## LEADING OFF

- The winner of this weekend's series will take over sole possession of first place in the ACC Coastal Division. Miami was picked to win the Coastal Division and Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC Preseason Coaches Poll.
- The Cavaliers have won all 17 games at home this season and 18-straight dating back to last season. A win in the series opener would tie UVA's program record of 19-straight home wins established last season.
- A series victory this weekend would mark the first time UVA has won double-digit ACC games through its first 15 ACC games since 2013 and the fifth time in program history.
- Miami will be the first ranked opponent to visit Disharoon Park this season. UVA is 4-2 against ranked foes in 2023. The last matchup of two ranked teams at The Dish was last season in a three-game series that featured then-No. 7 Virginia and then-No. 11 Virginia Tech.
- Virginia won its 25th game of the year on Tuesday and is one of six teams in the country with 25 or more wins. UVA's four losses are the second fewest in the nation, only five college baseball programs have four or fewer losses.
- Friday commences an eight-game homestand for the Cavaliers. Of the next 23 games on the schedule for Virginia, 19 will be played at Disharoon Park. UVA has seven true road games left to play this season.
- Virginia comes into the weekend as the national leader in hits (349) and doubles (83).
- As a team, the Cavaliers rank second the nation in team batting average (.333), fourth in ERA (3.09) and 11th in fielding percentage (.981). UVA is the only team in college baseball to rank in the top-10 in the country in both ERA and batting average. Only Virginia and consensus No. 1 LSU are the only teams in the country to currently rank in the top-20 in team batting average, ERA and fielding percentage.

## AGAINST MIAMI

- The all-time series against Miami has been a tale of two eras. From 2010-2017, Virginia won 19-of-27 matchups against the Hurricanes including eight straight games from 2011-2013. The pendulum has swung back in favor of Miami which has won 12 of the last 13 meetings. Of those 13 meetings, seven have been decided by one or two runs.
- The Hurricanes own a 37-29 advantage in the all-time series that was first played in 1985, an NCAA regional matchup in Coral Gables.
- Since joining the ACC full time in 2005, the Hurricanes hold a slight, 24-28 edge ACC regular season action.

- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)

### DOUSING THE FLAMES

- Virginia held Liberty scoreless for the first seven innings and held on for a 4-1 victory in Lynchburg on Tuesday. A season-high seven pitchers combined to strike out 12 batters in the contest.
- Freshman Cullen McKay made his first collegiate start and struck out a season-high six batters in three innings pitched.
- The Cavaliers scored all four of its runs with two outs.
- UVA improved to 16-0 against non-conference opponents in 2023 and have won their last 20 games against non-ACC foes dating back to last season. Virginia's last loss to a non-conference team came on April 19, 2022, a 9-7 extra-inning loss at VCU.

### ON THE MOUND

- With the return of Nick Parker to the rotation, Virginia will have used the trio of Edgington, Parker and O'Connor in seven of the eight series this season.
- Brian Edgington will make his third series opening start of the season and is coming off one of his best performances of the year last weekend at Virginia Tech. The righthander fanned eight batters over six innings of work and didn't allow an earned run. It was his staff-best, third quality start of the season.
- Edgington enters Friday with 229 career strikeouts, second to only Rhett Lowder (237) for the most by an active ACC pitcher. Edgington and Parker have the most career strikeouts of any pitching duo in the country with a combined 445.
- Parker returns to the mound after exiting in the first inning of game one against Florida State when a line drive struck him in the head. In five of his six starts this season, he has pitched at least four innings, with FSU being the lone exception.
- Parker has 46 career starts to his credit over the course of his collegiate career at Coastal Carolina and UVA, the second most of any active pitcher in D-I baseball.
- First year Jack O'Connor will make his eighth-straight Sunday start. He is one of three UVA freshman to earn start a game on the mound for UVA. After not walking a batter in consecutive starts against NC State and Florida State, the righthander issued three and hit a batter at Virginia Tech in his shortest outing of his young career (1.2 innings).
- O'Connor enters the weekend with a 3.27 ERA, the 14th lowest in the ACC and the fourth lowest of any qualified Power-5 freshman.
- Despite the three games in Blacksburg in which UVA issued 19 walks and surrendered 31 hits, Virginia ranks 11th in the country in WHIP (1.23). The Cavaliers have pitched an ACC-best four shutouts in 2023 and limited opponents to two runs or less 10 times.

