LEADING OFF

- Virginia comes into the weekend with 12 wins, the most of any team in the ACC. The 12 wins are tied for the sixth-most in the country and UVA is one of 10 teams nationally with 12 or more wins.
- Virginia has recorded 12 or 13 wins in its first 13 games nine times in 21 seasons under head coach Brian O'Connor. The Cavaliers went 13-0 in 2021 and 13-0 in 2022.
- O'Connor won his 850th game on Tuesday with a 6-3 win over Penn State and now sits at 851 wins after Wednesday's victory over George Washington. He is one of eight coaches in ACC history with 850 wins as a member of the league.
- Virginia enters ACC play as the No. 4 hitting team in the country with a team batting average of .363. Its 172 hits are second to only Nicholls (181) for the most in Division I baseball.
- The Cavaliers are averaging 10.8 runs per game, the ninth most in the nation.
- UVA has faced a deficit in eight of the 13 games this season and have recorded two walk-off victories. The largest come-from-behind win came against then-No. 18 Iowa on Feb. 24 in Jacksonville, Fla. where UVA trailed by six runs.
- Virginia is 5-0 this season in games decided by one or two runs. The Cavalier had seven one or two-run victories in all of 2023.

VISITING THE HURRICANES

- With the exception of the shortened 2020 season, Virginia and Miami have squared off every year since 2003. The Hurricanes currently hold a 37-32 edge in the all-time series that began in 1985.
- Virginia swept the Hurricanes last season in Charlottesville, the first series win against Miami since 2017.
- UVA has dropped six-straight games against Miami at Alex Rodriguez Park and have not taken a road series against the Hurricanes since 2016. Virginia won four-straight road series against Miami from 2010-16.

- Three-time National Coach of the Year (2006, '09, '15)
- Four-time ACBA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year (2004, '09, '11, '14, '15)

- NCAA tournament appearances in 14-straight seasons (UVA had been to three NCAA tournaments prior to his arrival)
- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021, 2023 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals
- 2009 trip to CWS was first in school history (Irvine Regional and Oxford Super Regional champions)
- Competed in 17 NCAA regionals and eight super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won eight regionals, six super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Five 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014, 50 in 2023)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 97 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 20 years and 31 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 38 All-America and 89 all-conference selections in his tenure

ON THE MOUND

- Second year Cullen McKay slides into the weekend rotation and will get the start on Friday night against the Hurricanes. In two midweek starts, he's allowed one run over 10.1 innings and fanned 11 batters. He was credited with his first career victory on Feb. 28 against VMI when he delivered UVA's first quality start of the season (6.0 IP, 1 ER).
- McKay has five career starts in his first two collegiate seasons. He has allowed just three earned runs in 17.1 innings pitched as a starter (1.56 ERA).
- Evan Blanco will get the nod for the middle game, making his third-straight weekend start. Blanco has walked three batters in 13 innings and ranks in the top-10 in the ACC in WHIP (0.92 - 8th) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.33 - 9th).
- Last weekend against UMass, Blanco struck out a career-high eight batters, the most by a UVA pitcher this season and the most by a Cavalier since Brian Edgington's 11-strikeout performance against Duke in the 2023 NCAA Super Regional. Blanco retired the first 10 batters of the game including five of the first six by way of the strikeout.
- Jay Woolfolk is slated to make his second-consecutive Sunday start. The righthander put together his best outing in a Cavalier uniform last week against UMass. He pitched a career-high six innings, allowed one run and matched a career-best with five strikeouts.

D.C. POWER SURGE

- In UVA's first true road contest on Wednesday, Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.
- Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra - 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.
- As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- Virginia ranks in the top-10 in the country in six different offensive categories - hits (172 - 2nd), batting average (.363 - 4th), doubles (40 - 4th), on-base percentage (.469 - 6th), runs (140 - 7th) and scoring (10.8 rpg - 9th).
- The Cavaliers lead the ACC runs, hits and doubles.
- Sophomore **Henry Godbout** has seven doubles this season, tied for the most in the ACC and tied for 12th in the nation. Godbout has not struck out in 39 at bats this season, one of four players with 30 or more at bats yet to go down on strikes.

PLAYER NOTABLES

- **Ethan Anderson, Henry Godbout, Anthony Stephan and Casey Saucke** have successfully reached base in all 13 games this season.
- Saucke reached in his last eight games last season, all NCAA postseason contests. He has now reached in 21-straight including the 13 games this year.
- After going hitless in the opener Godbout, carries the team's longest hitting streak at 12 games. He also leads the team with a .487 batting average, the fourth highest in the ACC.
- **Harrison Didawick** has homered in back-to-back games and co-leads the team with five. It's the second time this season he's homered in consecutive games after he began the season with three homers in his first four games.
- **Henry Ford** became the first Cavalier freshman since Joe McCarthy in 2013 to hit multiple homers in a game when he homered in back-to-back innings against George Washington. Since 2002, Ford, McCarthy and former big-leaguer Mark Reynolds are the only Cavalier freshmen with multi-homer games.
- Freshman **Eric Becker** collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five

hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years. His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinero and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

MONDAY POLLING

- Virginia remained No. 13 in the D1Baseball.com Top-25 poll after a 3-1 week. Virginian spent the pre-season and first week at No. 14.
- The Cavaliers are ranked as high as No. 8 according to Baseball America, the same spot they occupied last week. The Cavalier slid back one spot in the Perfect Game and NCBWA polls to No. 10 and No. 11, respectively. UVA dropped three spots to No. 12 in the USA/Today Coaches Poll

UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

- Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.
- Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.
- The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

- Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.
- The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelfo and Kyle Teel.
- Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

- UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.
- The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.
- Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (581-170) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.
- The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.
- The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.
- Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.
- The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

O'CONNOR 800

- Brian O'Connor reached his 800th career win with a 12-6 win over Rhode Island on March 4, 2013.
- Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 800 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

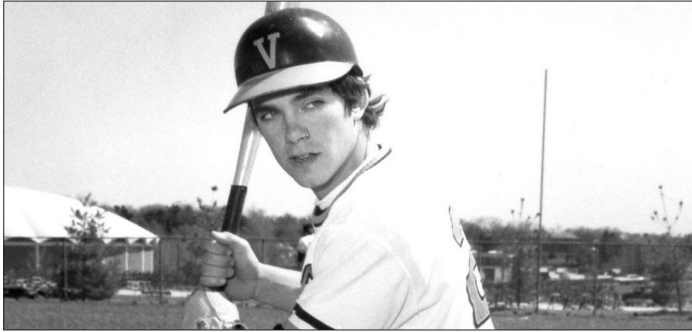
