## LEADING OFF

- VMI serves as the opponent in Virginia's home opener for the sixth time in the last seven seasons.
- UVA is 3-0 for the first time since 2017 and the eighth time (2004, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2013, 2015, 2017, 2022) under Brian O'Connor.
- The Cavaliers are 15-3 in home openers at Disharoon Park since 2004.
- Virginia and VMI will meet for the 141st time on Wednesday. The Cavaliers own a 108-32 advantage in the all-time series that dates back to 1889, the first year of Virginia baseball.
- UVA has won four-straight and is 15-5 against the Keydets in the O'Connor era.

## HOT START

- Virginia is one of 62 D-1 college baseball programs to come out of opening weekend without a loss. All but five ACC schools have started the year undefeated.
- Over the course of three games at the Jerry Bryson Classic hosted by Gardner-Webb, Virginia allowed three runs, 11 hits and did not commit an error 109 chances.
- It marked only the second time since 2000 that Virginia has started the season errorless through the first three games (2016). The Cavaliers committed their first error in 2016 in the fourth game against VMI.

## ON THE MOUND

- The Cavaliers recorded consecutive shutouts to open the season for only the second time in program history (2009) after blanking Bellarmine and Gardner-Webb at the Jerry Bryson Classic.
- It marked the first time since 2019 (March 2 vs. Seton Hall & March 4 vs. Wagner) that Virginia pitched consecutive shutouts.
- Virginia is one of six teams in the country to record multiple shutouts on opening weekend (Texas Southern-3, Belmont, Sacramento St., Tennessee & UCF).
- The three runs surrendered by Virginia in the first three games are the fewest since allowing one in the first three games of the 2009 season.
- UVA pitchers allowed 11 hits over its first three games, tied for the fourth-fewest by any program in the country.

## ORTIZ'S FIRST START OF 2022

- Righthander Devin Ortiz will make his first start on the mound since his start against ODU in the 2021 Columbia Regional Final. He was named the regional's most outstanding player after pitching four shutout innings and eventually hit a walk-off home run in the bottom of the 10th to send Virginia to the the super regionals.
- His pitching career will come full circle on Wednesday. His first career win on the mound came in his second collegiate appearance on Feb. 27, 2018 against VMI as a true freshman.
- Ortiz has not allowed an earned run in his last 27.1 innings pitched, a streak that started back in 2019. His last earned run came on April 20, 2019 against Florida State.

- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals

- Competed in 14 NCAA regionals and six super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

### ORTIZ'S FIRST START OF 2022

- Righthander Devin Ortiz will make his first start on the mound since his start against ODU in the 2021 Columbia Regional Final. He went on to earn the regional's most outstanding player award after pitching four shutout innings and eventually hit a walk-off home run in the bottom of the 10th to send Virginia to the College World Series.
- His pitching career will come full circle on Wednesday. His first win on the mound came in his second collegiate appearance on Feb. 27, 2018 against VMI as a true freshman.
- Ortiz has not allowed an earned run in his last 27.1 innings pitched, a streak that started back in 2019. His last earned run came on April 20, 2019 against Florida State.

### ON THE BASEPATHS

- Chris Newell stole three bases in the season opener against Bellarmine, the first UVA player to steal three in a game since 2017 when Adam Haseley swiped three against VCU on March 29.
- Newell's three stolen bases are tied for the most in the ACC.
- Newell's .923 career stolen base percentage (24-26) is the third highest of any Cavalier with 20 or more attempts since 2000.

### LAST MEETING

- On Feb. 23, 2021, Virginia erased a 3-0 deficit in the second inning and scored 14 consecutive runs over the next seven turns at the plate to secure their fourth-straight win over VMI.
- Chris Newell hit his second career grand slam in the sixth inning as part a five-run sixth inning. Newell went 2-for-5 with a double, home run, two runs scored and four RBI in the contest.
- Eight different pitchers combined to strikeout 18 VMI batters in the contest. It was the first of five different occasions that Virginia struck out 18 or more batters during the 2021 season.

### OTHER CAVALIER NOTABLES

- Virginia climbed up to No. 4 in the Baseball America Top-25. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 2 after the first week of action last season according to Baseball America.
- Catcher Kyle Teel reached safely in all three games of the Jerry Bryson Classic, extending his reached base streak to 29 games that dates back to the 2021 season.
- Freshman Casey Saucke homered in his first collegiate game, serving as the designated hitter against Gardner-Webb. He leads the team with a .571 batting average (4-for-7) going into midweek action.
- At the plate Devin Ortiz is five hits away for 100 for his career.

### PRESEASON POLLING

- For the second-straight season, Virginia comes into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.
- After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.
- In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.
- Virginia was picked to finished second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

### NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

- Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.
- Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.
- As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.
- Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).
- Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.
- Dating back to last season, Teel has reached base in 26-straight games.

### PRESEASON NOTARIETY

- The Cavaliers had seven players included on D1Baseball's Position Power Rankings - 2B Max Cotier (40), OF Chris Newell (56), 1B Devin Ortiz (29), Catcher Kyle Teel (3), SP Matt Wyatt (52), SP Nate Savino (82) and Brandon Neeck (105)
- On Baseball America's top-150 baseball players list, Kyle Teel came in at 44, Savino at 74 and Newell at 76.

### LOOKING BACK TO 2021

- UVA went 4-12 in its first 16 ACC games and finished and won 14 of its last 20 ACC games to earn the 8th seed in the ACC Tournament.
- To close out the regular season, Virginia won 10 of its last 14 games.
- Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.
- All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.
- Virginia ranked 14th in the nation with a 3.62 ERA and second in the ACC, the first time in the top-20 since 2014.
