LEADING OFF

- After playing three of the last four weekends on the road, Virginia will close out its home conference schedule with three-straight ACC series at Disharoon Park beginning Friday with North Carolina.
- Virginia will play 13 of the next 14 games at home and will not leave the Commonwealth until its May 19-21 series at Louisville.
- Dating back to last season, Virginia has won four-straight ACC series at home including three-game sets this season against Boston College and Georgia Tech in 2022.
- The Cavaliers have dropped five of their last six ACC games and have lost back-to-back ACC series. Virginia has lost five in a six-game ACC stretch under head coach Brian O'Connor (2022, 2021, 2019, 2018, 2015 (2x), 2008, 2005), seven times.
- At 778 career wins, O'Connor needs two more to tie former North Carolina head coach Mike Roberts (780) for the eighth most by an Atlantic Coast Conference Coach.
- Virginia is ranked No. 11 by D1Baseball.com falling out of the top-10 of the for the first time since March 14 when it debuted in the poll at No. 19.
- The Cavaliers offense ranks in the top-5 in the country in scoring (4th - 9.7 rpg), hits (5th - 425) and runs (4th - 367).

AGAINST NORTH CAROLINA

- North Carolina is the only opponent that Virginia has played 300 games against. The all-time series dates back to 1891 with the Tar Heels holding a 188-113-4 advantage.
- Either Virginia and/or North Carolina has been nationally ranked when playing one another in each of the last 17 weekend series.
- UNC has won the last four series against UVA, three of them taking place in Chapel Hill. This weekend will be the Tar Heels' first visit to Charlottesville since 2018 when they won the final two games to clinch the series.
- The two teams opened up the extended conference schedule at the end of February last season against one another with three, one-run games. The Tar Heels won the series by winning the first two games, 3-2 and 2-1. The Cavaliers salvaged the series behind a quality start from Mike Vasil (6.0 IP, 0 R) and a two-run homer by Nic Kent.

MIDWEEK REVIEW

- The Cavaliers snapped a four-game win streak in extra inning games with a 6-4 setback against VCU this week. The Rams hit a walk-off, two-run homer in the ninth to win their third-straight game against the Cavaliers. The last UVA extra-inning loss was to North Carolina in the 2019 ACC Tournament.
- UVA erased a five-run deficit with a five-run seventh inning, capped by a game-tying two-run over by Devin Ortiz. On the mound Jacob Hodorovich eclipsed career-highs in innings pitched (4.0) and strikeouts (5).
- The Cavaliers bounced back on Wednesday against Georgetown with their seventh come-from-behind victory of the season. UVA trailed twice in the contest and didn't take its first lead until the eighth inning. Jay Woolfok, who gave up the walk-off homer the night prior, struck out five-straight batters in 1.2 innings and earned the win in the contest.

- NCAA tournament appearances in 14-straight seasons (UVA had never to three NCAA tournaments prior to his arrival)
- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals
- 2009 trip to CWS was first in school history (Irvine Regional and Oxford Super Regional champions)
- Competed in 14 NCAA regionals and six super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

ON THE MOUND

- The Cavaliers will have an all-left-handed rotation for the ninth-straight weekend. The three-man combination of Nate Savino, Brian Gursky and Jake Berry stays intact for the third-straight series. Prior to this season, O'Connor had never started three lefthanders in a weekend series.
- Friday night starter Nate Savino began the season with four wins in six starts and has since dropped three-straight decisions. Of the 18 runs that have come around to score against him in those three starts, 13 have been earned. Against Pitt last Friday, Savino left with two outs and the bases loaded in the sixth before a Cavalier fielding error allowed six unearned runs to score in the frame, the most runs in an inning by a UVA opponent this season.
- Brian Gursky turned in his longest outing of his career last Saturday against Pitt, tossing 6.2 innings of two-hit, shutout baseball. It was his second quality start of the season. He combined with Alex Greene for the team's seventh shutout, tied for the most in the NCAA. In the eight games Gursky has started, UVA has outscored its opponents 101-75.
- Sunday afternoon starter Jake Berry, who started the season working out of the bullpen, logged 1.1 innings of relief work on Wednesday against Georgetown. The lefty was incredibly efficient, needing only 14 pitched to record four outs, two by way of the strikeout. He has struck out 33 batters in 11 relief appearances this season. Sunday will be his fifth career start since he made an emergency start against Wake Forest on March 26. He delivered five hitless innings and struck out a career-high nine batters in a combined no-hit bid in Winston-Salem that was broken up on an infield single with two outs in the ninth.
- As a staff, Virginia sports a 3.40 ERA, the ninth-lowest in the country and the lowest in the ACC. In addition, the Cavalier hurlers are allowing only 7.03 hits per game which is the fewest of any team in the country.
- UVA has struck out 411 batters this season the fifth-most in the country and the Cavaliers are one of 10 teams to reach the 400-strikeout plateau. The 11.0 strikeouts per nine innings are the 11th most in the nation.
- Virginia, Stanford and Vanderbilt come into the weekend with an NCAA-best, seven shutouts.

