LEADING OFF

- Wednesday will mark the first of three meetings against ODU in 2024. The Cavaliers will host the Monarchs again on April 2nd and play at Harbor Park in Norfolk on April 16. It would mark the first time ever the two schools have played three times in one season.
- Dating back to the 2022 season, Virginia has won its last 32 games against non-conference opponents in the regular season. UVA went 25-0 against non-ACC foes in the regular season in 2023 and won its last four non-conference games in the 2022 regular season.
- The Cavaliers have won 19-straight games in the month of February going back to 2022.
- ODU was the last non-ACC team to win at Disharoon Park on April 12, 2022. Since then, the Cavaliers have rattled off 23-straight home wins against non-conference foes in the regular season.
- Virginia is one of 56 teams in the country to come out of opening weekend without a loss. Of the 14 teams in the ACC, 10 did not suffer a defeat.
- The Cavaliers scored 42 runs in three games against Hofstra over the weekend. The 42 runs are the most in the first three games of season in the Brian O'Connor era (2004-present) and the most by a UVA team since 1911.
- Virginia is averaging 14.0 runs per game, the 13th highest in the country and the third-best in the ACC.

AGAINST ODU

- Separated by 163 miles, Virginia and ODU will square off for the 70th time in an all-time series that was first played in 1965.
- Virginia has won seven of the last eight meetings, including both games of the 2021 Columbia Regional.
- Under Brian O'Connor, UVA has won 12 of 20 matchups.
- Last year's meeting with ODU was the second matchup of the 2023 season that featured two 20-win teams. Thanks to a seven-run second inning, UVA came away with an 8-1 victory and tied the best start in program history through 25 games (23-2).

ON THE MOUND

- Righthander Cullen McKay will get the start on Wednesday, his fourth of his career. He tossed one scoreless inning in game two against Hofstra.
- He amassed 26 strikeouts in 16.2 innings pitched last season as a true freshman.
- In his three combined starts in 2023, he totaled seven innings, allowed two earned runs and struck out eight batters.

- Won 2015 NCAA National Championship (one of 8 active coaches to own a national title)
- Three-time National Coach of the Year (2006, '09, '15)
- Four-time ACBA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year (2004, '09, '11, '14, '15)
- Five-time ACC Coach of the Year (2004, '10, '11, '13, '14)
- NCAA tournament appearances in 14-straight seasons (UVA had been to three NCAA tournaments prior to his arrival)
- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021, 2023 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals
- 2009 trip to CWS was first in school history (Irvine Regional and Oxford Super Regional champions)
- Competed in 17 NCAA regionals and eight super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won eight regionals, six super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Five 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014, 50 in 2023)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 97 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 20 years and 31 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 38 All-America and 89 all-conference selections in his tenure

NATIONAL NOTABLES

- Virginia led the country in doubles last season and compiled 13 in three games against Hofstra, including seven in the finale on Sunday. The 13 doubles are the seventh-most in the country and the most of any ACC team.
- Reliever Aidan Teel saved both the series opener and series finale against Hofstra. He tied for second in the country in saves and one of seven players with multiple saves after opening weekend.

HOOS HOT

- Freshman Henry Ford made a big splash in first weekend of college baseball. He put forth multi-hit efforts in each of his first three games, blasted two homers and drove in six runs. His three-run homer in the bottom of the sixth of the series finale proved to be the difference in the game.
- Ford is one of 11 freshmen nationally to hit multiple home runs this season in his first three games.
- Leadoff man Griff O'Ferrall started his 2024 season off with a bang, homering on the fifth pitch of the season. His only other home run prior to that point was a lead-off long ball against Duke in game two of the 2023 Super Regional.
- O'Ferrall homered for the second-straight game with a big fly in the third inning of Saturday's series clincher against Hofstra, doubling his career home run total in the first two games of the 2024 season.
- Luke Hanson scored five times in game two, matching a single-game UVA record. He reached base five times - two walks, two hit by pitches and his first career home run in the third inning.
- Graduate transfer Bobby Whalen put forth a career effort in his first Cavalier start on Saturday by going 4-for-4 with two doubles, six RBI and a run scored. It was the fourth four-hit game of his career and the six RBI established a new career-high.

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

- Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCWBA.
- The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.
- Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

- UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.
- The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-lead the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.
- Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Virginia will begin its 23rd season playing at the 5,919-seat stadium. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (577-170) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.
- The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.
- The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.

- Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.
- The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

O'CONNOR 800

- Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island on March 4, 2013.
- Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .704 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.


