LEADING OFF

- The weekend series pits two of the top-five offenses in the country against one another. Virginia is averaging 12.0 runs per game this season, tops in the NCAA. The Demon Deacons are fifth in the nation, scoring 10.5 runs per game.
- Brian O'Connor and Wake Forest head coach Tom Walter enter the weekend each with 770 career wins, tied for the 26th-most among active head coaches. O'Connor is second among active head coaches with a .706 career winning percentage.
- The Cavaliers are 20-1 for the first time in the 134-year history of the program. It surpassed the 19-1 starts by the 2009 and 2011 College World Series teams.
- UVA is one of three, one-loss teams remaining in college baseball (Tennessee - 20-1; Purdue 17-1).
- In addition to scoring, Virginia enters the weekend tops in the nation in team batting average (.347), runs (251) and shutouts (5).
- UVA is the only school in the country to be ranked in the top-10 in batting average (1st - .347), earned run average (4th - 2.24) and fielding percentage (8th - .985).
- O'Connor enters the weekend with a 313-199-1 career record in ACC play. He is one eight coaches in the history of the league with 300 ACC wins.

AGAINST WAKE FOREST

- The Demon Deacons hold a 90-84 advantage in the all-time series against UVA that dates back to 1894. Virginia is 25-14 against Wake Forest in the O'Connor era (2004-present).
- UVA has won four of the last five meetings including a sweep in last year's series in Charlottesville. The Cavaliers combined for a no-hitter in the opener and recorded walk-off victories in the Saturday and Sunday matchups.
- Virginia has dropped its last two series in Winston-Salem (2014 & 2018) and haven't recorded a series victory at Wake Forest since 2013.

RAKE GELOF

- Sophomore Jake Gelof enters the weekend as the nation's leader in home runs (13), RBI (46), slugging percentage (1.194) and total bases (86).
- He's hit four home runs in the last three games. In the middle game against Boston College, he went deep twice, the fourth multi-home run game of the season.
- His 13th home run came against Towson in the midweek and moved him into a tie with Pavin Smith (2017) for 10th most in a single-season in school history.
- Gelof is one of nine players in college baseball with double-digit home runs this season. He has a two-home run lead on the trio of Brad Malm (Albany), Derek Orndorff (Liberty) and Tommy White (NC State) going into the weekend.
- Gelof became a regular in the Cavalier lineup late last season, starting the final 24 games. UVA is 36-9 with him in the lineup over the last 45 games.

- Competed in 14 NCAA regionals and six super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

FIRST YEAR CONTRIBUTIONS

- Wednesday's midweek win over Towson featured 16 Cavalier hits, 11 off the bat of four UVA first years.
- Griff O'Ferrall has led off and played shortstop for all 21 games this season. He ranks 16th in the country and seventh in ACC with 28 runs scored.
- Casey Saucke brings a 19-game hit streak with him to Winston-Salem, the longest by a UVA freshman since 2000. The hit streak is the longest of any Cavalier in a single season since Dan Grovatt strung together 19-straight games with a hit to start the 2009 campaign.

- Infielder Justin Rubin has started four of the six ACC contests at second base. Against Towson he hit his first home run, a two-run shot in the sixth inning. He also delivered a game-tying RBI single in the series finale at Duke.
- Colin Tuft had his best game of his young career against Towson on Tuesday, finishing 3-for-4 with three runs scored and three RBI. He's scored a run in 10 of his 11 starts.

ON THE MOUND

- Slightly overshadowed by the Cavalier offense that has outscored opponents, 251-56, the Virginia pitching staff ranks fourth in hits allowed per game (6.4), sixth in strikeouts per nine innings (11.7) and 11th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.67).
- The Cavaliers have struck out 246 batters, the fifth-most in the country. Virginia has collected 10 or more strikeouts in 16 of the 21 games this year.
- Friday night starter Nate Savino has turned in three-straight quality starts, including a complete game shutout at Duke in the season's ACC opener. It still stands as the only nine-inning complete game shutout by an ACC pitcher this season.
- Brian Gursky is one of nine pitchers with five wins in the fifth weekend of the series. As a graduate transfer from USC, he came to UVA with five career wins total. The Cavaliers have given him plenty of run support, outscoring opponents 66-11 with him on the hill.
- Brandon Neeck is seeking his first win since March 6 against Penn State where he pitched five innings and struck out a season-high, eight batters.

