LEADING OFF

- Virginia is one of five ACC schools with 14 wins this season. Only Clemson (15), Florida State (15) and North Carolina (16) enter the weekend with more wins. UVA is one of 19 teams in the country with 14 or more wins.
- This weekend pits the 2023 ACC Atlantic Division champion (Wake Forest) and the 2023 ACC Coastal Division Champion (Virginia) against one another. The two teams did not square off last year. Both teams were picked to repeat as division champions in the 2024 ACC Preseason Coaches poll.
- Both Virginia and Wake Forest represented the ACC in the College World Series last season. UVA is one of four schools nationally to go to Omaha twice in the last three seasons - Stanford (3), Tennessee (2), Texas (2) & Virginia (2).
- The Cavaliers will entertain a ranked foe at Disharoon Park in the regular season for only the second time in the last two seasons. At No. 7, Wake Forest is the highest ranked team to come to Charlottesville since 2022 (No. 7 Virginia Tech).
- Virginia enters the weekend with the second-most hits of any team in the country. Wake Forest is allowing 6.75 hits per nine innings, the second fewest in the ACC and the ninth-fewest in the country.
- UVA is 9-1 at home this season and 46-6 in the last 52 games at Disharoon Park.

AGAINST WAKE FOREST

- Under head coach Brian O'Connor, UVA is 27-15 against Wake Forest and own an overall mark at home of 41-27.
- The last time the Demon Deacons were in Charlottesville, UVA completed a three-game sweep that included a 18-0, combined no-hitter on Friday and a pair of walk-off Cavalier victories in the final ACC series of the year.
- Wake Forest's King Seaver and Michael Massey played alongside UVA's Griff O'Ferrall and Jay Woolfolk on the 2023 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team.
- Demon Deacon graduate student Tate Ballesterio is using his final year of eligibility after playing the last two seasons at St. John's. He played for Virginia in 2020 and 2021. He appeared in 17 games (nine starts) on UVA's College World Series team in 2021.

- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021, 2023 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals
- 2009 trip to CWS was first in school history (Irvine Regional and Oxford Super Regional champions)
- Competed in 17 NCAA regionals and eight super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won eight regionals, six super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Five 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014, 50 in 2023)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 97 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 20 years and 31 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 38 All-America and 89 all-conference selections in his tenure

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOP OFFENSES

- Virginia's .356 team batting average is the fourth-highest of any college baseball team this season.
- The Cavaliers are ranked in the top-15 in seven categories: hits (2nd - 224), doubles (3rd - 50), on-base percentage (.456), runs (12th - 177), scoring (12th - 10.4 rpg) and slugging percentage (15th - .583)
- The Cavaliers lead the ACC hits and doubles.
- Last season, Virginia led the country in batting average, doubles and hits. It ranked in the top-10 in seven different offensive categories.

ON THE MOUND

- **Cullen McKay** (5.1 IP, 0 ER, 8 SO) and **Evan Blanco** (5.0 IP, 3 ER, 6 SO) are the two announced starting pitchers for the weekend. The two combined for 10.1 innings pitched, three earned runs and 14 strikeouts at Miami last weekend but did not factor in the decision after the Cavaliers let leads slip away in the late innings.
- On Friday against Miami **McKay** took a no-hitter into the fifth inning and struck out a career-high, eight batters in a no-decision. The only two runners to reach over the first four innings were two-out walks in the second and the third innings. McKay pitched 5.2 innings and exited with two outs and the bases loaded in the sixth.
- **McKay** moved into the weekend rotation for the first time last weekend. Including his start against Miami, he has six career starts under his belt, three as a true freshman last year and three this season.
- In his six career starts, **McKay** has allowed three earned runs in a total of 22.2 innings pitched.
- **Blanco** left the game as the pitcher of record in Saturday's contest after he allowed three runs in five innings of work. He fanned three of the first six batters he faced and finished with six strikeouts in a no-decision.
- **Blanco's** 4.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.40) is the eighth best of any ACC pitcher.
- **Jack O'Connor** has filled a role in the bullpen for the Cavaliers and flourished in four appearances. He has struck out eight batters in 3.2 innings of work. He earned his first career save in Sunday's series finale against Miami.
- **Aidan Teel** has either a save or factored in a decision in seven of his nine appearances for UVA this season. His four saves are tied for fifth in the country and ranked second in the ACC.

COMEBACK CAVS

- UVA has faced a deficit in 12 of the 17 games this season and have recorded two walk-off victories.
- The Cavaliers trailed Miami, 11-10 in the series finale on Sunday and scored four runs in its final two at bats to win. Virginia has three wins when trailing after the seventh this season, the most since 2019 when it had four in 54 games.
- Prior to UVA's 5-4, 10-inning walk-off win against Wichita State on Feb. 23, the Cavaliers had lost 39-straight games when trailing after seven.
- Of the Cavaliers eight come-from-behind victories, the largest came against then-No. 18 Iowa on Feb. 24 in Jacksonville, Fla. where UVA trailed by six runs.
- Virginia is 5-1 this season in games decided by one or two runs. The Cavalier had seven one or two-run victories in all of 2023.

