LEADING OFF

- · Virginia's 21 wins are one shy of national leaders Tennessee (22-4), North Carolina (22-4), Texas A&M (22-3) and Clemson (22-2). Only nine teams in the country have 21 or more wins, three of them reside in the ACC Clemson, North Carolina and Virginia.
- · Virginia comes into the series winners of six-straight games, the second six-game win streak of the season. UVA started the year winning its first nine games. Only North Carolina (7) and Virginia Tech (7) have longer win streaks among ACC teams.
- Duke will be UVA's third nationally ranked opponent of the season. The Cavaliers haven't squared off against a top-25 opponent on the road in the regular season since then-No. 8 Miami in 2022. UVA's last road series win over a nationally ranked opponent was in 2021 winning the final two games at then-No. 6 Georgia Tech. Including the two victories against the Yellow Jackets, UVA went on to win 14 of the final 20 ACC games this season and eventually reached the program's fifth College World Series.
- The weekend's matchup pits Virginia, which currently sports the nation's second highest team batting average (.359) and the most hits (336), against Duke, which allows the second-fewest hits (6.17) per game and has the sixth-lowest ERA (3.46) in the country.
- · Virginia has won 20 or more wins in its first 25 games 12 times under head coach Brian O'Connor, including each of the last three seasons (2022 23-2; 2023 23-2 & 2024 21-4).
- · Virginia has won four of its last five ACC series dating back to last season. Three of the four series wins have been sweeps including last weekend at Pitt.
- This will mark the second-straight seasons that both Virginia and Duke are ranked in the top-25 when facing one another. The two teams had never played against one another with both teams in the top-25 until last season.

AGAINST DUKE

- ·This weekend will be a rematch of the 2023 Charlottesville Super Regional. The Blue Devils took game one, 5-4 but the Cavaliers stormed back outscoring Duke 26-6 in the final two games.
- ·The two teams met six times last season with Duke taking two out of three in the regular season at Disharoon Park.
- · Virginia is 109-68-1 against Duke in an all-time series that was first played in 1926, an 8-2 Cavalier victory. Friday's meeting will be the 180th all-time meeting between the two schools.
- · UVA has 100 all-time wins against five schools, Duke (109), North Carolina (118), Virginia Tech (108), Maryland (113) and VMI (111).

- · Virginia has won 20 of 24 ACC series against the Blue Devils since 2000.
- Cavalier freshman Charlie Oschell is the younger brother of Duke All-American RHP Fran Oschell. Fran played on the USA Baseball Collegiate National team with Cavalier shortstop Griff O'Ferrall and righthanded pitcher Jay Woolfolk last summer.
- · Cavalier lefthanded pitcher Owen Coady and Duke first baseman Ben Miller were teammates at Penn the last four years before transferring to their current institutions. Both were All-lvy League selections.

COMEBACK CAVS

- · UVA has faced a deficit in 18 of the 25 games this season and recorded 14 come-from-behind victories.
- The Cavaliers have recorded three walk-off victories and four wins when erasing a deficit of four or more runs.
- Of the Cavaliers 13 come-from-behind victories, the largest came against then-No. 18 Iowa on Feb. 24 in Jacksonville, Fla. where UVA trailed by six runs. They trailed by five runs in the opener against Wake Forest and five runs after the seventh inning stretch in the finale against the Demon Deacons.
- Virginia is 6-1 this season in games decided by one or two runs and have gone to extra innings on three different occasions. The Cavalier had seven one or two-run victories in all of 2023.
- \cdot Remarkably, UVA is 10-2 when opponents score first and 9-2 when opponents score in the first inning.
- Prior to UVA's 5-4, 10-inning walk-off win against Wichita State on Feb. 23, the Cavaliers had lost 39-straight games when trailing after seven.

MIDWFFK REVIEW

- Despite surrendering a first inning grand slam, Virginia overcame two early deficits in a 15-5 win over Richmond on Tuesday. The Cavaliers scored 11 unanswered runs against the Spiders for their sixth-straight win.
- Ethan Anderson was one of three, three-hit performers on the day. He pulled the Cavaliers within a run in the second inning with his second homer of the year. He then tied the game at four in the third inning with an RBI single.
- Harrison Didawick put UVA up for good in the bottom of the fourth with his team-leading 12th home run of the season. Didawick drove in four runs on the day and stole two bases.
- Freshman Matt Augustin did the bulk of the heavy lifting out of the bullpen pitching three scoreless innings and faced only the minimum, nine batters in his ninth appearance of the year.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

Postseason

- The Virginia offense comes into the midweek ranked No. 1 in the country in hits (336) and doubles (77). The team's collective batting average of .359 is the second highest of any team in college baseball.
- · In total, the Cavaliers are ranked in the top-10 in the nation in seven different offensive categories including: on-base percentage runs (2nd 273), (4th .454), scoring (3rd 10.9) and slugging percentage (8th .596).
- Virginia has racked up double-digit hits in six-straight games, including a 19-hit effort in seven innings against Pitt in the series opener last Friday.
- · Last season, Virginia led the country in batting average, doubles and hits. It ranked in the top-10 in seven different offensive categories.

ON THE MOUND

Virginia will stick with Cullen McKay and Evan Blanco to start the first two games of the series for the third-straight weekend.