### PRODUCTION AT THE PLATE

- The Cavaliers are averaging 9.3 runs per game, 12th most in the country and have the fourth largest scoring margin in college baseball.
- Virginia has struck out 184 times as a team this season, the fewest of any team in the ACC.
- UVA has four batters ranked in the top-10 in the ACC in batting average, no other school has two.

### MIDSEASON ACCOLADES

- Kyle Teel and Jake Gelofo were both named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List on Wednesday. Only 15 teams in the country had multiple players on the list. Gelofo, a semifinalist for the award last season, was one of seven 2022 semifinalists included on this year's midseason watch list.
- Teel garnered midseason First Team All-America honors from Perfect Game and D1Baseball. Gelofo was a third team All-America selection by Perfect Game at the third base position.

### PLAYER NOTES

- Teel leads the ACC with a .440 batting average and has reached base safely in all 29 games this season. He's 10 hits shy of matching his entire season hit total from a year ago. There are nine players in college baseball to eclipse the 50-hit plateau in 2023.
- Teel leads the team with 17 multi-hit efforts this season. He has two or more hits in eight of his last 10 games.
- Griff O'Ferrall put together his fourth, four-hit game of his career in a 4-for-6 day at the plate against Liberty on Tuesday. Two of his four-hit games have come in 2023. The Cavalier shortstop has reached base safely in 20-straight games.
- Ethan O'Donnell had a monster weekend in Blacksburg and has the team's longest active hit streak (8 games) after a single against Liberty on Tuesday., the longest active streak on the team. O'Donnell went 7-for-12 with three doubles, a home run and five RBI in three games against Virginia Tech. Four of his seven home runs have come in conference play.
- O'Donnell is batting .408 (20-for-49) in ACC play this year and has scored a team-high 14 runs.
- Jake Gelofo, who leads the ACC in RBI, has driven in 21 against league foes.

### THE HOME RUN CHASE

- Jake Gelofo is all alone in fourth place with 34 career home runs at UVA. The junior hit a 459-foot blast in the middle game against Virginia Tech last weekend.
- Gelofo leads the team with nine home runs this season, tied for the sixth-most in the ACC.
- He has homered in his last eight ACC series dating back to last season.
- Only six players in UVA history have 30 career home runs and the last Cavalier to eclipse the 30-home run mark was Mark Reynolds (2002-04).

### BLACKSBURG REVIEW

- Virginia lost its first weekend series of the season and dropped back-to-back games for the first time in 2023 after losing two-out-of-three to Virginia Tech.
- The two Cavalier offense combined to score 17 runs and 26 in the two losses to the Hokes. UVA out-hit Virginia Tech 36-31 in the three-game set and 26-24 in the two losing efforts.
- Virginia captured game one in decisive manner, scoring the game's first nine runs including six in the first two innings.
- With the exception of Brian Edgington on Friday night, UVA starting pitchers in the final two games combined for 3.2 innings pitched. The staff totaled an uncharacteristic, 19 walks over the weekend including a season-high eight in the middle game.
- Virginia scored 10 runs in a game two loss, the first time UVA lost when scoring 10 or more runs since Feb. 22, 2020 in game two of a doubleheader against Bucknell (14-10).

### HOW IT STARTED

- Virginia started the season by winning its first 14 games and was the last undefeated team remaining in college baseball before dropping the series finale at North Carolina on March 12. It marked the second-straight year and fourth time in program history (2009, 2013, 2022, 2023) UVA has won its first 14 games of the season.
- Through the first 26 games of the season, UVA matched the best start in program history (24-2). The stretch included road ACC series victories over ranked foes, North Carolina and NC State. The Cavaliers were also 24-2 to start the 2011 and 2013 seasons.

## SWEEP SUCCESS

·Virginia has the longest winnings streak (5) in the ACC thanks to a three-game sweep of Florida State this past weekend. The Cavaliers have now won three-straight ACC series to start the season and will head to Virginia Tech for three this weekend.

