## LEADING OFF

- Since 2009, Virginia has a 48-25 record against ACC foes coming out of exam break. The Cavaliers have won 14-straight home series after breaking for exams.
- The Cavaliers will close out an 11-game homestand this weekend, the longest of the season. UVA is 6-2 in its last eight games at home.
- Virginia enters the weekend with 38 wins, tied with LSU for the second-most in college baseball. The Cavaliers are two-wins behind consensus No. 1 Wake Forest.
- UVA is seeking its first 40-win season since 2017 and 12th under head coach Brian O'Connor.
- Virginia comes into the weekend as the national leader in hits (584) and doubles (136). The team batting average of .335 is the second highest in the country.
- UVA is the only team in the country to rank in the top-10 in BOTH batting average (2nd - .335) and ERA (9th - 3.86).

## NON-CONFERENCE DOMINANCE

- Virginia went 25-0 this season against non-conference opponents and has won 29-straight regular season games against non-conference foes dating back to last year.
- The Cavaliers finished unblemished in non-conference play for the first time in program history and are the first DI team without a non-conference loss since 2015.
- Only three NCAA teams since 2010 have finished the regular season without a non-conference loss - Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).
- Virginia is the only team in the country this season without a non-conference loss. Wake Forest, NC State and Northeastern are the next closest, all with two non-league losses.
- UVA outscored non-conference foes, 287-77 and held a team batting average of .369.
- Cavalier arms produced five shutouts in non-ACC action and pitched to a 2.48 ERA in 221 innings.

- All-time winningest coach at Virginia

- One of nine coaches in the history of the ACC to accumulate 700 wins and his .700 winning percentage is the third-highest among active NCAA coaches.
- Won 2015 NCAA National Championship (one of 7 active coaches to own a national title)
- Three-time National Coach of the Year (2006, '09, '15)
- Four-time ACBA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year (2004, '09, '11, '14, '15)
- Five-time ACC Coach of the Year (2004, '10, '11, '13, '14)
- NCAA tournament appearances in 14-straight seasons (UVA had been to three NCAA tournaments prior to his arrival)
- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals
- 2009 trip to CWS was first in school history (Irvine Regional and Oxford Super Regional champions)
- Competed in 16 NCAA regionals and seven super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won seven regionals, five super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Four 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 94 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 19 years and 29 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 34 All-America and 83 all-conference selections in his tenure

### NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia boasts a 29-4 mark at home this season and has the second most home wins in the country behind Tennessee (30).
- UVA has won 25 or more games at home 14 of the 20 seasons under head coach Brian O'Connor.
- Virginia has matched its home win total posted last season and haven't won 30 games at home since 2013.
- The Cavaliers have won 25 or more home games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2013 and 2014. UVA won 25 or more games at Disharoon Park in each of Brian O'Connor's first 11 seasons, including a school record, 35 twice first in 2011 and again 2013.
- The Cavaliers have won over 77 percent of their games (566-169) at Disharoon Park since the facility opened in 2002.
- UVA is amid an 11-game homestand, the longest stint at home this season. After returning home from Notre Dame, UVA will not leave the Commonwealth for 23 days until its final road series of the regular season against Georgia Tech (May 18-20).

### AGAINST LOUISVILLE

- Over the last eight meetings against Louisville, the two teams have each won four games. All but two of those games have been decided by three or less runs.
- Louisville has a 13-9 advantage in the all-time series that first began when the Cardinals entered the league in 2015.
- The last series win over Louisville came in 2019 at Disharoon Park when the Cavaliers took the final two games of the series by a combined score of 22-8.
- One of the most exciting games in recent memory against Louisville was a 10th-inning walk-off winner in the series opener of the 2019 series at Disharoon Park. Devin Ortiz tied the game with a home run in the ninth and Logan Michaels came around to score the winning run on a Louisville fielding error.