HOME COOKING

- The Cavaliers leave behind an 18-game home win streak that dates back to last season. It is the third-longest active home win streak in the country (Tennessee - 24 games; North Carolina 20 games).
- Virginia matched the Disharoon Park record and have hit 38 home runs at home this season. The Cavaliers also hit 38 in 2017 over the course of 34 games.
- Virginia has won all 15 of its home games this season and scored 10 or more runs in all but one contest at its home venue. UVA is averaging 13.87 runs per game at The Dish this season.
- The Cavaliers are outscoring opponents 208-45 in home games this spring.

YEAR OF THE GRAND SLAM

- Through the first 21 games, Virginia has hit four grand slams, three have come off the bat of Kyle Teel, the other from Chris Newell.
- Virginia has hit four grand slams in a season, four times in the last 22 years (2022, 2021, 2013, 2009).
- UVA has hit three grand slams in its last six games. In Friday's series opener against Boston College, Teel and Newell cleared the bases with a home run marking only the third time since 2000 and the last time since Kenny Towns hit two grand slams himself in 2013 against ECU that the Cavaliers have hit two in the same game.
- Teel, whose most notable grand slam came in game three of last year's Super Regional, has four grand slams in his first 74 collegiate games the most of any Cavalier since 2000.
- With the bases loaded this season, Teel is 4-for-4 with a grand slam, a triple and 15 RBI.
- Newell has a grand slam in each of his three seasons as a Cavalier.

CAVALIER NOTABLES

- Alex Tappen earned ACC Player of the Week honors on Monday, March 21 after batting .611 (11-for-18) with two doubles, three homers and 14 RBI. He drove in a career-high six runs in a 4-for-4 effort at the plate. Tappen has reached base safely in 20-straight games.
- In the last six games, Devin Ortiz scored 13 times. He reached base 15 times in the five contests and batted .563 (9-for-16) with two home runs and seven RBI in five games last week.

CONSENSUS TOP 10

- Virginia ascended nine spots in the D1Baseball.com poll and comes into the week as the No. 10 team in the country.
- The Cavaliers are ranked as high as No. 3 according to Collegiate Baseball Newspaper. Baseball America has UVA ranked No. 4 (up one spot) while the USA Today Coaches, NCBWA and Perfect game each have Virginia as the eighth-ranked team in the country.
- Virginia goes into the weekend ranked No. 14 in the NCAA RPI with a home run marking only the third time since 2000 and the last time since Kenny Towns hit two grand slams himself in 2013 against ECU that the Cavaliers have hit two in the same game.
- Teel, whose most notable grand slam came in game three of last year's Super Regional, has four grand slams in his first 74 collegiate games the most of any Cavalier since 2000.

THE BIG INNING

- Virginia has scored five or more runs in a single inning, 11 times this season and all nine games its season-opening homestand.
- The Cavaliers broke a 1-1 tie in the fifth inning of game one against Penn State with an eight-run outburst, the largest of the season.
- The fifth inning has been the launching pad for four of the 11 "big innings".

GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

- Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Colle-

giate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
 · In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
 · In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
 · He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

· Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
 · Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
 · The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
 · Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
 · Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
 · Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

PRESEASON POLLING

· For the second-straight season, Virginia comes into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.
 · After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 ac-

ording to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.

· In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.

· Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

· Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.

· Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.

· As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.

· Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).

· Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.

· Dating back to last season, Teel has reached base in 26-straight games.

· The Cavaliers had seven players included on D1Baseball's Position Power Rankings - 2B Max Cotier (40), OF Chris Newell (56), 1B Devin Ortiz (29), Catcher Kyle Teel (3), SP Matt Wyatt (52), SP Nate Savino (82) and Brandon Neeck (105)
 · On Baseball America's top-150 baseball players list, Kyle Teel came in at 44, Savino at 74 and Newell at 76.

LOOKING BACK TO 2021

· UVA went 4-12 in its first 16 ACC games and finished and won 14 of its last 20 ACC games to earn the 8th seed in the ACC Tournament.

· To close out the regular season, Virginia won 10 of its last 14 games.

· Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.

· All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.

· Virginia ranked 14th in the nation with a 3.62 ERA and second in the ACC, the first time in the top-20 since 2014.