·The Cavaliers played their first extra inning ballgame of the year in game one. The Cavaliers rallied to tie the game in the bottom of the ninth and won it on a walk-off with graduate transfer Chris Baker at the plate.

·Virginia outscored FSU 27-8 in the final two games of the series to complete the first sweep of FSU since 2013. The 15 runs in the series finale matched the most ever against an FSU.

## HISTORIC WIN STREAK

·The 14-straight wins to start the season was tied for the second-best start in program history. UVA has gone 14-0 to start the season four times (2009, 2013, 2022 & 2023). The Cavaliers 14-game win streaks to start the season in 2022 and 2003 both ended in the nightcap of a road ACC doubleheader.

·Virginia has put together a win streak of 12 or more games 10 times in the 135-year history of the program, all have come under the direction of head coach Brian O'Connor (2004-present).

## O'CONNOR 800

·Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island.

·Now in his 20th season, O'Connor became the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .703 winning percentage is the second highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).

·All 800 of his wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

## BEST OFFENSIVE START SINCE THE 19TH CENTURY

·The Cavaliers have scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.

·The current Hoos need 24 runs its fifth game to match the 1889 club's 89-run output in its first five contests.

·The 1889 squad averaged 16.14 runs per game in a 7-0, undefeated season. It marks the only undefeated season in program history.

## 20-RUN GAMES

·Virginia's 26 runs against Longwood were the most in a single game since crossing the plate 27 times at Maryland on April 23, 2010.

·The 24-run victory is the largest margin of defeat for a UVA team since the 27-2 win over Maryland in 2010.

·The Cavaliers have scored 20 or more runs three times this season, matching a school record first established in 1889 and duplicated in 1898 and 1889.

·The 20 runs against George Washington marked the 61st time in program history that UVA has scored 20 runs in a game.

## ROSTER BREAKDOWN

·Virginia returns seven position players that started more than 20 games last year and five that started over 40 games.

·The Cavaliers added 21 newcomers comprised of 13 freshman, six graduate transfers and three transfers from four-year schools. The 21 additions to the roster are the most in head coach Brian O'Connor's tenure.

·The Cavaliers lost nearly 70 percent of its innings on the mound from a season ago including two of its weekend starters, both to professional baseball. Only two pitchers that started a game last season remain on the 2023 roster (Jake Berry, Matthew Buchanan).

·Virginia bolstered its pitching depth with accomplished transfers Nick Parker (219.0 career innings), Brian Edgington (190.2 career innings), Connelly Early (122.0 career innings), Angelo Tonas (115.1 career innings) and Chase Hungate (63.0 career innings). The five pitchers account for 710.0 career innings pitched in college baseball, nearly 200 more innings than the whole UVA staff threw last season.

·D1Baseball rated Virginia's transfer class No. 18 in the country. Three Cavaliers ranked in the D1Baseball's top-100 transfers list - No. 15 Ethan O'Donnell (Northwestern), No. 32 Connelly Early (Army), and No. 94 Brian Edgington (Elon).

## PRESEASON RECOGNITION

·Juniors Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel were each listed on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, annually giving to the country's top amateur baseball player by USA baseball.

·Gelof has earned preseason First Team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game and Second Team honors from D1Baseball.

·Teel was Baseball America's First Team preseason All-American at catcher and he also garnered third team accolades from D1Baseball.

·Righthanded pitcher Jay Woolfolk was included on the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Watch list after garnering Freshman All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and D1Baseball.

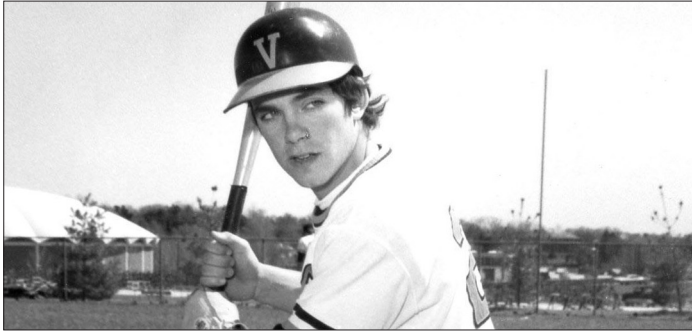
