LEADING OFF

- Virginia comes into the weekend winners of six-consecutive games, one win shy matching last season's longest win streak.
- With a 10-3 record, Virginia has posted double-digit wins through its first 13 games 11 times in 17 seasons under head coach Brian O'Connor including 13-0 starts in 2013, 2009 & 2007.
- Virginia and NC State are two of the 29 teams in Division I College Baseball with a double-digit win total entering the fourth weekend of the season.
- Under head Coach Brian O'Connor, the Cavaliers are 288-179-1 in ACC play. His 288 wins are the 8th most in league history and fourth most among active ACC coaches. His winning percentage (.616) in ACC play is the sixth-highest in league history and second among active coaches.
- NC State is the first team on Virginia's schedule ranked in the USA Today Coaches poll. Last season the Cavaliers were 4-12 against ranked foes.
- Virginia has scored 115 runs this season, the most in the ACC and the ninth most in the country.
- Virginia is 9-1 on its current 15-game home stand, the longest home stint in the Brian O'Connor era (2004-present)

AGAINST NC STATE

- Coming into the series last year, NC State owned a 25-1 record and the Cavaliers handed the Wolfpack a 4-3 loss in the weekend opener. Previously NC State had been unbeaten in all 10 of its one-run games.
- Friday night starter Griff McGarry struck out five of the first six batters he faced and totaled eight in 4.2 innings pitched.
- NC State visits Charlottesville for the first time since 2016, a 2-1 series victory for the Wolfpack.
- Virginia is seeking its first series win over NC State since the 2013 season.
- 12 of the last 15 games between the two schools have been decided by three or less runs, including six by one run.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- The Cavalier offense has totaled 10 or more runs in six of the last eight games, including a 20-run outburst against Dartmouth on Feb. 28.
- The 20-run effort was the first since a 20-7 win over Wagner on March 9, 2016. It marked the 10th time Virginia has scored 20 or more runs under O'Connor. The 22-hit performance in the contest was the most since March 25, 2017 when the Cavaliers racked up 20 in a 13-7 win over Duke. The 22 hits are tied for the eighth most in single game under head Coach Brian O'Connor (since 2004).
- Virginia has racked up 10 or more hits in four of the last five games.
- The only loss on the Cavalier home stand came in a 14-10 decision against Bucknell in which the tying run came to the plate in the ninth. The loss when scoring 10 runs was on the second since the 2015 season.
- Virginia has scored in bunches with five innings of five or more runs in the last four games.

- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 27 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

· After not leaving the yard in the first four games of the year, Virginia has hit home runs in eight of the last nine games, including six-straight.
 · The Cavaliers have hit 15 home runs through the first 13 games, the second most in O'Connor's tenure (2017 - 16 HRs). The 15 home runs are third most in the ACC and 16th most in the nation.

ON THE HILL

- The Virginia pitching staff has struck out 152 batters this season, the sixth-most in the country.
- Right-handed pitcher Griff McGarry will be Virginia's Friday night starter for the fourth-straight week. Opponents are batting .097 off him, the second-lowest in the league.
- Both McGarry and Saturday starter Mike Vasil have set single-game strikeout highs this season - McGarry, 12 strikeouts vs. Dartmouth and Vasil 10 strikeouts vs. Bucknell. The duo is responsible for all three of the staff's quality starts this season.
- Out of the bullpen, graduate transfer Stephen Schoch is tied for second in the ACC and eighth in the country with four saves. He has appeared in eight games this season and struck out 20 batters in 10.2 innings pitched.
- With a combined 12 appearances, Andrew Abbott and Kyle Whitten have yet to surrender an earned run. Abbott is tied for the team lead with three wins and Whitten has a team-best three bullpen holds to his credit.

PLAYER NOTES

- Logan Michaels and Marc Lebrux have hit safely in a team-high six-straight games. Michaels set new single-game career bests in hits (4), doubles (2) and RBI (4) against Richmond on Tuesday night.
- Freshman Max Cotier tripled for the third time this season in Tuesday's win over Richmond. The three triples are the most in the ACC and tied for the second most in the country. Two of the three came against Dartmouth last Saturday becoming the first Cavalier since Adam Haseley in 2016 to triple twice in a game.

