· As a team UVA has accumulated 16 doubles in four games, ranked sixth in DI college baseball. The Cavaliers broke the program's single-season record and led the nation with 172 doubles in 2023.

· The Cavaliers are averaging 12.5 runs per game, only behind North Carolina (13.5) for tops in the ACC. Sophomore Henry Godbout is the ACC leader with four two-baggers, also good for the 10th-most in the NCAA.

· As a team, UVA is slugging .662 with eight home runs and 16 doubles. Only seven teams in the country have a higher slugging percentage going into weekend action.

RETURN TO JACKSONVILLE

· Virginia will play in Jacksonville for the first time since the 2008 season. The ACC Tournament was played at 121 Financial Field from 2005-2008.

· Of the four ACC Tournaments in Jacksonville, the Cavaliers were ACC runner-up twice – 2005 and 2008.

· The Cavaliers went 8-6 in 14 total ACC Tournament games played in Jacksonville.

· Cavalier pitchers Bradley Hodges (St. John's Country Day) and Patric Menk (The Bolles School) each played high school baseball in the Jacksonville area. Including Menk and Hodges, UVA has five student-athletes on the roster from the state of Florida.

ON THE MOUND

· **Evan Blanco** will get the start for the Cavaliers on Friday against Wichita State, his second career start. Last weekend against Hofstra, Blanco pitched the first three innings of a 21-3 win over Hofstra. He did not allow an earned run and struck out three batters in the contest.

· Righthander **Jack O'Connor** slides into the Saturday role to face No. 18 Iowa after serving as UVA's opening day starter last weekend. O'Connor threw 69 pitches over four innings and struck out three batters in an eventual no-decision.

· Both Blanco and O'Connor saw significant time as true freshmen on UVA's college world series team. O'Connor was a weekend starter for the majority of the year before transitioning to the bullpen for UVA's stretch run. Blanco made 24 appearances out of the bullpen, tied for second-most on the staff last season.

HOOS HOT

· Leadoff man **Griff O'Ferrall** comes into the weekend riding a 12-game hit streak that includes his last eight games of 2023. He has put together four, multi-hit efforts in four games this season.

· **Harrison Didawick** has three home runs in four games, including a solo shot against ODU in the midweek. Last year as a true freshman he powered four out of the yard in 159 at bats. The four long balls this season are tied for the ACC lead and tied for the seventh most in the country.

· O'Ferrall has already eclipsed his career home run total in four games, with a pair of home runs on opening weekend. He started the 2024 season off with a bang, homering on UVA's fifth pitch of the season. His only other home run prior to that point was a lead-off long ball against Duke in game two of the 2023 Super Regional.

· Freshman **Henry Ford** made a big splash in first weekend of college baseball. He put forth multi-hit efforts in each of his first three games, blasted two homers and drove in six runs. His three-run homer in the bottom of the sixth of the series finale proved to be the difference in the game..

· **Luke Hanson** scored five times in game two, matching a single-game UVA record. He reached base five times – two walks, two hit by pitches and his first career home run in the third inning.

· Graduate transfer **Bobby Whalen** put forth a career effort in his first Cavalier start on Saturday by going 4-for-4 with two doubles, six RBI and a run scored. It was the fourth four-hit game of his career and the six RBI established a new career-high.

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

· Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.

· The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.

· Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

· UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.

· The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.

· Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

· Virginia will begin its 23rd season playing at the 5,919-seat stadium. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (577-170) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.

· The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.

· The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.

· Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.

· The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

· Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.

· Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.

· Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).

· UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).

· UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.

· Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.

· The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.

· The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.

· Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.

· UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.

· Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

O'CONNOR 800

· Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island on March 4, 2013.

· Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .704 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).

· All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

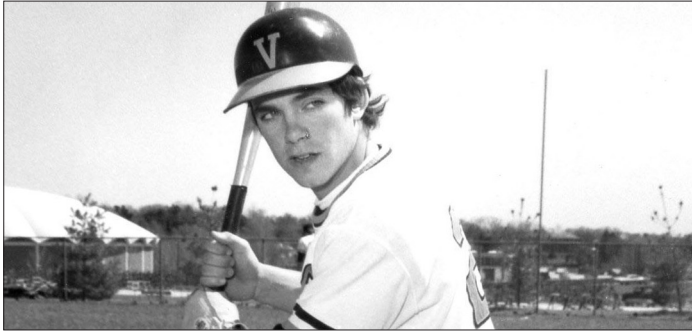
