OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

- Virginia welcomes the Air Force Falcons to Klöckner Stadium on Saturday. Faceoff is set for 4 p.m.
- This week Virginia is ranked No. 8 in the USILA coaches poll and No. 9 in the Inside Lacrosse media poll.

THE SERIES VS. THE FALCONS

- Saturday marks the third all-time meeting between Air Force and Virginia in men's lacrosse. Last year's March 1 meeting at Klöckner Stadium was the first meeting in the series since 2004.
- UVA and Air Force met on a neutral site at the University of Denver, which resulted in a 7-6 win by the Falcons.
- The game, which was part of the Pioneer Face-Off Classic, hosted by the University of Denver, was Virginia's first-ever trip West.
- The 2020 meeting with Air Force was UVA's last home game of the season before the pandemic shutdown the season on March 12.

UVA ON THE GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER

- Virginia owns a 153-40 (.7927) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 2-0 mark in 2021 and are winners of 14 of last 16 played in the historic edifice. UVA also is 12-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- UVA is 26-8 all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- Klöckner Stadium first hosted lacrosse in 1993.



GK Alex Rode made 17 saves in Wednesday's win over No. 19 High Point. His next win between the pipes will make him the sixth Cavalier all-time to win 30 games between the pipes.

COVERING THE CAVALIERS

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos"

was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

UVA VS. THE SOUTHERN CONFERENCE

- The Southern Conference is in its seventh season as a men's lacrosse conference.
- Virginia is 39-3 all-time against current members of the Southern Conference.
- Virginia is 1-1 against Air Force, 3-0 against Bellarmine, 4-2 against High Point, 6-0 against Richmond and 25-0 against VMI.
- There are two Southern Conference opponents UVA has never played: Jacksonville and Mercer.
- All three of those programs started playing lacrosse in the last nine years: Jacksonville (2010) and Mercer (2011).
- The conference as a whole is very young in lacrosse. Richmond began in 2014 and High Point began in 2013. The old guard in the league are Air Force, who began playing lacrosse in 1967, and VMI, who started in 1983.
- By comparison, UVA started its first varsity lacrosse season in 1904.

TIFFANY AND WILSON HISTORY

- This is Air Force head coach Bill Wilson's fifth meeting against UVA head coach Lars Tiffany. The duo faced each other three times in Ivy League play from 2007-2009 when Wilson was the head coach at Dartmouth and Tiffany was at Brown.
- Tiffany is 10-1 all-time as a head coach against Dartmouth, but his only loss came in his first-ever game against DU and Wilson in 2007. Tiffany won the 2008 and 2009 meetings against Wilson's team.
- Wilson has also coached four previous times at Klöckner Stadium, bringing his Dartmouth team to Charlottesville in 2007, 2008 and 2009, followed by Air Force in 2020.

FIRST MEETING BETWEEN UVA AND AIR FORCE ACADEMY: 2004

- Virginia's Justin Mullen scored the game's first goal less than four minutes in, but the remainder of the period saw both teams play rather deliberately. Air Force goalie Justin Pavoni recorded five of his 14 saves in the opening quarter.
- The Falcons capitalized on a Virginia turnover late in the first quarter as Dave Brown scored on a fast break opportunity with 17 seconds to go in the period.
- Virginia took a 3-1 lead into halftime behind second quarter goals by Joe Yevoli and John Christmas.
- The Falcons came out strong to start the second half and clearly controlled the pace of the game as they gained confidence. Greg Dangler brought them within one with a goal at the 4:24 mark and William Meister tied the score at three 58 seconds later. Freshman midfielder Justin Kuchta scored what proved to be the winning goal with 8:34 to go in the quarter. Meister ran the Falcons run to four straight with his second of the quarter with 5:37 left.
- Matt Ward pulled UVA within one at 5-4 by scoring the first of his three goals on the afternoon.
- Air Force tallied twice in the opening three minutes of the final period to build a 7-4 lead. Virginia battled back behind two Ward goals, the last coming with 1:50 to play. The Cavaliers lost the ensuing faceoff, but regained possession when Ricky Smith forced a Meister turnover with less than 40 seconds on the clock. Virginia called a timeout with 33 seconds remaining to set up a final play, but a stingy Falcon defense prevented UVA from getting a shot off before time expired.

LAST MEETING: 2020 AT VIRGINIA (UVA 15, AFA 5)

• Then-No. 8 Virginia cruised to a home victory over the Air Force Falcons, 15-5, at Klöckner Stadium the last time these teams met. It ended up being the final home game of 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic canceling the season on March 12.

