LEADING OFF

- UVA is making its 19th NCAA postseason appearance and have qualified for the NCAA Tournament in 16th in 18 chances under head coach Brian O'Connor.
- Virginia has reached the College World Series five times since 2009, tied for the second most in of any college baseball program.
- The Cavaliers are one of the six teams that went to Omaha last year that are part of the 2022 field.
- Head coaches Gary Gilmore and Brian O'Connor are two of the seven active coaches with a National Championship to their credit. A total of five are playing in this year's tournament.
- The Greenville Regional is one of four in this year's tournament to feature two teams that have won a national championship. Four of the last six national champions are grouped in two regionals - Virginia (2015) and Coastal Carolina (2016) in Greenville; Oregon State (2018) and Vanderbilt (2019) in Corvallis.
- Virginia enters the NCAA postseason averaging 8.8 runs per game, the ninth-highest scoring offense in the country.
- Virginia and consensus No. 1 Tennessee are the only two programs in the country to be ranked in the top-20 in both batting average (11th - .311) and earned run average (17th - 4.03).

NOTING THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Virginia has won seven regional championships (2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2021) and reached the College World Series five times - 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021.
- UVA has played on the road for a regional in three of the five times it has reached the College World Series (2009, 2015, 2021).
- Brian O'Connor is one of seven active coaches to win a National Championship.
- Competing in its 19th NCAA tournament, Virginia is 61-42 in NCAA play.
- UVA is 49-24 in the NCAA tournament since 2009, tied for the third-most NCAA wins in that span.
- Under Brian O'Connor (since 2004), UVA is 55-35 in the NCAA tournament and 37-23 in regional play.
- The Cavaliers captured the program's first National Championship in 2015 in a rematch of the 2014 College World Series final. Virginia became the first ACC school to claim a national title since 1955 (Wake Forest).

AGAINST THE GREENVILLE FIELD

- East Carolina is the only team in the regional Virginia has faced in the NCAA Tournament. The two teams met in the 2016 Charlottesville regional with ECU coming away with an 8-6 win.
- UVA and Coastal Carolina were regular opponents from 2007 to 2012 and last played in 2016, the Chanticleers national championship season. Coastal has won five of the nine all-time meetings, including a 5-4 victory over the Cavaliers in the third game of the 2016 season.
- Virginia is 31-21 against East Carolina in an all-time series that was first played in 1967. Despite dropping four of the last five games against the Pirates, UVA is 14-5 against ECU under Brian O'Connor.
- The Cavaliers have won all nine meetings against Coppin State and last played in 2008 in Charlottesville, a 27-1 UVA victory. The 27 runs are the most by the Cavaliers in the O'Connor era (2004-present).

- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 90 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 18 years and 29 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 31 All-America and 78 all-conference selections in his tenure

DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

- The Virginia roster boasts seven position players (Cotier, Gelof, Newell, Ortiz, Sullivan, Tappen, Teel) and four pitchers (Neeck, Ortiz, Savino, Wyatt) that have played in an NCAA Tournament game.
- In UVA's 2021 College World Series run, not a single Cavalier had been to an NCAA Regional.

ON THE MOUND

- Lefthander Nate Savino is scheduled to make his 15th start of the season and his second NCAA Tournament start of this career on Friday.
- Savino pitched nine innings in three NCAA Tournament appearances last season including a start in the decisive game three of the Super Regionals against Dallas Baptist on June 14. Allowed three earned runs in NCAA postseason and struck out four batters.
- Savino recorded his first win since March 25 in his final regular season start at Louisville. He scattered five hits over five innings of work and was charged with one earned run.
- In the ACC Tournament pool play finale, Savino pitched into the fifth inning for the 10th time in 13 starts this season but was on the losing end of a 3-0 Notre Dame victory. The lefthander struck out five batters and allowed two runs in 4.2 innings of work.
- Over the first 37 games of the season, UVA pitchers recorded two saves, one being a three-inning outing by Avery Mabe in a 14-4 win over Rider.
- Brandon Neeck has assumed UVA's closer role after pitching in the weekend rotation earlier this season. Since moving to the bullpen he has three saves (all in ACC play) and has a 2.76 ERA with 30 strikeouts in 16.1 innings pitched.
- The Cavaliers have allowed 7.94 hits per game the third fewest of any staff in the ACC. UVA ranks 16th in the country in hits allowed per game.
- Virginia ranks sixth in the country with 10.8 strikeouts per nine innings. Its 581 punchouts are the fourth most in program history and are tied with East Carolina for the 15th most in the country.
- Including this season, UVA has struck out 500+ batters 11 times including a school-record 687 batters last season.
- Virginia is one of nine teams in the country with seven or more shutouts (Vanderbilt, Tennessee, Stanford, Central Michigan, Omaha, Texas, Long Beach St. Southern Miss).

