OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

- Virginia hits the road for the first time in 2021 when the Cavaliers head to Baltimore on Saturday to face the Loyola (Md.) Greyhounds. Faceoff is set for 5 p.m.
- Virginia is ranked No. 3 in both the USILA coaches and Inside Lacrosse media polls.
- Loyola is ranked No. 11 in both the coaches and media polls.

VIRGINIA VS. LOYOLA (MD.)

- Saturday marks the 25th all-time meeting between the Cavaliers and Greyhounds in a series that began in 1938. The series took a 23-year hiatus before being rekindled for the 2014 season. Saturday's marks the fifth time in seven seasons these teams have met in Baltimore, which includes 2015, 2017, 2018 and 2019.
- Loyola head coach Charley Toomey is in his 16th season at the helm of his alma mater. He led the Greyhounds to a 4-2 record in 2020 before the season was canceled due to COVID-19.

VIRGINIA AT THE RIDLEY ATHLETIC COMPLEX

- UVA is playing its fifth all-time contest at the Ridley Athletic Complex.
- UVA is 2-2 against the Greyhounds at the edifice, including losing the last two meetings at the complex. Both those losses came in back-to-back game. The first was in the NCAA Tournament's first round of 2018, followed by the 2019 season opener. The 2019 loss was one of UVA's three during its NCAA title season.
- The first game of the Lars Tiffany's UVA tenure was a 16-15 UVA win over Loyola at the Ridley Athletic Complex in 2017.



Payton Cormier leads UVA with nine goals and 12 points. The "Oakville Ox" has a hat-trick in five of his eight career games with the Cavaliers.

#GOHOOS: BY THE NUMBERS

1	UVA is No. 1 in the nation in opponents clearing percentage. The UVA ride has opponents clearing at 57.9 percent.
28	Matt Moore has a goal in 28-straight games, which ranks No. 7 in the nation among active streaks.
51	UVA is averaging 51 ground balls per game, which ranks No. 1 in the nation.
283	Merrimack College graduate transfer Charlie Bertrand has tallied 283 career points (215 gls, 68 assists), including nine at UVA.

COVERING THE CAVALIERS

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos"

was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

THE SERIES VS. THE GREYHOUNDS

- Virginia leads the all-time series with Loyola by a 16-8 margin.
- The series between these programs began in 1938, and only five current Division I programs have an all-time series with UVA that began earlier: Johns Hopkins (1926), Maryland (1926), Yale (1927), Navy (1928) and Penn (1929).
- Saturday marks the eighth year in a row these programs have met.
- UVA and Loyola started the 2014 season off with a bang as UVA escaped with a 14-13 overtime win at Klöckner Stadium. UVA was cruising with a 12-4 lead through three quarters. The fourth quarter started with UVA's Greg Danseglio serving a one-minute slashing penalty, which helped jump-start a nine-goal run by Loyola. The Greyhounds took a 13-12 lead with 18 seconds remaining in regulation when Tyler Albrecht capped the run. Mick Parks won the ensuing faceoff and James Pannell found Ryan Tucker, who scored with one-tenth of a second to force overtime. UVA's Parks won the overtime faceoff and Pannell tallied the game-winning goal with 2:16 left in the overtime period in the instant classic. The game was dubbed nationally via social media as "the most watched game on Twitter."
- UVA manufactured a five-goal third quarter and survived a late rally by No. 7 Loyola to win the 2015 season opener in Baltimore, 13-12.
- Prior to the 2014 meeting, the most recent meeting between UVA and Loyola was in 1991 at Scott Stadium in a match-up between the No. 2 Greyhounds and the No. 3 Cavaliers. Loyola started the game on a 6-1 run and it looked as if the Greyhounds would roll.
- After that lackluster first quarter, UVA jumped on the shoulders of sophomore attackman Kevin Pehlke for a 14-1 run and Virginia never looked back, winning 17-10. Pehlke scored seven goals and finished with 10 points.
- The win in 1991 snapped Loyola's three-game winning streak in the series, and coupled that week with a loss by No. 1 Syracuse, UVA ascended to the top of the polls. At the time it was the first time UVA had been No. 1 in the nation since the end of the 1980 regular season.
- Before Loyola's win in 1987, UVA had enjoyed a 10-game winning streak in the series that spanned from 1947-1986.
- UVA and Loyola played every season from 1982-1988.

LAST MEETING: 2020 AT UVA'S KLÖCKNER STADIUM (UVA 12, LU 9)

- Then-No. 1 UVA used a strong first half to outlast then-No. 14 Loyola, 12-9, at UVA's Klöckner Stadium to open the 2020 season.
- Cavalier goalie Alex Rode tied his career high with 19 saves, including 13 in the first half as Virginia built a 9-3 heading into intermission. Rode earned ACC Defensive Player of the Week honors for his efforts.
- A Matt Moore added three goals and two assists on offense, while A/M Payton Cormier scored three goals in his collegiate debut.
- LSM Jared Conners added six ground balls and three caused turnovers.