LEAVING THE YARD

- Through 13 games this season Virginia has hit 15 home runs, the third most in the ACC.
- Virginia has hit 15 or more home runs through its first 13 games one other time in Brian O'Connor's tenure - 2017 with 16 in the first 13 games.
- Eight different players have been responsible for the 15 Cavalier long balls. Of the eight players, five went deep for the first time in their Cavalier careers.
- Christian Hlinka leads the team and is tied for second with four homers in just 24 at bats. Of the 72 players in DI baseball with four or more home runs, only 11, including Hlinka, have appeared in 10 or less games.
- Virginia has hit two grand slams, the latest coming off the bat of Chris Newell who powered an eight-run seventh inning against Dartmouth on last weekend
- Zack Gelof rounded the bases for an inside the park home run on Saturday against Dartmouth, the first since Danny Hultzen did it against Richmond on April 20, 2011.
- Hlinka and teammate Jimmy Sullivan went back-to-back against Dartmouth on Saturday becoming the first duo since Jake McCarthy and Adam Haseley hit consecutive home runs at Georgia Tech on May 18, 2017.

NEWELL-COMER

- In four games last week, freshman Chris Newell went 10-for-15 (.667) with three doubles, a triple, a grand slam eight RBI and five runs scored.
- Newell currently leads the team in batting average (.410) and co-leads the team with in hits (16) and RBI (13).
- Newell's .574 on-base percentage is the second-highest in the ACC and ranked 20th-best in the NCAA.
- Newell has reached base in all but one of his first 13 games of his college career and has five-straight multi-hit games coming into Friday.
- On top of his work at the plate, Newell is a perfect 6-for-6 in

stolen bases, tied for the fourth most in the ACC.

PENSACOLA IN REVIEW

- Virginia began the season with a 6-0 shutout of Oklahoma who was ranked as high as No. 16 in this week's Baseball America Top 25.
- The opening day shutout was the first by the Cavaliers since 2009 (12-0 vs. Bucknell). Four Cavalier pitchers - Griff McGarry, Kyle Whitten, Andrew Abbott and Stephen Schoch limited the Sooners too just two hits.
- With inclement weather in the forecast, the two teams were forced to play a doubleheader on Saturday in which the Sooners were victorious, 7-2 and 5-1 to take the three-game series.
- Oklahoma pitchers limited the Cavaliers to six hits over the 18 innings of the Saturday double dip.
- The series took place at the Pensacola Blue Wahoos, the Double-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

NEW HOOS

- Over the weekend, eight new Cavaliers saw their first action as a member of the program. A total of four position players and three pitchers made their collegiate debuts.
- Second baseman Max Cotier started all three games and his first hit of his college career came in his first at bat last Friday night, an RBI single that scored Nic Kent.
- Junior transfer Marc Lebrux also started all three games (1 Lf, 2 RF) and came up with a big two-RBI hit late in the season-opening win over Oklahoma.
- Three freshman hurlers - Jacob Baldino, Nate Savino and Matt Wyatt - all saw action on opening weekend. Baldino pitched the final two innings of game one of Saturday's doubleheader, did not allow a run and struck out a pair of batters.

- Baseball America picked LHP Nate Savino as the publication's ACC Freshman of the Year. Savino and OF Chris Newell were the top two freshmen in the ACC.
- LHP Nate Savino came in at No. 3 on D1Baseball.com's Preseason Top 150 freshman while fellow first year Chris Newell came in at No. 11

SEASONED PITCHING STAFF

- A stark contrast from a year ago, Virginia returns over 380 innings from its pitching staff last season, including Griff McGarry, Chesdin Harrington and Mike Vasil who all spent time on the weekend rotation.
- The 2019 Cavaliers returned just 177 innings, the fewest in O'Connor's tenure at Virginia and only the second time the Cavaliers had less than 200 innings returning since 2004.
- At the back end of the bullpen, Virginia will turn to Andrew Abbott who has been one of the ACC's most reliable arms the past two seasons. He spent the summer of the 2019 on the U.S. Collegiate National team, co-leading the high-profile staff in appearances (7) while sporting a 2-1 record with a 2.25 ERA and 12 strikeouts in 12 innings pitched.

