LEADING OFF

- Virginia is one of nine programs in the country to reach the 20-win mark after this past weekend's action. Among the 20-win college baseball programs thus far, the Cavaliers are joined by ACC foes Clemson (22) and North Carolina (21).
- The Cavaliers are winners of five-straight games, their second five-game win streak of the season after starting the year winning their first nine games. The five-consecutive wins are tied with North Carolina for the third longest win streak in the ACC.
- Tuesday will mark the final home game in the month of March for UVA and it will return home next Tuesday to start a six-game homestand.
- Virginia is 12-2 at home this season and has won 49 of its last 56 games at Disharoon Park.
- The Cavaliers are 14-1 against non-conference opponents this season and have won 43 of their last 44 games against non-conference opponents in the regular season.
- The Cavaliers have 20 wins through its first 24 games for the 11th time under Brian O'Connor. Through its first 24 games in 2022 and 2023, UVA posted 22-2 marks, which matched the best start in program history.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- The Virginia offense comes into the midweek ranked No. 1 in the country in hits (319) and doubles (77). The team's collective batting average of .355 is the second highest of any team in college baseball.
- In total, the Cavaliers are ranked in the top-10 in the nation in seven different offensive categories including: on-base percentage (4th - .451), runs (3rd - 258), scoring (3rd - 10.8) and slugging percentage (8th - .595).
- Virginia has racked up double-digit hits in five-straight games, including a 19-hit effort in seven innings against Pitt in the series opener on Friday.
- Last season, Virginia led the country in batting average, doubles and hits. It ranked in the top-10 in seven different offensive categories.

SHARP IN ALL PHASES

- Virginia got it done at the plate, on the mound and in the field in a three-game road sweep against Pittsburgh this past weekend.
- The Cavaliers outscored the Panthers 36-8 and recorded their first series victory against Pitt since 2019. It also marked the first road win against the Panthers since 2016.
- Virginia starting pitching was the story of the weekend. Cullen McKay (5.0 IP 2 ER), Evan Blanco (5.2 IP, 3 ER) and Kevin Jaxel (5.0 IP, 1 ER) each earned victories and combined for a 3.45 ERA over 15 innings. McKay struck out a career-high 10 batters on Friday, the most of any Cavalier pitcher this season. Jaxel made his first career start on Sunday and allowed just two hits in his five innings of work.
- UVA also flashed the leather, committing one error in the three games. The Cavaliers turned four double plays in the finale, the most in a game since 2018. Virginia leads the ACC with 24 double plays this season.

AGAINST RICHMOND

- Tuesday marks the 162nd all-time meeting between Virginia and Richmond.
- The first ever game on record in Virginia baseball history came against Richmond, a 13-4 UVA victory on the April 20, 1889 in the season opener.
- The Cavaliers own an 90-59-2 record against Richmond. The 90 wins are the third-most against a Commonwealth opponent (VMI - 110; Virginia Tech - 108).
- Virginia has won 19 of the last 20 meetings against Richmond and are 18-1 against the Spiders under head coach Brian O'Connor.
- The last 14 meetings between Virginia and Richmond have taken place in Charlottesville.
- Prep Connections: Cavalier pitcher Evan Blanco and Richmond infielder Jake Elbeery played high school baseball together at Austin Preparatory School. UVA pitcher Patric Menk and Richmond pitcher Matthew Anderson both played at The Bolles School in Jacksonville, Fla.

ON THE MOUND

- First year lefty **Freddy Beruvides Jr.** will make his third-straight Tuesday start. Against Georgetown he fanned five of the first seven batters he faced including three in the second inning. He was lifted in the third after the first two Hoyas reached base and did not factor in the decision.
- Beruvides has four collegiate appearances under his belt including two starts.
- In his first collegiate start against William & Mary, Beruvides got the first four outs of the game and struck out three batters. He surrendered a first inning homer before fanning the next three batters.

CHASING HISTORY

- **Ethan Anderson**, UVA's single-season record holder in doubles, entered the program's career top-10 list with his 48th career double in Sunday's finale at Pitt. He's collected a double seven of his last 10 games.
- Anderson set the school mark for doubles in a season in 2023 with 26.

- Junior **Griff O'Ferrall** stole two bases in the three-game series at Pitt, becoming the newest member of UVA's 40 career stolen bases. He's the first Cavalier with 40 career stolen bases since 2010 - Phil Gosselin (48), Tyler Cannon (49), Jarrett Parker (46). O'Ferrall needs seven stolen bases to enter UVA's all-time top-10.

