LEADING OFF

- Virginia comes into the weekend series winners of three-straight games, the fifth time the Cavaliers have brought a three-plus game win streak into an ACC weekend.
- The Cavaliers have won three-straight series against Virginia Tech and have won seven of the last nine meetings.
- Head Coach Brian O'Connor enters the series with 698 career wins, all at UVA. He is currently fourth among active head coaches with a .710 winning percentage.
- Against the Hokies, O'Connor is 30-12 in his tenure. The Cavaliers own a 101-86 edge in the all-time series that was first played in 1900.
- The Cavaliers own a 7-8 mark in true road games this season.
- Virginia is 11-2 against teams from the Commonwealth this season.

MIDWEEK RECAP

- Virginia closed out its non-conference slate with an 8-7 win over VCU at Disharoon Park. It marked the 11-straight win against a non-ACC for this season.
- Cayman Richardson drove in the go-ahead run in the bottom of the eighth inning to put the Cavaliers in front for good.
- Redshirt senior Riley Wilson secured his first career save in what was likely his last career appearance at Disharoon Park. He is the team's active leader in appearances with 54.
- VCU erased a four-run deficit in the top eighth inning to tie the game at seven.

TEAM NOTES

- The Cavaliers have swiped 10 bases in the last three games, the most in a three-game stretch this season.
 - Virginia has racked up 10 or more hits in the last three games. The Cavaliers eclipsed the 500-hit mark for the season, one of seven teams in the league with 500 or more hits.
 - Virginia is ranked third in the ACC in batting (.294) and second in fielding percentage (.978).
 - The Cavaliers totaled 29 runs in their three-game series with Louisville, the most in any series of the season. The Cardinals came into the weekend with the ACC's top team earned run average.
 - As a team, the Cavaliers have struck out 328 times, the fewest in the ACC.
- stole eight bases in the Louisville series, including a season-high four in the series clinching win on Saturday (May 11). The four stolen bases in the contest were the most in a conference game since swiping six at Virginia Tech on April 19, 2017.

PLAYER NOTES/TRENDS

• Cameron Simmons became the third player on the team to enter the double-digit stolen base club last Friday against Louisville with his 10th of the season. He is a perfect 11-for-11 on the year and 23-for-27 in his career. Virginia has only had three different players steal 10 or more bases one other time the previous five seasons (2017).

• Senior Nate Eikhoff enters the weekend having reached base in 16-straight games, the fourth Cavalier this season to run a streak of 15 more games. Eikhoff, the team's active leader in hits (172) and runs scored (93) is an RBI shy of 100 for his career. He has started 106 consecutive games, including all 51 at first base this season.

• Tanner Morris leads the league in doubles with 20, despite 10-game doubles drought. He currently ranks 6th in the league in batting average (.355) and eighth in hits (71).

• Cayman Richardson blasted his first career home run in game two of the Louisville series as part of a 6-for-8 effort in Virginia's two wins against Louisville. The junior is batting .329 (28-for-85) with 19 runs scored in 26 ACC games.

• Nic Kent did it all for the Cavaliers in Saturday's series clinching victory. He put forth his second, four-hit game by going 4-for-4 with a run scored, an RBI and a stolen base. He also recorded seven assists in the field, the most by a Cavaliers since 2017.

• Two-way player Devin Ortiz has allowed only one run (unearned) in his last 14.2 innings pitched. His a tied for the team lead in wins (4) and has 31 strikeouts in 30.2 innings pitched.

FIRST YEAR THIEVES

- Freshmen Zack Gelof and Nic Kent each have 10+ stolen bases to their credit
- Only one other time in UVA history has a two or more freshmen stolen 10 bases in a single season. Back in 2008, Jarrett Parker (14), Dan Grovatt (10) and David Coleman (10) swiped 10 or more bags in their first year on grounds.
- As a team, Virginia has compiled 50 stolen bases in 50 games with Gelof (15) and Kent (13) leading the way.

