LEADING OFF

- Virginia is one of three unbeaten teams remaining in college baseball - Alabama (14-0) & NC State (13-0). It marks the second-straight year, the Cavaliers are one of the last three undefeated teams in the country.
- UVA is ranked higher in five of the six major college baseball polls. D1Baseball is the only poll to list North Carolina higher (No. 14).
- This weekend marks the first time since 2017 that both Virginia and North Carolina are ranked in their annual Coastal Division showdown. Either Virginia and/or North Carolina has been nationally ranked when playing one another in each of the last 18 ACC series.
- Friday's series opener will be UVA's second true road game of the year and only third game away from Disharoon Park this season.
- Virginia is 12-0 for the fourth time under head coach Brian O'Connor (2009, 2013, 2022 & 2023). The Cavaliers won their first 14 games in 2009, 2013 & 2022 and have only been 15-0 to start the season once in program history (2009).
- The Cavaliers rank third in the country in team batting average (.365), fifth in team ERA (2.29) and sixth in fielding percentage (.988). Virginia is the team in the country to rank in the top 20 in all three categories.

NATIONALLY ACCLAIMED

- Virginia enters the weekend with the most doubles of any NCAA team with 39.
- The Cavaliers currently boast the third-highest scoring offense in the country, averaging 11.7 runs per game.
- UVA's 161 hits are the seventh most of any team in the country. It has posted single-game hit efforts of 25 (vs. Longwood) and 20 (vs. Navy) this season.
- On the pitching side the Cavalier hurlers rank second in the country in shutouts (3), 13th in hits allowed per game (6.62), seventh in WHIP (1.01) and seventh in walks allowed per nine innings (2.46).

AGAINST THE HEELS

- North Carolina is the only opponent that Virginia has played 300 games against. The all-time series dates back to 1891 with the Tar Heels holding a 188-116-4 advantage.
- Virginia hasn't taken a series in Chapel Hill since sweeping the Tar Heels in 2015.
- Head coach Brian O'Connor owns a 30-30 mark against North Carolina since taking over in 2004.
- The series was highlighted by a seesaw, 10-inning battle in the series-clinching game on Saturday. Devin Ortiz hit a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the tenth to punctuate a UVA victory.

- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals

- Competed in 16 NCAA regionals and seven super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 94 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 19 years and 29 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 34 All-America and 83 all-conference selections in his tenure

ON THE MOUND

- Despite 2023 being his first season in the ACC, Nick Parker is scheduled to make his third start against North Carolina. He took a no-decision in a 4-3 loss to the Tar Heels as a member of the Coastal Carolina program last season after he pitched 5.0 innings, allowed two runs and struck out six batters. The Tar Heels won on a walk-off single by Mac Horvath in the ninth inning.
- The last Cavalier to start three games against North Carolina was Adam Haseley (2015-17).
- Parker had his shortest outing of the young 2023 season last weekend, after getting lifted with two outs in the fifth against Rhode Island. He went into the URI series without issuing a walk, a streak he was able to run up to 14-straight innings before walking the leadoff man in the top of the fourth.
- Brian Edgington is one nine ACC pitchers with three wins on the year and his ranked eighth amongst ACC arms with 22 strikeouts. The righthander fanned 10 batters in a 13-0 shutout of URI last week, the fourth time in his career with double-digit strikeouts.
- Parker and Edgington each eclipsed the 200-strikeout mark for their career last week. Virginia is the only staff in the country that features multiple pitchers with 200 or more career strikeouts. Edgington's 209 career Ks are the 13th most among active NCAA players in the country, one behind Wake Forest's Rhett Lowder for the most by an ACC pitcher.
- Righthander Jack O'Connor allowed his first runs of the season last weekend against URI after going the first 11 innings of his college career without a runner crossing home plate. He surrendered a home run to the first batter of the game last Sunday and pitched into the fifth inning for his third-straight start.
- The Cavaliers are one of nine teams in the country and one of three in the ACC (Duke & NC State) with three shutouts on the year.
- The Cavaliers rank fifth in the NCAA in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.72) and have the ninth-lowest WHIP (1.03) of any staff in the nation.
- UVA's bullpen sports a 2.23 ERA in 44.1 innings pitched. Jake Berry has made five relief appearances and has yielded only two hits in 10.2 innings pitched. He has pitched in two of UVA's three shutouts, has a hold and one save to his credit.
- Virginia's bullpen has inherited nine runners in 11 games this season and the only one to score was against Connelly Early in the season opener against Navy.

MAN OF TEEL

- Going into the weekend, Kyle Teel is batting an eye-popping .568, the third highest batting average in the country. The two hitters in front of him for the national lead, Steve Luttazi (UMass) and Noah Rivera (Hartford) have a combined 10 hits in 15 at bats on the year.
- Teel's go-ahead RBI double in the bottom of the first inning against William & Mary, was his ninth hit in 10 at bats. He finished the day 2-for-4 with an RBI, his team-leading eighth multi-hit game of the season.
- In addition to leading the ACC in batting average going into league play, Teel ranks fourth in hits per game (2.08), sixth in hits (25) and fifth in on-base percentage (.642).
- He's statistically the third-toughest player to strikeout in the ACC going down on strikes only twice this season (once per every 26.5 plate appearance)
- In four games last week, the Virginia catcher was 12-for-17 (.706) with eight runs scored, three doubles and nine RBI. He put together back-to-back four-hit games against URI, the fourth and fifth four-hit performances of his career.
- In addition to his cartoon numbers at the plate, he has now started the last 70 consecutive games at catcher for UVA. He currently holds the team's longest consecutive games played streak which now sits at 122-straight dating back 2021.

