LEADING OFF

- Virginia enters Tuesday's game unbeaten in its last 23 games against non-conference opponents. UVA's last lost against a non-conference foe was to VCU nearly one year ago to the day (April 17, 2022) in walk-off fashion at The Diamond.
- Virginia and Wake Forest enter the midweek with the most wins (31) of any team in the country. The Cavaliers winning percentage (.838) is the second highest of any college baseball program. Virginia's six losses are tied with LSU and South Carolina for the second fewest in the country behind Wake Forest's five.
- Tuesday's contest will be the final non-conference road game of the regular season for Virginia and one of seven regular season games left to be played away from Disharoon Park.
- Virginia's seven road wins thus far in 2023 matches the entire road win total from last year. The Cavaliers have won double-digit road games 13 times in O'Connor's 20 seasons, most recently in 2021. The 19 road wins in O'Connor's first year on the job in 2004 remain the most in his tenure.
- The Cavaliers went 3-2 last week and are a consensus top-10 team for the fifth-straight week, coming in at No. 8 in this week's D1Baseball Top-25. It's the longest UVA has been in D1Baseball's top-10 since it was ranked No. 3 the first five weeks of the 2015 National Championship season.
- Virginia enters the game 7-2 against schools from the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- Tuesday's game will feature two of the top run producers in the country, Jake Gelof currently leads the nation in RBI with 62. VCU's lineup features Brandon Eike who leads the A-10 and ranks 16th in the country with 49.

IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Virginia enters the midweek No. 1 in the country in batting average (.337), doubles (102) and hits (445).
- The Cavaliers rank in the top-10 in the nation in runs (4th - 337), on-base-percentage (5th - .438) and scoring (6th - 9.4 rpg).
- On the mound, the Cavaliers have the fourth-lowest team ERA (3.20).
- Virginia has pitched five shutouts this season, tied for the most in the ACC and the seventh-most in the country.
- Of the 371 strikeouts (14th most in NCAA) recorded by Cavalier pitching, 129 have come looking, the most of any staff in the country.
- The Cavalier hurlers also boast college baseball's 10th-best strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.04) and rank 15th in WHIP (1.26).
- Virginia is the only team in the country to rank in the top-20 in the nation in batting average (1st), ERA (4th) and fielding percentage (12th). Only Virginia and UTSA (11th in BA & 10th in ERA) rank in the top-20 in batting average and ERA.

- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 94 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 19 years and 29 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 34 All-America and 83 all-conference selections in his tenure

· Tuesday will be the 71st meeting between Virginia and VCU with UVA holding 45-25 advantage in the all-time series that was first played in 1979, a 17-4 Cavalier victory in Charlottesville.
 · Under Brian O'Connor Virginia boasts a 21-6 mark against VCU.
 · Except for 2020, the two schools have played a home and home series every year since 2016.
 · VCU spoiled a valiant comeback effort last year at the Diamond where UVA erased a five-run deficit. The Rams won 7-5 in extra innings on walk home run by Jacob Selden. The Cavaliers earned the split in the season series with a 12-6 win in Charlottesville. It was a one-run game over the first six innings until UVA plated six runs in the seventh.

RICHMOND/VCU TIES

· Chase Hungate makes his return to The Diamond after playing his freshman season for the Rams under head coach Shawn Stiffler who left to become the head coach at Notre Dame (UVA's weekend opponent). Hungate pitched in both games against UVA last season, allowing four runs in 7.2 IP. He was in line to get the win after three shutout innings against the Cavaliers in the May 4th game in Charlottesville before UVA scored eight of the last nine runs on the Rams bullpen.
 · Chesterfield native Jay Woolfolk surrendered the walk-off homer against VCU last season on his fifth pitch of the ballgame. The righthander turned around the next day and struck out five of the seven batters to earn a five-out save against Georgetown.
 · Griff O'Ferrall (Richmond), Travis Reifsnider (Richmond) Jay Woolfolk (Chesterfield) and Connelly Early (Midlothian) all hail from the Richmond area.

ON THE MOUND

· Connelly Early is scheduled to make his eighth midweek start of the season and ninth overall. The lefthander is in a three-way tie with Rhett Lowder (Wake Forest) and Carson Liggett (Louisville) for the most wins in the ACC. There are 15 pitchers in the country with seven or more wins and only two with eight (Cooper Rawls - Louisiana & Grant Rogers - McNeese).
 · Early is looking to become the fifth UVA pitcher since 2016 to record eight wins in a season. Andrew Abbott was the last to win eight when he went 9-6 in 2021.
 · Early got back on track with a combined shutout of Richmond last Tuesday. The lefthander allowed two hits, issued two walks and struck out four batters over six innings in his third quality start of the season. Early has started two of UVA's ACC-best, five shutouts this season.

PRODUCTION AT THE PLATE

· The Cavaliers are averaging 9.4 runs per game, sixth-most in the country and have the third largest scoring margin in college baseball.
 · Virginia has struck out 239 times as a team this season, the fewest of any team in the ACC.
 · UVA has five players ranked in the top-5 in the ACC in batting average, no other school has two.

