## LEADING OFF

- Virginia is one of eight NCAA teams with either one or no losses. Purdue remains the only unbeaten team in college baseball. Mercer, Tennessee, Clemson, Old Dominion, SE Missouri St, Notre Dame and UVA each have one loss.
- UVA's 14 wins are tied for the third most in the nation and it's .933 winning percentage is tied for the fourth-highest in the country
- Virginia had its 14-game win streak snapped in the nightcap of a doubleheader at Duke on Sunday after a 7-6 loss. The win streak was tied for the second longest in school history. Both UVA's school record 19-game win streak in 2009 and this year's 14-game win streak ended with one-run losses.
- The Cavaliers are 9-0 at Disharoon Park this season and have won 12-straight games at home dating back to last season.
- Virginia has played three midweek contests this season and is outscoring its opponents 36-2 in those games. Two of those wins have been shutouts (VMI & William & Mary).

## AGAINST RIDER

- The midweek series will be the first games between UVA and Rider since 2011. UVA has won all six meetings against the Broncos, including three under Brian O'Connor.
- UVA won both games in 2011 by a combined score of 16-11.
- The two schools squared off in an elimination game at the 2008 NCAA Regional in Fullerton, Calif. in which the Cavaliers came away with an 8-2 victory behind seven strong innings on the mound from Andrew Carraway.

## NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Virginia is nationally ranked by D1Baseball for the first time, entering the poll this week at No. 19. The Cavaliers are now ranked in all six of the major collegiate top-25 polls and are ranked as high as No. 5 according to Baseball America and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.
- Virginia comes out of the first ACC weekend ranked No. 32 in the NCAA RPI.
- The Cavaliers go into Tuesday ranked in the top-10 in the country in ERA (3rd - 1.75), fielding percentage (8th - .987) and batting average (10th - .328). Virginia is the only program in the country to be ranked in the top 10 in all three categories.
- The Cavaliers have the No. 2 scoring offense in the country, averaging 11.3 runs per game. The 169 runs are second behind Tennessee's 197.
- Virginia is the only pitching staff in the country with five shutouts this season.
- Jake Gelfo leads the country in RBI (36) and slugging percentage (1.200). He ranks second in the NCAA in total bases (60) and third in home runs (9).

- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

### ON THE MOUND

- Freshman Matthew Buchanan is scheduled to make his first start on the mound. He has appeared in two games this season, both relief appearances in which he combined to strike out four batters over 2.2 innings.
- In addition to the nation's third lowest ERA, the Cavalier pitching staff has allowed only 5.98 hits per nine innings the sixth-lowest rate in the NCAA this season. UVA hurlers have a 12.2 strikeout per nine innings ratio, the fourth best in the country.
- Of the 15 Cavalier pitchers that have appeared in a game this season, 10 have contributed to the five shutouts on the year. Reliever Devin Ortiz has pitched in three of the five shutouts this season, the most on the staff.

### CAVALIER NOTABLES

- At the top of the lineup for all 15 games, shortstop Griff O'Ferrall has scored 23 runs, the 10th-most in the NCAA and the third most in the ACC. He co-leads the team with seven stolen bases, tied for the fourth most in the ACC.
- Freshman Casey Saucke has hit safely in all 13 games he's appeared in, the longest streak on the team. He has extended the streak despite not starting in two of the 13 games including Sunday when he came on as a pinch-hitter and drove in two runs in UVA ninth-inning comeback attempt on Sunday at Duke.
- Catcher Kyle Teel was added to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List prior to last week's series at Duke. He is one of 76 backstops from around the country to be included on the initial list.
- Chris Newell has drawn 13 walks in 12 games played this season. His 1.08 walks per game are the second-most of anyone in the country.

### HIGHLIGHTS OF THE HOMESTAND

- After winning all three games at the Jerry Bryson Classic hosted by Gardner-Webb, Virginia returned for a nine-game homestand, what is scheduled to be its second-longest stint at home this season.
- UVA extended its home win streak to 12 games and includes last year's sweep of Wake Forest.
- The Cavaliers scored 10 or more runs in each of the nine games at home and limited opponents to 17 runs in that span.
- The series finale against Penn State drew 4,459 fans to Disharoon Park, the largest crowd since 2016.
- Cavalier pitchers struck out 23 batters in the series opener against Cornell, just the 11th time in NCAA history a staff has struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game.
- Jake Gelof hit for the cycle in the series finale against Cornell, the first by a UVA hitter since 2001. He accomplished the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.
- Virginia scored 24 runs against Cornell on Feb. 25, the sixth time under O'Connor that UVA eclipsed the 20-run plateau.
- Lefthander Brian Gursky completed an "immaculate inning" on Feb. 26 against Cornell. He struck out all three batters he faced in the second inning on a total of nine pitches.

### THE BIG INNING

- Virginia has scored five or more runs in a single inning, 11 times this season and all nine games of the recent homestand.
- The Cavaliers broke a 1-1 tie in the fifth inning of game one against Penn State with an eight-run outburst, the largest of the season.
- The fifth inning has been the launching pad for four of the 11 "big innings".

### GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

- Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of College Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
- In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
- In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
- He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

### HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

- Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
- Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
- The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
- Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
- Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
- Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

## PRESEASON POLLING

· For the second-straight season, Virginia comes into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.

· After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.

· In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.

· Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

## NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

· Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.

· Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.

· As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.

· Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).

· Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.

· Dating back to last season, Teel has reached base in 26-straight games.

## PRESEASON NOTARIETY

· The Cavaliers had seven players included on D1Baseball's Position Power Rankings - 2B Max Cotier (40), OF Chris Newell (56), 1B Devin Ortiz (29), Catcher Kyle Teel (3), SP Matt Wyatt (52), SP Nate Savino (82) and Brandon Neeck (105)

· On Baseball America's top-150 baseball players list, Kyle Teel came in at 44, Savino at 74 and Newell at 76.

## LOOKING BACK TO 2021

· UVA went 4-12 in its first 16 ACC games and finished and won 14 of its last 20 ACC games to earn the 8th seed in the ACC Tournament.

· To close out the regular season, Virginia won 10 of its last 14 games.

· Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.

· All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.

· Virginia ranked 14th in the nation with a 3.62 ERA and second in the ACC, the first time in the top-20 since 2014.
