LEADING OFF

- Six members of the Virginia baseball team were recognized as part of the Atlantic Coast Baseball postseason accolades. The Cavalier duo of Henry Godbout and Henry Ford landed second-team honors while Jacob Ference, Eric Becker and Aidan Teel appeared on the third team, with Tomas Valincius garnering Freshman All-ACC honors.
- UVA enters the ACC Baseball Championship having homered in 20 straight games dating back to April 6 at NC State. The 20-game streak is the longest by the Hoos in the Brian O'Connor era.
- March 29's win over Stanford was coach Brian O'Connor's 900th career victory. With the win, O'Connor became the 15th active head coach in Division I with 900 career wins.
- Entering the ACC Championship, 17 of UVA's 32 wins on the season are of the comeback variety, including May 10th's instant classic walk-off win against Miami.
- UVA is 22-6 on the season when junior Aidan Teel is batting leadoff for the Cavaliers

THE VIRGINIA RESUME

- UVA finished sixth in the ACC, which was only a game and a half out of first place.
- Virginia won 12 of its final 14 games, including its final three ACC series (including at Georgia Tech, a home sweep of Miami and at Virginia Tech).
- Since the start of the Stanford series (March 27), UVA has won 20 of its 26 games.
- The Cavaliers won six of nine ACC series played, including the last four series.
- UVA was one of three ACC teams that did not lose back-to-back league series all season. The other two are Florida State (37-13, 17-10) and NC State (33-18, 17-11).
- Virginia was one of two ACC teams to take a road series at regular-season champions Georgia Tech. The other was Clemson (41-15, 18-12).

RANKING THE HOOS

- Entering the ACC Championship, UVA's arms ranked fourth in the ACC with an ERA of 4.63. Along with ERA, Virginia pitchers are averaging 9.6 strikeouts-per-game to place 31st in the country. UVA has turned 41 double plays this year, which ranks fifth in the ACC. As a team, UVA is batting .309, good enough for 25th nationally and third in the league.
- The power surge since the start of the Stanford series has raised the UVA scoring average to 8.0, which ranks 49th nationally and fifth in the ACC.

- Three-time National Coach of the Year (2006, '09, '15)
- Four-time ACBA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year (2004, '09, '11, '14, '15)
- Five-time ACC Coach of the Year (2004, '10, '11, '13, '14)
- NCAA tournament appearances in 14-straight seasons (UVA had been to three NCAA tournaments prior to his arrival)
- Guided UVA to 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2021, 2023, 2024 College World Series including the 2014 and 2015 CWS Finals
- 2009 trip to CWS was first in school history (Irvine Regional and Oxford Super Regional champions)
- Competed in 18 NCAA regionals and nine super regionals (hosted 10 NCAA regionals and six super regionals)
- Has won nine regionals, seven super regionals
- Led UVA to 2010, 2011 & 2023 ACC Coastal Division titles
- Second fastest in ACC history to reach 600 wins (825 games); only FSU's Mike Martin did so faster (802)
- One of eight coaches in history of ACC with 300 conference wins
- Led teams to ACC Championship games in 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2011 (won '09 and '11 titles)
- Five 50-win seasons (51 in 2010, 56 in 2011, 50 in 2013, 53 in 2014, 50 in 2023)
- Guided UVA to school-record win total each year from 2009-11 (49 in 2009, 51 in 2010, 56 in 2011)
- 97 players picked in Major League Baseball Draft over the last 20 years and 31 have reached the big leagues
- UVA has had 38 All-America and 89 all-conference selections in his tenure

ROSTER MAKEUP

- UVA added 20 newcomers (10 freshmen, 3 grad transfers, 4 four-year transfers, 3 junior college) to bolster its 2025 roster.
- The Cavalier offensive attack that broke single season records for team batting average (.333), runs per game (9.22), home runs (116), home runs per game (1.84), RBI (536) and total bases (1281) returns just over 50 percent of its at bats from a year ago. UVA returns 77 home runs from last year's historic power surge, the most in the ACC.
- Virginia returns 13 pitchers that saw action in 2024. The Cavaliers return a total of 356 innings pitched from 2024's College World Series squad, the most for a UVA pitching staff since 2020 and the second most in the ACC.

