LEADING OFF

- UVA's 22 wins are tied for the eighth-most in the country and tied for the third-most in the ACC.
- Virginia is 13-2 at home this season and has won 50 of its last 57 games at Disharoon Park.
- The Cavaliers are 15-1 against non-conference opponents this season and have won 44 of their last 45 games against non-conference opponents in the regular season.
- Tuesday will mark the second of three meetings against ODU this season. The Cavaliers won the first game back on Feb. 21, 8-0 and will travel to Norfolk for the final matchup of the year on April 16 at Harbor Park, Triple-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles.
- The Virginia offense leads the country in hits (361) and doubles (87) while sporting the nation's second-best team batting average (.347).
- ODU is one of the top pitching teams in the Sun Belt Conference. The Monarchs' team ERA of 4.07 is the second lowest in the league and ranks 25th in the NCAA. ODU's 3.15 strikeout-to-walk ratio is the sixth best in DI baseball.
- Tuesday will mark UVA's first scheduled home night game (5 p.m. or later) of the season. The Cavaliers have started two home games after 5 p.m. this season due to weather delays (VMI - 2/28 & Wake Forest 3/15).

ROUND TWO VS. THE MONARCHS

- The all-time series between ODU and UVA is now even at 34-34-1 after an 8-0 Virginia win back on Feb. 21.
- The last six regular season meetings between the two commonwealth schools have occurred in Charlottesville. The April 16 matchup will be the first time the two teams have met in Norfolk since the 2016 season.
- The Cavaliers have won eight of the last nine meetings against ODU and are 13-8 against the Monarchs under Brian O'Connor.
- The shutout against ODU on Feb. 21 is the only clean sheet for the Cavalier pitching staff this season. Five UVA pitchers combined to allow just four hits with Kevin Jaxel earning the first of his team-leading four wins on the year. Jaxel stranded four runners between the fifth and sixth in a total of 1.2 innings of work.
- Harrison Didawick hit his third home run in four games and went 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI to pace the UVA offense.

ON THE MOUND

- Righthander Joe Savino is expected to make his season debut on Tuesday and will be the ninth Cavalier to get a start on the mound this year.
- Savino is a graduate transfer from Elon where he posted a 3.94 ERA over 50 appearances and 169 innings pitched in three seasons. He struck out 193 batters and walked only 32.
- Last season for the Phoenix he was one of the top relievers in the CAA, earning an all-conference honorable mention distinction.
- Savino's last collegiate start came on May 13, 2022 against Towson where he took a no-decision in a 5-4, hit-by-pitch, walk-off victory in the bottom of the ninth for Elon.

- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021, 2023 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals

- Competed in 17 NCAA regionals and eight super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won eight regionals, six super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Five 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014, 50 in 2023)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 97 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 20 years and 31 have reached the big leagues

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- The Virginia offense comes into the midweek ranked No. 1 in the country in hits (361) and doubles (87). The team's collective batting average of .347 is the second highest of any team in college baseball.
- In total, the Cavaliers are ranked in the top-10 in the nation in seven different offensive categories including: on-base percentage (5th - .442), runs (3rd - 288), scoring (3rd - 10.3) and slugging percentage (9th - .571).
- Last season, Virginia led the country in batting average, doubles and hits. It ranked in the top-10 in seven different offensive categories.

- Junior Griff O'Ferrall stole two bases in the three-game series at Pitt, becoming the newest member of UVA's 40 career stolen bases. He's the first Cavalier with 40 career stolen bases since 2010 - Phil Gosselin (48), Tyler Cannon (49), Jarrett Parker (46). O'Ferrall needs six stolen bases to enter UVA's all-time top-10.

COMEBACK CAVS

- UVA has faced a deficit in 19 of the 27 games this season and recorded 14 come-from-behind victories.
- The Cavaliers have recorded three walk-off victories and three wins when erasing a deficit of five or more runs.
- Of the Cavaliers 14 come-from-behind victories, the largest came against then-No. 18 Iowa on Feb. 24 in Jacksonville, Fla. where UVA trailed by six runs. They trailed by five runs in the opener against Wake Forest and five runs after the seventh inning stretch in the finale against the Demon Deacons.
- Virginia is 6-1 this season in games decided by one or two runs and have gone to extra innings on three different occasions. The Cavalier had seven one or two-run victories in all of 2023.
- Remarkably, UVA is 10-3 when opponents score first and 9-3 when opponents score in the first inning. Virginia has scored 39 runs in the sixth inning this season, its most potent frame.
- Prior to UVA's 5-4, 10-inning walk-off win against Wichita State on Feb. 23, the Cavaliers had lost 39-straight games when trailing after seven.