Virginia starting pitching was the story of last weekends sweep at Pitt. McKay (5.0 IP 2 ER), Blanco (5.2 IP, 3 ER) and Kevin Jaxel (5.0 IP, 1 ER) each earned victories and combined for a 3.45 ERA over 15 innings. McKay struck out a career-high 10 batters on Friday, the most of any Cavalier pitcher this season. Jaxel made his first career start on Sunday and allowed just two hits in his five innings of work.

McKay had his best outing of his young Cavalier last weekend at Pitt and finished off the day retiring nine of the last nine of the last 10 batters he faced. He allowed only three hits, none in his final three innings of work. The 10 strikeouts were the most by a Cavalier since Brian Edgington struck out 11 in a complete game against Duke in game three of the 2023 Charlottesville Super Regional.

Blanco just missed out on what would have been UVA's third quality start of the season last weekend against Pitt. He logged 5.2 innings and struck out six batters. He fanned four of the first six batters he faced and struck out the side in the first inning.

PLAYER NOTABLES

- · Harrison Didawick is one of four players in the country with at least 12 homers and seven stolen bases. The second year swiped two bags on Tuesday against Richmond matching a career-high. Didawick leads the ACC in runs scored (40) and co-leads the league in RBI with 40. Didawick enters the series with a team-best 15-game hitting streak and has four homers in his last six games.
- Ethan Anderson is the only Cavalier to reach base safely in all 25 games this season and has a 14-game hit streak of his own. Anderson has three multi-hit performances in his last five games, including his second three-hit game of the season on Tuesday against Richmond.
- Jacob Ference has a hit in each of his last 10 games played and all seven of his home runs have come in that span. He produced multi-home run efforts against Wake Forest (March 15) and Pitt (March 22), giving him six two-homer games in his career (four at Salisbury and two at UVA).
- · Five of Casey Saucke's seven home runs have come in the last 10 games. He has reached base in all but one game this season and 32 of his last 33 games dating back to last season. Saucke has four multi-hit efforts in the last five games.
- · Henry Ford co-leads all NCAA D-I freshman with 39 hits, tied with Miami's Daniel Cuvet. His 11 mulit-hit games are tied with Saucke for the team lead.
- 12 home runs and 7 stolen bases in DI Baseball Ryley Preece (Morehead State) - 12 HRs, 13 SB Lyle Miller-Green (Austin Peay) - 14 HRs, 9 SB Grant Knipp (Campbell) - 15 HRs, 7 SB Harrison Didawick (Virginia) - 12 HRs, 7 SB

CHASING HISTORY

- · Ethan Anderson, UVA's single-season record holder in doubles, entered the program's career top-10 list with his 48th career double in Sunday's finale at Pitt. He's collected a double seven of his last 10 games.
- ·Anderson set the school mark for doubles in a season in 2023 with 26.

· Junior Griff O'Ferrall has a stolen base in each of his last three games. He is the newest member of UVA's 40 career stolen base club and the first Cavalier with 40 career stolen bases since 2010 - Phil Gosselin (48), Tyler Cannon (49), Jarrett Parker (46). O'Ferrall needs six stolen bases to enter UVA's all-time top-10.

DOWN GOES NO. 7

- · Virginia took two out of three against then-No. 7 Wake Forest on March 15-17, a matchup of the defending Atlantic and Coastal Division Champions. The Demon Deacons were the country's consensus preseason No. 1 team and held the position for each of the first three weeks of the season.
- · Virginia had a total of 15,278 fans at Disharoon Park over the threegame stretch including a sellout (5,919) for Saturday's middle game. The sellout was Virginia's first ever in the month of March.
- ·The Cavaliers won their seventh-straight series against Wake Forest at Disharoon Park. The Cavaliers are 17-4 against Wake Forest in Charlottesville under head coach Brian O'Connor.
- •The win was Virginia's first over a top-10 foe in the regular season since taking two out of three against then-No. 7 NC State in 2020. The 2020 season was canceled four days later due to the CoVID19 pandemic.

SERIES SALVAGE IN MIAMI

- The Cavaliers led by at least four runs in all three-games at Miami last weekend. The Hurricanes overcame a 4-run advantage in the opener on Friday and did the unthinkable, erasing a nine-run deficit in the middle game.
- · Virginia used their own comeback magic in the finale, tying the game in the eighth on a Casey Saucke solo homer and plated three runs in the top of the ninth to open up a three-run advantage. The Cavaliers escaped bases loaded jams in the eighth and ninth innings to preserve the 14-11 victory.
- The 31 runs in the series were tied for the most every by the Cavaliers against the Hurricanes. The two teams combined for 64 runs and 83 hits over the weekend. The 64 combined runs were the most 22 all-time, three-game series between the two schools.

D.C. POWER SURGE

- Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington on March 6, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.
- -Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.
- $\hbox{-As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years. } \\$
- Freshman Eric Becker collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years.
 His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinero and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

0'CONNOR 850

- · Brian O'Connor reached his 850th Career win on March 5, a 6-3 victory over Penn State at Disharoon Park
- Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 850 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- ·All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

- · Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.
- · Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.
- ·The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miam Marlins

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

- Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.
- •The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.
- ·Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

- · UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 fouryear transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.
- •The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.
- ·Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- · Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (587-172) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.
- •The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.
- The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.
- · Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.
- ·The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- · Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It
 marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in
 the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in
 that span (Louisville).
- ·UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- · UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- · Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- · Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17. Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 24-0).
