## LEADING OFF

- Virginia is making its 22nd NCAA Tournament appearance, with 19 of them coming since 2004. Overall, UVA holds a postseason record of 72-49.
- The Cavaliers have reached the College World Series seven times since 2009, which is tied for the second most in the country over that span.
- Dating back to the 2015 national championship season, Virginia is 16-7 in regionals, with four super regional appearances.
- The Cavaliers have won 60 NCAA Tournament games since 2009, the most of any ACC School and fifth-most in the country.
- Entering the postseason, Virginia is averaging 7.9 runs per game, which ranks 31st in the country and seventh in the league. Overall, UVA has scored the 29th-most runs in the country at 453.
- UVA's 95 home runs have powered the power surge throughout the season. The 95 blasts rank 20th nationally and third in the ACC. In 2025, the Cavaliers hit 69 home runs in 50 games as a team.
- A pair of Cavaliers were named to the All-ACC teams when the league announced its league awards last week. AJ Gracia landed second team honors, while Eric Becker garnered.
- In his first season as the Head Hoo, Chris Pollard has guided UVA to 36 wins. The 36 victories to date are the fourth-most by a first-year head coach in the country. Pollard's 36 wins in his inaugural season trail only Brian O'Connor's 44 in 2004 for the most wins by a first-year coach in program history.
- In the opening game of the Louisville series, the Cavaliers claimed their 35th win of the season. The 2026 season is the 19th time that Virginia has cleared that benchmark in the last 25 seasons. In the same time span, only Florida State and North Carolina have more than 35-win seasons in the ACC.

## RECORDS WATCH

- The 2026 season has been on for the record book as this edition of the Cavaliers rank top 10 all-time in runs per game (9th), home runs (2nd), home runs per game (2nd), runs batted in (10th), slugging percentage (6th), total bases (10th), strikeouts per nine (5th) and hit by pitch (5th).
- Entering the Harrisburg Regional, Harrison Didawick has a chance to solidify himself as one of the best to ever wear the orange and blue.
- Out of the bullpen, Lucas Hartman's 24 appearances are tied for second all-time and are only two behind Michael Schwimer's 36 in 2006.
- At the plate, Noah Murray has worked 54 walks on the season, which is tied for the second most in a season. Mike Papi holds the program record with 61 in 2014.
- Eric Becker has been hit by 17 pitches this season, which is tied for the third most by a Cavalier all-time.

### POLLARD NOTES

· Director of Athletics Carla Williams announced the hiring of Chris Pollard as the University of Virginia's Head Baseball Coach on June 10, 2025.

· Pollard arrives in Charlottesville after spending the last 13 seasons at Duke, leading the Blue Devils to a 420-296 record, seven NCAA tournament berths, four Super Regional appearances and two ACC Baseball Tournament championships. His 420 wins are the most by a head coach in Duke baseball history.

· During his time at Duke, Pollard coached 46 Major League Baseball Draft picks, 28 All-ACC selections, nine Freshman All-Americans and seven All-Americans.

· Virginia will be Pollard's fourth stop as a collegiate head coach. Over his 26 seasons as a skipper, Pollard has compiled a career record of 806-614-3, including stops at Pfeiffer (2000-04), Appalachian State (2005-12) and Duke (2013-25). As he did at Duke in 2025, Pollard led Appalachian State to the NCAA Tournament during his final season with the Mountaineers in 2012.

· In his final two seasons in Durham, Pollard led the Blue Devils to back-to-back 40-win campaigns for the first time in program history, culminating in Duke hosting its first Super Regional in 2025.

· The Pollard era in Boone was highlighted by the 2012 Mountaineers winning their first conference championship since 1987 and advancing to NCAA postseason play for the first time since 1986. Appalachian State also claimed four wins over nationally-ranked opponents and spent six weeks in the national rankings. Before the record-breaking 2012 campaign, the Mountaineers boasted just one win over a nationally ranked team since 1982 and one appearance in a major college baseball poll.

· Pollard got his first head coaching gig at DII Pfeiffer University. In his final year at Pfeiffer, Pollard coached the Falcons to the winningest season in school history, a 41-14 campaign that culminated with Pfeiffer's second straight Carolinas-Virginia Athletics Conference regular-season championship and a berth in the 2004 NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional.

### ROSTER MAKEUP

· UVA added 27 newcomers (15 freshmen, eight four-year, three grad and one junior college transfer) to build the 2026 roster.

· Highlighted by preseason All-Americans AJ Gracia, Joe Tiroly and Lucas Hartman, 64 Analytics ranked Virginia as the seventh-best transfer class in America.

· Not to be outdone, Pollard and the staff also imported the fourth-best high school recruiting class according to Perfect Game. Names to watch in the freshman class include John Paone, Noah Yoder and Jayden Stroman.

· Virginia returns 13 players from the 2025 squad that went 32-18 overall and 16-11.

· After being named third-team All-ACC in 2025, Eric Becker leads the 13 returners.

· The five returning pitchers from 2025 combined for 52.2 innings, which is 12% of the season total a year ago.

· Offensively, UVA returns four batters that accounted for 359 at-bats last season. Of the four returns, they totaled just under 21% of all at-bats for UVA.

