## LEADING OFF

- The Cavaliers will close out their five-game homestand on Tuesday and play seven of their next eight games on the road.
- Virginia is one of 17 schools with 16 or more wins this season. Of the 17 schools, four play in the ACC - Florida State (20), North Carolina (17), Clemson (17) and Virginia (16).
- Georgetown comes into Disharoon Park on a seven-game win streak, tied for the eighth-longest in DI college baseball. Its last loss came against then-No. 1 Wake Forest on March 5 in Winston-Salem, a contest it led 6-2 after four innings.
- Tuesday's contest will feature two of the top scoring teams in the country, UVA is posting 10.4 runs per game, one of 11 teams nationally posting a double-digit scoring average. Georgetown is scoring 9.4 runs per game, which currently ranks 24th in DI Baseball.
- The Cavaliers are 13-1 against non-conference opponents this season and have won 42 of their last 43 games against non-conference opponents in the regular season.
- Virginia enters the contest with the most hits (257) of any team in the country. The Cavaliers .346 as a team, the fifth-highest average in the nation. f UVA is 11-2 at home this season and 48-7 in the last 55 games at Disharoon Park.

## AGAINST GEORGETOWN

- Tuesday marks only the eighth time UVA and Georgetown have met in the last 30 years. Virginia owns a 6-1 record against the Hoyas under head Coach Brian O'Connor.
- UVA has won seven of the last eight meetings against the Georgetown, including back-to-back 6-4 decisions in 2022 and 2023.
- Last year, Jake Gelof homered twice and Kyle Teel added a solo homer as UVA raced out to a 5-1 advantage after four innings and held on for the victory. Kevin Jaxel recorded his first collegiate win against the Hoyas after pitching 2.2 scoreless innings of relief.
- Virginia Lefthanded pitcher Angelo Tonas started his career at Georgetown and was a four-time member Big East Academic All-Academic Team selection. He logged 115 career innings and struck out 121 batters in a Georgetown uniform. He matched a program record with 30 appearances in the 2022 season.

## ON THE MOUND

- True freshman Freddy Beruvides Jr. will get the start for the second-straight Tuesday. He has made three appearances for the Cavaliers, including first collegiate start against William & Mary last on March 12.
- Beruvides made a brief appearance against Wake Forest on Saturday, throwing just three pitches to get the final out of the top of the ninth inning.
- Against William & Mary, Beruvides got the first four outs of the game, including a season-best three strikeouts. He surrendered a first inning homer before fanning the next three batters.

### COMEBACK CAVS

- UVA has faced a deficit in 15 of the 20 games this season and recorded 11 come-from-behind victories.
- The Cavaliers have recorded three walk-off victories and three wins when erasing a deficit of five or more runs.
- Of the Cavaliers 11 come-from-behind victories, the largest came against then-No. 18 Iowa on Feb. 24 in Jacksonville, Fla. where UVA trailed by six runs. They trailed by five runs in the opener against Wake Forest and five runs after the seventh inning stretch in the finale against the Demon Deacons.
- Virginia is 6-1 this season in games decided by one or two runs and have gone to extra innings on three different occasions. The Cavalier had seven one or two-run victories in all of 2023.
- Remarkably, UVA is 8-2 when opponents score first and 7-2 when opponents score in the first inning. Virginia has scored 39 runs in the sixth inning this season, its most potent frame.
- Prior to UVA's 5-4, 10-inning walk-off win against Wichita State on Feb. 23, the Cavaliers had lost 39-straight games when trailing after seven.

### ONE OF THE NATION'S TOP OFFENSES

- Virginia's .346 team batting average is the fifth-highest of any college baseball team this season.
- The Cavaliers are ranked in the top-10 in five other categories: hits (1st - 257), doubles (3rd - 56), runs (7th - 207), scoring (6th - 10.4 rpg) and on-base percentage (10th - .448).
- The Cavaliers lead the ACC runs scored, hits and doubles.
- Last season, Virginia led the country in batting average, doubles and hits. It ranked in the top-10 in seven different offensive categories.