• UVA held a 6-3 lead with 5:48 left in the second quarter after Air Force's Ethan Grandolfo scored on a Brandon Dodd helper, cutting UVA's lead to three goals. The UVA vise grip went into effect as UVA went on a 9-0 run and held the Falcons scoreless for the next 32:31 of game action to solidify the win.

• Peter Garno started the run with his second goal of the game with 3:45 left in the second quarter on a Michael Kraus helper. Kraus capped the streak with an extra-man goal on a Jeff Conner assist with 8:52 left to play. Birthday boy Payton Cormier scored twice during the run. In the closing 3:17 of the game, Air Force managed two goals to snap its scoring drought in the losing effort.

• Cormier led UVA with three goals and two assists, while Kraus added three goals and one assist in the win. SSDM Grayson Sallade had two ground balls and caused four turnovers.

UVA VS. THE ACADEMIES

• Virginia has the three service academies on its 2021 schedule. UVA beat Army, 14-9, on Feb. 14. The Cavaliers host Air Force on Saturday and are set to play at Navy on May 1. UVA is the first team since Lehigh in 2013 to have all three service academies on its regular season schedule.

KOLOGY HEATING UP

• Preseason All-American D Kyle Kology is starting to heat up. He has 10 ground balls and six caused turnovers over the past two games.

• Kology had five ground balls and five caused turnovers in the win over High Point while guarding All-American Asher Nolting. While Kology guarded Nolting, the HPU senior did not score a goal. Nolting scored his only goal on an EMO situation while Kology was in the penalty box.

• Nolting had 12 turnovers against UVA last time out.

CORMIER AND SHELLENBERGER MAKING MARKS EARLY

• A/M Payton Cormier leads UVA with 14 goals in just five games. He had 12 goals in UVA's six games in 2020. Cormier also has at least a hat-trick in six of his 11 career games.

• A/M Connor Shellenberger is off to a productive start in his career. He leads the team in points with 22. Shellenberger dished out at least two assists in four of UVA's five games, including season highs of three against Towson, at No. 11 Loyola and against No. 19 High Point.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

• Virginia has been ranked in the top five of the USILA Coaches poll 294 weeks all-time.

• UVA has been ranked in the Top 10 in 442 polls all-time.

• UVA has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 68 all-time polls.

• The USILA Poll began in 1973.

BERTRAND'S GOAL-SCORING STREAK

• Grad transfer Charlie Bertrand has scored at least one goal in all 63 of his career collegiate games. It is the longest active streak of all DI players entering 2021.

• Bertrand's 63-game goal scoring streak is a collegiate record when spanning all DI, DII and DIII players.

UVA GETS A GOAL-SCORING MACHINE IN BERTRAND

• Charlie Bertrand scored 210 goals over 58 career games at Merrimack from 2017-20, which includes at least one in all 58 career games for MC. During that span he helped Merrimack win back-to-back NCAA DI titles in 2018 and 2019, while also being named the NCAA DI National Player of the Year in each of those seasons. Merrimack made the jump to DI in 2020 and Bertrand scored 18 goals and dished five assists for 23 points in just six games in 2020 before the season was canceled due to the pandemic.
 • Bertrand left Merrimack with 274 career points on 210 goals and 64 assists.
 • In his first game with the Cavaliers he tallied four goals and two assists against Towson.
 • In his college career he has recorded at least two goals in 56 of his 63 career games (88.9), while in 43 of his 63 career games (68.3) he scored at least three goals.

VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE

- Virginia is currently No. 1 in the nation with 44.80 ground balls per game.
- Entering 2021, UVA has led the nation in ground balls seven of the last 12 years, including the last four seasons under Lars Tiffany.
- UVA is the only school in the nation to finish in the Top-5 nationally in ground balls per game 11 times over the last 12 seasons.
- Duke is the closest team to UVA, finishing in the Top-5 five times during the same span.
- The only school in 2016 to finish with more ground balls per game was UVA head coach Lars Tiffany's 2016 Brown team.
- Lars Tiffany-coached teams have led the nation in ground balls in six-straight seasons, including the 2015 and 2016 seasons at Brown.

UVA'S RIDING GAME

- The Cavaliers are No. 3 in the nation in the riding game, limiting its opponents to .718 clearing. The two teams ranked higher than Virginia have only played one and two games, respectively, while UVA has played five. Navy (2) and UMBC (1) share the nation's lead at .714.
- In 2020 Virginia was No. 2 in the nation in riding, limiting its opponents to .737 clearing. Bucknell was No. 1 in the nation at .690.
- UVA was No. 2 in the nation in 2019 at .711, trailing only Cleveland State (.707).