Griff O'Ferrall was UVA's best hitter over the five games last week. He was 10-for-18 (.558) at the plate with eight runs scored, two doubles and three RBI. He is currently riding a career-high, 14-game hit streak and has reached base safely in his last 28 games. Over the course of his 14-game hit streak he is 29-for-57 (.508) with 24 runs scored.

· Kyle Teel leads the ACC in batting average (.435), hits (65), hits per game (1.73) and on-base percentage (.503). He has reached base safely in all 37 games this season, the second-longest stretch of his career. As a freshman he reached base in 44-straight at the end of the 2021 season and the first 17 games of the 2022 season, the second-longest streak of any Cavaliers since 1998.

· Teel's 65 hits on the year are second only to Jonah Cox (Oral Roberts) who has 66 in 37 games for the national lead.

THE NEW HOME RUN KING

· Jake Gelof broke UVA's all-time home run record on Tuesday against Richmond with his 38th of his career, a solo shot to left field on an 0-2 pitch.
 · Gelof came back on Wednesday and hit another home run, his fifth in the last five games to up his career total to 39. It marked the first time in his career he hit five home runs in a five-game stretch. He's looking to become the 14th active D-1 player with 40 career home runs.
 · It took Gelof 454 at bats and 129 career games to eclipse UVA's all-time mark, 39 games fewer than any Cavalier to hit 30 or more home runs in a career.
 · Gelof has homered in nine-straight ACC series dating back to last season.
 · This past weekend against Miami was the third time in his career he homered three times in a three-game series (2022 vs. Cornell & 2022 vs. Boston College)
 · Gelof leads the team with 14 home runs this season, second-most in the ACC and ninth-most in the country.
 · Only six players in UVA history have 30 career home runs and the last Cavalier to eclipse the 30-home run mark was Mark Reynolds (2002-04).

MIDSEASON ACCOLADES

· Kyle Teel and Jake Gelof were both named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List on Wednesday. Only 15 teams in the country had multiple players on the list. Gelof, a semifinalist for the award last season, was one of seven 2022 semifinalists included on this year's midseason watch list.

· Teel garnered midseason First Team All-America honors from Perfect Game and D1Baseball. Gelof was a third team All-America selection by Perfect Game at the third base position.

HOW IT STARTED

· Virginia started the season by winning its first 14 games and was the last undefeated team remaining in college baseball before dropping the series finale at North Carolina on March 12. It marked the second-straight year and fourth time in program history (2009, 2013, 2022, 2023) UVA has won its first 14 games of the season. · Through the first 26 games of the season, UVA matched the best start in program history (24-2). The stretch included road ACC series victories over ranked foes, North Carolina and NC State. The Cavaliers were also 24-2 to start the 2011 and 2013 seasons.

HISTORIC WIN STREAK

· The 14-straight wins to start the season was tied for the second-best start in program history. UVA has gone 14-0 to start the season four times (2009, 2013, 2022 & 2023). The Cavaliers 14-game win streaks to start the season in 2022 and 2003 both ended in the nightcap of a road ACC doubleheader. · Virginia has put together a win streak of 12 or more games 10 times in the 135-year history of the program, all have come under the direction of head coach Brian O'Connor (2004-present).

· Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island. · Now in his 20th season, O'Connor became the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .703 winning percentage is the second highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years). · All 800 of his wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

BEST OFFENSIVE START SINCE THE 19TH CENTURY

· The Cavaliers have scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season. · The current Hoos need 24 runs its fifth game to match the 1889 club's 89-run output in its first five contests. · The 1889 squad averaged 16.14 runs per game in a 7-0, undefeated season. It marks the only undefeated season in program history.

20-RUN GAMES

· Virginia's 26 runs against Longwood were the most in a single game since crossing the plate 27 times at Maryland on April 23, 2010. · The 24-run victory is the largest margin of defeat for a UVA team since the 27-2 win over Maryland in 2010. · The Cavaliers have scored 20 or more runs three times this season, matching a school record first established in 1889 and duplicated in 1898 and 1889. · The 20 runs against George Washington marked the 61st time in program history that UVA has scored 20 runs in a game.

· Virginia returns seven position players that started more than 20 games last year and five that started over 40 games. · The Cavaliers added 21 newcomers comprised of 13 freshman, six graduate transfers and three transfers from four-year schools. The 21 additions to the roster are the most in head coach Brian O'Connor's tenure. · The Cavaliers lost nearly 70 percent of its innings on the mound from a season ago including two of its weekend starters, both to professional baseball. 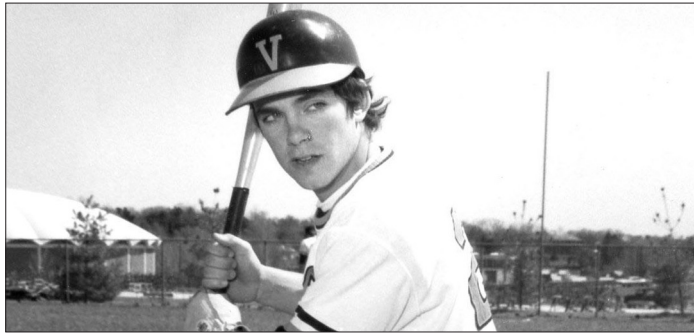
