify for the NCAA Tournament. The streak of 14-straight regionals was the fourth-longest in college baseball going into last season. Only two programs, Florida State (41-straight) and Cal State Fullerton (27-straight) hold active streaks more than 14.

· In the history of college baseball only 15 programs have qualified for the NCAA Tournament 14-straight seasons.
· Head Coach Brian O'Connor is one of five coaches ever to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the first 14 seasons at the helm.

· RHP Chesdin Harrington - Missed 2018 season due to injury, figures to big part of UVA bullpen in 2019, one of three pitchers with NCAA Regional experience

· Virginia reliever Andrew Abbott, a freshman All-American last season was on the initial NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Watch list, annually giving to the country's top relief pitcher.
· Abbott pitched almost exclusively out of the bullpen with 23 relief appearances
· His 74 strikeouts as a reliever were the third most in the ACC and sixth most in the ACC

- Six Cavaliers were selected in the 2018 MLB Draft for the second-straight season.
