## LEADING OFF

- Virginia is one of seven ACC schools with 13 wins this season. Only Florida State and North Carolina enter the midweek with more wins (14). UVA is one of 23 teams in the country with 13 or more wins.
- Through its first 16 games, Virginia is the national leader with 217 hits and ranks fourth in college baseball in team batting average (.363). Last year, the Cavaliers co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766).
- UVA has scored 57 runs in its last four games, the most in a four-game span since the first four games of last season in which the Cavaliers plated 65 runs.
- Virginia is 8-1 at home this season and 45-6 in the last 51 games at Disharoon Park.
- William & Mary is the third Commonwealth of Virginia opponent this season. The Cavaliers have won 11-straight games at Disharoon Park against Commonwealth Schools.

## AGAINST WILLIAM & MARY

- Virginia owns an 81-31-2 all-time mark against William & Mary in a series that was first played in 1902, a 27-1 Cavalier victory.
- The Cavaliers and Tribe have met every year since 2007 and UVA has won 17 of the last 19 meetings.
- Under head coach Brian O'Connor UVA is 20-3 against the Tribe.
- After William & Mary briefly grabbed the lead in the top of the first, Virginia plated three in the bottom half and never looked back in a 7-3 win in Charlottesville last season.

## ON THE MOUND

- First year Freddy Beruvides Jr. will get the start on the mound for UVA, the first of his collegiate career. He is the fourth UVA pitcher to make his first collegiate start this year (Evan Blanco, Jay Woolfolk, Matt Augustin).
- Beruvides has one other appearance under his belt, working 0.2 innings at George Washington last Tuesday. The lefthander faced three batters, allowed one hit and struck out one.

- Won 2015 NCAA National Championship (one of 8 active coaches to own a national title)
- Three-time National Coach of the Year (2006, '09, '15)
- Four-time ACBA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year (2004, '09, '11, '14, '15)
- Five-time ACC Coach of the Year (2004, '10, '11, '13, '14)
- NCAA tournament appearances in 14-straight seasons (UVA had been to three NCAA tournaments prior to his arrival)
- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021, 2023 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals
- 2009 trip to CWS was first in school history (Irvine Regional and Oxford Super Regional champions)
- Competed in 17 NCAA regionals and eight super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won eight regionals, six super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Five 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014, 50 in 2023)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 97 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 20 years and 31 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 38 All-America and 89 all-conference selections in his tenure

### COMEBACK CAVS

- UVA has faced a deficit in 11 of the 16 games this season and have recorded two walk-off victories.
- The Cavaliers trailed Miami, 11-10 in the series finale on Sunday and scored four runs in its final two at bats to win. Virginia has three wins when trailing after the seventh this season, the most since 2019 when it had four in 54 games.
- Prior to UVA's 5-4, 10-inning walk-off win against Wichita State on Feb. 23, the Cavaliers had lost 39-straight games when trailing after seven.
- Of the Cavaliers eight come-from-behind victories, the largest came against then-No. 18 Iowa on Feb. 24 in Jacksonville, Fla. where UVA trailed by six runs.
- Virginia is 5-1 this season in games decided by one or two runs. The Cavalier had seven one or two-run victories in all of 2023.

### SERIES SALVAGE

- The Cavaliers led by at least four runs in all three-games at Miami over the weekend. The Hurricanes overcame a 4-run advantage in the opener on Friday and did the unthinkable, erasing a nine-run deficit in the middle game.
- Virginia used their own comeback magic on Sunday, tying the game in the eighth on a Casey Saucke solo homer and plated three runs in the top of the ninth to open up a three-run advantage. The Cavaliers escaped bases loaded jams in the eighth and ninth innings to preserve the 14-11 victory.
- The 31 runs in the series were tied for the most every by the Cavaliers against the Hurricanes. The two teams combined for 64 runs and 83 hits over the weekend. The 64 combined runs were the most 22 all-time, three-game series between the two schools.

### OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- Virginia ranks in the top-10 in the country in six different offensive categories - hits (217 - 1st), batting average (.363 - 4th), doubles (48 - 3rd), runs (171 - 9th), slugging percentage (.593 - 10th) and scoring (10.7 rpg - 10th).
- The Cavaliers lead the ACC runs, hits and doubles.
- Harrison Didawick and Henry Ford have combined for 14 home runs this season. Didawick, who has hit five homers in his last five games, tied for the second-most in the ACC with eight on the season.

### PLAYER NOTABLES

- Didawick hit a home run in four-straight games last week, including his first career multi-homer effort on Saturday night in Miami. The only game he did not homer, he came through with a two-out, two-run double in the top of the ninth inning to give UVA a three-run cushion in the series finale.
- Didawick reached base 15 times in five games and was responsible for 23 Cavalier runs (11 scored and 12 RBI). He has doubled his home run output from last season in just 16 games and finished the week as the ACC's leading run scorer and is tied for second in home runs.
- Griff O'Ferrall is expected to make his 140th-straight start, which accounts for every game since the beginning of the 2021 season. He's played all 139 of his games at shortstop and batted leadoff in 138 of them.
- Casey Saucke has enjoyed hitting against the Hurricanes the past two years. He had a multi-homer affair in last year's series sweep of Miami in Charlottesville and belted two opposite field shots out of Alex Rodriguez Park one Sunday, the only two multi-homer games of his career. Saucke went 4-for-5 with two dingers, two singles, three RBI and three runs scored in the finale on Sunday.
- Saucke has reached safely in 24-straight games dating back to UVA's postseason run. He reached in all eight NCAA postseason games last year and the first 16 of the 2024 season.
- Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Ethan Anderson have reached base safely in all 16 games this season.

- Anderson was 9-for-22 (.409) with three doubles and three runs scored in five games last week. He recorded his first three-hit game of the season in the finale against Miami.
- Henry Ford has had a knack for coming up in the clutch this season. His two-out RBI infield single gave UVA a 12-11 advantage in the bottom of the ninth of game three. He currently leads the team with nine multi-hit games.

### D.C. POWER SURGE

- Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington on March 6, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.
- Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra - 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.
- As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years.
- Freshman Eric Becker collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years. His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinero and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

### O'CONNOR 850

- Brian O'Connor reached his 850th Career win on March 5, a 6-3 victory over Penn State at Disharoon Park
- Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 850 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

## UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

•Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.

•Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.

•The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

## PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

•Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.

•The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.

•Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

## ROSTER MAKEUP

•UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.

•The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.

•Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

## HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

•Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (581-170) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.

•The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.

•The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.

•Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.

•The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

## 2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

•Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.

•Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time

since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.

- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

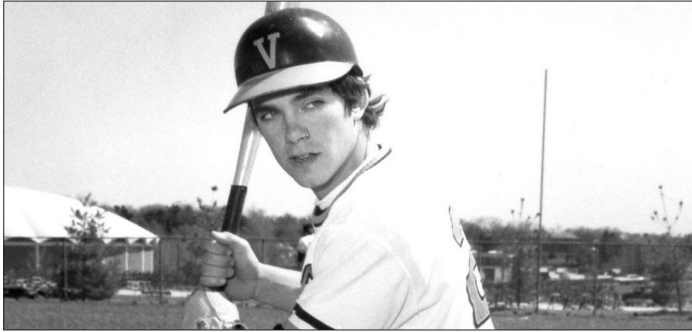
