## LEADING OFF

- Virginia is in the midst of an eight-game stretch that includes seven road games, its longest stint away from Disharoon Park this season.
- Virginia is 17-0 in non-conference action and 19-1 overall at Disharoon Park this season.
- Tuesday will be the first of two meetings in 2022 against the Monarchs. The two teams are slated to play at Harbor Park in Norfolk on April 26. It will be the first visit to Norfolk in exactly six years after Virginia won the April 26, 2016 meeting, 8-4.
- The Cavaliers have outscored midweek opponents 92-16 and are 5-0 against teams from the Commonwealth this year.
- Virginia is the No. 1 scoring team in the country, averaging 10.3 runs per game. UVA and Tennessee are the only two teams nationally averaging double-digit runs per game.
- Old Dominion comes into Tuesday scoring 9.7 runs per game, the seventh most in the country.
- Virginia is a consensus top-10 team for the fourth-straight week, dropping to No. 8 in the D1Baseball.com national rankings. The Cavaliers come in as high as No. 5 according to Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

## AGAINST OLD DOMINION

- The Monarchs will visit Charlottesville for the first time since 2019. The two programs were scheduled to meet in the regular season last year but were rained out.
- Old Dominion holds a 33-32-2 edge in the all-time series that was first played in 1965. In Brian O'Connor's 19 seasons, UVA has won 11 of 18 meetings.
- The two teams met in the NCAA postseason for the first time last year with Virginia winning both games of the NCAA Columbia Regional.

## COLUMBIA REGIONAL FINALS REMATCH

- Last season ODU took the conventional route for a shot at the Columbia Regional Championship, winning its first two games as the top seed. One win over Virginia would have sent the Monarchs to the Super Regional while the Cavaliers needed to win two against ODU for its first berth into the Supers since 2015.
- Griff McGarry and Brandon Neeck struck out a combined 24 batters in an 8-3 win over the Monarchs, Virginia's second win of the day after eliminating host South Carolina. Neeck set the UVA postseason record with 16 strikeouts. The 24 strikeouts were the most in a nine-inning NCAA Division I baseball game since Auburn struck out 25 against Arkansas on May 19, 1994.
- The historic victory setup a winner-take-all matchup a day later (due to a rainout) at 9 a.m. Devin Ortiz made his first career start on the mound in the contest and pitched four shutout innings while recording six batters. He stayed in the game as the team's designated hitter and hit a walk-off solo homer in the 10th inning to send UVA to the Super Regionals.
- Virginia won six-straight elimination games in the 2022 NCAA postseason en route to the program's fifth College World Series berth.

## ON THE MOUND

- Will Geerdes will be the eighth different Cavalier to start a game this season. The start will be Geerdes' first at UVA and his first since March 7, 2020 while playing for Columbia.
- Nine of Geerdes' 13 appearances this season he's been called upon to finish the game, none of which have been save chances.
- Geerdes allowed just two runs and two hits over his first 11 appearances, a total of 15.2 inning.

- Competed in 14 NCAA regionals and six super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

- Virginia sports a 3.30 team ERA, the 10th lowest in the country and is allowing 7.0 hits per nine innings, the ninth fewest of any staff in college baseball.
- The Cavaliers are one of seven teams with an NCAA-best six shutouts this season.
- Virginia has struck out 359 batters in 284 innings pitched, the fifth most in the country. The Cavaliers set a program record with 687 punch outs last year.
- UVA pitchers have struck out 10 or more batters in 22 of 32 games this season including 23 against Cornell on Feb. 25, the most in a nine-inning game by any team in the NCAA this season.

### HOME COOKING

- Virginia has won 22 of its last 23 games at home, including a school-record streak of 19-straight that ended on April 1 against Georgia Tech.
- UVA is 19-1 at Disharoon Park in 2021, the 19 home wins are tied for the fourth most in the country this season - Tennessee (23), Mercer (21), Davidson (20), & Virginia (19), Wake Forest (19).
- The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (527-161) of its games over the course of 21 seasons at The Dish.
- UVA is outscoring its opponents 261-73 at home this season.

- Virginia has scored 10 or more runs in 16 of its 20 games at home this season.