ON THE MOUND

- Jay Woolfolk will get the ball on Wednesday for UVA. The righthander leads all Cavalier pitchers with 67 strikeouts on the season. Woolfolk is averaging 10.37 strikeouts per nine innings to place sixth in the league.
- During the 2024 ACC Tournament and postseason, Woolfolk went 2-1 with a 3.66 ERA over four appearances and three games started. During the run to Omaha, Woolfolk fanned 20 batters in 19.2 innings pitched.

PRESEASON HONORS

- Headlined by consensus Preseason All-American Henry Godbout, a total of six Cavaliers landed on Preseason All-American teams.
- Henry Ford was named to three teams while Jacob Ference and Evan Blanco each landed on two. Chris Arroyo was named to D1Baseball's squad and Harrison Didawick found himself on NCBWA's team.
- Virginia is ranked top 5 in all five major College Baseball polls. The No. 2 ranking from D1Baseball is the program's highest preseason slot in the poll since 2015.
- In a poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference coaches, the Virginia baseball team was picked to win the league. UVA was picked to finish first in the conference in 2015, prior to the program's first National Championship.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- The home opening series against Dartmouth saw a combined attendance of 12,641, which was the largest crowd ever for a home-opening series.
- The ACC opening series against Boston College saw 16,301 fans packed Disharoon Park. The most for a regular season home series in program history including the earliest sell out in program history in the weekend finale.
- UVA ranked 14th in the NCAA in total attendance, second highest in the ACC during the 2024 season. The per game average of 4,197 ranked 18th in the country and third in the ACC.
- Disharoon Park was sold out a program single-season record, six times in 2024 including the final four games of the season.
- Virginia went 31-7 at Disharoon Park, the second-straight season UVA has 30 or more wins at home. It was the ninth time the Cavaliers have posted 30 or more home wins.
- Nine of the largest 25 Disharoon Park crowds were in 2024.

2024 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Reached the Men's College World Series for the seventh time in program history and the third time in the last four seasons. The seven trips to Omaha are the second-most of any college baseball program since 2009. Only Virginia, Tennessee and Stanford have appeared in three the last four MCWS.
- Virginia swept through the NCAA postseason, going 5-0 for only the second time in seven trips to the MCWS.
- UVA was the No. 12 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament and was the only team in the country to host NCAA Regionals and Super Regionals in back-to-back seasons.
- Virginia reached the Super Regional round for the ninth time since 2009, only two schools have more appearances in the span (Florida-10, Florida State-10).
- The Cavaliers racked up their 14th 40-win season, 13 of which have come under the direction of Brian O'Connor.
- Virginia's 46 wins were tied for the fifth-most of any team in the country and marked the ninth time in program history UVA had 45 or more wins. All nine 45+ win seasons have come in O'Connor era (2004-present).

- The back-to-back 45-win seasons were the first since 2013 (50 wins) and 2014 (53 wins).
- Virginia lost back-to-back games once in the regular season. It's only the fifth time since 2004 UVA has lost consecutive games once in regular season play - 2024, 2017, 2013 (0 times), 2011 & 2010.
- Virginia registered 23 come-from-behind wins in 2024 including nine in ACC play and three more in the NCAA Tournament.
- UVA went 22-2 in non-conference action during the regular season, one of six teams nationally with two or fewer non-conference losses.
- Virginia captured the inaugural Jacksonville College Classic title at 121 Financial Field in Jacksonville, Fla. After outlasting Wichita State in 10 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers downed then-No. 18 Iowa (12-9) and handed Auburn its first loss of the season with a 6-4 win on Sunday.

O'CONNOR'S 900

- Brian O'Connor reached his 900th Career win on March 29, a 9-8 victory over No. 20 Stanford at Disharoon Park
- Now in his 22nd season, O'Connor is the eighth baseball coach in ACC history to accumulate 900 wins at an ACC institution. His .702 winning percentage is the highest of any active coach in DI baseball (min. 10 years).
- All his career wins have come at Virginia. He became the program's all-time wins leader on May 28, 2016, with his 595th win, a 7-2 victory over Louisville in the ACC Tournament.

LIFE ON THE ISLAND

·For the first time since the 2022 season, the Virginia Cavaliers started the season on the road. The 2025 opening weekend also marked the first time that the Hoos played in Puerto Rico.

