**OPENING DRAW**

**GAME OVERVIEW**

- Virginia welcomes the High Point Panthers to Klöckner Stadium on Wednesday. Faceoff is set for 3 p.m.
- This week Virginia is ranked No. 8 in the USILA coaches and No. 9 in the Inside Lacrosse media polls. High Point is ranked No. 19 in both polls.

**THE SERIES VS. THE PANTHERS**

- Wednesday afternoon Virginia and High Point meet for the sixth time, a series that UVA leads narrowly, 3-2.
- UVA holds a 38-3 all-time advantage over current teams from the Southern Conference.
- Tuesday marks the first UVA game in 2021 against a SoCon team. The Cavaliers have three SoCon teams on their 2021 schedule, all at Klöckner Stadium. UVA hosts Air Force on Saturday and Richmond on April 3.
- Jon Torpey is in his ninth season as the Panthers' head coach, their only one in program history. The Panthers first season of playing lacrosse was the 2013 season. Torpey and High Point went 2-6 in 2020 before the season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Five of those losses came to ranked teams. In 2019 HPU went 13-3 and was upset by Richmond in the SoCon championship game. High Point won the SoCon in 2015 and made its first NCAA Tournament appearance.



Charlie Bertrand leads all DI players with at least one goal in all 62 of his collegiate games. He is also the only player in collegiate lacrosse (DI, DII, DIII) with 200+ career goals.

**#GOHOOS: BY THE NUMBERS**

- 1** Charlie Bertrand is the only player in college lacrosse (DI, DII, DIII) with over 200 career goals. He currently has 219 career goals.
- 8** Matt Moore needs eight goals to become the 19th Cavalier in program history to reach 100 career goals.
- 62** Charlie Bertrand has a goal in 62-straight games, which is a collegiate record (DI, DII, DIII).

## COVERING THE CAVALIERS

**UNIQUELY UVA**

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

**Grounds:** The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

**First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year:** Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

**Commonwealth:** Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

**UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES**

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

**Legend** has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos"

was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

**THE CAVALIER MASCOT**

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

**UNIVERSITY COLORS**

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

**WAH-HOO-WAH**

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

**THE SERIES VS. HIGH POINT AND THE SOUTHERN CONFERENCE**

- Wednesday marks the sixth meeting in the all-time series with High Point. UVA leads the series, 3-2. HPU won the first meeting in the series in 2016, a 12-11 win in overtime win at Klöckner Stadium.
- Zed Williams scored five goals in the final 25:10 of the game to force overtime. UVA trailed 10-5 until Williams scored his first goal with 5:10 left in the third quarter. That Williams goal started a 4-0 UVA run that cut the deficit to one goal, 10-9. Williams scored the first three in that spurt. After High Point scored with 4:41 left to increase its lead to two goals, 11-9, Williams put UVA on his back and scored twice with under a minute left to force overtime. High Point's Dan Lomas scored the game-winning 27 seconds into the extra frame to clinch the upset for the Panthers.
- Virginia bounced back in 2017 and beat High Point at Klöckner Stadium, 18-12. Dox Aitken scored five goals, while Michael Kraus dished out five assists and scored two goals in the win.
- UVA beat HPU again in 2018 by six goals, 18-12. It was UVA's first trip in the series to High Point. After trailing 5-2 early, UVA surged back to tie High Point 9-9 at the half. UVA outscored HPU 9-3 in the second half to pick up the win. Kraus had seven points again, but this time on five goals and two assists. Ian Laviano tallied four goals and Dox Aitken scored three. Mikey Herring dished out four assists.
- The Panthers responded with a 14-13 win over the Cavaliers at Klöckner in 2019, serving UVA one of only three losses during UVA's 2019 NCAA title season.
- The Southern Conference is in its seventh season as a men's lacrosse conference.
- Virginia is 38-3 all-time against current members of the Southern Conference.
- Virginia is 1-1 against Air Force, 3-0 against Bellarmine, 3-2 against High Point, 6-0 against Richmond and 25-0 against VMI.
- There are two current Southern Conference opponents UVA has never played: Jacksonville and Mercer.
- Those two programs started playing lacrosse in the last nine years: Jacksonville (2010) and Mercer (2011).
- The conference as a whole is very young in lacrosse. Richmond began in 2014 and High Point began in 2013. The old guard in the league are Air Force, who began playing lacrosse in 1967, and VMI, who started in 1983.
- By comparison, UVA started its first varsity lacrosse season in 1904.