FRESHMEN SHINE VS. LOYOLA

- Fourth year Ian Laviano scored six points (five goals, one assist) in his collegiate debut against then-No. 13 Loyola in the 2018 season opener. Along with Matt Moore's three points (two goals, one assist), the duo matched Dox Aitken and Michael Kraus' duo debut in 2017 with nine combined points.
- Aitken (four goals) and Kraus (two goals, three assists) led UVA with nine combined points at then-No. 6 Loyola in 2017.
- The nine combined points by the 2017 and 2018 UVA freshmen duos in a season-opening collegiate debut is the most since Drew McKnight (two goals, four assists) and Jay Jalbert (four goals) combined for 10 points in the 1997 season opener against then-No. 2 Syracuse.
- Laviano became the 8th Cavalier freshman since 1997 to record at least four points in a season-opening debut. Aitken and Kraus were No. 6 and No. 7.
- Laviano was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week and the *Baltimore Sun's* National Player of the Week for his efforts in this year's season-opening win.

LOYOLA'S CHARLEY TOOMEY AND VIRGINIA

- Charley Toomey never lost to the Cavaliers as a player, going 3-0. The 2014 season-opening 14-13 overtime win by UVA was the first time Toomey faced Virginia as a coach. He is now 3-5 against UVA as a coach.
- The two-time All-American goalie made 13 saves for the Greyhounds in the 1990 meeting, a 14-8 Loyola win in Baltimore. Toomey did not play in the 1987 or 1988 meetings, but Loyola came away with wins during the Greyhounds' three-game win streak, the longest of the series for Loyola.
- Toomey served as the NCAA Charlottesville site rep during UVA's 2011 NCAA First Round game with Bucknell, a game that the Cavaliers won in overtime, 13-12, catapulting Virginia to its fifth NCAA title.

FAMILIAR FACE ON LOYOLA SIDELINE

- Former Virginia associate head coach Marc Van Arsdale is in his fourth season as an assistant coach for Loyola.
- Van Arsdale spent 21 years as an assistant coach at Virginia under Hall of Fame coaches Jim Adams and Dom Starsia.
- Van Arsdale's first stint at UVA was from 1991-96, which he left to become the head coach at Penn from 1997-2001. He returned to UVA in 2002 and was the top assistant on UVA's 2003, 2006 and 2011 NCAA title teams.

OFFENSE SPREADING THE WEALTH

- Last time out against No. 12 Army, UVA had five players with 3+ points in the win, highlighted by Payton Cormier's high of five points.
- Charlie Bertrand (1-2-3), Matt Moore (3-0-3), Ian Laviano (2-1-3) and Connor Shellenberger (1-2-3) also added three points in the win.
- Bertrand (6), Cormier (7) and Shellenberger (7) also finished with 3+ points in the season opener against Towson.

GAVIN NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK (FEB. 16)

- GK Bobby Gavin (San Diego, Calif.) was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 16.
- Gavin made his first collegiate start against No. 12 Army after he was pressed into action for starter Alex Rode, the 2019 NCAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Player, who was not available.
- In just his second collegiate game, Gavin made 13 saves and helped UVA defeat the Black Knights, 14-9.
- After allowing four goals on the first four shots he saw on goal, Gavin saved 13 of the Black Knights next 18 shots on goal to aid the Cavalier defense.
- Gavin also saved seven of nine shots on goal by Army's All-American attackman Brendan Nichtern. He also picked up six ground balls and caused two turnovers in the winning cause.

CAVALIERS WELCOME THREE SENIORS USING THE NCAA'S COVID YEAR

- Virginia welcomes two seniors back and one graduate transfer that are utilizing the NCAA's extra year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- M Dox Aitken and LSM Jared Conners, both first-team USILA All-Americans in 2019, return for their fifth year on Grounds.
- UVA welcomes grad transfer Charlie Bertrand from Merrimack College. Bertrand was the 2018 and 2019 DII National Player of the Year after leading Merrimack to back-to-back NCAA titles.
- Bertrand appeared in 58 career games for Merrimack, scoring 210 goals, dishing out 64 assists and notching 274 points for a career. Merrimack made the jump to DI in 2020 and Bertrand scored 18 goals and dished five assists for 23 points in just six games in 2020 before the season was canceled due to the pandemic.

AITKEN RETURNS TO UVA AFTER FOOTBALL STINT AT VILLANOVA

- Aitken, who graduated from UVA last May with a degree in foreign affairs, enrolled last fall at Villanova to play football.
- With uncertainty of being able to play a full FCS schedule this spring, Aitken was able to transfer back for the men's lacrosse season.