·The season opening defeat against Michigan was highlighted by a two-run home run by Puerto Rico native Chris Arroyo in the seventh inning. Jay Woolfolk struck out five batters over 4.2 innings of two-run ball. Jacob Ference tied the school record for hit by pitches in a single game with three. Ference became the sixth Cavalier and first since Caleb Knight in 2018 to be plunked three times.

· In Virginia's first win of the season over Villanova, Bryson Moore did not surrender a hit over his first five innings of work and struck out a career-high, six batters in 5.2 innings of work but did not factor into the decision. Freshman James Nunnallee had a breakout performance by going 3-for-4 with an RBI and two runs scored in the 3-2 victory.

·Powered by freshman Tomas Valincius, UVA prevailed 7-0 over Rice in the weekend finale. In his collegiate debut, Valincius fanned 10 Owl batters over six innings of scoreless one-hit ball for the win. Valincius' 10 Ks were the most by a Virginia freshman since Alec Bettinger struck out 11 against Richmond in 2013. Along with Valincius, Five Cavalier pitchers combined for 15 strikeouts on Sunday, the most in a game since fanning 17 against Columbia on Feb. 24, 2023. Offensively, Henry Ford, Jacob Ference and Aidan Teel each had a pair of hits and scored once in the heart of the Cavalier lineup.

TEXAS ON THE MIND

·On the second weekend of the 2025 season, the Virginia Cavaliers travel to the Lone Star State to participate in the Round Rock Classic.

· In the weekend opener, UVA fell 7-2 to the Oregon State Beavers before bouncing back to take a 4-2 contest against the Minnesota Gophers. The weekend concluded with a 12-inning marathon with Oklahoma that the Sooners took 5-4.

· It marked the fourth time that the Cavaliers have been away from home on the second weekend since 2004 and the second consecutive season.

NOTING THE HOMESTAND

·During the eight-game homestand, the Virginia offense averaged just under 11 (10.6) runs per game on 13.1 hits per game while outscoring opponents 85-44.

· During the same span, the UVA tallied 7.5 strikeouts per nine innings with a total of 50.

·To secure the weekend sweep of Dartmouth, the freshman quartet of James Nunnallee, Chone James, Adien Harris and Jackson Sirois combined for seven hits, seven RBIs and four runs scored in the 13-3 victory.

· UVA's 10-run third inning against William & Mary was the most runs scored at home in an inning since Virginia plated 10 against Longwood in 2023.

· In the Saturday slugfest against Boston College, UVA's nine-run eighth inning is the most runs scored by the Cavaliers at home against an ACC opponent since scoring 10 on Georgia Tech in 2022.

·The 22 runs were the most runs for Virginia in an ACC game since 2010 – 27 vs. Maryland (4/23/10).

CALIFORNIA COMEBACKS

· In the first true road series of the 2025 season, Virginia took two of three from the Cal Golden Bears with both wins coming in comeback fashion.

·Virginia trailed 2-0 after two innings and was down 7-2 entering the ninth inning on Saturday, only to even the weekend series with UVA's sixth come-from-behind victory of the year. The five-run deficit was the largest the Cavaliers have overcome for a victory in 2025.

·The Saturday rally was sparked by the pinch-hit duo of Chone James and Walker Buchanan. The pairing combined for four hits, four RBI and three runs scored in the eighth-inning rally.

· In the weekend finale, the Cavaliers allowed the first run of the game in the bottom of the first before exploding for nine runs in the top of the second to take a commanding 9-1 lead en route to an 11-5 victory.

STANFORD SWEEP

·To close out the month of March, the Cavaliers swept a three-game weekend over then-No. 20 Stanford at Disharoon Park.

·The three-game sweep of the Cardinal was the first home sweep of a ranked team for Virginia since taking all three games from No. 20 Miami in 2023.

·The Cavalier offense produced 33 runs on 44 hits during the three-game series.

· UVA trailed in all three games including a five-run deficit in the middle game and a four-run hole in the series finale.

·The Saturday win was Virginia's second walk-off of the season and the first one involving a base hit.

DIDN'T FALL INTO THE PITT

·After a steady downpour forced a doubleheader on Saturday, UVA took two of three from the Pitt Panthers in a 36 hour span.

· Henry Ford played hero in game one of the doubleheader as the sophomore smacked a two-run walk-off home run. The walk-off was UVA's third walk-off of the season and first that featured a home run.

