LEADING OFF

- Virginia is 8-0 to start the season for the ninth time in program history and the sixth time under head coach Brian O'Connor (2008, 2009, 2013, 2015, 2017, 2021).
- Entering the weekend UVA is one of 15 undefeated teams in the country and one of four in the ACC.
- The Cavaliers have posted double-digit run efforts in each of the last five games, a feat that hasn't been accomplished by a UVA offense since 2010. Virginia has scored 10 or more runs in six consecutive games three times in program history - 1889, 1893 & 2006.
- Dating back to last season, Virginia has won its last seven games at home, including all five this season.
- Virginia begins the series as the national leader in strikeouts (116), strikeouts per nine innings (14.5) and shutouts (4)

AMONG THE NATION'S ELITE

- UVA is nationally ranked by Baseball America (5), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (12), USA Today/Coaches (22) and the NCBWA (23).
- Virginia pitchers lead the country in strikeouts per nine innings (14.9) and have fanned 10 or more batters in all but one game this season.
- On offense UVA ranks seventh in runs scored (102), 8th in batting average (.350), 8th on-base percentage (8th) and 10th in home runs (14).
- In addition to the top ranks in the nation in strikeouts, strikeouts per nine innings and shutouts, the UVA pitching staff ranks sixth in the NCAA in ERA (1.38), 6th in hits allowed per nine innings (5.12), and 10th in WHIP.

FROM THE BUMP

- All three UVA starting pitchers, Nate Savino, Brian Gursky and Brandon Neeck earned a win their respective outings against Cornell last weekend.
- Virginia pitchers have combined to strikeout 10 or more batters in seven of the eight games this season.
- Last Friday, Savino struck out the final eight batters he faced and racked up a career-high 11 strikeouts in his first win of the season. The 11 strikeouts are the most by a Cavalier hurler this season and the most since Andrew Abbott fanned 10 against Tennessee in the College World Series last season.
- Gursky collected his second win of the season after he pitched 5.2 innings, allowed no earned runs and struck out a career-high nine batters in the middle game against Cornell. He completed the rare "immaculate inning" in the second, striking out all three batters by using nine pitches.
- Neeck pitched five innings of one-run baseball and struck out eight batters. Neeck struck out the first three batters he faced on 11 pitches and has allowed one run in 9.1 innings pitched this season.

- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

AGAINST PENN STATE

- Virginia will square off against Penn State for the first time since 2004, the first year the Cavaliers were under the direction of head coach Brian O'Connor.
- The Cavaliers won the first five games of O'Connor's coaching career including a 7-1 victory over the Nittany Lions on Feb. 21, 2004. Penn State came back and handed O'Connor and the Cavaliers their first loss of the 2004 campaign the next day.
- Virginia owns a 12-10 all-time record against Penn State in a series that was first played in 1894, a 14-4 UVA victory.
- After playing a Big Ten only schedule in 2021 and an abbreviated 2020 slate, Virginia will be Penn State's first series against an ACC opponent since 2019 when Duke took two out of three against the Nittany Lions in Bradenton, Fla.

OFF THE CHARTS

- Second-year Jake Gelof comes into the weekend as the national leader in batting average (.636) and slugging percentage (1.682). He ranks in the top 10 in RBI (2nd), on-base percentage (5th), total bases (5th), triples (6th) and home runs (6th).
- On Tuesday against William & Mary, Gelof was a home run short of a cycle in consecutive games and went 3-for-4 with 4 RBI and two runs scored.
- Gelof leads the team with five home runs in eight games. In 38 games played as a true freshman last season he hit four.
- Since being inserted as a regular starter in the Cavalier lineup midway through last season UVA is 24-8.

CAVALIER NOTABLES

- In addition to his 5.2 shutout innings on the mound, two-way player Devin Ortiz was 2-for-3 with two RBI and two runs scored against William & Mary on Tuesday. His two-run single in the bottom of the first to give UVA the initial lead was his 100th hit of his career.
- Prior to Tuesday's game, Ortiz was named the College Baseball Foundation's John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Week.
- Griff O'Ferrall, Gelof, Ortiz and Kyle Teel have each reached base in all eight games. Dating back to last season, Teel has reached base safely in 34-straight games.
- Alex Tappen and Casey Saucke carry six game hit streaks into the weekend series against Penn State.

GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

- Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
- In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
- In Friday's series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
- He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

- Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
- Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
- The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
- Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
- Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
- Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

CAVALIER NOTABLES

- At the plate, Ortiz needs one more hit to reach 100 for his career.
- Alex Tappen is the team's active leader in hits (129) and RBI (96). He is four RBI shy from reaching the century mark.
- Kyle Teel, Griff O'Ferrall, Devin Ortiz and Jake Gelof have all reached safely in UVA's first seven games. Casey Saucke and Max Cotier each own the team's longest hit streaks at six.
- Teel has reached base safely in 33-straight games dating back to last season.

PRESEASON POLLING

· For the second-straight season, Virginia comes into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.

· After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.

· In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.

· Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

· Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.

· Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.

· As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.

· Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).

· Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.

· Dating back to last season, Teel has reached base in 26-straight games.

PRESEASON NOTARIETY

· The Cavaliers had seven players included on D1Baseball's Position Power Rankings - 2B Max Cotier (40), OF Chris Newell (56), 1B Devin Ortiz (29), Catcher Kyle Teel (3), SP Matt Wyatt (52), SP Nate Savino (82) and Brandon Neeck (105)

· On Baseball America's top-150 baseball players list, Kyle Teel came in at 44, Savino at 74 and Newell at 76.

LOOKING BACK TO 2021

· UVA went 4-12 in its first 16 ACC games and finished and won 14 of its last 20 ACC games to earn the 8th seed in the ACC Tournament.

· To close out the regular season, Virginia won 10 of its last 14 games.

· Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.

· All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.

· Virginia ranked 14th in the nation with a 3.62 ERA and second in the ACC, the first time in the top-20 since 2014.
