LEADING OFF

- After playing six of the last seven games on the road, Virginia will play eight-straight at home, the longest stretch of the season.
- In the month of March, the Cavaliers are scheduled to play 12 games at Disharoon Park and five away from Charlottesville.
- Virginia has won 18-straight midweek games going into Tuesday's non-conference tilt.
- The Cavaliers come into the game having allowed three or less runs in eight of the first 11 games.
- At Disharoon Park this season, Virginia has won four of five games. Dating back to last season, the Cavaliers are 17-3 in the last 20 games at home.
- Tuesday will mark the 149th meeting between Richmond and Virginia in a series that was first played 1889.

AGAINST RICHMOND

- The Cavaliers are 87-59-2 all time against the Spiders and 15-1 under Brian O'Connor.
- The last 11 games involving the two schools have occurred in Charlottesville.
- Richmond was one of eight opponents the Cavaliers squared off against in 2020. The Cavaliers erupted for 16 runs in their lone contest against the Spiders last season, its third-highest run total in the 18-game shortened season.
- In last year's meeting, Richmond led 3-2 before Virginia scored the next 13 runs in an eventual 16-7 victory, the sixth-consecutive win heading into the first ACC series against then-No. 7 NC State.
- Logan Michaels had his best game as a Cavalier in 2020, going 4-for-5 with four RBI and a run scored. The four hits and four RBI remain career highs.

ON THE HILL

- Last Tuesday against George Washington, Nate Savino sat down the first 10 batters he faced and pitched into the fifth inning in his second start of the year. The lefty struck out four batters and did not allow an earned run or issue a walk in career-high, 4.2 innings pitched.
- As a staff, Virginia ranks fifth in the country with 138 total strikeouts and its 13.1 strikeouts per nine innings are the seventh most of any D1 program.
- Virginia is allowing 6.25 hits per nine innings, the fewest among any ACC school and is ranked 17th among NCAA D1 schools.
- In a three-game series at Florida State, the Cavaliers combined for 44 strikeouts including 14 by Friday night starter Andrew Abbott, the most by a UVA pitcher since 2014.
- The Cavaliers have struck out 10 or more batters in nine of 11 games this season and 15 or more on five different occasions.

MIDWEEK MADNESS

- In two midweek games this season, Virginia has amassed 25 runs on 25 hits. The Cavaliers posted a season-high, 14 runs against VMI on Feb. 23.
- On the flip side Virginia pitchers have surrendered just three earned runs, in 18.0 innings, good for an ERA of 1.50. Against George Washington last Tuesday, seven Cavalier pitchers did not yield an earned run.

ONE RUN AFFAIRS

- Virginia was on the right side of a one-run game on Sunday at Florida State for the second time in ACC play this season. The Cavaliers are 3-3 in games decided by one run in 2021.
- The Cavaliers were involved in five, one-run decisions in their first seven games of the 2021 season, matching a school record set in 1938 and 1951.
- The North Carolina series marked the first time Virginia played an ACC series with each game decided by a run since 2018 when it played six-straight starting with Louisville on the road and ending with a three-game set against Clemson at Disharoon Park.
- The Cavaliers have played a total of six ACC series in which all three games were decided by a run in the Brian O'Connor era.

CLOSING THE DOOR

- Closer Stephen Schoch is 4-for-4 in save attempts this season, tied for the most in the NCAA. No save was more stressful than Sunday's seven-out heart-stopper at Florida State. The righthander escaped two bases loaded jams and left the tying run on second in the ninth inning in an eventual 2-1 victory. The save was Schoch's longest as a Cavalier and fourth save that has required four or more outs.
- Schoch's 22 career saves are tied for the second most among active NCAA pitchers. Nine of the 22 have come in a Cavalier uniform.
- Three more saves and Schoch will enter the top-10 all-time in career saves at UVA.

PLAYER NOTES

- Reliever Blake Bales co-leads the ACC with six appearances out of the bullpen. He has not allowed a run in 5.1 innings pitched and has fanned 11 of the 20 batters he's faced this season.
- Catcher Logan Michaels has caught all 11 games for the Cavaliers and has also made an impact on the offensive end. He leads the team with nine runs scored and his 10 hits are the third most on the team. Michaels has only struck out five times in 37 at bats and his 0.45 strikeouts per game are the seventh fewest in the ACC.
- Brendan Rivoli was responsible for both Cavalier runs in the 2-1 Sunday victory over Florida State. His double in the first and single in the third both came with two outs. He is 5-for-12 (.417) when batting with two outs this season.

HOME AT THE DISH

- 2021 is the 20th season of baseball at Disharoon Park in which the Cavaliers own a 496-149 (.769) mark
- Before the 2020 season came to a halt, the Cavaliers wrapped a 15-game home stand, the longest in Brian O'Connor's tenure in which they posted a 13-2 record
- The Cavaliers will play 29 home regular season home games in Charlottesville this season.

OPENING WEEKEND TIDBITS

- In three games decided by one or two runs, the Cavaliers took two out of three games against UConn this past weekend at Disharoon Park. The Huskies had been receiving votes in a number of college baseball polls.
- The two wins on opening weekend for the Cavaliers were the first since 2017 when they won games against Liberty, The Citadel and Kansas in Charleston. The weekend sweep sparked a 10-game win streak to start the season.
- Virginia clinched the series on Sunday with a 4-2 victory thanks to a quality start from Mike Vasil (6 IP, 0 ER, 6 SO) and a pair of timely two-out hits from Brendan Rivoli and Logan Michaels. Along with Vasil, the Cavalier bullpen did not surrender an earned run and closer Stephen Schoch shut the door in the ninth with his second save of the weekend.
- Starting pitchers Andrew Abbott and Griff McGarry each struck out nine batters in their first starts of the season. The Cavaliers struck out 15 batters on Friday and Saturday while it fanned 11 in the series finale on Sunday.
- Three Cavaliers made their collegiate debuts - Jake Gelof, Jake Berry and Luke Schauer.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- For the first time since 2017, the Cavaliers open the season ranked in every major college baseball poll. The Cavaliers come in as high as No. 5 in Baseball America, the fifth time appearing in its preseason top five since 2010.
- Senior pitcher Andrew Abbott and junior third baseman Zack Gelof were both listed on the initial, 55-person watch list for the Golden Spikes Award, annually given to the top amateur baseball player in the country
- In the release of Baseball America's top 150 college players, eight Cavaliers were included, tied for the most in the country.