### CAVALIER TIDBITS

- Virginia recorded 21 hits in three games in Miami, the fewest in a three-game stretch this season. The Cavaliers scored first in all three losses to the Hurricanes after winning all 22 previous games when scoring the game's first run.
- Jake Gelof trails the trio of Kevin Parada (Georgia Tech), Andy Garriola (ODU) and Jason Hinchman by one in the national home run race. Gelof has 14 homers in 32 games this season.
- Gelof and Tappen have combined for 101 RBI this season. Gelof is second in the nation with 54 while Tappen ranks seventh with 47. Either would have led UVA's College World Series team last season.
- The Cavaliers were held to a season-low, two hits in Friday's opener at Miami, with both hits coming off the bat of Justin Rubin. The last time UVA was held to less than two hits was also against Miami in 2021 but Virginia won the game, 4-0.
- Statistically, freshman Griff O'Ferrall is the toughest Cavalier to strikeout and the third toughest in the ACC, going down on strikes once every 9.2 at bats. In addition, O'Ferrall is tied with Kyle Teel for the team lead with 28 walks, the fourth most in the ACC.
- Chris Newell matched a career-high with four hits in the series finale at Miami. He hit his eighth home run of the season and 17th of his career.

### CAVALIER TIDBITS

- Alex Tappen has reached base in 28-straight games. The streak is the longest in a single season by a Cavaliers since Zack Gelof reached base in the first 28 games of his career back in 2018. He's looking to become the 15th Cavalier since 2000 to put together a reached base streak of 30 games or more. Kyle Teel had a reached base streak of 36 games that spanned over the course of two seasons (2021 and 2022).
- Tappen leads all active UVA players with 21 career homers, he's the first UVA hitter to reach the 20-career homer plateau since Pavin Smith (28) and Adam Haseley (21) in 2017.
- Catcher Kyle Teel has reached base in all but one game this season and has started every contest for the Cavaliers behind the plate. He has hit three grand slams this season and four in his career.

- The one-two punch of Chris Newell and Griff O'Ferrall on the basepaths have helped UVA rank second in the ACC in stolen bases with 43. Newell's 13 swiped bags are the fourth most in the ACC and O'Ferrall is right behind him with 11, tied for the sixth most in the league.
- O'Ferrall has led off and played shortstop in all 29 games this season. He was named the Brooks Wallace Shortstop of the Week on Tuesday (April 5) after he hit .578 (9-for-17) with two doubles, a triple, five runs scored and eight RBI in four games. In Saturday's game against Georgia Tech, he gave UVA its first lead of the series with a bases clearing, three-run double. On Sunday erased a three-run deficit with one swing, recording his first triple of the season. All eight of his RBI came in the last two games against the Yellow Jackets.

### GOLDEN HOUR

- On Tuesday, Jake Gelof and Nate Savino were two of 45 players included on the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List, an award annually presented to the top amateur baseball player by USA Baseball.
- Virginia was one of eight programs nationally with multiple players on the midseason watch list.
- All-time, UVA has produced 12 midseason watch list selections, the sixth most of any school in the country. The Cavaliers have been represented six times since 2013, tied for the ninth most in college baseball.

### YEAR OF THE GRAND SLAM

- Through the first 21 games, Virginia has hit four grand slams, three have come off the bat of Kyle Teel, the other from Chris Newell.
- Virginia has hit four grand slams in a season, four times in the last 22 years (2022, 2021, 2013, 2009).
- UVA has hit three grand slams in its last six games. In Friday's series opener against Boston College, Teel and Newell cleared the bases with a home run marking only the third time since 2000 and the last time since Kenny Towns hit two grand slams himself in 2013 against ECU that the Cavaliers have hit two in the same game.
- Teel, whose most notable grand slam came in game three of last year's Super Regional, has four grand slams in his first 74 collegiate games the most of any Cavalier since 2000.
- With the bases loaded this season, Teel is 4-for-4 with a grand slam, a triple and 15 RBI.
- Newell has a grand slam in each of his three seasons as a Cavalier.

### GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

- Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
- In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
- In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
- He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

### HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

- Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
- Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
- The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
- Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
- Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
- Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

### PRESEASON POLLING

- For the second-straight season, Virginia comes into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.
- After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.
- In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.
- Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

### NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

- Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.
- Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.
- As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.
- Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).
- Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.

### PRESEASON NOTARIETY

- The Cavaliers had seven players included on D1Baseball's Position Power Rankings - 2B Max Cotier (40), OF Chris Newell (56), 1B Devin Ortiz (29), Catcher Kyle Teel (3), SP Matt Wyatt (52), SP Nate Savino (82) and Brandon Neeck (105)
- On Baseball America's top-150 baseball players list, Kyle Teel came in at 44, Savino at 74 and Newell at 76.

### LOOKING BACK TO 2021

- UVA went 4-12 in its first 16 ACC games and finished and won 14 of its last 20 ACC games to earn the 8th seed in the ACC Tournament.
- To close out the regular season, Virginia won 10 of its last 14 games.
- Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.
- All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips

to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.

Virginia ranked 14th in the nation with a 3.62 ERA and second in the ACC, the first time in the top-20 since 2014.