BREAKING DOWN THE STREAK(S)

- Freshman Zack Gelof reached base in his first 28 games of his collegiate career, only Joe McCarthy (36 games in 2013) started off on a longer streak in UVA history.
- He used a hit in 24 of the 28 games to reach base.
- In the midst of the reached base streak, Gelof put together a 17-game hit streak, the longest by a UVA freshman since 2000.
- He prolonged his reached base streak in his final turn at the plate five times and used his final turn to extend his hit streak, three times.

SUCCESS AT THE DISH

· The victory on April 24th against James Madison was the 20th of the season for the Cavaliers. Virginia has won 20 or more games at home in all but one season (2015) since Brian O'Connor took over the program in 2004.
· Virginia is 448-123 (.785) overall and 107-53 (.669) in ACC play at Disharoon Park during O'Connor's tenure.

SMALL MARGIN FOR ERROR

· Virginia has played in 12, one-run games this season and own a 5-7 mark in those matchups. All but two of those one-run games have come in ACC play.
· The Cavaliers have dropped four, series-deciding victories by one run this season including Sunday finales against then No. 4 NC State and then No. 15 North Carolina.
· Of the 27 ACC games played this season, 13 have been decided by one or two runs with Virginia owning a 4-9 record in those contests.
· Over the past two seasons, Virginia is 9-15 in one-run games against ACC foes.

MLB4 AT A GLANCE

· Virginia played three ranked foes (No. 2 Vanderbilt, No. 17 TCU & No. 24 Cal State Fullerton) in the inaugural MLB4 Collegiate Baseball Tournament in Scottsdale, Ariz. to open the 2019 season.
· It marked the first time in school history Virginia played three-ranked opponents to start a season and Vanderbilt was the highest ranked team to open the season since 2010 when it started up with a three-game series at No. 11 East Carolina.
· Against Vanderbilt, an eight-run third inning doomed Virginia in a 15-9 loss in a game that aired live on MLB Network. On Saturday against TCU, the Cavaliers fell behind 7-0 after the first inning and could not recover. In the tournament finale, Cal State Fullerton scored three runs in the top of the ninth to wipe away a 5-3 Virginia advantage.
· Virginia is winless through its first four games for the first time since 2003 when it dropped its first three games at Auburn.

FRESH START

· 2018 marked the first time in Brian O'Connor's tenure that Virginia failed to qualify for the NCAA Tournament. The streak of 14-straight regionals was the fourth-longest in college baseball going into last season. Only two programs, Florida State (41-straight) and Cal State Fullerton (27-straight) hold active streaks more than 14.
· In the history of college baseball only 15 programs have qualified for the NCAA Tournament 14-straight seasons.
· Head Coach Brian O'Connor is one of five coaches ever to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the first 14 seasons at the helm.

COMEBACK KIDS

· RHP Noah Murdock - Had Tommy John surgery after 2017 season, pitched in five games at end of 2018 season.
· RHP Evan Sperling - Sunday starter in 2018, season cut short due to injury, had a 1.96 ERA over first four starts
· RHP Chesdin Harrington - Missed 2018 season due to injury, figures to big part of UVA bullpen in 2019, one of three pitchers with NCAA Regional experience

STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

· Virginia reliever Andrew Abbott, a freshman All-American last season was on the initial NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Watch list, annually giving to the country's top relief pitcher.
· Abbott pitched almost exclusively out of the bullpen with 23 relief appearances
· His 74 strikeouts as a reliever were the third most in the ACC and sixth most in the ACC

· SS Tanner Morris, a draft eligible sophomore is the No. 49 overall prospect on Baseball America's Top. 50 College Prospect list.

- Six Cavaliers were selected in the 2018 MLB Draft for the second-straight season.
- Two of this year's picks fell in the Top 40, including Daniel Lynch at No. 34 overall to the Royals.
