LEADING OFF

- Virginia is 8-2 on its current 13-game homestand, the longest stint at Disharoon Park this year. The Cavaliers will wrap up the regular season at Louisville next weekend (May 19-21).
- Since 2009, Virginia has a 45-22 record against ACC foes coming out of exam break. The Cavaliers have won 13-straight home series after breaking for exams.
- The Cavaliers are 27-4 at home this season and are 9-3 against ACC foes at Disharoon Park this season. Only three teams in the country have 27 or more home wins in 2022 - Tennessee (31), Arkansas (27) and Virginia (27).
- Virginia is one of two schools (Davidson) to be ranked in the top-20 in the country in batting average (3rd - .319) and ERA (12th - 3.59).
- Virginia moved up two spots to No. 12 in the D1Baseball.com Top-25 polls after a weekend off from competition. Of the six major college polls, the Cavaliers highest ranking comes from USA Today/Coaches poll at No. 9. UVA enters play on Friday with an RPI of 15, one of five ACC teams with a top-15 RPI ranking.
- Prior to Sunday's game, the Virginia baseball program will honor its 10 seniors and graduate students - Dylan Bowers, Drew Hamrock, Will Geerdes, Brian Gursky, Paul Kosanovich, Brandon Neeck, Devin Ortiz, Billy Price, Jimmy Sullivan and Alex Tappen - in a pregame ceremony.

AGAINST CLEMSON

- Friday will be the 168th meeting between Clemson and Virginia. The Tigers own a 109-58 advantage in the all-time series that was first played 1955.
- Since head coach Brian O'Connor took over in 2004, UVA is 29-13 against Clemson and has won four of the last five series against the Tigers.
- The Cavaliers took two out of three at Clemson last season as part of a 14-7 finish in ACC play to conclude the season.
- Virginia won the rubber match on Sunday last year thanks to a three-run rally in the seventh inning, capped by a go-ahead, two-run single by Kyle Teel. Stephen Schoch sealed the victory with a six-out save.

MIDWEEK REVIEW

- Graduate student Alex Tappen drove in the final four runs of an 8-3 victory over Longwood on Wednesday. The Cavaliers finished the season 21-2 against non-conference foes.
- Three of the four RBI from Tappen came on a three-run, eighth inning homer, his 13th long ball of the year.
- Making his 23rd appearance of the season, righthander Dylan Bowers picked up his first win as a Cavalier. He was part of a quartet of UVA relievers who did not allow a run over the final four innings.
- Freshman Ethan Anderson went 2-for-4 with a double, his first collegiate triple and an RBI. He scored the go-ahead run in the sixth on an RBI groundout by Griff O'Ferrall.

- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 84 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 16 years and 20 have had 20 reach the big leagues
- UVA has had 29 All-America and 72 all-conference selections in his tenure

CAVALIER NOTABLES

- Catcher Kyle Teel is slated to make his 100th-straight start on Friday night. He has started all 47 games for UVA behind the plate this season and split time as an outfielder, catcher and designated hitter in 2021 as a true freshman.
- In the last five games, Alex Tappen is 9-for-21 (.429) with three home runs, four runs scored and 10 RBI. The graduate student risen to the occasion in ACC play this season, leading the team in bat-ting average (.379), home runs (9), hits (36) and RBI (39) in 24 league games this season.
- Devin Ortiz has reached base in 14-straight games, the longest active streak on the team. Griff O'Ferrall and Teel are right behind him reaching in 11 consecutive contests.
- O'Ferrall has led off and played shortstop in all 47 games for UVA as a true freshman. He's statistically the third-toughest batter in the ACC to strikeout and is ranked fifth in the ACC in stolen bases with 16.
- Centerfielder Chris Newell has homered in three of his last five games to up his season total to 11 on the season.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

- Virginia has homered in nine-straight games and is two home runs shy of matching the school single-season record of 67 set back 1988. It took the 1988 club 52 games to reach the 67-home run mark.