### DOWN GOES NO. 7

- Virginia took two out of three against then-No. 7 Wake Forest on March 15-17, a matchup of the defending Atlantic and Coastal Division Champions. The Demon Deacons were the country's consensus preseason No. 1 team and held the position for each of the first three weeks of the season.
- Virginia had a total of 15,278 fans at Disharoon Park over the three-game stretch including a sellout (5,919) for Saturday's middle game. The sellout was Virginia's first ever in the month of March.
- The Cavaliers won their seventh-straight series against Wake Forest at Disharoon Park. The Cavaliers are 17-4 against Wake Forest in Charlottesville under head coach Brian O'Connor.
- The win was Virginia's first over a top-10 foe in the regular season since taking two out of three against then-No. 7 NC State in 2020. The 2020 season was canceled four days later due to the COVID19 pandemic.

### PLAYER NOTABLES

- Ethan Anderson, who was at the plate for UVA's walk-off win on Sunday vs. Wake Forest, is the only Cavalier to reach base safely in all 20 games this season after a 1-for-4 effort at the plate in the finale. He is currently riding a nine-game hitting streak.
- Jacob Ference put together his fifth multi-home run performance of his career and first as a Cavalier on Sunday against Wake Forest. He had four two-home run games at Salisbury University. Ference went 5-for-8 with five runs scored, two doubles, three home runs, five RBI and racked up 16 total bases in two starts against the Demon Deacons.
- Henry Ford enters Tuesday with 31 hits, tied for the most of any freshman in the country. He currently co-leads UVA in multi-hit (10) and multi-RBI games (9).
- Casey Saucke, was UVA's hottest hitter going into the Wake Forest series but was 0-for-11 going into his dramatic 9th-inning homer in the weekend finale, tying the game at 10 with two outs. His 26-game reached base streak that date back to last season's postseason run came to a close on Saturday.
- The power surge put forth by Harrison Didawick this season has already seen him double his home run total from a year ago. The second year outfielder is tied for third in the ACC with nine home runs, four of which have come in ACC play. In addition, Didawick is carrying UVA's longest hitting streak (10 games) into Tuesday's

midweek contest.

· Henry Godbout is statistically the ACC's toughest player to strikeout. He has gone down on strikes just three times in 61 at bats. He and Anderson were the only Cavaliers in the starting lineup that didn't strikeout in Wake Forest righthander Chase Burns' 13-K performance on Saturday. Godbout tagged Burns for a homer in the second inning after he fanned four of the first five batters. It was only the third homer surrendered by Burns in 30.1 innings this season.

### SERIES SALVAGE IN MIAMI

- The Cavaliers led by at least four runs in all three-games at Miami last weekend. The Hurricanes overcame a 4-run advantage in the opener on Friday and did the unthinkable, erasing a nine-run deficit in the middle game.
- Virginia used their own comeback magic in the finale, tying the game in the eighth on a Casey Saucke solo homer and plated three runs in the top of the ninth to open up a three-run advantage. The Cavaliers escaped bases loaded jams in the eighth and ninth innings to preserve the 14-11 victory.
- The 31 runs in the series were tied for the most every by the Cavaliers against the Hurricanes. The two teams combined for 64 runs and 83 hits over the weekend. The 64 combined runs were the most 22 all-time, three-game series between the two schools.
- two-run double in the top of the ninth inning to give UVA a three-run cushion in the series finale.

### D.C. POWER SURGE

- Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington on March 6, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.
- Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra - 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.
- As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years.
- Freshman Eric Becker collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years. His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinero and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

### O'CONNOR 850

- Brian O'Connor reached his 850th Career win on March 5, a 6-3 victory over Penn State at Disharoon Park
- Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 850 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

### UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

• Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.

• Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.

• The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

### PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

• Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.

• The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.

• Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

### ROSTER MAKEUP

• UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.

• The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.

• Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

### HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

• Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (585-172) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.

• The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.

• The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game post-season run.

• Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.

• The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

## 2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

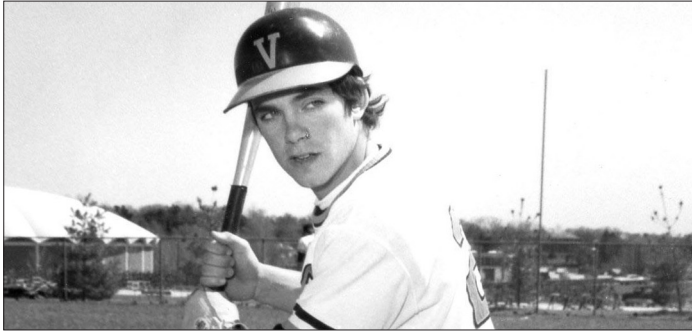