### ON RECORD WATCH

- Ethan Anderson is one double away from matching the school single season record of 23 held by Stephen Bruno (2012) and Dan Street (2002). Kyle Teel (21) and Jake Gelof (20) are all within striking distance entering the weekend.
- Gelof has two of the three 75+ RBI seasons in school history. He's six RBI shy of matching his own single season mark set last year and three shy of passing Pavin Smith's 2017 total of 77.
- Gelof hit his 19th home run of the season on Wednesday against Radford, moving into sole possession of third place on UVA's single season home run mark. Brian Buchanan owns the school mark of 22 set in 1994. Gelof is looking for his second-straight 20-homer season after blasting 21 last year.
- With one more run scored, Griff O'Ferrall can become the 13th player in UVA history to score 60 runs in a season.

### SEEING DOUBLE

- Virginia leads the country with 136 doubles, 10 more than any other team in the country.
- Ethan Anderson's 22 doubles are the most in the ACC and tied for the fourth most in the country.
- For the first time in program history, the Cavaliers have three players with 20 or more doubles in a year - Anderson (22), Kyle Teel (21) and Jake Gelof (20).
- UVA has five players with 15 or more doubles, all ranking in the top-eight in the ACC.

### ON THE MOUND

- A graduate transfer from Coastal Carolina, Nick Parker will make his final regular season start at Disharoon Park on Friday night. Parker has 50 collegiate starts under his belt, tied for the second-most among active NCAA pitchers.

- The righthander is coming off his best game as a Cavalier, fanning a career-high 12 batters over 6.2 innings against then-No. 20 Duke on April 29. Parker improved to 4-0 on the season and UVA is 8-2 in games which he starts.
- The 12 strikeouts were the most by a Cavalier pitcher in 2023 and the most since Brandon Neeck struck out 16 in the 2021 NCAA Columbia Regional.
- Connelly Early will make his second start of the week and 13th start of the season on Saturday. The lefthander threw 20 pitchers, faced four batters before giving way to Jack O'Connor on Wednesday against Radford.
- Early slides into the weekend rotation for the second time this season. After an injury to Parker against Florida State, Early was slotted into the middle game against Virginia Tech.
- The lefthander notched his 20th career victory in his outing against JMU last Wednesday. He is one of 16 active NCAA pitchers with 20 or more wins and his 20 wins tied for 8th most among active NCAA pitchers.
- Early tossed six shutout innings against JMU on May 3 and produced his fourth quality start, tied with Brian Edgington for the most on the staff.
- Early is looking to become the 12th UVA pitcher ever to record 10 wins in a season and the first since Connor Jones recorded 11 in 2016.
- Going into the weekend, Early trails only Rhett Lowder (10) for the ACC lead in wins. Lowder is one of four pitchers with an NCAA-best, 10 wins.
- Early ranks in the top-10 in the ACC in WHIP (5th - 1.07), strikeout-to-walk ratio (6th - 4.57), ERA (7th - 2.83) and hits allowed per nine innings (8th - 7.33).
- The Cavalier pitching staff boasts the eighth-lowest team ERA (3.86) in the country and third-lowest in the ACC.
- Of the 497 strikeouts (11th most in NCAA) recorded by Cavalier pitching, 162 have come looking, the second-most in the country.
- UVA is looking for its third-straight 500-strikeout season under pitching coach Drew Dickinson. The Cavaliers broke the school record with 687 in 2021 and struck out 598 batters last season, the third-most in program history.
- The Cavalier hurlers also boast college baseball's 6th-best strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.15) and rank 12th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.29).

### POTENT ATTACK

- The Cavaliers have scored 445 runs this season the seventh-most of any team in the nation and are averaging 9.1 runs per game, the ninth-most in the country.
- There are 30 players in D-I baseball batting over the .400 mark, two of them are in the Cavalier lineup - Kyle Teel (.416) and Griff O'Ferrall (.405). UVA is one of three schools with multiple players batting .400 (Omaha - 2, Sam Houston - 2).
- Virginia has struck out 310 times as a team this season, the fewest of any team in the ACC.
- Virginia has the fourth largest scoring/run differential in the country.