·To secure the weekend win, the Cavaliers offense exploded for 18 runs in the Sunday finale.

·The 18 runs on Sunday were the second most runs in a game for Virginia this season, only behind the 22-run outburst against Boston College on March 8.

·The 18 runs in the weekend finale were also scored in front of a sellout crowd. Sunday's 18-0 victory was the second of the season and 13th since the start of the 2023 season.

HOT BATS IN HOTLANTA

· In the final ACC weekend of April, the Cavaliers went down to Atlanta and took two of three from then-No. 24 Georgia Tech.

· In the series opener, Virginia rode a seven-run fourth inning to a 12-9 victory. The seven-run fourth featured a pair of two-run home runs from James Nunnallee and Aidan Teel, along with a three-run bomb from Henry Godbout.

·To capture the weekend series, Bradley Hodges dazzled in the first weekend start of his career. The junior surrendered one run on two hits over a career-best seven innings pitched. Hodges also struck out seven Yellow Jackets to tie a career-high.

·Throughout the three-game series, the Hoos hit a total of eight home runs, which is two more than the squad hit in the entire month of February.

NO HURRICANE WARNING NEEDED

· On Senior Weekend, the Cavaliers swept the Miami Hurricanes for Virginia's second ACC sweep of the season.

· In potentially his final home start of his career, senior Jay Woolfolk tossed six innings of one-run ball with seven strikeouts in the series opener. Harrison Didawick and Luke Hanson paced the offense with a pair of home runs.

· In the second game, UVA erased a four-run deficit to walk off the Hurricanes. The walk-off was Virginia's fourth of the season and second off the bat of Aidan Teel.

· In the series finale, Henry Ford homered twice to lift the Hoos over the Canes. It was Ford's second multi-home run game of the season and fifth of his career.

CLAIMED THE COMMONWEALTH

·To close out the regular season, Virginia took two of three from Virginia Tech in Blacksburg.

· In the series opener, the Cavaliers rode eight innings of two-run ball from Jay Woolfolk and a five-run eighth highlighted by a Chris Arroyo home run.

·After dropping the middle game, Virginia bounced back on the final day of the regular season with a 3-1 victory over the Hokies. Tomas Valincius tossed a season-long 6.2 innings of one-run ball. All three Cavalier runs came via home runs off the bats of Chris Arroyo and Jacob Ference.

·With the win, Virginia improved to 113-93 against Virginia Tech and had won back-to-back season series against the Hokies for the first time since the 2019 and 2021 editions of the Commonwealth Clash.

DIDAWICK'S HOME RUN HUNT

·After exploding for 23 home runs in the 2024 season, Harrison Didawick jumped into the top 10 all-time in career homers for the Cavaliers.

·With his recent power surge, Didawick enters the final two weeks of the regular season with 33 career homers in a UVA uniform.

· Eric Becker ranks among the league's best when it comes to batting. The sophomore ranks second in the league with 20 doubles, sixth with 1.43 hits per game, and eighth with a .357 batting average.

· Henry Ford ranks 10th in ACC with a batting average of .356. The sophomore is also averaging 1.47 hits per game to rank fourth in the league and 72nd nationally.

·Aidan Teel's 20 doubles rank the junior with the third-most two-baggers in the league.

· Elsewhere in the lineup, Henry Godbout and James Nunnallee are proving to be two of the hardest outs in the conference. Godbout has a strikeout rate of 10.9 to rank third in the ACC, while Nunnalle enters the weekend with a K rate of 10.6 to place him fourth in the league.

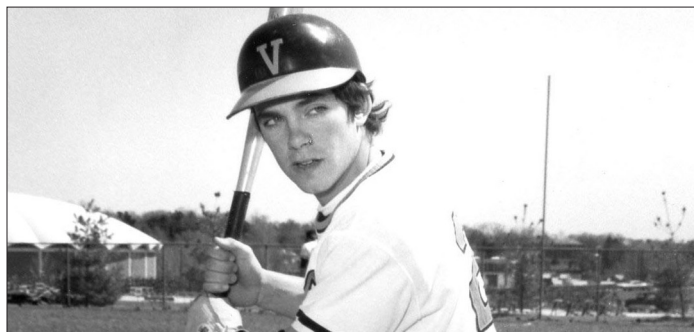
