LEADING OFF

- The Diamond will be Virginia's fourth professional baseball stadium the Cavaliers will play at this season. UVA has played at 121 Financial Ballpark (Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp), Harbor Park (Norfolk Tides, Fenway Park (Boston Red Sox) and The Diamond (Richmond Flying Squirrels). The 2024 ACC Tournament is slated to be played at Truist Field (Charlotte Knights). UVA is 3-2 at professional parks this season.
- Virginia climbed three spots in the D1Baseball.com top-25 poll to No. 11. The Cavaliers are inside the top-15 for the seventh-straight week.
- UVA's 33 wins are tied for the eighth most in the country. The Cavaliers are tied with North Carolina for the third-most wins in the ACC, one behind Florida State and Clemson.
- The Cavaliers are 10-5 in true road games 13-7 in games away from Disharoon Park this season. The Cavaliers have tallied 11 true road wins in two of the last three years.
- Virginia's 548 total hits are tied with Austin Peay for the most by any team in the country. The Cavaliers have seven qualified hitters batting over the .300 mark and are hitting .335 as a team, the third-highest average in the country.
- VCU comes into Tuesday's contest with a team ERA of 4.67, the lowest in the A-10. Navy is the top fielding team in the Patriot League and its .980 fielding percentage is the ninth-highest in D-I college baseball.

ROUND TWO VS. VCU

- Virginia erased deficits of 1-0 (first inning) and 4-3 (fifth inning) and came away with an 8-4 win over the Rams on April 2 at Disharoon Park. Harrison Didawick provided the decisive blow with a three-run homer in the bottom of the fifth. Chase Hungate, a VCU transfer, was credited with the win after pitching two scoreless innings.
- Virginia has won four-straight games against VCU and owns a 48-25 mark against the Rams in an all-time series that was first played in 1979.
- The Cavaliers are looking to sweep the season series for the second-straight year. Virginia has not taken both games of the season series in back-to-back years since the 2013 and 2014 seasons.
- Last year at The Diamond, Ethan Anderson went 5-for-6 with three doubles and two home runs against the Rams. He homered from both sides of the plate (left/right). The three doubles in the contest also matched a school record.

AGAINST NAVY

- Virginia and Navy will square off for the 26th time on Wednesday. The Cavaliers are 15-10 in the all-time series that dates back to 1889.
- UVA has won five-straight meetings, including a 24-5 win in the 2023 season opener at Disharoon Park, a game that was originally scheduled to be played in Wilmington, N.C.
- In last year's meeting, the Cavaliers erupted for 14 runs in the fifth inning, the most by a Virginia team in a single inning under Brian O'Connor (2004-present). The Cavaliers collected 20 hits in the contest including the first collegiate home run by Harrison Didawick in his UVA debut.

ON THE MOUND

- First year **Bryson Moore** will make a midweek start for the third-straight week. The righthander pitched the first two innings of last Tuesday's 14-4 win over Liberty last Tuesday. In two starts he's logged three innings, allowed two runs, struck out one and walked two.
- Virginia is coming off its third shutout of the season after blanking Boston College on Saturday and first in ACC play since March 17, 2023, against NC State. The Cavaliers have not recorded back-to-back shutouts since the 2022 season.
- Beginning with his April 9 outing against VCU, **Chase Hungate** has been one of UVA's most consistent arms out of the bullpen. Over his last six appearances, he has 4-0 with a 1.10 ERA over 16.1 innings pitched. He has issued one walk and struck out five.

MILESTONE WATCH

- After four home runs last Tuesday vs. Liberty, Virginia has 76 long balls on the season, the second-most in a single season in program history. Last year UVA set the program mark, launching 83 homers in 65 total games. The three highest single-season home run totals have occurred in the last three seasons.
- Griff O'Ferrall is currently ranked tied for ninth on UVA's career hit list with current UVA undergraduate assistant coach and UVA Baseball Hall of Famer, John Hicks at 245. O'Ferrall set UVA's single-season record for hits in 2023, compiling 108 as the leadoff man for UVA's College World Series team.