MOORE NAMED ACC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK (FEB. 23)

- A Matt Moore (Garnet Valley, Pa.) was named the ACC Offensive Player of the Week on Feb. 23. It was the first career weekly ACC accolade of Moore's career.
- Moore led UVA with five goals in the Cavaliers' 15-12 win at No. 11 Loyola.
- Moore scored three times in a key third quarter that spelled the difference in the game. Twice in the third quarter his goals broke a tie, including for the last time in the game with 2:58 remaining in the period to give UVA a 10-9 lead.
- His fifth goal iced the game in the fourth quarter.

GAVIN NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK (FEB. 16)

- GK Bobby Gavin (San Diego, Calif.) was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 16.
- Gavin made his first collegiate start against No. 12 Army after he was pressed into action for starter Alex Rode, the 2019 NCAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Player, who was not available.
- In just his second collegiate game, Gavin made 13 saves and helped UVA defeat the Black Knights, 14-9.
- After allowing four goals on the first four shots he saw on goal, Gavin saved 13 of the Black Knights next 18 shots on goal to aid the Cavalier defense.
- Gavin also saved seven of nine shots on goal by Army's All-American attackman Brendan Nichtern. He also picked up six ground balls and caused two turnovers in the winning cause.

CONNERS AND FOX REPEAT AS TEAM CAPTAINS IN 2021

- Virginia men's lacrosse head coach Lars Tiffany announced that long-stick midfielder Jared Conners and midfielder John Fox have been selected as captains for the 2021 season, as voted on by their peers.
- Conners and Fox repeat as captains. It makes just the fourth time that UVA has had at least two repeat captains. In 1971 and 1972 it was Jay Connor and Bob Proutt, while in 1985 and 1986 it was Roddy Marino and Jeff Nicklas. Most recently, it was Conor Gill and Mark Koontz in 2001 and 2002.

AITKEN RETURNS TO UVA AFTER FOOTBALL STINT AT VILLANOVA

- Aitken, who graduated from UVA last May with a degree in foreign affairs, enrolled last fall at Villanova to play football.
- With uncertainty of being able to play a full FCS schedule this spring, Aitken was able to transfer back for the men's lacrosse season.

The No. 5 Virginia Cavaliers (1-0) used a seven-goal second quarter to distance themselves from the Towson Tigers (0-1), 20-11, at Klöckner Stadium.

Connor Shellenberger scored seven points on four goals and three assists in his collegiate debut. Payton Cormier added a career-high six goals and one assist, while graduate transfer Charlie Bertrand notched four goals and two assists in his UVA debut.

HOW IT HAPPENED

UVA scored 52 seconds into the game to take an early 1-0 lead on an unassisted Shellenberger score. Towson rebounded with a 4-1 spurt to take a 4-2 lead with 6:26 left in the first frame. Cormier broke through with his first goal at 3:50 in the first quarter to jumpstart a 7-0 Cavalier run, pushing the Cavaliers ahead for good. Cormier scored four times during the run and capped it on a Shellenberger helper with 9:37 left in the second quarter, giving UVA an 9-4 lead.

Leading at the half, 11-5, UVA opened the third quarter scoring on a 7-2 streak to put the game out of reach. A dropdown shot by Peter Garno on another Shellenberger assist closed the third quarter scoring as UVA led 18-7 heading into the fourth quarter.

FROM THE LOCKER ROOM

“Give Towson a ton of credit. The way they came at us in the first quarter – they scored those four goals and hit three pipes. They were all over us. They came to Charlottesville to get a win and they were not intimidated at all. I was really impressed with their team and their coaching staff and how prepared they were. For us, it was getting into a rhythm at the face-off X, and Petey LaSalla started to pick up some tough ground balls and winning the possessions there. I thought we really did a nice job with our shooting. The goalie for Towson, Shane Brennan, was fantastic early and he’s a really talented goalie, but we were smart with our shooting and didn’t take too many shots from too far out. I know Griff Harris stuck one from deep in that first quarter, but for the most part we made sure we got closer and took good shots and got them off his body. There was a tenacity and selling out for loose balls – I’m a very grateful coach and a very grateful man to have a team that is going to sell out for their teammates.” – Lars Tiffany

The Cavaliers won 10-of-13 first-half faceoffs to control possession and alleviate a first-time starter in goal, Bobby Gavin, from a strong Army attack. Gavin, starting for Alex Rode who wasn’t available, allowed four goals on the first four shots he saw from Army. He settled down and shutout Army in the second quarter as UVA held an 8-4 lead going into the intermission.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Army scored first on a Bobby Abshire goal 1:04 into the game. UVA won the next three faceoffs, which resulted in three-straight goals by the Cavaliers, giving UVA a lead (3-1) they never relinquished.