COMEBACK CAVS

- UVA has faced a deficit in 17 of the 24 games this season and recorded 13 come-from-behind victories.
- The Cavaliers have recorded three walk-off victories and three wins when erasing a deficit of five or more runs.
- Of the Cavaliers 13 come-from-behind victories, the largest came against then-No. 18 Iowa on Feb. 24 in Jacksonville, Fla. where UVA trailed by six runs. They trailed by five runs in the opener against Wake Forest and five runs after the seventh inning stretch in the finale against the Demon Deacons.
- Virginia is 6-1 this season in games decided by one or two runs and have gone to extra innings on three different occasions. The Cavalier had seven one or two-run victories in all of 2023.
- Remarkably, UVA is 9-2 when opponents score first and 8-2 when opponents score in the first inning. Virginia has scored 39 runs in the sixth inning this season, its most potent frame.
- Prior to UVA's 5-4, 10-inning walk-off win against Wichita State on Feb. 23, the Cavaliers had lost 39-straight games when trailing after seven.

PLAYER NOTABLES

- **Jacob Ference** produced his second multi-homer game in a three-game span when he left the yard twice in the opener against Pitt. In four-games last week, Ference started every game and went 8-for-15 (.538) with five extra-base hits (double, triple, 3 home runs) and four RBI. He has six homers in his last six games.
- Ference has six career multi-home run games, four at Salisbury and two in his first season as a Cavalier.
- **Harrison Didawick** delivered a two-run home run in the seventh inning of the finale in Pitt, his 11th long ball of the year. He is tied for fourth in the country in home runs and leads the ACC in runs scored. Didawick's last three homers have been in the seventh inning or later.
- **Griff O'Ferrall** recorded his first four-hit game of the season in the opener against Pitt. The Cavalier leadoff man is riding a 13-game hit streak, three shy of a career-high.
- Anderson is the only Cavalier to reach base safely in all 24 games this season and has a 13-game hit streak.
- Five of **Casey Saucke's** seven home runs have come in the last nine games, including a solo shot in the eighth inning against Georgetown last Wednesday. He has reached base in all but one game this season and 31 of his last 32 games dating back to last season.
- **Henry Ford** co-leads all NCAA D-I freshman with 38 hits, tied with Purdue-Fort Wayne's Justin Osterhouse. He leads the Cavaliers with 11 multi-hit games.

DOWN GOES NO. 7

- Virginia took two out of three against then-No. 7 Wake Forest on March 15-17, a matchup of the defending Atlantic and Coastal Division Champions. The Demon Deacons were the country's consensus preseason No. 1 team and held the position for each of the first three weeks of the season.
- Virginia had a total of 15,278 fans at Disharoon Park over the three-game stretch including a sellout (5,919) for Saturday's middle game. The sellout was Virginia's first ever in the month of March.
- The Cavaliers won their seventh-straight series against Wake Forest at Disharoon Park. The Cavaliers are 17-4 against Wake Forest in Charlottesville under head coach Brian O'Connor.
- The win was Virginia's first over a top-10 foe in the regular season since taking two out of three against then-No. 7 NC State in 2020. The 2020 season was canceled four days later due to the COVID19 pandemic.

SERIES SALVAGE IN MIAMI

- The Cavaliers led by at least four runs in all three-games at Miami last weekend. The Hurricanes overcame a 4-run advantage in the opener on Friday and did the unthinkable, erasing a nine-run deficit in the middle game.
- Virginia used their own comeback magic in the finale, tying the game in the eighth on a Casey Saucke solo homer and plated three runs in the top of the ninth to open up a three-run advantage. The Cavaliers escaped bases loaded jams in the eighth and ninth innings to preserve the 14-11 victory.
- The 31 runs in the series were tied for the most every by the Cavaliers against the Hurricanes. The two teams combined for 64 runs and 83 hits over the weekend. The 64 combined runs were the most 22 all-time, three-game series between the two schools.
- two-run double in the top of the ninth inning to give UVA a three-run cushion in the series finale.

D.C. POWER SURGE

- Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington on March 6, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.
- Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra - 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.
- As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total

bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years.

- Freshman Eric Becker collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years. His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinerio and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

O'CONNOR 850

- Brian O'Connor reached his 850th Career win on March 5, a 6-3 victory over Penn State at Disharoon Park
- Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 850 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

- Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.
- Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.
- The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

- Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.
- The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.
- Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

- UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.
- The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-lead the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.
- Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (585-172) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.
- The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.
- The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.
- Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.
- The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

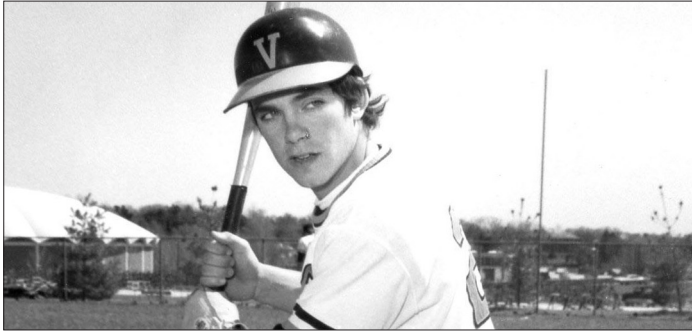