**PLAYER NOTABLES**

- Kyle Teel, who has started the last 107 games at catcher for UVA, is sixth in the country in hits (82). He leads the ACC in batting average (.416), hits and hits per game (1.67).
- Teel needs six more hits to crack the top-10 on UVA's single season hits lists. He's the 31st Cavalier to record 80 hits in a season.
- Ethan O'Donnell is hitting .475 (9-for-19) with a home run, eight runs scored and six RBI in his last five games. Against JMU he recorded his third, four-hit game of the season going 4-for-5 and added a career-high two stolen bases.
- Casey Saucke has reached base 13-straight games, the longest active streak on the team. The sophomore is batting .391 (18-for-46) in that span.
- Virginia has four of the top-8 ACC hits leaders in its lineup – Teel (1st – 82), O'Ferrall (2nd – 79), Anderson (4th – 77) and O'Donnell (8th – 71).

**GELOF CHASING RBI HISTORY**

· Already the program's single-season record holder in RBI with 81 last season, Gelof is the first Cavalier with two seasons of 70 or more RBI. Currently only Gelof and UVA Baseball Hall of Famer Phil Gosselin are the only two Cavaliers to have two seasons of 60 or more RBI.

**THE NEW HOME RUN KING**

- Jake Gelof broke UVA's all-time home run record against Richmond on April with his 38th of his career, a solo shot to left field on an 0-2 pitch.
- Gelof came back the next afternoon and hit another home run, his fifth in the last five games to up his career total to 39. It marked the first time in his career he hit five home runs in a five-game stretch.
- It took Gelof 454 at bats and 129 career games to eclipse UVA's all-time mark, 39 games fewer than any Cavalier to hit 30 or more home runs in a career.
- Only six players in UVA history have 30 career home runs and the last Cavalier to eclipse the 30-home run mark was Mark Reynolds (2002-04).

**MIDSEASON ACCOLADES**

- Kyle Teel and Jake Gelof were both named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List on Wednesday. Only 15 teams in the country had multiple players on the list. Gelof, a semifinalist for the award last season, was one of seven 2022 semifinalists included on this year's midseason watch list.
- Teel garnered midseason First Team All-America honors from Perfect Game and D1Baseball. Gelof was a third team All-America selection by

Perfect Game at the third base position.

· Reliever Jay Woolfolk was one of 56 players on the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List. He was one 18 pitchers on the preseason watch list to make the cut. UVA has produced three finalists for the award since 2010 - Blake Bales (2021), Branden Kline (2011) & Kevin Arico (2010).

**HOW IT STARTED**

- Virginia started the season by winning its first 14 games and was the last undefeated team remaining in college baseball before dropping the series finale at North Carolina on March 12. It marked the second-straight year and fourth time in program history (2009, 2013, 2022, 2023) UVA has won its first 14 games of the season.
- Through the first 26 games of the season, UVA matched the best start in program history (24-2). The stretch included road ACC series victories over ranked foes, North Carolina and NC State. The Cavaliers were also 24-2 to start the 2011 and 2013 seasons.

**HISTORIC WIN STREAK**

- The 14-straight wins to start the season was tied for the second-best start in program history. UVA has gone 14-0 to start the season four times (2009, 2013, 2022 & 2023). The Cavaliers 14-game win streaks to start the season in 2022 and 2003 both ended in the nightcap of a road ACC doubleheader.
- Virginia has put together a win streak of 12 or more games 10 times in the 135-year history of the program, all have come under the direction of head coach Brian O'Connor (2004-present).

**O'CONNOR 800**

- Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island.
- Now in his 20th season, O'Connor became the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .703 winning percentage is the second highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All 800 of his wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

On the front the UVA's jerseys, opposite of the Nike logo, is a black patch with "DISH" imprinted on it. The patch is to commemorate Leslie B. Disharoon, longtime supporter of the Virginia baseball program, who passed away on April 18 at the age of 90. Disharoon Park, Virginia's home stadium, is named in honor of Leslie and his late wife, Ann Merriweather Disharoon.