- **Ethan Anderson** also has chance surpassing a John Hicks career mark. Anderson has 54 career doubles, tied with Hicks for the third-most in UVA history.
- **Henry Ford** is currently tied with Mark Reynolds (2002) for the most home runs by a UVA freshman. He is three RBI shy of matching Steven Proscia's 2009 mark of 58, the current freshman program record.

POTENT ATTACK

- The Virginia offense comes into the midweek tied for the national lead in hits (548).
- UVA ranks in the top-10 in the nation in five other categories: batting average (3rd - .335), doubles (4th - 111), runs (4th - 436), sacrifice flies (4th - 33), scoring (6th - 9.7 rpg). The Cavaliers are ranked 11th in the country with a .559 team slugging percentage.
- Virginia scored double-digit runs 22 times this season and its 19-3 when scoring 10 or more runs in a game.
- UVA leads the ACC in batting average, doubles, hits, on-base percentage, runs and sacrifice flies and scoring.
- Last season, Virginia led the country in batting average, doubles and hits. It ranked in the top-10 in seven different offensive categories.

PLAYER NOTABLES

- **Griff O'Ferrall** leads the Cavaliers with 21 multi-hit games and is statistically the second-toughest batter in the ACC to strikeout. O'Ferrall leads the team and ranks third in the ACC with 67 hits on the season. His nine sacrifice flies are the most of any ACC hitter.
- **Ethan Anderson** is 7-for-17 (.412) with two doubles and five runs scored in his last five games. He has reached base safely in 17-straight games, second-longest active streak on the team (Eric Becker - 18).

- In the three-game series against Boston College, **Bobby Whalen** reached base eight times after going 3-for-7 with five walks two runs and three RBI. He also made a key defensive play, with a full-extension, diving grab in center field in the sixth inning of game two. Whalen's .405 batting average is the third-highest in the ACC and his .500 on-base percentage is second only to Pitt's Luke Cantwell for the highest among any ACC hitter.
- **Henry Ford's** 63 hits and 55 RBI are the most by any DI freshman in the country.
- **Casey Saucke** enters the midweek on a team-best seven-game hit streak. He's put forth multi-RBI efforts in the last three ACC series finales. His 65 hits are the fifth-most in the ACC and 10-shy of matching his career-high of 75 last season.

- Six different Cavaliers have put forth multi-home run games this season - Jacob Ference (3), Henry Ford (3), Harrison Didawick (1), Ethan Anderson (1), Luke Hanson (1) and Casey Saucke (1).

·Virginia went four games without a home run before blasting five in the opener against North Carolina on April 5. It marked the longest home run drought since a four-game spell between March 27 - April 21, 2021. The Cavaliers broke out of that homerless spell in 2021 with a grand slam by Nic Kent in an 8-2, game two at Georgia Tech. The win proved significant as UVA went on to win 14 of its next 20 ACC games after starting league play 4-12, a run that sparked a berth into College World Series for the fifth time in program history.

·Henry Ford broke UVA's latest home run drought with his first career grand slam and the second by a Cavalier this season (Henry Godbout vs. GW on March 6). It was the first of three long balls for Ford in the contest, the first three-homer game by a UVA hitter since 2002 (Dan Street vs. ODU).

40 STOLEN BASE CLUB

·Junior **Griff O'Ferrall** stole two bases in the three-game series at Pitt, becoming the newest member of UVA's 40 career stolen bases. He's the first Cavalier with 40 career stolen bases since 2010 - Phil Gosselin (48), Tyler Cannon (49), Jarrett Parker (46). O'Ferrall needs three stolen bases to enter UVA's all-time top-10.

OFF TO THE RACES IN LOUISVILLE

·Virginia matched the school record for runs in a three-game ACC series, previously set in 2009 at Wake Forest. UVA scored 18 runs in the opener, eight runs in the middle game and 21 in the finale.

·The 47 runs scored by Virginia are the most in any three-game series since plating 60 in a three-game series against Cornell in 2022.

·The Cavaliers hit 11 home runs in the series, five in the opener, one in the middle game and six in the series finale. UVA has hit five or more home runs in a game, three times this year. Three different players had multi-home run games in the series - Henry Ford, Jacob Ference and Luke Hanson.

