LEADING OFF

- Going into this weekend's action, Virginia is one of nine unbeaten teams remaining in college baseball and one of four ACC teams without a loss (Wake Forest, NC State, Georgia Tech).
- Virginia is 8-0 for the second-straight season and the seventh time under head coach Brian O'Connor. UVA has gone 9-0 and 10-0 six times since 2004. Virginia has been 11-0 four times in O'Connor's tenure (2008, 2009, 2013 & 2022).
- O'Connor enters the weekend three wins away from 800 for his career. He's looking to become the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to reach 800 wins at an ACC school.
- Virginia comes into the series with a 10-game winning streak against non-conference opponents at Disharoon Park
- The Cavaliers enter the weekend action ranked fourth in the country in batting average (.357), fifth in ERA (1.80) and 14th in fielding percentage (.989). UVA and Wake Forest are the only two programs in the country to rank in the top-15 in all three categories.

ON THE MOUND

- In last weekend's series against Columbia, the three Cavalier starting pitchers - Nick Parker, Brian Edgington and Jack O'Connor, combined to allow just two runs in 17 innings pitched and 18 strikeouts.
- Parker has yet to issue a walk in 11 innings pitched this season. He is one of 11 pitchers with at least 11 innings pitched that has yet to walk a batter. He has 42 career starts, the third-most of any active DI college pitcher. Dating back to last season at Coastal Carolina, Parker has won his last five starts.
- Edgington struck out nine batters against Columbia, the fifth time in his career he has struck out nine or more in a game. His only run allowed was a solo homer to lead off the game by Columbia's Cole Hage.
- Both Parker and Edgington sit on 198 strikeouts for their careers. Parker fanned 182 batters in four seasons with Coastal Carolina while Edgington had 167 in three seasons at Elon and 19 in 2018 with St. Joseph's.
- Jack O'Connor was about as efficient as you can get in his Disharoon Park debut. He needed just 76 pitches go seven innings. He sat down the first eight batters in order and faced just three batters in four of the six innings that he worked.
- Jake Berry has made three relief appearances this season and allowed one hit over eight innings of work. His 1.12 hits allowed per nine innings is the lowest in the ACC and the sixth lowest in the country.
- The five Cavalier first years that have pitched in a game this season, Jack O'Connor, Bradley Hodges, Evan Blanco, Cullen McKay and Kevin Jaxel have not allowed a single run in a combined 18.1 innings pitched this season.

- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 94 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 19 years and 29 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 34 All-America and 83 all-conference selections in his tenure

AGAINST RHODE ISLAND

- Virginia and Rhode Island will meet for the first time since 2010 when the Cavaliers were the No. 1 ranked team in the country.
- The Cavaliers won all three games by a combined score of 43-7.
- UVA is 10-0 all-time against Rhode Island in a series that began in 1961.
- Rhode Island is one of four A-10 team UVA will square off against in 2023 (George Washington, Richmond, VCU).

MIDWEEK REVIEW

- Led by lefty Connelly Early, five UVA pitchers combined for a three-hit shutout against VMI on Tuesday at Disharoon Park. Early logged five innings and struck out eight batters, one shy of matching a career high.
- The four Cavalier relievers, Alex Greene, Angelo Tonas, Jake Berry and Jay Woolfolk did not allow a hit in the final four innings of work. Woolfolk tossed a scoreless ninth inning and recorded his first career save.
- Kyle Teel provided the offense, driving in all three runs with two outs. His bases loaded, two-out single in the third broke up a scoreless tie. He added an insurance run in the seventh with a two-out, opposite field double.