### ON THE MOUND

· Henry Zatkowski will get the ball on Friday. The lefty is 8-1 on the year with a 4.03 ERA in 17 appearances.

· The lefty leads the Hoos with 92 strikeouts in 80.1 innings pitched.

· The sophomore ranks seventh in the ACC with 88 strikeouts and eighth in wins.

· Zatkowski needs eight strikeouts to become the first UVA pitcher since Connelly Early in 2023 to record 100 strikeouts in a season.

· In the 2025 Athens Regional, Zatkowski tossed 4.2 innings of two-run ball for Duke against Oklahoma State.

### PRESEASON HONORS

· Headlined by consensus Preseason All-American AJ Gracia, a total of four Cavaliers landed on Preseason All-American teams.

· Eric Becker was named to two teams while Joe Tiroly and Lucas Hartman each landed on one team.

· Along with Preseason All-American accolades, Gracia and Becker were each named to the Golden Spikes Watch List. Becker also found himself on the Baseball America Preseason Player of the Year Watch List while Hartman was added to the Stopper of the Year Watch List.

· Virginia is ranked in four of the five major national polls with the Cavaliers checking in at 14 for Baseball America and Perfect Game.

· In a poll of the Atlantic Coast Conference coaches, the Virginia baseball team was picked to finish seventh in the league.

### BREAKING IN THE NEW VIDEO BOARD

· To go along with the debuts on Davenport Field, a new state-of-the-art video board also made its debut on opening weekend and it had plenty to display.

· Over the course of the opening weekend, UVA plated 69 runners in three games. The most ever in a three-game stretch to start a season. The previous high was set in 1889, when the baseball team representing the University of Virginia scored 59 runs in the first three games ever played.

· The weekend was capped off by a 31-8 victory in the Saturday nightcap. The 31 runs broke the previous program for most runs in a game, which was when the Hoos dropped 29 runs on Niagara in 2007.

· Crozet native Noah Murray broke the run record with a three-run blast in the eighth inning. With the home run, Murray became the 15th Cavalier to score five times in the same time.

· Chris Pollard became just the third head coach in program history to win his first three games. The other two coaches were H.H. Lannigan in 1918 and Brian O'Connor in 2004.

### FUN IN THE SUN

· For the first road trip of the 2026 season, Virginia headed south for a round robin tournament hosted by Stetson. The Hoos dismantled the Monmouth Hawks on Friday before falling in walk-off fashion to Stetson on Saturday. UVA rode late-inning heroics to a victory over North Dakota State in the weekend finale on Sunday.

· On Friday, the Hoos smashed seven home runs en route to a 21-8 win over Monmouth. The seven dingers were the most by UVA in a game since hitting eight against George Washington in

2024.

In the weekend opener against Monmouth, the UVA trio of Noah Murray, Sam Harris and AJ Gracia each hit multiple home runs, becoming the first trio of Cavaliers to hit multiple home runs in the same game this century.

### DIDAWICK'S RECORD HUNT

## SPRING CLEANING

- On the third weekend of the season, Virginia swept the VCU Rams in a three-game series that saw the first two games played at Disharoon Park with the finale at The Diamond in Richmond.
- UVA took the series opener by a score of 5-3 and was powered by a career-high eight-strikeout performance by Henry Zatkowski and a leadoff home run from Eric Becker.
- Saturday's game two saw UVA win its first walk of the season as the Cavaliers won 7-6 in 11 innings. AJ Gracia homered while Eric Becker was in the middle of the game-tying play in the ninth and the walk-off in the 11th.
- Sunday's series finale included eight innings of one-run ball from the freshman trio of John Paone, Noah Yoder and Jayden Stroman. Gracia, Sam Harris and Zach Jackson all homered to secure the sweep.

## CAROLINA CONQUERED

- For the opening weekend of ACC play, Virginia took two of three games from No. 8 North Carolina in Chapel Hill. The Cavaliers outscored the Tar Heels 29-13 during the weekend set.
- In game one, UVA rode monster offensive performances from Harrison Didawick, Noah Murray and Eric Becker to a 13-3 victory in seven innings. Henry Zatkowski held North Carolina to five hits over 5.1 innings of work.
- To claim the series, Max Stammel had his best game in a Virginia uniform, surrendering one run in six innings. Zach Jackson and Sam Harris each homered in the 9-2 victory.

## DEFORESTATION AT THE DISH

- For the opening home weekend of ACC play, Virginia took two of three games from in-commonwealth rival Virginia Tech at Disharoon Park.
- In game one, UVA rode a career-high performance from Henry Zatkowski as the lefty fanned 10 Hokies. The Virginia offense exploded for eight runs over the middle third to take the series opener.
- To claim the series, four different Cavaliers homered, led by Sam Harris, who did it twice, as Virginia got a trio of shutdown innings from Kevin Jaxel and Noah Yoder in relief.
- The Saturday series clincher gave Virginia a share of the Smithfield Commonwealth Clash. UVA exited the weekend leading 11-4, with seven sports remaining.