RANKED FOES AT HOME

- Virginia last regular season series win at home over a nationally ranked opponent was in 2022 when they took two out of three against then-No. 22 Georgia Tech.
- The Cavaliers last win over a top-10 team in the regular season at home was against then-No. 7 NC State in 2020. The season was canceled due to the COVID19 pandemic four days later.
- The only ranked opponent to come to The Dish in 2023 was then-No. 20 Duke which won the rubber game. The Cavaliers later hosted the Blue Devils in the Charlottesville Super Regional and lost game one, 5-4 before outscoring the Blue Devils 26-6 in the final two games to advance to the College World Series for the second time in the last three years.

PLAYER NOTABLES

- **Casey Saucke** is UVA's hottest hitter over the last 10 games, batting .421 (16-for-38) with four home runs and 11 RBI. He is in the midst of a team-best, nine-game hit streak and has reached base safely in 25-straight games dating back to the final eight games of the 2023 season, all NCAA postseason contest.
- **Saucke** has been crucial in UVA's last two wins, hitting three homers in his last two games. His eighth-inning, lead-off homer in the series finale against Miami tied the game at an 11, setting up a 14-11 series salvaging victory. It was his second of two long balls on the season. Against William & Mary he worked through a seven-pitch at bat, including a foul ball off his knee right before he blasted a 463-foot homer over the left field bleachers. It sparked a six-run, sixth inning in an eventual 6-2 comeback win over the Tribe.
- **Harrison Didawick** doubled his 2023 season home run total in the first 16 games of the season and is tied for third in the ACC with eight bombs. He hit five home runs in a four-game stretch from March 5-9, including his first career multi-homer effort on in the middle game against Miami on March 8. The only game he did not homer in the Miami series he came through with a two-out, two-run double in the top of the ninth inning to give UVA a three-run cushion in the series finale.
- **Henry Godbout** struck out for the first time this season after getting caught looking in the fourth inning against William & Mary on Tuesday. He did not strikeout in his first 48 at bats of the season. He is statistically the toughest player to strikeout in the ACC and one of four players in the country with 50 or more at bats and two or less strikeouts.
- Saucke, **Anthony Stephan** and **Ethan Anderson** have reached base safely in all 17 games this season.
- Anderson was 9-for-22 (.409) with three doubles and three runs scored in five games last week. He recorded his first three-hit game of the season in the finale against Miami.
- **Henry Ford** has had a knack for coming up in the clutch this season. His two-out RBI infield single gave UVA a 12-11 advantage in the bottom of the ninth of game three. At the Jax College Classic against Wichita State he delivered a walk-off double in the 10th inning, the first of three wins on the weekend for UVA. He currently leads the team with nine multi-hit games and co-leads the Cavaliers in hits (27) and multi-RBI games (8).

SERIES SALVAGE IN MIAMI

- The Cavaliers led by at least four runs in all three-games at Miami last weekend. The Hurricanes overcame a 4-run advantage in the opener on Friday and did the unthinkable, erasing a nine-run deficit in the middle game.
- Virginia used their own comeback magic in the finale, tying the game in the eighth on a Casey Saucke solo homer and plated three runs in the top of the ninth to open up a three-run advantage. The Cavaliers escaped bases loaded jams in the eighth and ninth innings to preserve the 14-11 victory.
- The 31 runs in the series were tied for the most every by the Cavaliers against the Hurricanes. The two teams combined for 64 runs and 83 hits over the weekend. The 64 combined runs were the most 22 all-time, three-game series between the two schools.
- Two-run double in the top of the ninth inning to give UVA a three-run cushion in the series finale.

D.C. POWER SURGE

•Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington on March 6, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.

•Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra - 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.

•As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years.

• Freshman Eric Becker collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years. His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinerio and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

O'CONNOR 850

• Brian O'Connor reached his 850th Career win on March 5, a 6-3 victory over Penn State at Disharoon Park

• Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 850 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).

• All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

•Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.

• Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.

• The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

- Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O’Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O’Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.
- The duo of Anderson and O’Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation’s top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.
- Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program’s highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

- UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA’s freshman class No. 21 in the country.
- The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.
- Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O’Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers’ top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (582-171) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.
- The program’s total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it’s second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.
- The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.
- Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.
- The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men’s College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA’s 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA’s 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

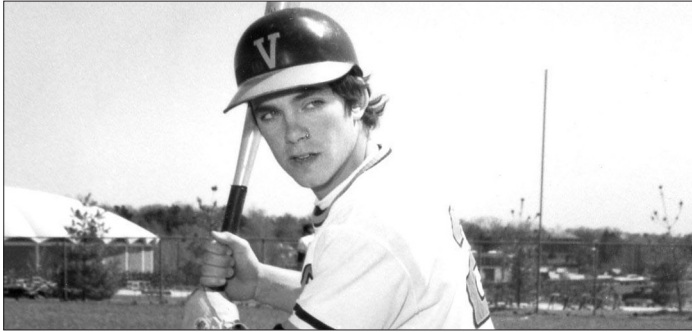