PLAYER NOTES

- Kyle Teel continued his eye-popping success with the bases loaded in his career. In three seasons he is 9-for-14 (.643) with a triple, four home runs and 33 RBI with the bases juiced. His four career grand slams and hit three last season, both the most of any Cavalier since 2000.
- On Friday, Teel was one of 65 catchers named to the initial Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award Watch List.
- Ethan Anderson, Jake Gelof, Ethan O'Donnell, Casey Saucke and Teel have reached base safely in all eight games this season.
- O'Donnell is two hits shy of 100 for his career. He has 11 hits in his first eight games as a Cavalier.
- Jake Gelof has 28 career home runs, tied for the sixth-most in program history. He is two shy of matching UVA Hall of Famer Brian Buchanan's 30 hit from 1992-94. Only five players in UVA history have hit 30 career home runs.
- Griff O'Ferrall who is 2-for-2 on stolen bases this year is now 19-21 for his career. The .905 career stolen base percentage is the sixth-highest of any Cavaliers since 2000.

DOUBLE DIPPING

- After playing only two doubleheaders in all of 2022, the Cavaliers are playing doubleheaders in back-to-back weekends in the early parts of 2023.
- UVA is 93-38-1 in doubleheaders under Brian O'Connor (2004-present).
- The Cavaliers swept Columbia in a twinbill last weekend, the first doubleheader sweep in the regular season since 2019. UVA split its doubleheaders against Duke and Clemson last season.

BEST OFFENSIVE START SINCE THE 19TH CENTURY

- The Cavaliers have scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- The current Hoos need 24 runs its fifth game to match the 1889 club's 89-run output in its first five contests.
- The 1889 squad averaged 16.14 runs per game in a 7-0, undefeated season. It marks the only undefeated season in program history.

20-RUN GAMES

- Virginia's 26 runs against Longwood were the most in a single game since crossing the plate 27 times at Maryland on April 23, 2010.
- The 24-run victory is the largest margin of defeat for a UVA team since the 27-2 win over Maryland in 2010.
- Virginia has scored 20 or more runs twice in a season, four times under head coach Brian O'Connor - 2006, 2010, 2020 and 2023.
- The Cavaliers haven't scored 20-runs three times in a season since 1905 and have only done it three times - 1905, 1898 and 1889.
- The 24 runs against Longwood marked the 60th time in program history that UVA has scored 20 runs in a game.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- Virginia returns seven position players that started more than 20 games last year and five that started over 40 games.
- The Cavaliers added 21 newcomers comprised of 13 freshman, six graduate transfers and three transfers from four-year schools. The 21 additions to the roster are the most in head coach Brian O'Connor's tenure.
- The Cavaliers lost nearly 70 percent of its innings on the mound from a season ago including two of its weekend starters, both to professional baseball. Only two pitchers that started a game last season remain on the 2023 roster (Jake Berry, Matthew Buchanan).
- Virginia bolstered its pitching depth with accomplished transfers Nick Parker (219.0 career innings), Brian Edgington (190.2 career innings), Connelly Early (122.0 career innings), Angelo Tonas (115.1 career innings) and Chase Hungate (63.0 career innings). The five pitchers account for 710.0 career innings pitched in college baseball, nearly 200 more innings than the whole UVA staff threw last season.
- D1Baseball rated Virginia's transfer class No. 18 in the country. Three Cavaliers ranked in the D1Baseball's top-100 transfers list - No. 15 Ethan O'Donnell (Northwestern), No. 32 Connelly Early (Army), and No. 94 Brian Edgington (Elon).

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

- Juniors Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel were each listed on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, annually giving to the country's top amateur baseball player by USA baseball.
- Gelof has earned preseason First Team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game and Second Team honors from D1Baseball.
- Teel was Baseball America's First Team preseason All-American at catcher and he also garnered third team accolades from D1Baseball.
- Righthanded pitcher Jay Woolfolk was included on the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Watch list after garnering Freshman All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and D1Baseball.

- Virginia was the only team in the country to rank in the top-15 nationally in BOTH batting average (11th - .309) and ERA (14th - .309).
- The potent Cavalier offense broke the single season team record for home runs with 75, including 57 at Disharoon Park, also a new facility record.
- Scored 499 runs, third most in program history and most since 2010. Averaged 8.60 runs per game the most in the O'Connor era and the most by UVA since 1985.
