## LEADING OFF

- Virginia is one of three teams in college baseball that enter the weekend unbeaten (Purdue & Clemson).
- Including the unbeaten, Virginia is one of seven schools (Mercer, Tennessee, Wake Forest & St. Mary's) with 12 wins through the first three weeks.
- The Cavaliers are 12-0 for the third time (2009, 2013, 2022) under head coach Brian O'Connor and are off the best start since the 2013 season when UVA won its first 14 games.
- Through 12 games, Virginia has outscored its opponents 145-23.
- UVA has scored 10 or more runs in nine-straight games, a program record.
- O'Connor enters the 2022 conference slate with a 308-198-1 overall record in league play. The 308 ACC wins are the eighth-most in league history.

## AGAINST DUKE

- Virginia has played Duke to open ACC play four times in the Brian O'Connor era - 2014 (2-1), 2016 (2-1), 2018 (1-2) & 2019 (1-2).
- The Blue Devils have taken six of the last 10 meetings including a 4-2 win in the semifinals of last year's ACC Tournament.
- The Cavaliers own a 104-64-1 all-time advantage in the all-time series that dates back to 1926. Virginia is 35-18 against the Blue Devils under O'Connor.
- Eight of the last 10 meetings have been decided by three or less runs including three one-run affairs.

## NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Virginia is nationally ranked in five of the six major collegiate top-25 polls and come in as high as No. 5 according to Baseball America. The Cavaliers are No. 33 in the latest RPI rankings.
- Virginia comes into the series ranked in the top-10 country in ERA (3rd - 1.58), batting average (9th - .335) and fielding percentage (9th - .988). The Cavaliers are the only team in the country ranked in the top-10 of all three categories.
- The Cavaliers have the No. 2 scoring offense in the country, averaging 12.1 runs per game. The 145 runs produced this season are behind only Tennessee (160) and Wake Forest (151) each club has played one more game than UVA.
- Jake Gelof is three RBI behind the national leader, Tommy White (NC State), going into ACC play. He ranks second in slugging percentage (1.211), fifth in home runs (7), sixth in total bases (46) and 10th in sacrifice flies (3).

- Competed in 14 NCAA regionals and six super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

### HIGHLIGHTS OF THE HOMESTAND

- After winning all three games at the Jerry Bryson Classic hosted by Gardner-Webb, Virginia returned for a nine-game homestand, what is scheduled to be its second-longest stint at home this season.
- UVA extended its home win streak to 12 games and includes last year's sweep of Wake Forest.
- The Cavaliers scored 10 or more runs in each of the nine games at home and limited opponents to 17 runs in that span.
- The series finale against Penn State drew 4,459 fans to Disharoon Park, the largest crowd since 2016.
- Cavalier pitchers struck out 23 batters in the series opener against Cornell, just the 11th time in NCAA history a staff has struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game.
- Jake Gelof hit for the cycle in the series finale against Cornell, the first by a UVA hitter since 2001. He accomplished the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.
- Virginia scored 24 runs against Cornell on Feb. 25, the sixth time under O'Connor that UVA eclipsed the 20-run plateau.
- Lefthander Brian Gursky completed an "immaculate inning" on Feb. 26 against Cornell. He struck out all three batters he faced in the second inning on a total of nine pitches.

### ON THE MOUND

- The Cavaliers have struck out 10 or more batters in all but two games this season including four performances of 15+ strikeouts.
- The Cavaliers rank second in the country with an average of 13.0 strikeouts per nine innings and have fanned 156 batters, tied for the fifth most in the nation.
- Virginia is tied for the national lead with four shutouts in 12 games.
- The pitcher of record for UVA in 10 of the 12 games this season has been the starter.
- In the last five games the Cavalier bullpen allowed four runs in a total of 21.2 innings pitched.
- Friday's starter, Nate Savino recorded UVA's first quality start of the season after tossing six innings of five-hit baseball against Penn State last weekend. Back-to-back doubles produced Penn State's only run of the game but Savino locked in, retiring 13 of the next 17 batters and totaled four strikeouts.
- Gursky, expected to get the nod Saturday, co-leads the team with three wins. He's pitched into the sixth in his last two outings.
- Sunday will be Neeck's third career start. He's pitched into the fifth inning in all three starts this season. Prior to this season, Neeck pitched 5+ innings once, a record-breaking performance of 16 strikeouts against ODU in the 2021 Columbia Regional elimination game.
- Two-way player Devin Ortiz pitched one inning of scoreless relief in Tuesday's midweek game against George Washington after starting the previous two midweek contests. Ortiz has not allowed an earned in in 38 consecutive innings.

### THE BIG INNING

- Virginia has scored five or more runs in a single inning, 11 times this season and all nine games of the recent homestand.
- The Cavaliers broke a 1-1 tie in the fifth inning of game one against Penn State with an eight-run outburst, the largest of the season.
- The fifth inning has been the launching pad for four of the 11 "big innings".

### FIRST YEAR IMPACT

- At the top of the lineup for all 12 games, shortstop Griff O'Ferrall has scored 21 runs, the third-most in the NCAA and the second most in the ACC. In his last two games, the first year is 7-for-9 with four runs scored, three RBI and two stolen bases.

- Freshman Casey Saucke leads the team and ranks ninth in the country with a .500 batting average. He has a team-best, 10-game hit streak going into Tuesday.
- Switch-hitting Ethan Anderson has blasted three home runs in the last five games. He has an RBI in six of his seven starts on the season.
- Colin Tuft has started all but two games as a true freshman (8 in LF, 1 at DH). He's scored a run in each of his nine starts. He notched a season-high three hits and scored three times in the finale against Penn State.

### GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

- Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
- In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
- In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
- He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

### HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

- Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
- Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
- The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
- Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
- Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
- Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

**PRESEASON POLLING**

· For the second-straight season, Virginia comes into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.

· After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.

· In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.

· Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

**NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP**

· Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.

· Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.

· As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.

· Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).

· Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.

· Dating back to last season, Teel has reached base in 26-straight games.

**PRESEASON NOTARIETY**

· The Cavaliers had seven players included on D1Baseball's Position Power Rankings – 2B Max Cotier (40), OF Chris Newell (56), 1B Devin Ortiz (29), Catcher Kyle Teel (3), SP Matt Wyatt (52), SP Nate Savino (82) and Brandon Neeck (105)

· On Baseball America's top-150 baseball players list, Kyle Teel came in at 44, Savino at 74 and Newell at 76.

**LOOKING BACK TO 2021**

· UVA went 4-12 in its first 16 ACC games and finished and won 14 of its last 20 ACC games to earn the 8th seed in the ACC Tournament.

· To close out the regular season, Virginia won 10 of its last 14 games.

· Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.

· All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.

· Virginia ranked 14th in the nation with a 3.62 ERA and second in the ACC, the first time in the top-20 since 2014.
