FOR OPENERS

- The Cavaliers are set to open the 53rd season of women's basketball at the University of Virginia when UVA hosts Morgan State at John Paul Jones Arena on Tuesday (Nov. 4) at 7 p.m. on ACC Network Extra (ACCNX).
- Head coach Amaka Agugua-Hamilton is 28-8 against nonconference opposition in her three seasons at the helm at UVA.
- Agugua-Hamilton is a perfect 6-0 in season openers as a head coach
- USF transfer, Romi Levy, needs eight points to eclipse 1,000 in her Cavalier debut
- NC State transfer, Caitlin Weimar, needs 14 rebounds to reach 1,000 for her career
- Virginia is in its 53rd season of women's basketball sporting a 993-563 (.638) record.

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia is set to match up with Morgan State for the sixth time in series history.
- The Cavaliers have won all five of the previous meetings, each of which took place in Charlottesville.
- The last meeting between the teams took place in 2022, Virginia's first season under Head Coach Amaka Agugua-Hamilton. The 84-28 win marked the 12th consecuitive victory to open the Coach Mox era.

PRESEASON HONORS

- Virginia's Kymora Johnson and Sa'Myah Smith picked up preseason honors at the conference and national level.
- Johnson was named to the Naismith Player of the Year Trophy Preseason Watch List, the Nancy Lieberman Preseason Watch List and a first-team All-ACC Selection.
 She was also ranked No. 15 on ESPN's preseason top-25 players in women's college basketball.
- Smith was named to the Katrina McClain Award Preseason Watch List, which honors the nation's best power forward.

ON THE HORIZON

- The Cavaliers will take on Bucknell on Sunday (Nov. 9) at John Paul Jones Arena.
- · Tipoff is set for 2 p.m. on ACCNX
- · Fans can also tune in live on WINA (98.9FM/1070AM).

CULTURE WINS

- Since becoming UVA's sixth head coach in the spring of 2022, one of Amaka "Mox" Agugua-Hamilton's biggest points of emphasis has been establishing a strong culture now and for years to come.
- A few of Virginia's team mantras include: "Grind Now, Shine Later(#GNSL), Culture Wins, and Family.
- Coach Mox has defined her mantra "Grind Now, Shine Later" as 'progress is a process'. When you focus on the work that's in front of you, the results and recognition will fall into place.

CHARLOTTESVILLE'S HOT TICKET

- The Cavaliers have broken the program's record for season tickets sold in both 2024 and 2025. They are expected to break that record once again in 2026.
- On March 3, 2024, UVA hosted 11,975 spectators on Senior Day for a 80-75 win over No. 5 Virginia Tech. The game set a record attendance figure for any women's basketball game in the state of Virginia.
- UVA was fifth in the ACC in attendance in 2025, the only season with higher attendance figures in program history was in 1991-92 when the team was coming off its first national championship appearance.

- Recruited in the nation's No. 13 signing class of 2023.
- Led UVA to its first top-25 ranking in the USA Today Coaches Poll since 2010.
- Spent three seasons at Missouri State where she led the Lady Bears to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2021.
- Two-time MVC Coach of the Year (2020-21).
- 2020 WBCA Rookie Coach of the Year.
- 2021 WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist.
- Recorded nine wins over Power-5 teams in three seasons at MSII
- First African-American woman to be named head coach for any sport at MSU.

VIRGINIA PICKED SEVENTH IN ACC PRESEASON POLL POLL

- · Virginia was selected seventh in the 2025-26 ACC preseason poll
- · The selection marks UVA's highest position in the poll since 2017 when it was picked sixth.
- · Duke was picked as the preseason favorite followed by NC State, North Carolina, Louisville, Notre Dame and Stanford.

THE RETURNERS

- · This season, Virginia returns five players from last year's squad including first team All-ACC Selection and WBCA All-America Honorable Mention Kymora Johnson.
- · The Cavaliers also return Paris Clark, Olivia McGhee, Breona Hurd and Jillian Brown.

