LEADING OFF

- Virginia is 6-2 through the first eight games of its season-long, 14-game homestand. The Cavalier have one ACC home series remaining (Clemson - 5/13-16) and non-conference matchups with VCU (May 3), Longwood (5/11) and Mount St. Mary's (5/17).
- VCU has won three-straight meetings against Virginia, including a 9-7 extra-inning loss to the Rams at the Diamond on April 19.
- UVA is 25-4 at home this season and owns has won 76 percent of its games at Disharoon Park since the facility opened in 2002. Tuesday will be the 698th game at The Dish.
- The Cavaliers own a 19-2 mark against non-conference foes this season and are 5-4 against schools from the Commonwealth this season.
- The Cavaliers are nationally ranked for the eighth-straight week but slipped to No. 14 in the D1Baseball.com national rankings, its lowest since entering the polls at No. 19 on March 14. UVA comes in as high as No. 9 in the USA Today/Coaches Poll.

AGAINST VCU

- Virginia owns a 44-25 all-time record against VCU in an all-time series that was first played in 1979, a 17-4 Cavalier victory in Charlottesville.
- Under Brian O'Connor, the Cavaliers own a 20-6 mark against the Rams.
- The Rams have won three-straight games against Virginia for the first time since 2002-03.
- In the April 19 meeting, Virginia stormed back from a 7-2 deficit with five runs in the top of the seventh inning. The game-tying hit for UVA was a 403-foot missile off the bat of Devin Ortiz. The Rams prevailed in extra innings on a two-run, walk-off homer by Jacob Selden in the 10th inning.
- Reliever Jacob Hodorovich established career-highs in innings pitched (4.0) and strikeouts (5) but was walked go-ahead run in the 10th that eventually came around to score on the Selden homer.

CHASING HISTORY

- Jake Gelof sits alone in third on Virginia's single-season home run list with 17 in 45 games the season. The 17 are the most in the Brian O'Connor era (2004-present) and trail Brian Buchanan (22 in 1994) and Jon Benick (18 in 2001).
- Gelof is also having a historic season driving in runs. His 67 are tied with Kenny Towns (2015) and Joe Koshansky (2004) for the second most in in program history. Pavin Smith set the school mark with 77 in 2017.
- Alex Tappen is looking to become the 13th Cavalier ever to reach 60 RBI in a season. Tappen has played in 205 career games, the 10th-most in program history and two behind Kenny Towns who appeared in 207 games for UVA.
- As a team, Virginia has hit 62 home runs, tied with the 1996 club for the second most in school history. Only the 1988 team, which hit 67 in 52 games, had more in a single season.

- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

CAVALIERS AT THE PLATE

- Virginia is the No. 6 scoring offense in the country, averaging 9.4 runs per game. The Cavaliers have totaled 422 runs in 45 games, tied for third nationally behind Texas Tech (423) and UNLV (438).
- The Cavaliers have scored 10 or more runs in a game 21 times this season, including 19 of the 29 games at Disharoon Park in 2022.
- Virginia has scored five or more runs in a single inning 24 times this season. The seven runs in the 10th against UNC on April 23 marked the ninth time UVA has scored seven or more in a single frame.
- UVA ranks in the top-10 nationally in batting average (4th), hits (5th), on-base percentage (6th), walks (7th) and sacrifice flies (8th).

ON THE MOUND

- As a staff, Virginia sports a 3.55 ERA, the 10th-lowest in the country and the lowest in the ACC. In addition, the Cavalier hurlers are allowing only 7.28 hits per nine innings which are the seventh fewest of any team in the country.
- UVA has struck out 486 batters this season the sixth-most in the country. UVA is averaging 10.9 strikeouts per nine innings are the ninth most in the nation.
- Virginia has seven shutouts this season, one behind national leader Vanderbilt. Virginia is one of five teams in the country with seven or more shutouts (Vanderbilt, Tennessee, Stanford, Central Michigan).

CAVALIER NOTABLES

- Freshman Griff O'Ferrall has hit safely in seven-straight games and comes into midweek action as the ACC's second-toughest batter to strikeout. He's fanned 18 times in 173 at bats and has collected 33 walks this season.
- O'Ferrall and Chris Newell are tied for fourth in the ACC with 16 stolen bases. Newell has swiped 37 career bags and owns the third-highest stolen base percentage (.902) by any Cavalier since 2000.
- Newell reached base six times in three games against Virginia Tech and hit his ninth and 10th home runs of the year. It marks the first time since 2010 Virginia has three players with double-digit home runs.