·The 21 runs on Friday were the most by any ACC team in a conference game this season and the most by the Cavaliers in an ACC game since scoring 27 against Maryland on April 23, 2010.

·Virginia scored 10 runs in the ninth inning in Friday's opener, the most in a single-inning this season and the most ninth-inning runs in any game over the last 24 years.

DOWN GOES NO. 7

·Virginia took two out of three against then-No. 7 Wake Forest on March 15-17, a matchup of the defending Atlantic and Coastal Division Champions. The Demon Deacons were the country's consensus preseason No. 1 team and held the position for each of the first three weeks of the season.

·Virginia had a total of 15,278 fans at Disharoon Park over the three-game stretch including a sellout (5,919) for Saturday's middle game. The sellout was Virginia's first ever in the month of March.

·The Cavaliers won their seventh-straight series against Wake Forest at Disharoon Park. The Cavaliers are 17-4 against Wake Forest in Charlottesville under head coach Brian O'Connor.

·The win was Virginia's first over a top-10 foe in the regular season since taking two out of three against then-No. 7 NC State in 2020. The 2020 season was canceled four days later due to the COVID19 pandemic.

SERIES SALVAGE IN MIAMI

·The Cavaliers led by at least four runs in all three-games at Miami last weekend. The Hurricanes overcame a 4-run advantage in the opener on Friday and did the unthinkable, erasing a nine-run deficit in the middle game.

·Virginia used their own comeback magic in the finale, tying the game in the eighth on a Casey Saucke solo homer and plated three runs in the top of the ninth to open up a three-run advantage. The Cavaliers escaped bases loaded jams in the eighth and ninth innings to preserve the 14-11 victory.

·The 31 runs in the series were tied for the most every by the Cavaliers against the Hurricanes. The two teams combined for 64 runs and 83 hits over the weekend. The 64 combined runs were the most 22 all-time, three-game series between the two schools.

·two-run double in the top of the ninth inning to give UVA a three-run cushion in the series finale.

D.C. POWER SURGE

·Virginia hit eight home runs at George Washington on March 6, the second-most in a single-game in program history. A school-record, seven different Cavaliers homered in the contest including Henry Ford who left the yard twice.

·Virginia eclipsed the 20-run mark for the second time this season (21 vs. Hofstra - 2/17) with a 26-run outburst against the Revolutionaries. It marked back-to-back seasons that UVA has scored 26 runs in a game and is the 10th time since 1950 UVA has scored 26 or more runs in a game.

·As a team UVA accumulated 24 hits, the most since racking up 25 against Longwood last year. The Cavaliers accumulated 54 total bases in the contest, the most in a game in the last 25 years.

·Freshman Eric Becker collected five hits (four singles, one double) in UVA's 26-12 win over George Washington on Wednesday. The five hits were the most in a game by any UVA freshman in the last 25 years. His seven at bats were the most by any UVA player since 2015 when Christian Lowry, Daniel Pinero and Kenny Towns all had eight at bats in UVA's 18-inning game against Marist.

O'CONNOR 850

·Brian O'Connor reached his 850th Career win on March 5, a 6-3 victory over Penn State at Disharoon Park

·Now in his 21st season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 850 wins at an ACC institution. His .705 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).

·All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016 with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

UNDISPUTED JAX CHAMPS

·Virginia was awarded the championship belt after it captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title this past weekend. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.

·Henry Ford, Henry Godbout, Casey Saucke, Anthony Stephan and Jay Woolfolk were each listed on the All-Tournament team.

·The Cavaliers made it to two ACC Championship games (2005 & 2008) when the conference tournament was played in Jacksonville. UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in games at 121 Financial Ballpark, home of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

PRESEASON RECOGNITIONS

·Juniors Ethan Anderson and Griff O'Ferrall headlined the Cavaliers preseason awards. O'Ferrall was a unanimous preseason All-American while Anderson garnered preseason All-America honors from D1Baseball and the NCBWA.