NEW FACES

- UVA inked seven players from the transfer portal this offseason including five bigs: Sa'Myah Smith (LSU), Tabitha Amanze (Princeton), Adeang Ring (UCF), Caitlin Weimar (NC State), and Dannelle Arigbabu (West Virginia).
- · Virginia also landed a pair of guards in Raiane Dias Dos Santos (FSU), and Romi Levy (USF).
- · Virginia signed four-star freshman guard Gabby White who ranked No. 96 in the ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruiting

2024-25 SEASON IN REVIEW

- · At 17-15, Virginia recorded its first winning record since the 2017-18 season, its eight ACC wins mark the highest total since the 2019-20 season.
- · The Cavaliers concluded 2024-25 by winning five of their last seven contests, including a win at No. 8 North Carolina, the program's first victory in Chapel Hill since
- · Virginia set a program record for season ticket sales for the second consecutive season in 2024-25. UVA was fifth in the ACC in attendance in 2025, the only season with higher attendance figures in program history was in 1991-92 when the team was coming off its first national championship appearance.
- · Seven of Virginia's 15 losses were by two possessions or

THE 2025-26 SCHEDULE

- · UVA's full season schedule features 28 unique opponents, 10 of which made NCAA Tournament play in 2024-25 and combined for a total of 11 wins in the tournament.
- · Eight of Virginia's opponents earned an eight-seed or higher in the 2024-25 tournament.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- · Under head coach Amaka Agugua-Hamilton, UVA is 28-8 against non-ACC teams.
- · The Cavaliers won their first 14 match ups against non-conference foes before falling to No. 25 Oklahoma, 82-67, on Nov. 19.

JOHNSON IN ELITE COMPANY

- The 2024-25 season featured impressive milestones for Kymora Johnson.
- · Kymora Johnson entered an exclusive club, recording just the third-ever triple double in program history in an 80-67 win over Pitt (Feb. 16) and the first at UVA since 1991.
- · Johnson totaled 20 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 11 assists in the performance.
- · Johnson is one of just two Cavaliers in the history of the program to record a triple double.
- · Dawn Staley first accomplished the feat against NC State (24 pts, 10 reb, 11 ast; 1/12/91) and did it again just over a month later once again against NC State (23 pts, 11 reb, 10 ast; 2/23/91).

JOHNSON JOINS 1K CLUB

- Kymora Johnson became the 37th Cavalier to join the 1,000 point club after scoring 33 points in an 89-69 win over Stanford (Feb. 23).
- The last Cavalier to reach the milestone was Dominique Toussaint who became the 36th member of the club in the 2018-19 season.
- The last player to join the club in her sophomore season was Jocelyn Willoughby in the 2018-19 season. Willoughby ranks No. 9 on the career scoring list with 1,677 points.

AN ELITE DISTRIBUTOR

- · As a freshman in 2023-24, Kymora Johnson set the Viginia freshman record for assists with 183.
- That freshman total ranks as the seventh highest singleseason total in program history.
- She followed her freshman season with another top-10 season with 185 assists as a sophomore in 2025.

WINS OVER RANKED OPPONENTS

- · Virginia went 1-6 against ranked opposition in 2025
- In 2024, the Cavaliers recorded four wins over ranked opponents (at #15 Florida State, vs. #20 North Carolina, at #20 Louisville and #5 Virginia Tech) for the first time since the 2008-09 season,
- Prior to Virginia naming Amaka Agugua-Hamilton head coach on March 21, 2022, the Cavaliers had lost 27 consecutive match ups to ranked opponents.
- Entering its match up against FSU, the Cavaliers were 3-47 in their last 50 games against ranked opponents.
- The win over the fifth-ranked Hokies marked UVA's first over an AP top-5 foe since knocking off No. 4 Florida State on Feb. 16, 2017.