AT THE PLATE

- Historically, Virginia has been one of the top hitting teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Since 2009, the Cavaliers are sport a .302 batting average, highest in the league during that span.
- In the past two seasons, Virginia has the fewest strikeouts of any team in the ACC. In 2019, UVA hitters fanned 371 times and in 2018, 319 times, both league-lows.
- Senior Logan Michaels was statistically the ACC's toughest batter to strikeout (11.3 AB/K) in 2019.

DYNAMIC DUO

- Nic Kent and Zack Gelof combined to steal 33 bases as freshmen. Only twice in UVA history has a pair of first years swiped 10+ bags in a single season. Only one other time in UVA history has a two or more freshmen stolen 10 bases in a single season.
- Kent was the first UVA freshman to earn First Team All-ACC honors since Danny Hultzen and first position player since 1973.
- Gelof reached successfully in first 28-straight games, second most as a freshman since 2000, his 17-game hit streak the longest by a UVA freshman since 2000.
- Kent ended the 2019 season on a 13-game hit streak and reached base safely 16-straight.
- Gelof has reached base safely in 12-straight games coming into the 2020 season.

- In the history of college baseball only 16 programs have qualified for the NCAA Tournament 14-straight seasons.
- Head Coach Brian O'Connor is one of five coaches ever to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the first 14 seasons at the helm.

- Jim Morris, Miami - 1994-2016 (23 seasons)
- Brian O'Connor, Virginia - 2004-17 (14 seasons)**

- Counting his time as an assistant at Notre Dame under Paul Mainieri, O'Connor went to 19-straight NCAA Regionals, five with the Irish from 1999-03.

HOOS AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL

- A total of five former Cavaliers made their Major League debuts in 2019 - Adam Haseley (Phillies), Danny Hultzen (Cubs), Branden Kline (Orioles), Josh Sborz (Los Angeles Dodgers) and Matt Thaiss (Los Angeles Angels). The five new big leaguers were tied for the most of any college baseball program.
- A total of 13 former Cavaliers were listed on MLB rosters during the 2019 season, establishing a new program record.

MLB DRAFT SUCCESS

- Virginia is one of four schools nationally (Arkansas, Florida & Rice) to have a pick in the first five rounds in each of the last 10 MLB Drafts.
- UVA was the only program in the country to have a first round pick every year from 2014-18. The Cavaliers have boasted a first round pick in eight of Brian O'Connor's 16 seasons.
- 20 Cavaliers have been selected in the top three rounds under in the past 16 years
- 84 players have been drafted in the Brian O'Connor era (since 2004) and a total of 132 since the start of the program.
- Virginia has had 14 First Round draft picks, 12 have played for head coach Brian O'Connor.
- Adam Haseley (7th overall) and Pavin Smith (8th overall) are

one of two sets of position players teammates to be selected in the top-10 since 1988 (OSU - Monty Fariss & Robin Ventura)

HOOS IN THE WORLD SERIES

- Former Cavaliers Ryan Zimmerman "Mr. National" and Sean Doolittle were key components to the Washington Nationals 2019 World Series Championship. Zimmerman blasted a three-run homer against the Dodgers in game four of the NLCS and is now regarded as one of the greatest moments in franchise history. Doolittle appeared in nine postseason games and didn't allow a run in three World Series appearances. He earned the save in game one of the World Series, a 5-4 win in Houston.
- Virginia is the only program in the country to be represented in the last four World Series.
- Chris Taylor became the first Cavalier to play in back-to-back World Series as a member of the Dodgers in 2017 and 2018. He was named co-MVP of the 2017 NLCS after batting .316 with two home runs, five runs scored and three RBIs. Virginia has been represented in the last three World Series (Brandon Guyer - CLE -2016).