CHASING HISTORY

- Jake Gelof is one home run away from becoming the sixth member of Virginia's 30 career-home run club. In his final at bat against Rhode Island on Sunday he hit a solo shot over the left field wall, his team-best fourth of the season.
- One more home run and Gelof would tie UVA Baseball Hall of Famer Brian Buchanan for the fifth most in program history. The last UVA batter to hit 30 home runs in a career was Mark Reynolds who hit 35 from 2002-04.
- He has hit 29 home runs in 108 career games played. Friday would be his 100th start of his collegiate career.

PLAYER NOTES

- Ethan Anderson, Ethan O'Donnell, Casey Saucke and Kyle Teel have each reached base in all 12 games this season. Anderson currently holds the team's longest hit streak which he extended to nine games with a single in the sixth inning against William & Mary.
- Anderson goes into ACC play tied for the league lead with UNC's Tomas Frick and FSU's Colton Vincent with seven. Anderson has seven hits in his last nine at bats including a season-high four hits in the nightcap of a doubleheader against Rhode Island.
- Ethan O'Donnell recorded his 100th hit of his career on Saturday with a home run in the eighth inning of game one. He came into the season with 87 hits in two seasons at Northwestern. He is one of five players on the Cavalier roster with 100 collegiate hits - Kyle Teel (156), Tommy Courtney (136), Chris Baker (132), Jake Gelof (126), O'Donnell (104).

· Gelof produced his fourth, four-RBI day of 2023 in the final game against Rhode Island on Sunday. The program's single season record holder for RBIs has now driven in a run in his last four games. His 21 RBI in the first 12 games of the season are the sixth-most in the ACC.

O'CONNOR 800

· Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island on Sunday.
 · Now in his 20th season, O'Connor became the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .703 winning percentage is the second highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
 · All 800 of his wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

BEST OFFENSIVE START SINCE THE 19TH CENTURY

· The Cavaliers have scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
 · The current Hoos need 24 runs its fifth game to match the 1889 club's 89-run output in its first five contests.
 · The 1889 squad averaged 16.14 runs per game in a 7-0, undefeated season. It marks the only undefeated season in program history.

20-RUN GAMES

· Virginia's 26 runs against Longwood were the most in a single game since crossing the plate 27 times at Maryland on April 23, 2010.
 · The 24-run victory is the largest margin of defeat for a UVA team since the 27-2 win over Maryland in 2010.
 · Virginia has scored 20 or more runs twice in a season, four times under head coach Brian O'Connor - 2006, 2010, 2020 and 2023.
 · The Cavaliers haven't scored 20-runs three times in a season since 1905 and have only done it three times - 1905, 1898 and 1889.
 · The 24 runs against Longwood marked the 60th time in program history that UVA has scored 20 runs in a game.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

· Virginia returns seven position players that started more than 20 games last year and five that started over 40 games.
 · The Cavaliers added 21 newcomers comprised of 13 freshman, six graduate transfers and three transfers from four-year schools. The 21 additions to the roster are the most in head coach Brian O'Connor's tenure.
 · The Cavaliers lost nearly 70 percent of its innings on the mound from a season ago including two of its weekend starters, both to professional baseball. Only two pitchers that started a game last season remain on the 2023 roster (Jake Berry, Matthew Buchanan).
 · Virginia bolstered its pitching depth with accomplished transfers Nick Parker (219.0 career innings), Brian Edgington (190.2 career innings), Connelly Early (122.0 career innings), Angelo Tonas (115.1 career innings) and Chase Hungate (63.0 career innings). The five pitchers account for 710.0 career innings pitched in college baseball, nearly 200 more innings than the whole UVA staff threw last season.
 · D1Baseball rated Virginia's transfer class No. 18 in the country. Three Cavaliers ranked in the D1Baseball's top-100 transfers list - No. 15 Ethan O'Donnell (Northwestern), No. 32 Connelly Early (Army), and No. 94 Brian Edgington (Elon).

· Juniors Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel were each listed on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, annually giving to the country's top amateur baseball player by USA baseball.

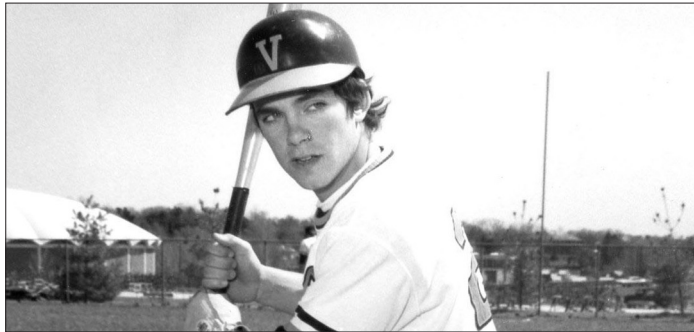
