## LEADING OFF

- The Cavaliers are off to an 8-0 start for the third-straight season. After winning all eight games to start the year, UVA extended its February win streak that dates back to 2021 to 24 games.
- Virginia is one of 13 unbeaten teams in college baseball. Last year, Virginia was the last unbeaten team standing when it started the season 14-0.
- Only three ACC teams have yet to suffer a loss - Florida State (6-0), Duke (7-0) and Virginia (7-0).
- Under head coach Brian O'Connor, UVA has started 8-0, eight times (2008, 2009, 2013, 2015, 2017, 2022, 2023, 2024).
- Virginia enters the contest with a 37-game win streak against non-conference opponents in the regular season. The Cavaliers have won 25-straight non-conference regular season home games.
- Virginia has won seven-straight home games including the final two games of the 2023 Charlottesville Super Regional against Duke.
- The Cavaliers eclipsed the 100-hit mark for the season and have 108 in just eight games, the seventh most in all of college baseball. Virginia has double-digit hit efforts in every game but one this season, the season opener against Hofstra.
- UVA has faced a deficit in six of its eight wins the season, the largest coming against then-No. 18 Iowa after it trailed 6-0 in the first inning.
- Four of UVA's eight wins have been decided by one or two runs. The Cavaliers were 7-8 in games decided by one or two runs last season, including two one-run losses in the College World Series.

## MIDWEEK MASHING

- Virginia collected a season-high 19 hits in 16-4 win over VMI on Wednesday at Disharoon Park. A total of 12 different Cavaliers were responsible for the 19 hits.
- Graduate transfer Jacob Ference went 5-for-6 with five RBI and matched a school single-game record with three doubles. Including Ference, 33 Cavaliers have accumulated three doubles in a game, the most recent being Ethan Anderson against VCU last season.

- Competed in 17 NCAA regionals and eight super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won eight regionals, six super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Five 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014, 50 in 2023)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)

- Starting pitcher Cullen McKay recorded his first career victory after six innings of one-run baseball. It marked the longest outing by a UVA starting pitcher this season and the first quality start by a Cavalier. He retired the first 11 batters he faced and matched a career-high with six strikeouts.
- The Cavaliers scored the first nine runs of the game and scored five runs in the fourth inning, the fifth time UVA has scored five or more runs in a single inning.

### ON THE MOUND

- Lefthander Evan Blanco will start the weekend opener for the second week in a row. He pitched a career-high 4.1, innings and matched a career best with five strikeouts in a no-decision over Wichita State at the Jax College Baseball Classic.
- Jack O'Connor will look to bounce back from a career-high eight earned runs against then-No. 18 Iowa last weekend. Six of the eight runs came across in the first inning and but still managed to pitch into the fourth inning.
- In the last five games, the Virginia bullpen yielded only five earned runs in 20 innings pitched (1.59 ERA).
- A big part in UVA's comeback win over Iowa last weekend was the relief performance from Jay Woolfolk who logged a career-high 4.1 scoreless innings and struck out five batters in a no-decision.
- Aidan Teel, who bookended the weekend in Jacksonville with saves, has three on the season, tied for the second-most in the country. Going into this weekend's action, only seven pitchers have three or more saves.

### AGAINST UMass

- UVA and UMass have only played one other time, a 7-4 Cavalier victory on March 24, 1971 in Charlottesville.
- UMass is one of five A10 opponents (George Mason, George Washington, Richmond and VCU) on the Virginia schedule in 2024.
- Minutemen graduate transfer Jacob Terwilliger and UVA sophomore Ryan Osinski played together at Bucknell last season.
- The lone Massachusetts native on the UVA roster, Evan Blanco, will make the start on the mound on Friday. His hometown of Woburn is outside of Boston and roughly 90 miles from the campus of UMass in Amherst.

### NATIONAL ATTENTION

- UVA led the country and broke the program's single-season record for doubles with 172. Through seven games, UVA has 31 doubles, the most in the ACC and third-most in the country.
- Virginia is batting .365 as a team, the second-highest average in the ACC and eighth-best in the nation. The Cavaliers also rank in the top-15 (7th) in hits with 108, on-base percentage (15th - .472) and runs with 89 (15th).
- Virginia moved up one spot in the D1Baseball.com Top-25 poll to No. 13. UVA is one of six ACC teams ranked in the top-20.
- The Cavaliers landed inside the top-10 in the Baseball America (No. 8), NCBWA (No. 10), Perfect Game (No. 9) and USA Today/Coaches (No. 9) national polls.

### PLAYER NOTABLES

- Graduate transfer **Bobby Whalen** ranks second in the ACC and 10th in the NCAA with a .571 (12-for-21) batting average. Whalen has a seven-game hit streak coming into the contest despite getting only one at bat as a pinch hitter in three of those games.
- **Henry Godbout** also has hit safely in seven-straight games and has yet to strikeout. Of all the hitters in the NCAA with at least 20 at bats in the young season only 13 have yet to go down on strikes, including Godbout who has recorded 24 at bats this year.

- Godbout leads the ACC with six doubles, which is tied for the eighth most in the country.
- Second year **Harrison Didawick** put together his first four-hit game of his college career after a 4-for-5, 4 RBI effort against VMI on Wednesday. Didawick ranks in the top-15 in the ACC in hits (11th), runs (8th) RBI (15th) and total bases (11th)
- Junior **Casey Saucke** has reached base safely in 16-straight games dating back to last season. He ended the 2023 post-season with an eight-game reached base streak and all eight this season. His six-game hit streak was snapped on Wednesday against VMI.
- First year **Henry Ford** leads the team and ranks eight in the ACC with 14 hits in his first eight college games. Ford's biggest hit came in the 10th inning against Wichita State last Friday, a walk-off double in the 10th inning to secure a 5-4 victory.

### UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

- Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.
- Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.
- The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

### PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

- Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.
- The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.
- Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

### ROSTER MAKEUP

- UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.
- The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.
- Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

### HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (579-170) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.
- The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.
- The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.
- Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.

·The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

### 2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

### O'CONNOR 800

- Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island on March 4, 2013.
- Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

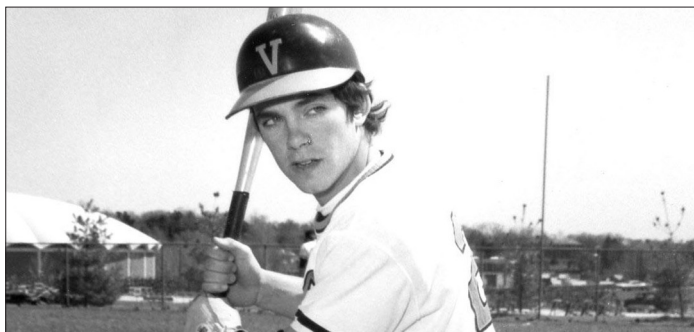