- Jake Gelof sits alone in third on Virginia's single-season home run list with 17 in 47 games the season. The 17 are the most in the Brian O'Connor era (2004-present) and trail Brian Buchanan (22 in 1994) and Jon Benick (18 in 2001) for the most in program history.
- Gelof is also having a historic season driving in runs. He recorded his 68th RBI of the season to stand alone in second place on UVA single season RBI list. He only trails Pavin Smith who dove in 77 in 2017.
- With 15 RBI in the last nine games, Tappen has shot up the single-season RBI list and now is tied for sixth with UVA Hall of Famers Jarrett Paker and Steven Proscia with 65.

ON THE MOUND

- Brian Gursky will get the nod on Friday night after starting the middle game of the weekend in all but two series this season. Gursky has the fourth-lowest ERA in the ACC at 2.53 over 53.1 innings pitched. In 10 starts by Gursky, Virginia is 9-1 and the Cavalier offense is outscoring its opponents 118-35.
- Junior Nate Savino is seeking his first win since March 25, an 8-2 series opening win over Wake Forest. The lefthander has pitched into the sixth inning in each of his last three starts. He struck out seven batters in 5.2 innings against Virginia Tech, the most since fanning eight against Boston College on March 18.
- Jake Berry is scheduled to make his seventh-straight ACC start this Sunday. The southpaw held Virginia Tech hitless over his first three innings before theokies got the first three runners aboard in the fourth to plate a pair of runs. Berry is 3-0 when pitching into the fifth inning this season.
- Virginia comes into the weekend with the lowest ERA (3.59) in the ACC and the 12th-lowest in the country. The Cavaliers have allowed 7.34 hits per game the eighth-fewest of any staff in the nation.
- UVA pitchers have 10.9 batters per nine innings, the eighth-highest ratio in the NCAA.
- Virginia eclipsed the 500-strikeout mark for the season with a 12-K performance against Longwood on Wednesday. It marks the 11th time in program history UVA has struck out 500 or more batters in a season. The Cavaliers fanned a school-record 687 batters last season.
- Virginia has seven shutouts this season, one behind national leader Vanderbilt. Virginia is one of seven teams in the country with seven or more shutouts (Vanderbilt, Tennessee, Stanford, Central Michigan, Omaha).

CAVALIERS AT THE PLATE

- Virginia is the No. 3 scoring offense in the country, averaging 9.4 runs per game. The Cavaliers have totaled 442 runs in 47 games, the sixth most national and second behind Wake Forest (453) for the ACC lead.
- The Cavaliers have scored 10 or more runs in a game 22 times this season, including 20 of the 31 games at Disharoon Park in 2022.
- Virginia has scored five or more runs in a single inning 25 times this season. The seven runs in the 10th against UNC on April 23 marked the ninth time UVA has scored seven or more in a single frame.
- UVA ranks in the top-10 nationally in batting average (3rd), on-base percentage (5th) and hits (8th).

HONORING RYAN ZIMMERMAN

- Zimmerman was the first player to have his number retired in the 134-year history of the program. No. 11 was retired as part of Ryan Zimmerman Day on April 30 at Disharoon Park.
- The No. 24 is UVA's only other retired number, worn by former head coach and UVA administrator Jim West.
- Zimmerman earned All-America honors from Baseball America (Second Team) and the NCBWA (Third Team) in 2005.
- Over his three-year career, Zimmerman batted .355 with seven home runs, 47 doubles and 140 RBI. His accumulated 250 career hits in 174 games, the fifth-most in program history before departing UVA for professional baseball.
- He left UVA as the single season record holder in hits (92 in 2005) and at bats (249 in 2004), both have since been surpassed.
- It took a little over two months since his last college baseball game for Zimmerman to make his MLB debut. In 2005, he was the fourth overall pick in the draft, the highest by any Cavalier at the time.
- Zimmerman was part of the inaugural class inducted into the UVA Baseball Hall of Fame in 2018.

MR. WALK-OFF

• Devin Ortiz hit a walk-off grand slam in the tenth inning on April 23 to help Virginia clinch its first series victory over North Carolina since 2016. The walk-off home run was his second of his career. He broke a 3-3 tie in the 10th of the 2021 NCAA Columbia Regional Championship game against ODU to send UVA to the Super Regionals.

