## LEADING OFF

- Virginia enters ninth weekend of play with the most wins (30) and the highest winning percentage (.875) in the country. The Cavaliers are also tied with Wake Forest and South Carolina for the fewest losses (4) in college baseball.
- The Cavaliers have won a school-record, 23-straight games at Disharoon Park dating back to last season, the longest home win streak in the country. The Cavaliers eclipsed the program's previous mark of 19 set in 2009 and 2022 last weekend against Miami.
- Virginia has won six-consecutive games dating back to its 4-1 win over Liberty on April 4. The six-game win streak is the longest in the ACC and tied with Arizona State the longest of any Power-5 program.
- UVA's 30-4 mark through 34 games is tied for the second-best start in program history. The 2011 College World Series team went 31-3 in its first 34 contests. The 2013 squad (30-4) is the only other Cavalier team in the 135-year history of the program with 30 wins in its first 34 games.
- Virginia owns a 22-0 mark at home this season, the 17th time in the last 22 years that the Cavaliers have won 20 games at Disharoon Park. UVA has won 77 percent (559-165) of its games at Disharoon park since the facility opened in 2002.
- Virginia held steady in the D1Baseball Top-25, coming in at No. 7 for the second-straight week. The Cavaliers have been inside the top-10 for four-consecutive weeks, the longest since garnering a No. 3 ranking from D1Baseball over the first five weeks of the 2015 National Championship season.

## TOP OF THE HEAP

- Virginia enters the weekend No. 1 in the country in batting average (.336), doubles (93) and hits (409).
- The Cavaliers rank in the top-10 in the nation in runs (3rd - 330), on-base-percentage (5th - .439) and scoring (5th - 9.7 rpg).
- On the mound, the Cavaliers have the second-lowest team ERA (2.74) behind Wake Forest (2.32).
- Virginia pitched its fifth shutout on Tuesday against Richmond, tied for the most in the ACC and the fifth-most in the country.
- Of the 345 strikeouts recorded by Cavalier pitching, 118 have come looking, the most of any staff in the country.
- The Cavalier hurlers also boast college baseball's seventh-best strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.19) and WHIP (1.21).
- Virginia is the only team in the country to rank in the top-20 in the nation in batting average (1st), ERA (2nd) and fielding percentage (19th).

- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)

### SERIES HISTORY - PITT

- Friday's series opener against the Panthers will be the 31st meeting between the two schools.
- Virginia owns a 21-9 advantage in an all-time series that was first played in 1940, a 19-5 Cavalier victory.
- Since beginning ACC Coastal Division play in 2014, the Cavaliers are 16-8 against the Panthers. From 2015-18, the Cavaliers won nine-straight games, sweeping the 2016 and 2017 series.
- On April 4, 2014, Nathan Kirby tossed the program's fifth no-hitter in a 4-0 shutout in Pittsburgh. Kirby struck out 18 batters in the contest and only two Panther hitters reached base (one hit, one error).
- Pitt has won back-to-back series against the Cavaliers and four of the last six games.

### ON THE MOUND

- Virginia pitchers have not allowed an earned run in its last 18 innings pitched after a shutout of Richmond on Tuesday and four unearned runs on Wednesday against Mount St. Mary's. The last earned run surrendered came in the seventh inning of the series finale against Miami.
- The Cavalier bullpen has not yielded any runs since April 8 against Miami, a span of 14.2 innings.
- Friday night starter Brian Edgington comes into the series opener with the eighth-lowest ERA of any pitcher in the country and the third-lowest in the ACC.
- Last weekend against Miami, the righthander matched a season-high with 10 strikeouts and in seven innings of one-run baseball. Edgington has allowed two earned runs in his last 17 innings pitched.
- Edgington has 239 career strikeouts (53 at UVA), only two behind Wake Forest's Rhett Lowder for the most by a current ACC pitcher.
- Edgington and Saturday's projected starter, Nick Parker, have a combined 458 career strikeouts, the most of any active pitching duo in the country.
- Parker is one of the most experience pitchers in college baseball with 47 starts to his name, the second most of any active D-I pitcher.
- Just 15 days after leaving the game after a line drive hit him in the side of the head, Parker returned to the mound to pitch four innings against Miami last weekend. He allowed four runs, struck out three and took a no-decision in the contest. He has pitched four or more innings in all but one appearance this season. UVA is 7-0 in games Parker starts on the mound.
- Jack O'Connor picked up his second ACC win of the season after he established season highs in innings pitched (6.1) and strikeouts (9) in a 6-3 win over Miami on Sunday. The righthander turned in his second quality start of the season allowing three runs on eight hits.
- O'Connor's 3.43 season ERA is the third-lowest of any qualified power-5 freshman in the country.

### PRODUCTION AT THE PLATE

- The Cavaliers are averaging 9.7 runs per game, fifth-most in the country and have the second largest scoring margin in college baseball.
- Virginia has struck out 212 times as a team this season, the fewest of any team in the ACC and the 16th-fewest of any team in the country that has played at least 30 games.
- UVA has five of the top eight batting averages in the ACC.

### THE NEW HOME RUN KING

- Jake Gelof broke UVA's all-time home run record on Tuesday against Richmond with his 38th of his career, a solo shot to left field on an 0-2 pitch.
- Gelof came back on Wednesday and hit another home run, his fifth in the last five games to up his career total to 39. It marked the first time in his career he hit five home runs in a five-game stretch. He's looking to become the 14th active D-1 player with 40 career home runs.
- It took Gelof 454 at bats and 129 career games to eclipse UVA's all-time mark, 39 games fewer than any Cavalier to hit 30 or more home runs in a career.
- Gelof has homered in nine-straight ACC series dating back to last season.
- This past weekend against Miami was the third time in his career he homered three times in a three-game series (2022 vs. Cornell & 2022 vs. Boston College)
- Gelof leads the team with 14 home runs this season, second-most in the ACC and ninth-most in the country.
- Only six players in UVA history have 30 career home runs and the last Cavalier to eclipse the 30-home run mark was Mark Reynolds (2002-04).