**LAST MEETING: 2020 AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM (UVA 18, HPU 15)**

• No. 8 Virginia used a late 3-0 run to outlast the High Point Panthers, 18-15, at Klöckner Stadium the last time these teams met. The win was the 150th by the Cavaliers at Klöckner Stadium.

• High Point tied the game, 15-15, on a Devon Buckshot goal with 9:32 left in the game.

• UVA responded with a 3-0 run to outlast the Panthers. Ian Laviano started the run when Jeff Conner found the attackman on the crease for a goal at 2:57 in the fourth. UVA won the ensuing faceoff and in transition Jared Connors found Michael Kraus with 2:38 left in regulation. Kraus scored an empty-net goal with 43 seconds left to cap the run and secure the win.

• The Panthers opened the game on a 4-1 lead after Dalton Sulver scored with 7:09 left in the first quarter. UVA responded quickly with a 9-1 run, taking a commanding 10-5 lead with 4:31 left in the second quarter. Kraus scored twice during the run and Payton Cormier finished off his first-quarter hat trick.

• High Point utilized an 8-3 run to tie the game, 13-13, as time expired in the third quarter. UVA and HPU traded goals on the way to a 15-15 tie, setting up UVA's final run.

• UVA got eight points from Moore (2-6-8) and seven points from Kraus (5-2-7), while Payton Cormier scored four goals and one assist.

**MOORE VS. HIGH POINT**

• Over his career, A Matt Moore has 16 points in three games against High Point.

• Last year Moore had eight points (2-6-8), while in 2019 he posted seven points (3-4-7). In 2018 playing on the second midfield as a true freshman he scored one goal at HPU.

**MOORE VS. NOLTING (LOOKING TO REBOUND)**

• Both UVA's Matt Moore and HPU's Asher Nolting look to get back on the + column in goals scored on Wednesday.

• Both attackmen had their goal-scoring streaks snapped in losses. Moore had a goal in 29-straight games before not scoring a goal at Syracuse, while Nolting had his streak of 26 snapped at North Carolina on Saturday too.

• Moore's streak was ranked No. 6 in the nation, while Nolting was ranked No. 8.

• Both attackmen kept their active point-scoring streak going. Nolting is No. 6 with a point in all 41 of his career game. Moore is No. 12 with at least one point in 36-straight games.

**UVA ON THE GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER**

• Virginia owns a 152-40 (.7906) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 1-0 mark in 2021 and are winners of 14 of last 16 played in the historic edifice. UVA also is 12-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.

• UVA is 25-8 all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.

• Klöckner Stadium first hosted lacrosse in 1993.

**CORMIER AND SHELLENBERGER MAKING MARKS EARLY**

• A/M Payton Cormier leads UVA with 14 goals in just four games. He had 12 goals in UVA's six games in 2020. Cormier also has at least a hat-trick in six of his 10 career games.

• A/M Connor Shellenberger is off to a productive start in his career. He is tied for the team lead in points with 18, sharing with Cormier. Shellenberger dished out at least two assists in each of UVA's first three games this year, including season highs of three against Towson and at No. 11 Loyola.

**UVA GETS A GOAL-SCORING MACHINE IN BERTRAND**

- Charlie Bertrand scored 210 goals over 58 career games at Merrimack from 2017-20, which includes at least one in all 58 career games for MC. During that span he helped Merrimack win back-to-back NCAA DII titles in 2018 and 2019, while also being named the NCAA DII National Player of the Year in each of those seasons. • The Cavaliers are No. 2 in the nation in the riding game, limiting its opponents to .709 clearing. The only team ranked higher than Virginia has only played one game, while UVA has played four. UMass-Lowell is No. 1 at .708.  
 • In 2020 Virginia was No. 2 in the nation in riding, limiting its opponents to .737 clearing. Bucknell was No. 1 in the nation at .690.  
 • UVA was No. 2 in the nation in 2019 at .711, trailing only Cleveland State (.707).

**VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE**

• Virginia is currently No. 3 in the nation with 41.25 ground balls per game.  
 • Entering 2021, UVA has led the nation in ground balls seven of the last 12 years, including the last four seasons under Lars Tiffany.  
 • UVA is the only school in the nation to finish in the Top-5 nationally in ground balls per game 11 times over the last 12 seasons.  
 • Duke is the closest team to UVA, finishing in the Top-5 five times during the same span.  
 • The only school in 2016 to finish with more ground balls per game was UVA head coach Lars Tiffany's 2016 Brown team.

• A Matt Moore (Garnet Valley, Pa.) was named the ACC Offensive Player of the Week on Feb. 23. It was the first career weekly ACC accolade of Moore's career.  
 • Moore led UVA with five goals in the Cavaliers' 15-12 win at No. 11 Loyola.  
 • Moore scored three times in a key third quarter that spelled the difference in the game. Twice in the third quarter his goals broke a tie, including for the last time in the game with 2:58 remaining in the period to give UVA a 10-9 lead.  
 • His fifth goal iced the game in the fourth quarter.

**GAVIN NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK (FEB. 16)**

• GK Bobby Gavin (San Diego, Calif.) was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 16.  
 • Gavin made his first collegiate start against No. 12 Army after he was pressed into action for starter Alex Rode, the 2019 NCAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Player, who was not available.  
 • In just his second collegiate game, Gavin made 13 saves and helped UVA defeat the Black Knights, 14-9.  
 • After allowing four goals on the first four shots he saw on goal, Gavin saved 13 of the Black Knights next 18 shots on goal to aid the Cavalier defense.  
 • Gavin also saved seven of nine shots on goal by Army's All-American attackman Brendan Nichtern. He also picked up six ground balls and caused two turnovers in the winning cause.

**CONNERS AND FOX REPEAT AS TEAM CAPTAINS IN 2021**

• Virginia men's lacrosse head coach Lars Tiffany announced that long-stick midfielder Jared Conners and midfielder John Fox have been selected as captains for the 2021 season, as voted on by their peers.

The No. 5 Virginia Cavaliers (1-0) used a seven-goal second quarter to distance themselves from the Towson Tigers (0-1), 20-11, at Klöckner Stadium.

Connor Shellenberger scored seven points on four goals and three assists in his collegiate debut. Payton Cormier added a career-high six goals and one assist, while graduate transfer Charlie Bertrand notched four goals and two assists in his UVA debut.

**HOW IT HAPPENED**

UVA scored 52 seconds into the game to take an early 1-0 lead on an unassisted Shellenberger score. Towson rebounded with a 4-1 spurt to take a 4-2 lead with 6:26 left in the first frame. Cormier broke through with his first goal at 3:50 in the first quarter to jumpstart a 7-0 Cavalier run, pushing the Cavaliers ahead for good. Cormier scored four times during the run and capped it on a Shellenberger helper with 9:37 left in the second quarter, giving UVA an 9-4 lead.

Leading at the half, 11-5, UVA opened the third quarter scoring on a 7-2 streak to put the game out of reach. A dropdown shot by Peter Garno on another Shellenberger assist closed the third quarter scoring as UVA led 18-7 heading into the fourth quarter.

**FROM THE LOCKER ROOM**

“Give Towson a ton of credit. The way they came at us in the first quarter – they scored those four goals and hit three pipes. They were all over us. They came to Charlottesville to get a win and they were not intimidated at all. I was really impressed with their team and their coaching staff and how prepared they were. For us, it was getting into a rhythm at the face-off X, and Petey LaSalla started to pick up some tough ground balls and winning the possessions there. I thought we really did a nice job with our shooting. The goalie for Towson, Shane Brennan, was fantastic early and he’s a really talented goalie, but we were smart with our shooting and didn’t take too many shots from too far out. I know Griff Harris stuck one from deep in that first quarter, but for the most part we made sure we got closer and took good shots and got them off his body. There was a tenacity and selling out for loose balls – I’m a very grateful coach and a very grateful man to have a team that is going to sell out for their teammates.” – Lars Tiffany

The No. 3 Virginia Cavaliers (2-0) picked up a key non-conference home win over the No. 12 Army West Point Black Knights (0-1), 14-9. The contest was played at the Lower Turf practice field due to field conditions at Klöckner Stadium.

The Cavaliers won 10-of-13 first-half faceoffs to control possession and alleviate a first-time starter in goal, Bobby Gavin, from a strong Army attack.
