LEADING OFF

- Virginia enters the midweek with 26 wins, tied for the eighth most in the country and third-most in the ACC. The Cavaliers are one of 12 schools in the country with 26 or more wins.
- UVA comes into the series as the No. 11 team in the country, its second-highest ranking of the season. Virginia has been as low as No. 9 back on March 26, the sixth week of the season.
- The Cavaliers have won three of their five ACC series this season and five of their last seven dating back to the 2023 season.
- With nine conference wins at the midpoint of its ACC schedule, it marks the third-straight season UVA has reached nine or more wins in its first 15 ACC games. Remarkably, UVA has reached the College World Series with four wins (2021) and six wins (2015 - won national championship) at the halfway point of its ACC schedule.
- The UVA offense leads the country in hits (415) and second in the nation in both doubles (93) and batting average (.342).
- The Cavaliers led the ACC in scoring (9.9 rpg) and total runs (328).

AGAINST LOUISVILLE

- Virginia is seeking its fourth-straight win over Louisville, something that neither team has been able to do against one another since the all-time series began in 2015.
- The Cavaliers came away with a series sweep last season, outscoring the Cardinals 27-9 over the three games. The sweep was part of a nine-game UVA win streak to close out the 2023 regular season.
- Louisville holds a 13-12 edge in the all-time series.
- UVA's lone series win in three tries against Louisville at Jim Patterson Stadium came in 2018, when it won two out of three games, all one-run affairs.

ON THE MOUND

- Evan Blanco is the only pitcher remaining from UVA's opening day rotation. The lefthander has made a staff-best, eight starts after appearing exclusively in relief last season.
- Blanco is coming off the longest outing by a UVA starter this season when he pitched 6.1 innings in a 7-2 win over then-No. 10 North Carolina last Saturday. He was one strikeout shy of matching a career-best, fanning seven Tar Heels.

- Named the ACC Coach of the Decade (2010-19) by D1Baseball.com
- One of nine coaches in the history of the ACC to accumulate 700 wins and his .704 winning percentage is the highest among active NCAA coaches.
- Won 2015 NCAA National Championship (one of 8 active coaches to own a national title)
- Three-time National Coach of the Year (2006, '09, '15)
- Four-time ACBA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year (2004, '09, '11, '14, '15)
- Five-time ACC Coach of the Year (2004, '10, '11, '13, '14)
- NCAA tournament appearances in 14-straight seasons (UVA had been to three NCAA tournaments prior to his arrival)
- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021, 2023 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals
- 2009 trip to CWS was first in school history (Irvine Regional and Oxford Super Regional champions)
- Competed in 17 NCAA regionals and eight super regionals (hosted nine NCAA regionals and five super regionals)
- Has won eight regionals, six super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Five 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014, 50 in 2023)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 97 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 20 years and 31 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 38 All-America and 89 all-conference selections in his tenure

· Blanco has pitched into the fifth inning in seven of his eight starts and has not allowed more than three runs in any of his outings this season.

· Kevin Jaxel slides into the Saturday starting role after starting on Sunday in each of the last three weekends, the first three starts of his career.

· His first two starts against Pitt and Duke he allowed three earned runs in a total of 10 innings pitched.

BULLPEN NOTABLES

· Virginia used a season-high 10 pitchers in its 8-4 midweek win over VCU on Tuesday. Chase Hungate, a transfer from VCU, was credited with the victory after pitching two scoreless frames beginning in the fifth inning. Hungate hasn't allowed a run in 10 of his 14 relief appearances this season.

· Graduate student Owen Coady was lights out for the Cavaliers in two appearances last week. He earned the win against ODU, striking out all six batters he faced. He came on to pitch the final 2.2 innings of UVA's 7-2 series-clinching win over North Carolina on Friday night to earn the save. He struck out nine of the 15 batters he faced.

· Lefthander Angelo Tonas the standout on the mound for the Cavaliers in the series finale against North Carolina. The graduate student took over on the mound in the third and kept the Tar Heels scoreless for the next 3.2 innings, his longest outing as a Cavalier. Tonas hasn't allowed a run in 13 of his 16 relief appearances this season. He was credited with a hold in the midweek win over VCU, stranding runners on the corners in the seventh inning.

· Blake Barker was a key piece in UVA's comeback win over North Carolina on Thursday. He put a halt to the early scoring outburst from the Tar Heels, pitching 3.1 innings of scoreless relief beginning in the third inning. He matched a career-high with five strikeouts and faced the minimum in the fourth, fifth and sixth innings.

HOOS DIG THE LONG BALL

· Virginia went four games without a home run before blasting five in the opener against North Carolina. It marked the longest home run drought since a four-game spell between March 27 - April 21, 2021. The Cavaliers broke out of that homerless spell with a grand slam by Nic Kent in an 8-2, game two at Georgia Tech. The win proved significant as UVA went on to win 14 of its next 20 ACC games after starting league play 4-12, a run that sparked a berth into College World Series for the fifth time in program history.

· Henry Ford broke UVA's latest home run drought with his first career grand slam and the second by a Cavalier this season (Henry Godbout vs. GW on March 6). It was the first of three long balls for Ford in the contest, the first three-homer game by a UVA hitter since 2002 (Dan Street vs. ODU).

· Ford has 10 home runs in his first 33 collegiate games. He is the fourth Cavalier freshman to hit 10 or more home runs in a season since 2004, joining UVA Baseball Hall of Famers Mark Reynolds (15 in 2002), Sean Doolittle (11 in 2005) and Steven Proscia (10 in 2009).