- Griff O'Ferrall has been the ultimate leadoff man for the Cavaliers and is 11-for-19 (.579) with nine runs scored in his last five games. He co-leads the team with nine stolen bases. O'Ferrall also leads the team with a .379 average in ACC play.
- Kyle Teel leads the ACC in batting average (.437), hits (59), hits per game (1.74) and on-base percentage (.503). He has reached base safely in all 34 games this season, the second-longest stretch of his career. As a freshman he reached base in 44-straight at the end of the 2021 season and the first 17 games of the 2022 season, the second-longest streak of any Cavaliers since 1998.
- Ethan Anderson and Harrison Didawick each hit their first career grand slams in Tuesday's rout of Richmond. It marked only the fourth time since 2000 that UVA has hit two grand slams in the same game. Anderson was 4-for-5 in the contest with a career-high five RBI.



## MIDSEASON ACCOLADES

· Kyle Teel and Jake Gelof were both named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List on Wednesday. Only 15 teams in the country had multiple players on the list. Gelof, a semifinalist for the award last season, was one of seven 2022 semifinalists included on this year's midseason watch list.

· Teel garnered midseason First Team All-America honors from Perfect Game and D1Baseball. Gelof was a third team All-America selection by Perfect Game at the third base position.

## HOW IT STARTED

· Virginia started the season by winning its first 14 games and was the last undefeated team remaining in college baseball before dropping the series finale at North Carolina on March 12. It marked the second-straight year and fourth time in program history (2009, 2013, 2022, 2023) UVA has won its first 14 games of the season. · Through the first 26 games of the season, UVA matched the best start in program history (24-2). The stretch included road ACC series victories over ranked foes, North Carolina and NC State. The Cavaliers were also 24-2 to start the 2011 and 2013 seasons.

## HISTORIC WIN STREAK

· The 14-straight wins to start the season was tied for the second-best start in program history. UVA has gone 14-0 to start the season four times (2009, 2013, 2022 & 2023). The Cavaliers 14-game win streaks to start the season in 2022 and 2003 both ended in the nightcap of a road ACC doubleheader.

· Virginia has put together a win streak of 12 or more games 10 times in the 135-year history of the program, all have come under the direction of head coach Brian O'Connor (2004-present).

## O'CONNOR 800

· Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island.

· Now in his 20th season, O'Connor became the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .703 winning percentage is the second highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).

· All 800 of his wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

## BEST OFFENSIVE START SINCE THE 19TH CENTURY

· The Cavaliers have scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.

· The current Hoos need 24 runs its fifth game to match the 1889 club's 89-run output in its first five contests.

· The 1889 squad averaged 16.14 runs per game in a 7-0, undefeated season. It marks the only undefeated season in program history.

## 20-RUN GAMES

· Virginia's 26 runs against Longwood were the most in a single game since crossing the plate 27 times at Maryland on April 23, 2010.

· The 24-run victory is the largest margin of defeat for a UVA team since the 27-2 win over Maryland in 2010.

· The Cavaliers have scored 20 or more runs three times this season, matching a school record first established in 1889 and duplicated in 1898 and 1889.

· The 20 runs against George Washington marked the 61st time in program history that UVA has scored 20 runs in a game.

## ROSTER BREAKDOWN

· Virginia returns seven position players that started more than 20 games last year and five that started over 40 games.

· The Cavaliers added 21 newcomers comprised of 13 freshman, six graduate transfers and three transfers from four-year schools. The 21 additions to the roster are the most in head coach Brian O'Connor's tenure.

· The Cavaliers lost nearly 70 percent of its innings on the mound from a season ago including two of its weekend starters, both to professional baseball. Only two pitchers that started a game last season remain on the 2023 roster (Jake Berry, Matthew Buchanan).

· Virginia bolstered its pitching depth with accomplished transfers Nick Parker (219.0 career innings), Brian Edgington (190.2 career innings), Connelly Early (122.0 career innings), Angelo Tonas (115.1 career innings) and Chase Hungate (63.0 career innings). The five pitchers account for 710.0 career innings pitched in college baseball, nearly 200 more innings than the whole UVA staff threw last season.

· D1Baseball rated Virginia's transfer class No. 18 in the country. Three Cavaliers ranked in the D1Baseball's top-100 transfers list - No. 15 Ethan O'Donnell (Northwestern), No. 32 Connelly Early (Army), and No. 94 Brian Edgington (Elon).

· Juniors Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel were each listed on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, annually giving to the country's top amateur baseball player by USA baseball.

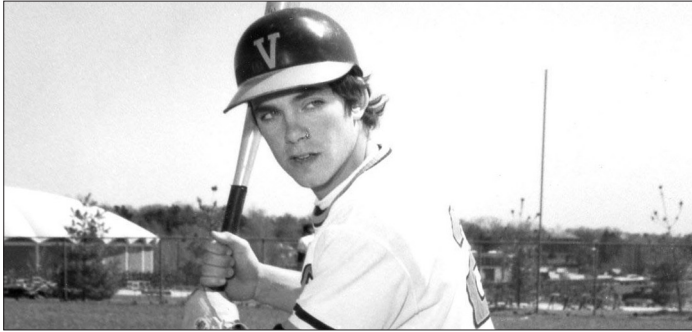