HOOS AT THE PLATE

- Virginia is the No. 9 scoring offense in the country, averaging 8.8 runs per game. The Cavaliers have totaled 484 runs in 54 games, the 11th most nationally. The 484 runs are the fourth most in a single season in program history.

CAVALIER NOTABLES

- Kyle Teel has started 107-consecutive games in his first two seasons for the Cavaliers. He has caught all 55 games for UVA this season and split time as an outfielder, catcher and DH as a true freshman. He batted .422 (19-for-45) with three doubles, a grand slam and eight RBI in last year's NCAA Tournament.
- Jake Gelof, a semifinalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy, has started all 55 games for UVA this season, 53 of them at third base. Along with his brother Zack, a

Gelof has occupied the hot corner in 178 of the last 185 games. The Cavaliers are 54-25 in the last 79 games with Jake Gelof in the lineup.

· Alex Tappen had 42 RBI in ACC play, the most of any hitter in the league. Tappen has been UVA's hottest hitter of the last 10 games, batting .439 (18-for-41) with six runs scored and 11 RBI.

· Devin Ortiz, a two-way player for the Cavaliers, is one of five finalists for the John Olerud Two Way Player of the Year Award. He earned Second Team All-America honors as a utility player. He homered in back-to-back games to close out the regular season and is one homer shy of matching his career high set last season.

· UVA has had three true freshman in the starting lineup in all but one game, the opening game of the season. The Cavaliers have had four true freshman in the lineup in 18 of 55 games this season.

McMULLAN RETURNS TO GREENVILLE

- Prior to joining O'Connor's staff, UVA associate head coach Kevin McMullan spent three seasons as ECU's recruiting coordinator. In his time in Greenville, the Pirates posted a record of 138-46, which placed ECU among the top five programs in the country in wins, averaging 46 victories a season. East Carolina won three conference championships and an NCAA Regional Championship in 2001.
- McMullan as the Pirates served as acting head coach at East Carolina in 2001-02 for Keith LeClair, who was diagnosed with Lou Gehrig's Disease. During that season, McMullan coached ECU to a 43-20 record, Conference USA Championship and NCAA Regional Final.
- McMullan has previously come back to Greenville as a member of the UVA staff for weekend series against the Pirates in 2010, 2013, 2015.

DYNAMIC DUO

- Third baseman Jake Gelof and Alex Tappen are the most prolific run-producing duo in school history, combining for 144 RBI this season. The make up two-thirds of UVA's single-season 70-RBI club.
- Gelof and Tappen were both First Team All-ACC selections, the first set of Cavalier position players to land on the first team since Pavin Smith and Adam Haseley who went on to become the seventh and eighth overall picks, respectively, in the 2017 MLB Draft

RECORD CHASING

- Jake Gelof surpassed Jon Benick (2001) for sole possession of second place on UVA's single season home runs list with his 19th in the middle game against Louisville on May 20. He trails Brian Buchanan (22 in 1994) for the most in program history.
- Gelof is also having a historic season driving in runs. He became the second player in UVA history to eclipse the 70-RBI mark with a two-run homer in the series finale against Clemson. He only trails Pavin Smith by three who drove in 77 in 2017 for the school record.
- With 15 RBI in the last 11 games, Tappen has shot up the single-season RBI list and became the third Cavalier to eclipse 70-RBI in a single season. He drove in four runs in three games in the final series of the season against Louisville.

HONORING RYAN ZIMMERMAN

· Zimmerman was the first player to have his number retired in the 134-year history of the program. No. 11 was retired as part of Ryan Zimmerman Day on April 30 at Disharoon Park.

· The No. 24 is UVA's only other retired number, worn by former head coach and UVA administrator Jim West.

· Zimmerman earned All-America honors from Baseball America (Second Team) and the NCBWA (Third Team) in 2005.

· Over his three-year career, Zimmerman batted .355 with seven home runs, 47 doubles and 140 RBI. His accumulated 250 career hits in 174 games, the fifth-most in program history before departing UVA for professional baseball.