## FRED NATED & BIRDBALLED

- Virginia bookended its four-game road swing with a pair of wins over Maryland in Fredericksburg and Boston College in the weekend series finale.
- During UVA's annual contest with Maryland at Virginia Credit Union Stadium, UVA picked up its ninth comeback victory of the year while also collecting its fifth run-rule victory of the season.
- After dropping the first two games of the weekend series at Boston College, the Cavaliers notched a 3-1 victory to salvage the weekend. The win was UVA's 10th comeback victory of the season and the first win of the year when Virginia trailed in the seventh inning or later.

## MIDSEASON HONORS FOR THE HOOS

- As the calendar turns to April, several Hoos have garnered national attention for their stellar play over the first half of the season.
- Four different Hoos found themselves on the various Perfect Game Midseason All-American teams when the publication announced its selections on Wednesday. AJ Gracia led the way on the first team while Lucas Hartman and Eric Becker landed on the second and third teams, respectively. Noah Yoder was named to the Freshman second team to round out the Virginia quartet.
- D1Baseball also announced its midseason accolades as Lucas Hartman earned second team Midseason All-American honors.
- To go along with his midseason All-American honors, Gracia was named to the Golden Spikes Midseason Watch List. The UVA outfielder was one of 45 amateur baseball players who were named to the watch list.

## SOUTH BEND SLUGGERS

- En route to its first series at Notre Dame since 2019, the Virginia offense came alive by crushing 10 home runs over the course of the weekend.
- In game one, Harrison Didawick cemented his place in the Virginia Blue & Orange as the senior moved to second all-time on the career home run list with a pair of dingers. With the game tied at four in the ninth, a Zach Jackson long ball opened the floodgates as Virginia won 8-4.
- To take the series, UVA exploded for 20 runs on 18 hits, including six home runs from five different Cavaliers in a 20-5 thrashing.

## TAMING THE TIGERS

- To claim its fifth ACC series victory of the season, the Virginia Cavaliers took the opening game and the rubber match from the Clemson Tigers.
- It was the ninth series win for the Cavaliers over the Tigers in 12 tries since the start of the 2006 season.
- In game one, Henry Zatkowski tossed seven innings of two earned run ball while tying a career-high in strikeouts with 10. AJ Gracia homered in the contest, while Jake Weatherspoon's bases-clearing three-run double in the sixth proved to be the difference in the 6-4 contest.
- With Eric Becker and AJ Gracia both out of the lineup, UVA got a pair of home runs from Harrison Didawick and 4.1 innings of one-run ball from John Paone to clinch the series win with a 5-4 victory.

## FELL INTO THE PITT & WENT UNDRAFTED

- For the final ACC series in April, Virginia was swept by the Pitt Panthers at Charles L. Cost Field.
- The series opener on Friday saw Zach Jackson and Joe Tirolly each homer to push the season team total to 76. With the 76 long balls, the 2026 squad passes the 2022 team for the third-most home runs in a season.
- Saturday was the first game since a 4-0 win over Miami on March 27, 2021, that the Virginia offense was held to a single base knock.
- Pitt became the first ACC team to sweep UVA in a three-game series on the road since Notre Dame in 2023.

## ON SENIOR WEEKEND

- To close out the home ACC slate for 2026, the Virginia Cavaliers dropped a weekend senior weekend.
- UVA's lone win of the series came in game two behind a strong pitching performance from John Paone. The freshman went a season-long 7.2 innings with nine strikeouts. The nine strikeouts were the most by a UVA freshman in a game since Tomas Valincius fanned 10 against Rice on Feb. 16, 2025, as part of the Puerto Rico Challenge.
- In the weekend finale, Joey Tirolly became just the seventh player in program history to homer three times in the same game and the first to do it at home since Henry Ford in 2024.

## HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?!?

- After a successful run at Duke, Pollard has brought his entire Blue Devil coaching staff with him from Durham including Brady Kirkpatrick (pitching), Derek Simmons (Infielders), Eric Tyler (Hitting), Brian Sakowski (Director of Recruiting) and John Natoli (Director of Player Development).
- To complement the staff, Pollard also brought in Casey Scott (Director of Operations), Bailey Hill (Athletic Training) and 2025 UVA Bullpen mainstay West Arrington (Assistant Director of Operations & Player Development).
- On the field, 27 new Cavaliers arrived on Grounds in the fall to make up a top ten transfer class and a top 10 high school recruiting class.

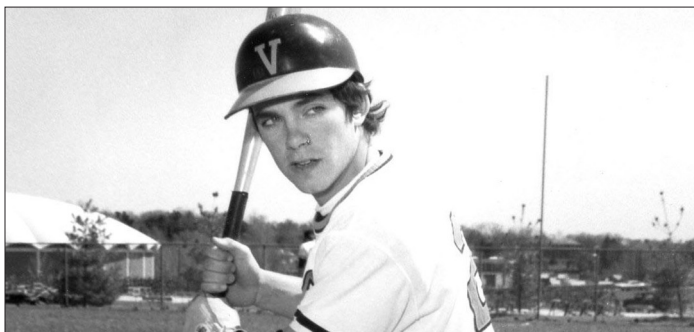