PLAYER NOTABLES

- Jacob Ferece is UVA's hottest hitter over the last 10 games: .441 (15-for-34) with a double, triple and five home runs. The graduate student is in the midst of a 13-game hit streak, the longest active streak on the team. Ferece has reached base safely in all 18 of his starts (14 at C, 4 DH) this season.
- Harrison Didawick leads the ACC in run scored with 42 and ranks in the top-5 in the league in RBI (2nd - 40), home runs (4th - 12) and total bases (5th - 81).
- First year Henry Ford's 41 hits are the second most of any freshman in the country behind Miami's Daniel Cuvet (42). Ford has reached base safely in 21-straight games.
- Casey Saucke has a hit in all but three games this season and is currently sporting a nine-game hit streak. He went 3-for-5 in the series finale, his sixth multi-hit game in the last nine games. Saucke ranks in the top-10 in the ACC ranks: in hits (4th - 46), runs (6th - 35) and RBI (10th - 32). The series finale against Duke marked Saucke's 100th consecutive start in a Cavalier uniform.
- Ethan Anderson reached base in the first 26 games of the season and the streak came to an end on Friday at Duke. He was kept off base for the final two games of the series, the first time he did not reach base in back-to-back starts in his career.
- Bobby Whalen enters the midweek ranked fifth in the ACC in batting average. He's reached in all but three of his starts this season.
- Henry Godbout had a double in each of the final two games at Duke and upped his season total to 13, tied for 8th in the NCAA.
- Griff O'Ferrall has recorded a hit in 16 of his last 17 games, including his fifth two-double effort of his career in Sunday's loss at Duke.

DOWN GOES NO. 7

- Virginia took two out of three against then-No. 7 Wake Forest on March 15-17, a matchup of the defending Atlantic and Coastal Division Champions. The Demon Deacons were the country's consensus preseason No. 1 team and held the position for each of the first three weeks of the season.
- Virginia had a total of 15,278 fans at Disharoon Park over the three-game stretch including a sellout (5,919) for Saturday's middle game. The sellout was Virginia's first ever in the month of March.
- The Cavaliers won their seventh-straight series against Wake Forest at Disharoon Park. The Cavaliers are 17-4 against Wake Forest in Charlottesville under head coach Brian O'Connor.
- The win was Virginia's first over a top-10 foe in the regular season since taking two out of three against then-No. 7 NC State in 2020. The 2020 season was canceled four days later due to the CoVID19 pandemic.

SERIES SALVAGE IN MIAMI

- The Cavaliers led by at least four runs in all three-games at Miami last weekend. The Hurricanes overcame a 4-run advantage in the opener on Friday and did the unthinkable, erasing a nine-run deficit in the middle game.
- Virginia used their own comeback magic in the finale, tying the game in the eighth on a Casey Saucke solo homer and plated three runs in the top of the ninth to open up a three-run advantage. The Cavaliers escaped bases loaded jams in the eighth and ninth innings to preserve the 14-11 victory.
- The 31 runs in the series were tied for the most every by the Cavaliers against the Hurricanes. The two teams combined for 64 runs and 83 hits over the weekend. The 64 combined runs were the most 22 all-time, three-game series between the two schools.
- two-run double in the top of the ninth inning to give UVA a three-run cushion in the series finale.

D.C. POWER SURGE

- Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington on March 6, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.
- Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra - 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.

- As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years.
- Freshman Eric Becker collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years. His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinero and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

O'CONNOR 850

- Brian O'Connor reached his 850th Career win on March 5, a 6-3 victory over Penn State at Disharoon Park
- Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 850 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

- Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.
- Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.

- The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

- Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.
- The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.
- Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

- UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.
- The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.
- Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (587-172) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.
- The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.
- The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.
- Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.
- The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest

- in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.

- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

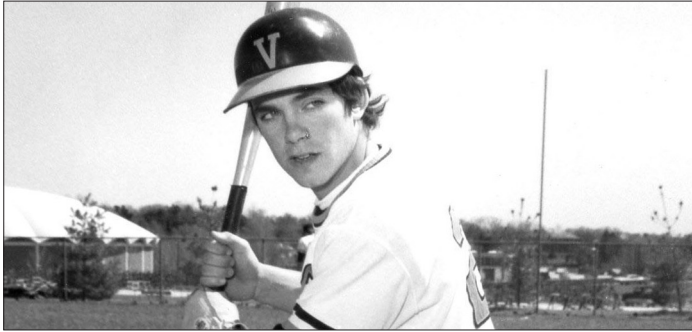