· He left UVA as the single season record holder in hits (92 in 2005) and at bats (249 in 2004), both have since been surpassed.

· It took a little over two months since his last college baseball game for Zimmerman to make his MLB debut. In 2005, he was the fourth overall pick in the draft, the highest by any Cavalier at the time.

· Zimmerman was part of the inaugural class inducted into the UVA Baseball Hall of Fame in 2018.

MR. WALK-OFF

· Devin Ortiz hit a walk-off grand slam in the tenth inning on April 23 to help Virginia clinch its first series victory over North Carolina since 2016. The walk-off home run was his second of his career. He broke a 3-3 tie in the 10th of the 2021 NCAA Columbia Regional Championship game against ODU to send UVA to the Super Regionals.

· The walk-off grand slam was the only one hit by a Cavalier in the last 22 years.

· Since 2000, there have been eight Virginia walk-off homers. Ortiz is the only Cavalier to hit two walk-off home runs in that span.

· Virginia won 32 of its last 37 games at home, including a school-record streak of 19-straight that ended on April 1 against Georgia Tech.

· UVA is 29-5 at Disharoon Park in 2021.

· The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (537-165) of its games over the course of 21 seasons at The Dish.

· UVA is outscoring its opponents 363-146 at home this season.

· The sixth-inning home run by Jake Gelof in the series finale against Georgia Tech on April 3 was the 39th hit by the Cavaliers at Disharoon Park this season, a facility record. The previous mark of 38 was set in 2017 over the course of 38 games.

· The Disharoon Park single-game attendance record fell on April 3 against Georgia Tech and again on April 30 for a sellout crowd for Ryan Zimmerman day. A total of 5,919 fans poured into the stadium, the third crowd of 5,000+ his season.

YEAR OF THE GRAND SLAM

· Virginia has hit five grand slams this season, the most of any Cavalier team since 2000.
 · In the series opener against Boston College, Teel and Newell cleared the bases with a home run marking only the third time since 2000 and the last time since Kenny Towns hit two grand slams himself in 2013 against ECU that the Cavaliers have hit two grand slams in the same game.
 · Teel, whose most notable grand slam came in game three of last year's Super Regional, hit four grand slams in his first 74 collegiate games the most of any Cavalier since 2000.
 · With the bases loaded this season, Teel is 5-for-8 (.625) with three home runs, a triple and 18 RBI
 · Newell has a grand slam in each of his three seasons as a Cavalier.

GELOF'S MONSTER WEEK

· Jake Gelof was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday (Feb. 28), NCBWA co-Hitter of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's National Players of the Week. He's the first Cavalier position player to take home the ACC weekly honor since 2017 (Pavin Smith & Jake McCarthy).
 · In four games from Feb. 23-27, Gelof batted .900 (9-for-10) with four home runs and 15 RBI. He reached base 13 times and slugged 2.500 for the week.
 · In the series opener against Cornell he blasted a pair of three-run homers and drove in eight runs, the most in a game since a UVA hitter since 2013.
 · He capped off his week by becoming the first Cavalier to hit for the cycle in 21 years, accomplishing the feat in just four at bats and five innings played.

HISTORIC NUMBERS VS CORNELL

· Virginia plated 60 runs in three games against Cornell, a new school record for runs in a three-game series. The 60 runs were tied for the most in any three-game span in the history of the program. The only other three-game stretch of 60 runs came in 1891.
 · Virginia scored 24 runs in the opening game against Cornell, the most in a game since scoring 24 against U-Mass Lowell in 2020.
 · The Cavaliers posted 41 runs in the first two games of the series, the second-most in back-to-back games during O'Connor's tenure at Virginia (44 in 2008 - Coppin St./Sienna).
 · Led by Nate Savino's 11, Virginia fanned 23 batters in the opening game against Cornell, the second-largest strikeout total in school history. It marked the fourth time in the last two seasons UVA pitchers have combined to strike out 20 or more in a game.
 · Only 11 times in NCAA history has a team struck out 23 or more batters in a nine-inning game. Virginia has produced two of the 11 games, both occurring in the last two seasons.
 · Virginia drew 17 walks in the opening game against Cornell, the most in any game since 2000. Kyle Teel was issued five free passes, tying the program's single-game mark held by Phil Gosselin.

 · Won six-straight elimination games between the NCAA Regional and Super Regional to advance to the program's fifth College World Series.
 · All five College World Series appearances for Virginia have come under head coach Brian O'Connor's watch. The five trips to Omaha since 2009 are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program.