HONORING RYAN ZIMMERMAN

- Zimmerman was the first player to have his number retired in the 134-year history of the program. No. 11 was retired as part of Ryan Zimmerman Day on April 30 at Disharoon Park.
- The No. 24 is UVA's only other retired number, worn by former head coach and UVA administrator Jim West.
- Zimmerman earned All-America honors from Baseball America (Second Team) and the NCBWA (Third Team) in 2005.
- Over his three-year career, Zimmerman batted .355 with seven home runs, 47 doubles and 140 RBI. His accumulated 250 career hits in 174 games, the fifth-most in program history before departing UVA for professional baseball.
- He left UVA as the single season record holder in hits (92 in 2005) and at bats (249 in 2004), both have since been surpassed.
- It took a little over two months since his last college baseball game for Zimmerman to make his MLB debut. In 2005, he was the fourth overall pick in the draft, the highest by any Cavalier at the time.
- Zimmerman was part of the inaugural class inducted into the UVA Baseball Hall of Fame in 2018.

MR. WALK-OFF

- Devin Ortiz hit a walk-off grand slam in the tenth inning on April 23 to help Virginia clinch its first series victory over North Carolina since 2016. The walk-off home run was his second of his career. He broke a 3-3 tie in the 10th of the 2021 NCAA Columbia Regional Championship game against ODU to send UVA to the Super Regionals.
- The walk-off grand slam was the only one hit by a Cavalier in the last 22 years.
- Since 2000, there have been eight Virginia walk-off homers. Ortiz is the only Cavalier to hit two walk-off home runs in that span.

- Shortstop Griff O'Ferrall led the rookies at the plate by batting .357 (5-for-14) with a home run and four runs scored. His solo home run on Friday night in the seventh inning broke a 2-2 tie in an eventual 4-2 victory.
- Outfielder Colin Tuft hit his first home run of the season in Saturday's contest and was 4-for-8 in two weekend starts.
- Ethan Anderson started all three games at DH and matched a season-high with three hits in the series finale.
- Anthony Stephan came on as a pinch-hitter in the 10th inning on Saturday and led off the seven-run inning with a base hit to left field.

HOME COOKING

- Virginia has won 28 of its last 32 games at home, including a school-record streak of 19-straight that ended on April 1 against Georgia Tech.
- UVA is 25-4 at Disharoon Park in 2021.
- The Cavaliers have won 76 percent (533-164) of its games over the course of 21 seasons at The Dish.
- UVA is outscoring its opponents 324-120 at home this season.
- The sixth-inning home run by Jake Gelof in the series finale against Georgia Tech on April 3 was the 39th hit by the Cavaliers at Disharoon Park this season, a facility record. The previous mark of 38 was set in 2017 over the course of 38 games.
- The Disharoon Park single-game attendance record fell on April 3 against Georgia Tech and again on April 30 for a sellout crowd for Ryan Zimmerman day. A total of 5,919 fans poured into the stadium, the third crowd of 5,000+ his season.

YEAR OF THE GRAND SLAM

• Virginia has hit five grand slams this season, the most of any Cavalier team since 2000.
 • In the series opener against Boston College, Teel and Newell cleared the bases with a home run marking only the third time since 2000 and the last time since Kenny Towns hit two grand slams himself in 2013 against ECU that the Cavaliers have hit two grand slams in the same game.
 • Teel, whose most notable grand slam came in game three of last year's Super Regional, hit four grand slams in his first 74 collegiate games the most of any Cavalier since 2000.
 • With the bases loaded this season, Teel is 5-for-8 (.625) with three home runs, a triple and 18 RBI
 • Newell has a grand slam in each of his three seasons as a Cavalier.

GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

• Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
 • In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
 • In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
 • He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

• Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
 • Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
 • The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
 • Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
 • Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
 • Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

PRESEASON POLLING

• For the second-straight season, Virginia came into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.
 • After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.
 • In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.
 • Virginia was picked to finished second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

• Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.
 • Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.