Disharoon is often referred to as the godfather of Virginia baseball and was an advocate for the program after retiring to Charlottesville in the late 1990s. Disharoon was not a UVA graduate. He earned a bachelor's degree from Brown and an MBA from Columbia. His affinity for academics and athletics led him to serving on boards at Johns Hopkins, Goucher College, Garrison Forest School, Randolph-Macon Woman's College and Virginia.

Prior to his arrival in Charlottesville, Disharoon served on the board of directors for the Baltimore Orioles for 20 years and was integral in securing approval for the creation of Oriole Park at Camden Yards. He is also one of the founders Caves Valley Golf Club, designed by Tom Fazio and one of the most prestigious golf courses in the United States and home to a number of professional tournaments including 2021 BMW championship and the 2005 NCAA Men's Golf Championships and 2009 NCAA Women's Golf Championships.

### BEST OFFENSIVE START SINCE THE 19TH CENTURY

- The Cavaliers have scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- The current Hoos need 24 runs in its fifth game to match the 1889 club's 89-run output in its first five contests.
- The 1889 squad averaged 16.14 runs per game in a 7-0, undefeated season. It marks the only undefeated season in program history.

### 20-RUN GAMES

- Virginia's 26 runs against Longwood were the most in a single game since crossing the plate 27 times at Maryland on April 23, 2010.
- The 24-run victory is the largest margin of defeat for a UVA team since the 27-2 win over Maryland in 2010.
- The Cavaliers have scored 20 or more runs three times this season, matching a school record first established in 1889 and duplicated in 1898 and 1889.
- The 20 runs against George Washington marked the 61st time in program history that UVA has scored 20 runs in a game.

### ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- Virginia returns seven position players that started more than 20 games last year and five that started over 40 games.
- The Cavaliers added 21 newcomers comprised of 13 freshman, six graduate transfers and three transfers from four-year schools. The 21 additions to the roster are the most in head coach Brian O'Connor's tenure.
- The Cavaliers lost nearly 70 percent of its innings on the mound from a season ago including two of its weekend starters, both to professional baseball. Only two pitchers that started a game last season remain on the 2023 roster (Jake Berry, Matthew Buchanan).
- Virginia bolstered its pitching depth with accomplished transfers Nick Parker (219.0 career innings), Brian Edgington (190.2 career innings), Connelly Early (122.0 career innings), Angelo Tonas (115.1 career innings) and Chase Hungate (63.0 career innings). The five pitchers account for 710.0 career innings pitched in college baseball, nearly 200 more innings than the whole UVA staff threw last season.
- D1Baseball rated Virginia's transfer class No. 18 in the country. Three Cavaliers ranked in the D1Baseball's top-100 transfers list – No. 15 Ethan O'Donnell (Northwestern), No. 32 Connelly Early (Army), and No. 94 Brian Edgington (Elon).

### PRESEASON RECOGNITION

- Juniors Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel were each listed on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, annually giving to the country's top amateur baseball player by USA baseball.
- Gelof has earned preseason First Team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, NCBWA and Perfect Game and Second Team honors from D1Baseball.
- Teel was Baseball America's First Team preseason All-American at catcher and he also garnered third team accolades from D1Baseball.
- Righthanded pitcher Jay Woolfolk was included on the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Watch list after garnering Freshman All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and D1Baseball.
- D1 Baseball ranked the top players in the country at each position prior to the season.

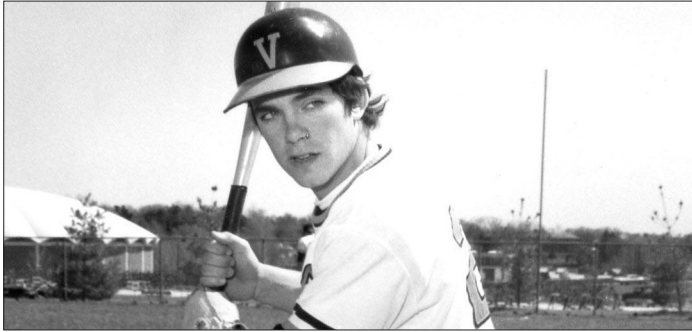