BERTRAND HAS A POINT IN 60-STRAIGHT GAMES

- Charlie Bertrand has a point in all 60 games of his career, which ranks No. 1 among active DI players.

UVA GETS A GOAL-SCORING MACHINE IN BERTRAND

- Charlie Bertrand scored 210 goals over 58 career games at Merrimack from 2017-20, which includes at least one in all 58 career games. During that span he helped Merrimack win back-to-back NCAA DII titles in 2018 and 2019, while also being named the NCAA DII National Player of the Year in each of those seasons.
- In his first game with the Cavaliers he tallied four goals and two assists against Towson.
- In his college career he has recorded at least two goals in 54 of his 60 career games (91.5), while in 43 of his 60 career games (72.9) he scored at least three goals.

UVA ON THE GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER

- Virginia owns a 152-40 (.7906) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 1-0 mark in 2021 and are winners of 14 of last 16 played in the historic edifice. UVA also is 12-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- UVA is 25-8 all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- Klöckner Stadium first hosted lacrosse in 1993.

CONNERS AND FOX REPEAT AS TEAM CAPTAINS IN 2021

- Virginia men's lacrosse head coach Lars Tiffany announced that long-stick midfielder Jared Conners and midfielder John Fox have been selected as captains for the 2021 season, as voted on by their peers.
- Conners and Fox repeat as captains. It makes just the fourth time that UVA has had at least two repeat captains. In 1971 and 1972 it was Jay Connor and Bob Proutt, while in 1985 and 1986 it was Roddy Marino and Jeff Nicklas. Most recently, it was Conor Gill and Mark Koontz in 2001 and 2002.

- In 2020 Virginia was No. 2 in the nation in riding, limiting its opponents to .737 clearing. Bucknell was No. 1 in the nation at .690.
- UVA was No. 2 in the nation in 2019 at .711, trailing only Cleveland State (.707).

BERTRAND AND MOORE GOAL-SCORING STREAKS

The No. 5 Virginia Cavaliers (1-0) used a seven-goal second quarter to distance themselves from the Towson Tigers (0-1), 20-11, at Klöckner Stadium.

Connor Shellenberger scored seven points on four goals and three assists in his collegiate debut. Payton Cormier added a career-high six goals and one assist, while graduate transfer Charlie Bertrand notched four goals and two assists in his UVA debut.

HOW IT HAPPENED

UVA scored 52 seconds into the game to take an early 1-0 lead on an unassisted Shellenberger score. Towson rebounded with a 4-1 spurt to take a 4-2 lead with 6:26 left in the first frame. Cormier broke through with his first goal at 3:50 in the first quarter to jumpstart a 7-0 Cavalier run, pushing the Cavaliers ahead for good. Cormier scored four times during the run and capped it on a Shellenberger helper with 9:37 left in the second quarter, giving UVA an 9-4 lead.

Leading at the half, 11-5, UVA opened the third quarter scoring on a 7-2 streak to put the game out of reach. A dropdown shot by Peter Garno on another Shellenberger assist closed the third quarter scoring as UVA led 18-7 heading into the fourth quarter.

FROM THE LOCKER ROOM

"Give Towson a ton of credit. The way they came at us in the first quarter – they scored those four goals and hit three pipes. They were all over us. They came to Charlottesville to get a win and they were not intimidated at all. I was really impressed with their team and their coaching staff and how prepared they were. For us, it was getting into a rhythm at the face-off X, and Petey LaSalla started to pick up some tough ground balls and winning the possessions there. I thought we really did a nice job with our shooting. The goalie for Towson, Shane Brennan, was fantastic early and he's a really talented goalie, but we were smart with our shooting and didn't take too many shots from too far out. I know Griff Harris stuck one from deep in that first quarter, but for the most part we made sure we got closer and took good shots and got them off his body. There was a tenacity and selling out for loose balls – I'm a very grateful coach and a very grateful man to have a team that is going to sell out for their teammates." – Lars Tiffany

The No. 3 Virginia Cavaliers (2-0) picked up a key non-conference home win over the No. 12 Army West Point Black Knights (0-1), 14-9. The contest was played at the Lower Turf practice field due to field conditions at Klöckner Stadium.

The Cavaliers won 10-of-13 first-half faceoffs to control possession and alleviate a first-time starter in goal, Bobby Gavin, from a strong Army attack. Gavin, starting for Alex Rode who wasn't available, allowed four goals on the first four shots he saw from Army. That was as close as Army would get. The Cavaliers outscored the Black Knights 3-0 in the second quarter on goals by Moore and two by Cormier to cushion UVA's lead. Cormier's third goal of the game came with 1.1 seconds left in the first half. UVA's lead never fell below four goals in the second half as the Cavaliers wrapped up the key home win.