• The walk-off grand slam was the only one hit by a Cavalier in the last 22 years.

• Since 2000, there have been eight Virginia walk-off homers. Ortiz is the only Cavalier to hit two walk-off home runs in that span.

• Shortstop Griff O'Ferrall led the rookies at the plate by batting .357 (5-for-14) with a home run and four runs scored. His solo home run on Friday night in the seventh inning broke a 2-2 tie in an eventual 4-2 victory.

• Outfielder Colin Tuft hit his first home run of the season in Saturday's contest and was 4-for-8 in two weekend starts.

• Ethan Anderson started all three games at DH and matched a season-high with three hits in the series finale.

• Anthony Stephan came on as a pinch-hitter in the 10th inning on Saturday and led off the seven-run inning with a base hit to left field.

• Virginia has won 30 of its last 34 games at home, including a school-record streak of 19-straight that ended on April 1 against Georgia Tech.

• UVA is 27-4 at Disharoon Park in 2021.

• The Cavaliers have won 76 percent (535-164) of its games over the course of 21 seasons at The Dish.

• UVA is outscoring its opponents 343-129 at home this season.

• The sixth-inning home run by Jake Gelof in the series finale against Georgia Tech on April 3 was the 39th hit by the Cavaliers at Disharoon Park this season, a facility record. The previous mark of 38 was set in 2017 over the course of 38 games.

• The Disharoon Park single-game attendance record fell on April 3 against Georgia Tech and again on April 30 for a sellout crowd for Ryan Zimmerman day. A total of 5,919 fans poured into the stadium, the third crowd of 5,000+ his season.

YEAR OF THE GRAND SLAM

• Virginia has hit five grand slams this season, the most of any Cavalier team since 2000.

• In the series opener against Boston College, Teel and Newell cleared the bases with a home run marking only the third time since 2000 and the last time since Kenny Towns hit two grand slams himself in 2013 against ECU that the Cavaliers have hit two grand slams in the same game.

• Teel, whose most notable grand slam came in game three of last year's Super Regional, hit four grand slams in his first 74 collegiate games the most of any Cavalier since 2000.

• With the bases loaded this season, Teel is 5-for-8 (.625) with three home runs, a triple and 18 RBI

• Newell has a grand slam in each of his three seasons as a Cavalier.

GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

• Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).

• In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.

• In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.

• He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

· Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.

· Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.

· The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).

· Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.

· Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.

· Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

PRESEASON POLLING

· For the second-straight season, Virginia came into the year ranked No. 5 by Baseball America. The Cavaliers were also inside the top 25 of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper (No. 24), USA Today Coaches (No. 21) and the NCBWA (No. 17) national polls.

· After appearing in the program's fifth College World Series last season, Virginia finished the 2021 season ranked in the top-10 of every major poll and finished as high as No. 6 according to Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game.

· In the annual preseason poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference baseball coaches, Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division. The Cavaliers received three votes to be the league's overall champion, second only to predicted winner, Florida State.

· Virginia was picked to finish second in the Coastal Division for the second-straight season and has been either first or second in the annual ACC preseason coaches poll in six of the last seven seasons.

NEW CAVALIER BACKSTOP

· Sophomore Kyle Teel will assume the starting catching role in 2020 after 15 of his 53 starts as a true freshman came behind the dish. He played 19 in right field and served as the designated hitter for 19 more.

· Teel was included on the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, an award in which UVA has boasted that UVA nine semifinalists, the fourth-most in college baseball.

· As a true freshman, Teel led the Cavaliers with a .335 batting average which was the 10th-highest in the ACC. It was the first time a UVA freshman led the team in hitting since 2008.

· Teel was a third-team All-ACC selection and earned freshman All-America honors from D1Baseball.com (first team), Baseball America (first team), Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game (second team).

· Teel collected a preseason All-America nod from D1Baseball and preseason All-ACC honors from Perfect Game.