· Harrison Didawick has 14 home runs in his first 33 games, tied for the second-most in the ACC and tied for 14th-most in the country.

· The Virginia offense comes into Tuesday night's contest ranked No. 1 in the country in hits (415) and are second in the nation doubles (93) and team batting average (.342).

· In total, the Cavaliers are ranked in the top-10 in the nation in seven different offensive categories including: runs (4th - 328), scoring (5th - 9.9), slugging percentage (8th - .566) and on-base percentage (10th - .435).

· UVA leads the ACC in batting average, doubles, hits, on-base percentage, runs and scoring.

· Last season, Virginia led the country in batting average, doubles and hits. It ranked in the top-10 in seven different offensive categories.

· Virginia has the fourth-highest scoring margin of any ACC team and 17th best in the NCAA, outscoring its opponents by average of 3.7 runs per game.

PLAYER NOTABLES

· **Henry Ford's** 50 hits are the most of any freshman in the country and his 10 homers are tied for third-most of any first year in D-I baseball. Ford has reached base safely in 26-straight games, the longest active streak on the team.

· **Griff O'Ferrall** has scored six runs in his last three games and moved into sole possession of ninth on UVA's career run list. He needs four more runs to tie former teammate Kyle Teel for eight all-time.

· **Casey Saucke** eclipsed the 50-hit mark with two base knocks in the series finale against North Carolina. Saucke and Ford co-lead the team with 16 multi-hit efforts. Saucke's 51 hits are tied for the fourth-most amongst ACC foes.

· **Ethan Anderson** homered twice in UVA's 7-2 series-clinching win over North Carolina on Friday, his second two-homer game of his career. He went 6-for-14 (.429), with two doubles, 2 home runs, and five RBI in three games vs. UNC.

· **Harrison Didawick** has scored 48 runs, the most in the ACC and tied for the eighth most in the country. He's already surpassed his season total from last year (44).

· **Bobby Whalen** enters the series ranked third in the ACC in batting average. He's reached in all but three of his starts this season.

· Junior **Griff O'Ferrall** stole two bases in the three-game series at Pitt, becoming the newest member of UVA's 40 career stolen bases. He's the first Cavalier with 40 career stolen bases since 2010 - Phil Gosselin (48), Tyler Cannon (49), Jarrett Parker (46). O'Ferrall needs five stolen bases to enter UVA's all-time top-10.

DOWN GOES NO. 7

• Virginia took two out of three against then-No. 7 Wake Forest on March 15-17, a matchup of the defending Atlantic and Coastal Division Champions. The Demon Deacons were the country's consensus preseason No. 1 team and held the position for each of the first three weeks of the season.

• Virginia had a total of 15,278 fans at Disharoon Park over the three-game stretch including a sellout (5,919) for Saturday's middle game. The sellout was Virginia's first ever in the month of March.

• The Cavaliers won their seventh-straight series against Wake Forest at Disharoon Park. The Cavaliers are 17-4 against Wake Forest in Charlottesville under head coach Brian O'Connor.

• The win was Virginia's first over a top-10 foe in the regular season since taking two out of three against then-No. 7 NC State in 2020. The 2020 season was canceled four days later due to the CoVID19 pandemic.

SERIES SALVAGE IN MIAMI

• The Cavaliers led by at least four runs in all three-games at Miami last weekend. The Hurricanes overcame a 4-run advantage in the opener on Friday and did the unthinkable, erasing a nine-run deficit in the middle game.

• Virginia used their own comeback magic in the finale, tying the game in the eighth on a Casey Saucke solo homer and plated three runs in the top of the ninth to open up a three-run advantage. The Cavaliers escaped bases loaded jams in the eighth and ninth innings to preserve the 14-11 victory.

• The 31 runs in the series were tied for the most every by the Cavaliers against the Hurricanes. The two teams combined for 64 runs and 83 hits over the weekend. The 64 combined runs were the most 22 all-time, three-game series between the two schools. two-run double in the top of the ninth inning to give UVA a three-run cushion in the series finale.

D.C. POWER SURGE

• Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington on March 6, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.

• Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra - 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.

• As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years.

• Freshman Eric Becker collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years. His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinero and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

O'CONNOR 850

• Brian O'Connor reached his 850th Career win on March 5, a 6-3 victory over Penn State at Disharoon Park

• Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 850 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).

• All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

• Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend.

After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.

• Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.

• The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

• Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.

• The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.

• Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

• UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.

• The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.

• Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

• Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (588-172) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.

• The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.

• The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.

• Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.

• The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

• Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.

• Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.

• Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).

• UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).

• UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.

• Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.

• The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.

• The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.

• Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.

• UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.

• Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

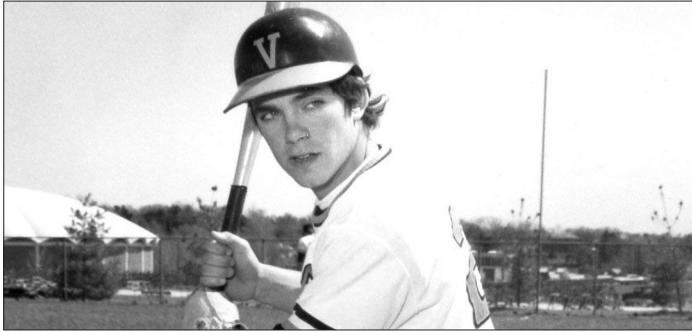