·The duo of Anderson and O'Ferrall were also included on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, an award annually given to the nation's top amateur player. Multiple Cavaliers have been featured have been featured on the preseason watch list in three of the last four years. Virginia had two semifinalists for the award last season in Jake Gelof and Kyle Teel.

·Virginia is ranked in all four major College Baseball polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 according to Baseball America. The No. 14 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2016.

ROSTER MAKEUP

·UVA added 19 newcomers (13 freshmen, 4 grad transfers, 2 four-year transfers) to bolster its 2024 roster. D1Baseball ranked UVA's freshman class No. 21 in the country.

·The Cavalier offensive attack, which co-led the country in team batting average (.332) and led the nation in doubles (172), doubles per game (2.65) and hits (766), returns nearly 60 percent of its at bats from a year ago. The 1,137 returning at bats are the most by UVA since the 2017 season.

·Virginia will need to replace three starting pitchers that all saw action the weekend rotation. Righthander Jack O'Connor, who made 11 weekend starts as a true freshman, will be the Cavaliers' top returning arm.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

·Disharoon Park is in its 23rd season playing as the home of Virginia baseball. The Cavaliers have won 77 percent (593-174) of its games at The Dish since the facility opened in 2002.

·The program's total attendance record (154,507) fell last season and UVA averaged it's second-highest per game total (3,678) in program history.

·The Cavaliers ended the season with five-straight sellouts. Six of the top eight crowds in Disharoon Park history came over the six-game postseason run.

·Virginia finished 37-5 mark at home in 2023, the most home wins of any team in the country and a new program record eclipsing the single-season record of 35 set in 2011 and 2013.

·The 32 regular season home wins were tied for the most in program history (2013).

2023 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the sixth time in program history and the second time in the last three seasons. The six trips to Omaha are tied for the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009.
- Virginia won the ACC Coastal Division Championship for the first time since winning back-to-back titles in 2010 and 2011. Virginia has finished first or second in the Coastal in 10 of the last 14 seasons.
- Virginia was one of five 50-win teams in college baseball in 2023. It marked the fifth 50-win season in program history, all have come in the last 14 years. Only one other team has more 50-win seasons in that span (Louisville).
- UVA's 44 regular season wins are the second-most in UVA history. The program record of 45, has been achieved four times (2006, 2010, 2011, & 2013).
- UVA's 19 ACC wins were the most since 2016.
- Virginia was the last undefeated team in the country, winning its first 14 games. It became the first team in the country to reach 30 wins and the second team to attain 40 wins.
- The 14-game win streak to start the season was the second-longest in program history and the Cavaliers later matched their best 25-game start by winning 23 of their first 25 games.
- The Cavaliers scored 65 runs in the first four games of the season, the second-best offensive output in the recorded Virginia baseball history. The inaugural 1889 club scored 70 through its first four games of its seven-game season.
- Virginia earned the No. 7 National Seed and hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2016 and a Super Regional for the first time since 2015. It marked the fifth top-8 seed in program history.
- UVA was a consensus top-8 team in the final national rankings. The Cavaliers ascended as high as No. 5 in the D1Baseball.com poll and lived in the top-10 for five-straight weeks from March 20 to April 17.
- Virginia went 25-0 against non-conference opponents in the regular season, only the third team since 2010 to accomplish the feat -- Virginia (2023 - 25-0), Texas A&M (2015 - 25-0) and Arizona State (2010 - 24-0).

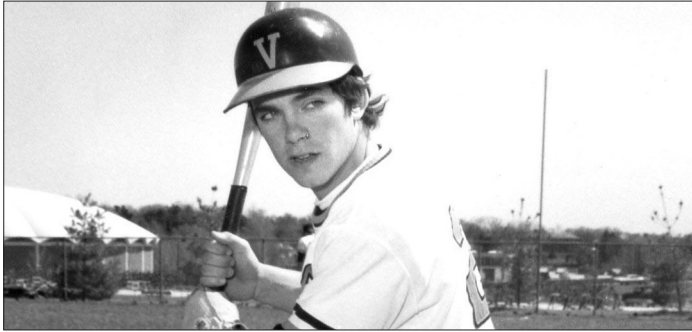