CAVALIER NOTABLES

- In two midweek games, Devin Ortiz drove in four runs, including two on a game-tying home run against VCU to cap a five-run seventh inning. The two-way graduate student has hit safely in five-straight games coming into the weekend.
- Freshman Griff O'Ferrall walked a season-high four times in Wednesday's win against Georgetown. He drew a bases loaded walk to tie the game in the sixth. Going into the series, he's statistically the toughest batter in the ACC to strikeout (1 every 10.8 AB).
- First year Justin Rubin was the only multi-hit performer on Wednesday against Georgetown. He has two or more hits in five of his last seven starts.
- Kyle Teel beat out a bases loaded single in the eight inning against the Hoyas to record his 18th RBI with the bases loaded this year. He is 5-for-8 (.625) with three home runs and a triple with the bases juiced this season.
- Alex Tappen and Jake Gelof are the only teammates in the country who each have 50 or more RBI this season. The duo has combined for 106 RBI, 56 from Gelof and 50 from Tappen. Both are career-highs through 38 games this season.
- Tappen has played in 198 career games for UVA and is looking to become the first Cavalier to reach the 200 games played mark since Kenny Towns appeared in 207 from 2012-15.

HOME COOKING

- Virginia has won 23 of its last 25 games at home, including a school-record streak of 19-straight that ended on April 1 against Georgia Tech.
- UVA is 20-2 at Disharoon Park in 2021.
- The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (528-162) of its games over the course of 21 seasons at The Dish.
- UVA is outscoring its opponents 269-86 at home this season.
- The sixth-inning home run by Jake Gelof in the series finale against Georgia Tech on April 3 was the 39th hit by the Cavaliers at Disharoon Park this season, a facility record. The previous mark of 38 was set in 2017 over the course of 38 games. UVA has 15 home games left on the schedule.
- The Disharoon Park single-game attendance record fell on April 3 against Georgia Tech. A total of 5,286 fans poured into the stadium breaking the previous mark of 5,074 set on April 14, 2012 against North Carolina.
- Virginia has scored 10 or more runs in 16 of its 22 games at home this season.

GOLDEN HOUR

- Jake Gelof and Nate Savino were two of 45 players included on the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List, an award annually presented to the top amateur baseball player by USA Baseball.
- Virginia was one of eight programs nationally with multiple players on the midseason watch list.
- All-time, UVA has produced 12 midseason watch list selections, the sixth most of any school in the country. The Cavaliers have been represented six times since 2013, tied for the ninth most in college baseball.

YEAR OF THE GRAND SLAM

- Through the first 21 games, Virginia hit four grand slams, three have come off the bat of Kyle Teel, the other from Chris Newell.
- Virginia has hit four grand slams in a season, four times in the last 22 years (2022, 2021, 2013, 2009).
- In the series opener against Boston College, Teel and Newell cleared the bases with a home run marking only the third time since 2000 and the last time since Kenny Towns hit two grand slams himself in 2013 against ECU that the Cavaliers have hit two grand slams in the same game.
- Teel, whose most notable grand slam came in game three of last year's Super Regional, hit four grand slams in his first 74 collegiate games the most of any Cavalier since 2000.
- With the bases loaded this season, Teel is 5-for-8 (.625) with three home runs, a triple and 18 RBI
- Newell has a grand slam in each of his three seasons as a Cavalier.

GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

- Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
- In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
- In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
- He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

- Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
- Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
- The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
- Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
- Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
- Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

PRESEASON POLLING

- For the second-straight season, Virginia came into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.
- After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.
- In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.
- Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

- Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.
- Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.
- As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.
- Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).
- Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.

PRESEASON NOTARIETY

- The Cavaliers had seven players included on D1Baseball's Position Power Rankings - 2B Max Cotier (40), OF Chris Newell (56), 1B Devin Ortiz (29), Catcher Kyle Teel (3), SP Matt Wyatt (52), SP Nate Savino (82) and Brandon Neeck (105)
- On Baseball America's top-150 baseball players list, Kyle Teel came in at 44, Savino at 74 and Newell at 76.

LOOKING BACK TO 2021

- UVA went 4-12 in its first 16 ACC games and finished and won 14 of its last 20 ACC games to earn the 8th seed in the ACC Tournament.
- To close out the regular season, Virginia won 10 of its last 14 games.
- Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.

- All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.
- Virginia ranked 14th in the nation with a 3.62 ERA and second in the ACC, the first time in the top-20 since 2014.
