## LEADING OFF

- The Cavaliers are off to a 7-0 start for the third-straight season. UVA has won 23-straight games in the month of February.
- Virginia is one of 15 unbeaten teams in college baseball. Only three ACC teams have yet to suffer a loss - Florida State (7-0), Duke (8-0) and Virginia (7-0).
- Under head coach Brian O'Connor, UVA has started 7-0, eight times (2008, 2009, 2013, 2015, 2017, 2022, 2023, 2024).
- Virginia enters the contest with a 36-game win streak against non-conference opponents in the regular season. The Cavaliers have won 24-straight non-conference regular season home games.
- Virginia has won six-straight home games including the final two games of the 2023 Charlottesville Super Regional against Duke.
- UVA has faced a deficit in six of its seven wins the season, the largest coming against then-No. 18 Iowa after it trailed 6-0 in the first inning.
- Four of UVA's seven wins have been decided by one or two runs. The Cavaliers were 7-8 in games decided by one or two runs last season, including two one-run losses in the College World Series.

## UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

- Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.
- Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.
- The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

## NATIONAL ATTENTION

- Virginia moved up one spot in the D1Baseball.com Top-25 poll to No. 13. UVA is one of six ACC teams ranked in the top-20.
- The Cavaliers landed inside the top-10 in the Baseball America (No. 8), NCBWA (No. 10), Perfect Game (No. 9) and USA Today/Coaches (No. 9) national polls.

- Has won eight regionals, six super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)

· UVA led the country and broke the program's single-season record for doubles with 172. Through seven games, UVA has 24 doubles, the second-most in the ACC and the 10th-most in the country through Tuesday's action.

· Virginia is batting .350 as a team, ranked 15th in the NCAA and fourth in the ACC. The Cavaliers are 11 hits shy of 100 for the season and have recorded 10 or more hits in each of the last six games.

### CAVALIERS VS. KEYDETS

· Wednesday will be the 143rd meeting between VMI and Virginia in an all-time series that first began in 1889. The Cavaliers own a 110-32 advantage in the all-time series including a 17-5 mark under head coach Brian O'Connor.

· Virginia has won six-straight meetings against VMI, including a 3-0 shutout on Feb. 28 last year. Five pitchers, including 2024 returners Angelo Tonas and Jay Woolfolk, combined for the shutout and Kyle Teel drove in all three runs for UVA.

· UVA is 155-26 (.856) against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia at Disharoon Park. The Cavaliers have won 11-straight games against in-state foes at The Dish.

· UVA pitcher Matthew Buchanan's brother Seth is a freshman infielder for the Keydets. They were teammates on Lebanon High School's 2021 state championship team.

### ON THE MOUND

· Righthander Cullen McKay will make his second-straight mid-week start and Wednesday will mark his fifth career start.

· Last weekend he headlined UVA's 8-0 shutout victory over ODU, logging a career-high 4.1 innings. The righthander retired the first eight batters he faced and fanned five, one shy of matching a career-best.

· In McKay's four career stats, the UVA offense has outscored its opponents 41-9.

· Over the course of three games in Jacksonville, the Virginia bullpen yielded only three earned runs in 17 innings pitched (1.59 ERA). The eight arms that came out of the bullpen combined for 18 strikeouts.

### PLAYER NOTABLES

· **Henry Godbout** led the team with seven hits and batted .583 (7-for-12) with two doubles in three games in Jacksonville. He reached base in nine of his 15 plate appearances. Godbout's six doubles are the most in the ACC and tied for the eighth most in the country.

· Godbout has yet to strikeout in 23 at bats this season. He is one of 18 players in the country with 20 or more plate appearances that hasn't struck out.

· **Anthony Stephan** found his way on base 10 times in three games in Jacksonville. He drew six walks in three games and drew a bases loaded free pass against then-No. 18 Iowa in the ninth inning that gave UVA a 10-9 lead. It was one of four walks in the he earned in the contest.

· **Henry Ford** has put forth a multi-hit effort in five of his first seven collegiate games. No hit was more important than his walk-off double in the 10th inning against Wichita State on Friday. He then provided insurance in the ninth inning against then-No. 18 Iowa with a two-out, two RBI single giving UVA a 12-9 advantage, the eventual final score.

· Graduate transfer **Bobby Whalen** has reached base in the last six games. He is batting .579 (11-for-19) on the year, the second-highest in the ACC and eighth-best in all of DI baseball. Whalen led off the game-winning rally in the bottom of the 10th with a walk on Friday against Wichita State and recorded an infield single in the ninth inning to move the go-ahead run on third base in Saturday's 12-9 win over then-No. 18 Iowa.

### PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

· Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers' preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.

· The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.

· Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

### ROSTER MAKEUP

· UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.

· The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.

· Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

### HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

· Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (578-170) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.

· The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.

· The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.

· Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.

· The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

### 2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

· Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.

· Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.

· Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).

· UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).

· UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.

· Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.

· The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.

· The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.

· Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.

· UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.

· Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

### O'CONNOR 800

· Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island on March 4, 2013.

· Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).

· All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

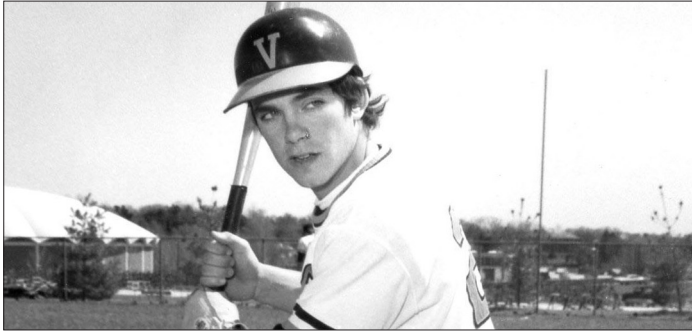
