LEADING OFF

- Virginia is a consensus top-5 team for the first time this season, coming in at No. 4 according to D1Baseball.com. The Cavaliers have jumped 15 spots since entering the top 25 at No. 19 on March 14.
- UVA comes into Tuesday with 18-straight wins at home, tied for the longest home win streak in school history.
- The 18-straight home wins is tied for the third-longest active streak in college baseball (Tennessee - 24; North Carolina - 20; UConn - 18)
- The Cavaliers have hit 38 home runs at Disharoon Park this season, tied for the most since the facility opened in 2002. The 2017 team belted 38 homers in 34 games.
- Virginia ranks in the top-4 nationally in batting average (3rd - .332), earned run average (2nd - 2.39) and fielding percentage (4th - .987). Only one other program in the country (Texas) is ranked in the top-15 in each category.
- UVA is No. 1 in the country in runs (268), runs per game (11.2) and shutouts (6).

AGAINST RICHMOND

- Virginia owns an 88-59-2 advantage in the all-time series against Richmond that was first played in 1889, a 13-4 victory for the Cavaliers in Charlottesville.
- Under Brian O'Connor, UVA has won 16 of the 17 meetings against Richmond. The lone blemish came in 2018, a 11-3 Spider victory at Disharoon Park.
- In last season's meeting, seven UVA pitchers combined for a four-hit shutout in a 7-0 victory in Charlottesville. Zach Messinger logged three innings and sat down all nine batters he faced.
- All 12 of previous meetings between the two school have taken place in Charlottesville.

HOME COOKING

- Virginia has scored 10 or more runs in all but one of its 15 games at home this season.
- The Cavaliers are outscoring opponents 211-45 at the Dish this season and have recorded a pair of shutouts at their home ballpark.
- The last time Virginia won 18-straight games at home was in 2008 when it won its first 18 home contests of the year. In that stretch, UVA outscored opponents 162-46 and featured a 27-1 victory over Coppin State, the second-largest run output of the O'Connor era. The win streak ended with a 17-5 loss to George Washington in the midweek.

ON THE MOUND

- Devin Ortiz is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season and first since March 16 against Rider.
- The righthander started the year without allowing a run in his first 12.2 innings pitched and had his streak of 38-straight innings without allowing a run snapped in a relief appearance against Duke. Ortiz has fanned 24 batters in 18 innings and issued only one walk this season.
- Virginia nearly tossed the program's eighth no-hitter in the middle game of a three-game series at Wake Forest. Tommy Hawke recorded an infield single with two outs in the bottom of the ninth. It was UVA's first one-hitter since holding Towson to one base knock on March 17, 2021.
- The Virginia pitching staff ranks third in the country in hits allowed per game (6.2) fourth in strikeouts (278) and sixth in strikeouts per nine innings (11.6). UVA pitchers have combined for 10 or more strikeouts in 18 of the 24 games this year.
- Virginia has logged six shutouts through 24 games in 2022, matching its season total from last year which was tied for the 15th most in all of college baseball.

- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

NATIONAL SPOTLIGHT

- Virginia earned its highest regular season ranking from D1Baseball.com since week five of the 2015 season. The Cavaliers have been inside the top-5 of the Baseball America poll in all but one week this season.
- The Cavaliers have racked up 22 wins in 24 games, the second most wins of any team in the country. There are only three teams nationally with three or less losses (Tennessee - 1; Purdue - 1; Virginia - 2).
- Sophomore Jake Gelof is the country's leader slugging percentage (1.085) and is tied for the most home runs of anyone in college baseball. His 46 RBI are one behind Carlos Contreras of Sam Houston State for the national lead.
- As a team, Virginia ranks in the top-10 in hits (3rd - 286), home runs (4th - 46), slugging percentage (4th - .569) and on-base percentage (7th - .439).

CAVALIER NOTABLES

- Virginia was held to a season-low, four hits in Sunday's loss to Wake Forest. Freshman Casey Saucke's 21-game hit streak was a casualty in the loss. It was the second longest hit streak in a single season by a Cavalier since 2000 (Brandon Guyer - 26 in 2007).
- Alex Tappen has hit six home runs in his last eight games played. On Saturday he went deep twice at Wake Forest, the first multi-homer game of his career. He has reached base in 23-straight games and has 21 career home runs, the first Cavalier to reach the 20 career homer plateau since Pavin Smith (28) and Adam Haseley (21) in 2017.

YEAR OF THE GRAND SLAM

- Through the first 21 games, Virginia has hit four grand slams, three have come off the bat of Kyle Teel, the other from Chris Newell.
- Virginia has hit four grand slams in a season, four times in the last 22 years (2022, 2021, 2013, 2009).
- UVA has hit three grand slams in its last six games. In Friday's series opener against Boston College, Teel and Newell cleared the bases with a home run marking only the third time since 2000 and the last time since Kenny Towns hit two grand slams himself in 2013 against ECU that the Cavaliers have hit two in the same game.
- Teel, whose most notable grand slam came in game three of last year's Super Regional, has four grand slams in his first 74 collegiate games the most of any Cavalier since 2000.
- With the bases loaded this season, Teel is 4-for-4 with a grand slam, a triple and 15 RBI.
- Newell has a grand slam in each of his three seasons as a Cavalier.

THE BIG INNING

- Virginia has scored five or more runs in a single inning, 11 times this season and all nine games its season-opening homestand.
- The Cavaliers broke a 1-1 tie in the fifth inning of game one against Penn State with an eight-run outburst, the largest of the season.
- The fifth inning has been the launching pad for four of the 11 "big innings".

GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

- Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
- In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
- In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
- He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

- Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
- Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
- The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
- Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
- Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
- Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

PRESEASON POLLING

· For the second-straight season, Virginia comes into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.

· After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.

· In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.

· Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

· Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.

· Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.

· As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.

· Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).

· Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.

· Dating back to last season, Teel has reached base in 26-straight games.

PRESEASON NOTARIETY

· The Cavaliers had seven players included on D1Baseball's Position Power Rankings – 2B Max Cotier (40), OF Chris Newell (56), 1B Devin Ortiz (29), Catcher Kyle Teel (3), SP Matt Wyatt (52), SP Nate Savino (82) and Brandon Neeck (105)

· On Baseball America's top-150 baseball players list, Kyle Teel came in at 44, Savino at 74 and Newell at 76.

LOOKING BACK TO 2021

· UVA went 4-12 in its first 16 ACC games and finished and won 14 of its last 20 ACC games to earn the 8th seed in the ACC Tournament.

· To close out the regular season, Virginia won 10 of its last 14 games.

· Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.

· All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.

· Virginia ranked 14th in the nation with a 3.62 ERA and second in the ACC, the first time in the top-20 since 2014.
